La capitana Karina Flores, una de las más altas de su equipo, dijo que “como mis compañeras son pequeñas pues el saque tiene que ser potente y agresivo, y fue un aspecto a nuestro favor, creo que hemos mejorado, no es todo lo que queremos, pero lucharemos por cerrar bien mañana, incluso hoy jugaron las más nuevas, necesitadas de ese fogueo”.

Hugo Jauregui, DT chileno, señaló más optimista “superamos el juego de ayer que fue el día malo de cualquier equipo en un torneo, hoy el accionar de mis alumnas fue de mayor nivel, el planteo táctico lo pudimos cumplir y es lo que nos sirve para saber que nos falta como mejorar la técnica y el físico, elementos en que las mexicanas nos aventajan”.

## PERÚ SERÁ EL RIVAL DE LAS MEXICANAS EN LA ÚLTIMA JORNADA

La selección de Perú se impuso a Costa Rica 25-6, 25-18 y 25-5 y será el rival de las mexicanas por el quinto escalón de la III Copa Panamericana femenina sub-18 de voleibol en la apertura (14:00 hora local) de la jornada final.

En el segundo triunfo de las peruanas ante tres fracasos, solo la central Maricarmen Guerrero con 11 puntos sobrepasó los dobles dígitos, aunque la opuesta Xiomeli Valencia aportó 9. Por las ticas nuevamente Allison Font fue la que más tributó (5).



El equipo de Costa Rica debe retornar a casa en la madrugada dominical, por lo que finaliza en octavo lugar con cuatro fracasos, en tanto Chile (1-4) se ubica séptimo automáticamente y verá el cierre desde las gradas.

El español Juan Diego García, entrenador de las sudamericanas, aseguró que “hemos superado un día complicado después de la derrota de ayer contra las boricuas, fue un golpe duro, y nos comenzamos a preparar por esa quinta plaza porque mejoraría el sexto que se obtuvo en la segunda Copa”.

Nicole Abreu, la capitana de Perú, analizó que “si bien Costa Rica no es el adversario más fuerte, en el segundo set hicieron bastante puntos por falta de comunicación y desconcentración, pero en el tercero supimos arreglar el juego, ahora volveremos a chocar con México, ante el cual perdimos 2-3 en el grupo A, pero saldremos mañana con todo a ganar”.

Andrés López, el DT centroamericano, manifestó que se marcha con el sabor de que su equipo puede dar más en un futuro, “no obstante estoy consciente que debemos dedicar muchas horas en calidad de trabajo y conseguir jugadoras de mayor talla, pero bueno en dos partidos jugaron todas y espero que retornen con una positiva experiencia de un torneo bien organizado en todos los aspectos, sin excepción”.

Su capitana, Mariana Rodríguez, expresó su alborozo “en parte pues regresamos con cosas nuevas que aprendimos en un nivel que no vemos siempre, aquí la mayor parte de lo mejor del continente y ha servido para comprender dónde mejorar y haber conocido un país tan bonito como Cuba”.

### **DOMINICANAS SUPERAN A BORICUAS EN SENSACIONAL CHOQUE SEMIFINAL**

República Dominicana superó a Puerto Rico 21-25, 26-28, 25-15, 25-18 y 15-9 en el partido más emotivo de la III Copa Panamericana femenina sub-18 de voleibol y discutirá mañana la medalla de oro.

Cuando parecía que las boricuas darían la gran sorpresa por la condición de favoritas de sus vecinas caribeñas, estas reaccionaron e impusieron su juego, destacándose por las campeonas de NORCECA en esta categoría la opuesta Massiel Matos (19), la esquina Natalia Martínez (18) y la central Lisbeth Rosario (11).

Dariana Hollingsworth, opuesta de las combativas adversarias, resultó la máxima anotadora con 21 puntos en el excitante choque que se extendió a poco más de dos horas, en el cual su compañera Paola Salas exhibió sus potentes remates y aportó 19 tantos.

Aunque en los últimos tres parciales las boricuas no pudieron detener la reacción quisqueyana, según las estadísticas estuvieron niveladas en el ataque (44-49) y en el bloqueo (15-11), sin embargo en el servicio la ventaja fue para Puerto Rico (5-11).

El brasileño Alexandre Ceccato, entrenador de las dominicanas, manifestó que “fue un choque difícil, no sé por qué jugaron los dos primeros sets asustadas, no era que las rivales estuvieran



bien, las nuestras con la autoestima baja, es lo que trato de entender y dada la tradicional rivalidad no debimos entregarlos, principalmente el segundo con ventaja de 21 a 16. Después las mías jugaron mejor, las contrarias bajaron la guardia y encontramos su juego”.

La capitana de las ganadoras, Yokaty Pérez, comentó que “tuve que hablar fuerte, esa es una de mis tareas para alertar y motivar, hoy salimos presionadas, nuestra líbero no estaba en su buen día y la titular de esa posición es algo muy importante, no nos salían bien las cosas, pero hubo cambios y felizmente mañana buscaremos el oro con el rival que sea”.

Luis Aponte, director técnico de Puerto Rico, calificó de excelente el partido, pero fallaron en dejar que se crecieran las dominicanas.

“Las teníamos en el piso al iniciar el tercer set, sin embargo no pudimos manejar los errores, nos trabajaron mucho la parte psicológica y fue difícil recuperarnos como en el quinto, que con ventaja de 6-4, buena en un parcial corto, nos hicieron un rally de cuatro y ya las nenas mostraron cansancio. Obvio, damos crédito a las rivales, quienes tuvieron muy buen bloqueo y defensa, además que son más potentes que las mías”.

Joscelyn Coronel, la espigada capitana, opinó que ganar los dos primeros sets provocó confianza en el equipo. “Para mí eso causó que nuestro nivel decayera en el tercero, ellas reaccionaron, realmente nos enfrentamos al nivel de los dominicanas pero no supimos salir del hoyo, pero mañana vamos a superar esto y lucharemos por el bronce”.

### **ARGENTINA ENFRENTARÁ A DOMINICANA EN LA FINAL SUB-18**

Argentina dominó a Cuba 25-15, 25-13, 18-25 y 25-22 en la semifinal y discutirá frente a República Dominicana este domingo la medalla de oro de la III Copa Panamericana femenina sub-18 en el coliseo de la Ciudad Deportiva.

“Estamos muy felices porque estas chicas, que nunca habían llegado a una final continental, han hecho un gran esfuerzo para que Argentina trate de repetir la victoria que logró aquel equipo que se impuso en el 2011 en la primera edición con sede en Tijuana”, manifestó emocionado el entrenador Mauro Silvestre.

“El voleibol en mi país está creciendo y confieso que Cuba siempre ha sido un referente doble para nosotros, hemos copiado mucho de su escuela, sobretodo en el ataque y su juego, por eso estamos tan contentos de ganarle porque tuvimos que estudiar mucho para poder contrarrestar su potencia física, sus remates y bloqueos”, aseguró.

En el triunfo, las máximas anotadoras fueron sudamericanas: Anahi Tosi (14) y Brenda Churin (12), mientras por las anfitrionas sobresalieron Diaris Pérez (11) y la capitana Aidachi Agüero (10).

Precisamente Aidachi felicitó a las argentinas porque supieron aprovechar la pasividad con que entraron a la cancha. “Cuando reaccionamos y quisimos apretar al final no fue suficiente para detenerlas”.



Mientras tanto, la capitana sudamericana, Azul Benítez, dijo excitada “sabíamos que teníamos que salir con todo a romper la cancha, donde tendríamos a la afición en contra, pero estamos acostumbradas a que nuestra selección le ponga garra y actitud a cada partido”.

Tomás Fernández, director técnico cubano, señaló que “las argentinas juegan por un libreto y juntas en la Liga Metropolitana, tienen muchos partidos y con un manejo increíble de la bola, pusieron nerviosas a mis muchachas en la recepción y el fuerte nuestro sobretodo es por el centro de la net y el bloqueo no funcionó, y tuve que improvisar. No nos dejaron jugar por su buen saque, en tanto el ataque de las mías fue muy impreciso, más la ansiedad por la victoria, ahora será muy difícil volver a enfrentar a Puerto Rico por el bronce, ya le ganamos, pero ese equipo ha crecido”.

### **MEXICO DEFEATS CHILE AND WILL PLAY FOR FIFTH PLACE AT U18 CUP**

HAVANA, Cuba, March 21, 2015 – Mexican team defeated Chile 25-15, 25-22, 25-23 and will play for the fifth place of the III Girls' U18 Volleyball Pan Am Cup held at the Coliseum of the Sports City since last Tuesday (17th).

In a match which lasted an hour and 13 minutes, the unique scorer with a double-digit tally was the Central American Kathya García (11); her team-mate Karla Mireles contributed with 9 points like the South American Amalia Carvajal.

Mexico will play for the fifth place against Peru which is favourite today versus Costa Rica as the latter, even surprising their rivals, will finish at the bottom of the table for having scheduled their flight back home on early Sunday. On the other hand Chile, without playing, assures the seventh place.

Cuban, Ricardo Naranjo, coach of Mexico, specified that “the girls have been overcoming the errors of the first two days. Today we based on the service and confidence to spike off the block. We tried to play fast and it worked out. I think it has been one of our best games at the tournament.”

The captain, Karina Flores, one of the tallest players in the team, said that “as my team-mates are short, the attack needed to be powerful and aggressive and it is where we had something in our favour. We have improved. It is not all we wanted, but we will fight for finishing well tomorrow. Today, even the new players played. They needed it to gain experience.”

Hugo Jauregui, Chilean coach, indicated more optimistic that “we improved yesterday's game which was a bad day that any team in this event may have. Today my pupils' game level was higher. We could achieve the tactics as planned and it helps us to know what is missing to improve the technique and fitness which are aspects where the Mexicans are superior.”

Their captain, Catalina Reyes, expressed that “this competition helped us to improve our game level, but we do not have still small details which come as times goes by. We lack mainly much mind and character. With respect to the organization of this event, everything was very good and its people have been very sympathetic. It is my impression in my first travel to Cuba.”



## **PERU IS MEXICANS' RIVAL ON LAST DAY**

Peru won over Costa Rica 25-6, 25-18, 25-5 and will be the Mexicans' rival for the fifth place of the III Girls' U18 Volleyball Pan American Cup in the opening match (14:00, local time) on the final day.

In the Peruvians' second win, only the middle blocker Maricarmen Guerrero (11) topped the double digits, although the opposite player Xiomeli Valencia contributed with 9 points. On the Costa Rica's side, once more, Allison Font was the top scorer (5).

Costa Rican team must come back home early on Sunday morning. Therefore they finish at the eighth place with a four-loss record, whereas Chile (1-4) gets automatically the seventh place and will see the final matches from the seats.

Spaniard, Juan Diego García, coach of the South Americans, assured that "we have overcome a complicated day after yesterday's loss against the Puerto Ricans. It was a tough blow but we have started to prepare to attain the fifth place as we would improve the sixth place obtained at the II Cup."

Nicole Abreu, captain of Peru, analysed that "although Costa Rica is not the strongest opponent, in the second set they tallied too much because of our lack of communication and concentration. However, in the third set we knew to fix the game. Now we will meet Mexico again with which we lost 2-3 in Pool A, but we will play against them with everything we have to win."

Andrés López, the Central American coach, expressed that he is leaving with the taste of his team is able to do much more in the future. "Nevertheless I am aware we must dedicate much time to work on the quality of game level and find taller players. Anyway, all the girls played in two matches and I hope they return home with a positive experience of a tournament which was well organised in every aspect, without any exception."

Their captain, Mariana Rodríguez, commented her joy "as we will come back with new things we have learned in an event with a level we do not always see where the majority of the best from the continent is. It has helped us to understand where we are called to improve and to have the chance to visit a country so beautiful like Cuba."

## **DOMINICANS OVERCAME PUERTO RICO IN SENSATIONAL SEMI-FINAL CLASH**

Dominican Republic overcame Puerto Rico 21-25, 26-28, 25-15, 25-18, and 15-9 in the most exciting match of the III Girls' U18 Pan Am Volleyball Cup and will play tomorrow for the gold medal.

When it seemed the Puerto Ricans would be the greatest surprise given the condition as favourite of their Caribbean neighbours, they reacted and imposed their game. By the



NORCECA reigning team at this category, the opposite player Massiel Matos (19), the outside hitter Natalia Martínez (18) and the middle blocker Lisbeth Rosario (11) excelled.

Dariana Hollingsworth, opposite players of the fighting rivals, was the top scorer (21) in this emotive clash which lasted little over two hours where her team-mate Paola Salas showed her power spike and contributed with 19 points.

Although in the last three sets, the Puerto Ricans could not stop the Dominican reaction which, according to statistics, were similar in spike (44-49) and block (15-11). However, the service was led by Puerto Rico (5-11).

Brazilian, Alexandre Ceccato, coach of the Dominicans, expressed that "it was a difficult match. I do not know why we played the two first sets scared. It did mean the rivals were playing well, but our girls had low self-esteem. It is what I try to understand. As the traditional rivalry, we should not give up particularly the second set where we were leading 21-16. Afterwards, mine played better whereas the opponents relaxed and we discovered their game."

The winning captain, Yokaty Pérez, commented that "I had to speak loudly. It is one of my tasks to alert and motive. Today we entered under pressure. Our libero was not on her best day and it is a relevant position. Things were not working out, but there were changes and happily we will fight for the gold medal tomorrow against any rival whatever it is."

Luis Aponte, coach of Puerto Rico, rated as excellent the match, but they failed to let the Dominicans to grow.

"We got them biting the dust prior to the third set. However we were not able to deal with our mistakes. They worked much on our psychological part and it was difficult for us to recover as happened in the fifth set where with a 6-4 lead which is good particularly for a short set, they made us a four-point rally and the girls showed tiredness. Obviously, we give credit to the opponents who had a very good block and defence and are more powerful than mine."

Joscelyn Coronel, the quite tall captain, stated that having won the two first sets caused confidence within the team. "In mi opinion, it made our game level decreased I the third set. Then they reacted. Actually we met the Dominican level, but did not know how to get out of the hole. However tomorrow we will overcome this error and will fight for the bronze."

### **ARGENTINA AGAINST DOMINICAN IN FINAL OF U18 CUP**

Argentina dominated Cuba 25-15, 25-13, 18-25 and 25-22 in semifinals and will meet Dominican Republic this Sunday for the gold medal of the III Girls' U18 Pan American Cup at the Coliseum of the Sports City.

"We are very happy as these girls, who had never reached a continental final, have made a great effort to make Argentina try to repeat the success attained by that team in 2011 which was champion of the very first edition held in Tijuana", stated, touched, the coach, Mauro Silvestre.



Volleyball in Argentina is growing and I confess that Cuba has always been a double reference for us. We have copied much of the academy from the Island, above all their attack and game. So we are so happy for having won over them as we had to scout them much to be able to counteract their physical power, spikes, and blocks”, assured.

In the triumph, the top scorers were the South Americans: Arahí Tosi (14) and Brenda Churin (12). On the host team, Diaris Pérez (11) and the captain Aidachi Aguero (10) stood out.

Precisely, Aidachi congratulated the Argentineans as they knew to get the most of the passive attitude with which the Cuban team entered the court. “When we reacted and wanted to smash at the end it was not enough to stop them.”

The South American captain, Azul Benítez, excited, said that “we knew we had to play with everything we had to break a court where we had the spectators against us. However we are accustomed to our team playing with impetus and attitude in each match.”

Tomás Fernández, Cuban coach, indicated that “the Argentineans follow a manual and play together in the Metropolitan League. They have played several games and have an unbelievable ball control which made my girls on nerves in the reception and our main strength is through the centre of the net. Moreover, the block did not work out and made me improvise. They did not let us play because of their good service and our attack was not precise in addition to the anxiety for the victory. Now it will be very hard to meet Puerto Rico again for the bronze. We defeated them, but that team has grown up.”
