Puerto Rico Fights Back for Seventh Place

RENO, USA (Aug. 17, 2015) – Puerto Rico fought back from two sets down to defeat Dominican Republic, 17-25, 22-15, 25-17, 25-23, 15-11 on Monday in the Pan American Cup seventh-place match.

Puerto Rico (1-4) got its first victory of the tournament to finish seventh while Dominican Republic (1-5) was eighth.

After Dominican Republic won the first two sets, Puerto Rico found its rhythm in the third, taking a 15-10 lead and increasing it to 22-15 before winning 25-17. Puerto Rico led the fourth set 23-20 when the Dominican Republic pulled to within one point at 23-22. Puerto Rico reached set point on kill from opposite Maurice Torres. The Dominican Republic responded with a block, but Puerto Rico's Josue Rivera won it with a kill.

The Dominican Republic led the tie-breaker 5-1 but Puerto Rico kept up the pressure at the net and also took advantage of Dominican mistakes to tie the score at 9-9 and then lead 11-9. Dominican Republic tied the score at 11-11, but Puerto Rico scored on two spikes by Torres and an ace from Josue Nunez to reach match point. The Dominican Republic was then given a red card to give Puerto Rico the victory.

Puerto Rico led the match in spikes (70-62), blocks (10-7) and aces (3-1). Dominican Republic scored on 31 Puerto Rico errors while committing 21.

Torres led all players in scoring with 24 points on 23 spikes and one ace. Nunez added 17 points for Puerto Rico on 15 attacks, one block and on ace. Jessie Colon had a match-high four blocks for Puerto Rico.

Luis Adames paced Dominican Republic with 23 points on 23 attacks. Henry Lopez added 19 points on 19 spikes.

Puerto Rico captain, Edgardo Goas

"That ace from our middle was the key to the set. Sometimes it's better to be lucky than not but that point was a key point in the match. We kept our composure and I think those last three sets went really well. Yesterday's match we lost in the same way with us having to come back and we fell short but today we finished strong which is that matters."

Puerto Rico head coach, Abdell Otero

"They improved over the course of the tournament. They trained so hard, they weren't like that before mentally. They kept their composure we blocked and served well. If they saw me arguing to the referees they would do the same thing but sometimes I do that for the energy of the team to maintain a high level. But we kept fighting with only one week of practice and a lot of injuries. It was a good win for the team and the program."

Dominican Republic head coach, Jose Alvarez Cutino

"It was a very good match. We played the first two sets very well but the level of play went down in the last three. It was a great match but it was our time to lose. The referee shouldn't be the star of the match. You have to let the players play."



Mexico Defeats United States for Fifth Place

RENO, USA (Aug. 17, 2015) – Mexico played strong defense and took advantage of 32 U.S. scoring errors in a 25-23, 25-20, 25-23 Pan American Cup victory on Monday at the Reno Events Center.

Mexico (2-3) finishes the tournament in fifth while the U.S. (2-3) places sixth.

The U.S. led the match in spikes (38-35) while Mexico led in aces (3-2). The teams tied in blocks (5-5). Twenty of the United States' 32 scoring errors came on serves. Mexico gave up 21 points on errors.

Mexico's hitting efficiency was .264 while the United States' was .239.

Opposite Daniel Vargas led Mexico with 13 points on 12 spikes and one block. Setter Pedro Rangel added seven points on three spikes, two blocks and two aces.

U.S. opposite Kyle Russell, who started the second and third sets, led all scorers with 15 points on 12 attacks and a match-high three blocks. Outside hitter Cody Kessel added nine points on eight spikes and one block.

Mexico head coach, Juan Roberto Vilches

"It was a great victory, the guys played really well. It gave us a lot of confidence because they learned a lot. The younger players really came together, especially the middle blockers who are on the junior team. We accomplished our goal and qualified for the World League. "

Mexico captain, Daniel Vargas

"It was important for us to play relaxed so everyone was loose on the court. It's always fun to play against the United States. We're going back home with a good taste and a lot of work to do in the future."

U.S. captain, Andrew Nally

"The United States volleyball program has a lot to look forward to in the future and the years to come. We have to move on towards our club and university seasons and grab what we can with what we did this week. It's unfortunate that we lost, we didn't perform to our best but we have a lot of good things going for us and we need to focus on that."

U.S. head coach, Jeff Nygaard

"We came in with the team goal of winning this tournament. We quickly recognized as coaches that our real job that we have is teaching these players what the international level is about so we can increase their learning. So when grassroots players of the U.S.A. pipeline are called the next time to represent the U.S. they have this experience to draw on. This tournament has been a wonderful resource because everyone got an opportunity; I got the opportunity to play everyone, everyone contributed at the international level, everyone had a positive impact on the team, and everyone walks away with the feeling that they played here and gained some experience."



Venezuela Outlasts Canada for Bronze Medal

RENO, USA (Aug. 17, 2015) – Venezuela and Canada battled for five sets before the South Americans pulled out the 25-22, 18-25, 25-23, 17-25, 19-17 win on Sunday for the bronze medal at the Pan American Cup at the Reno Events Center.

Venezuela finishes the tournament in third at 4-2 and will head to the FIVB World Cup in September to try to qualify for the 2016 Olympic Games. Canada finishes fourth at 3-3.

After the teams split the first four sets, the fifth set was a battle back and forth. With the score tied 13-13, Venezuela took the first match point on Canada's hitting error, but then Venezuela served out of bounds. Venezuela took match point two more times before Canada took its first match point at 17-16, but then it hit the ball out of bounds. At 17-17, Venezuela outside hitter Willner Rivas served an ace and Kervin Pinerua followed with an attack through the block for the victory.

Ironically, Canada led in all three scoring categories: kills (66-64), blocks (13-3) and aces (7-5). Canada's hitting efficiency was .455 while Venezuela's was .374.

Venezuela scored 32 points on Canada errors while committing 26.

Pinerua led Venezuela with 18 points on 18 spikes. Outside hitters Maximo Montoya and Rivas each added 17 points.

Canada outside hitter Stephen Maar led all scorers with 24 points on 18 spikes, four blocks and two aces. Opposite Casey Schouten added 18 points on 12 spikes, one block and a match-high five aces.

Venezuela captain, Kervin Urbina Pinerua

"We're very happy with a victory. It was a very tough match with a Canada team playing very. It was a beautiful show for these spectators and we're very happy with a bronze medal. I think every player assumed his role and his responsibility on the court in the fifth set."

Venezuela coach, Vicenzo Nacci

"I'm very happy for the guys. We have a lot of problems in our federation to receive proper funds so we are pleased with how we performed. 23 weeks without practicing to come here, there shouldn't be that kind of program. We are happy for the players because this demonstrates the ability that they have. I expect that if I'm able to carry on my plan with better help then I will take them further. I understand the problems in Venezuela but we need more help."

Canada captain, Brett Walsh

"We learned a lot. We're a fairly young team and we gained some good experience. I think we played eight different that all play different styles of play. I think we learned that at this level it takes patience. Sometimes we play a little too overzealous so I think that's a valuable lesson for us going forward."

Canada head coach, Jose Alvare

"I think consistency is something we need to work on. We know we're playing at a high level but we have to maintain that. This is the first competition of the summer for these guys because we can't afford to travel all over the world and unfortunately that shows on the court. This has been a learning experience and hopefully we can build upon it. This is a very good group of players."



Brazil Earns Gold with Win over Argentina

RENO, USA (Aug. 17, 2015) – Brazil lost its first set of the tournament, but came away with the victory and gold medal at the Pan American Cup on Monday at the Reno Events Center.

Brazil defeated Argentina, 22-25, 35-33, 25-17, 25-21 to finish the tournament 5-0 and 15-1 in sets. Brazil got a measure of revenge for its loss to Argentina at the Pan American Games. Argentina finished 4-1. Brazil opposite Alan Souza was named the tournament MVP.

Argentina's first-set win was Brazil's first set loss of the tournament. Argentina held a 23-21 lead in the second set before Brazil used a 3-0 run to reach set point. Argentina's Federicio Martina fought it off with a spike and the battle began. Before the set was over, each team held set point five times. At 33-33, Brazil's Leandro Santos scored on an attack and Argentina knocked its next attack out of bounds.

The loss seemed to deflate Argentina and it never posed a threat in the next two sets.

Argentina led in attacks (62-61) while Brazil dominated the blocking (13-4). Each team had one ace. Brazil's hitting efficiency was .354 and Argentina's .251. Brazil scored 32 points on Argentina's errors while committing 29.

Souza led the scoring with 24 points on a match-high 17 spikes and a match-high seven blocks. Outside hitter Carlos Barreto added 15 points on 13 attacks, one block and one ace.

Middle blocker Facundo Imhoff paced Argentina with 17 points on 14 spikes, two blocks and one ace. Middle blocker Pablo Guzman followed up with 14 points on 12 spikes and two blocks.
