Dominican Republic Wins second consecutive Pan Am Games Gold Medal beating Brazil

SANTIAGO, Chile, October 26, 2023. - Dominican Republic won its second consecutive Gold Medal at the Pan American Games after defeating Brazil 3-0 (26-24, 25-16, 25-19) in the final of the Women's Volleyball tournament at the 19th edition of the Games Santiago 2023, held at the Arena Parque O'Higgins.

The Dominican Republic has now earned three gold medals in the history of the Pan American Games (Santo Domingo 2003, Lima 2019, and Santiago 2023) and also holds a bronze medal from Toronto 2015. For Brazil, this is their third bronze medal (Mexico 1955, San Juan 1979, Santiago 2023).

Dominican Republic finished the event undefeated 5-0 and Brazil with a 4-1 win-loss record.

After 48 years, Mexico won a medal at the Pan American Games by defeating Argentina in five sets 3-2 (22-25, 25-23, 22-25, 25-18, 15-13) for the bronze medal. Gold Medal Dominican Republic 3, Brazil 0

Dominican Republic won its second consecutive Gold Medal at the Pan American Games after defeating Brazil 3-0 (26-24, 25-16, 25-19). The Dominican Republic has now earned three gold medals in the history of the Pan American Games (Santo Domingo 2003, Lima 2019, and Santiago 2023) and also holds a bronze medal from Toronto 2015. For Brazil, this is their third bronze medal (Mexico 1955, San Juan 1979, Santiago 2023). Dominican Republic finished the event undefeated 5-0 and Brazil with a 4-1 win-loss record. In the first set, the Dominican Republic came from behind 14-17 as Brazil, led by outside hitter Sabrina Machado and middle blocker Lorena Viezel, had the lead. However, thanks to the offensive efforts of the Martinez sisters, Brayelin and Jineiry, along with Candida Arias, the Dominicans tied the score at 17 points, and went on to win a thrilling 26-24 finish. In the second set, opposite hitter Gaila González and outside hitter Yonkaira Peña joined the Dominican offensive, neutralizing Brazil and building a significant lead of 15-7, which proved unbeatable. Despite Dominicans offensive errors, Sabrina Machado and Tainara helped Brazil recover from a four-point deficit (6-10) in the third set. Lorena, with precise blocking, contributed

to keeping the score tied at 13 points. Eventually, the Dominican Republic regained control, sealing the gold medal with a direct serve point from Brayelin Martínez and a comfortable 25-19 lead. The Dominicans outperformed Brazil in every skill of the game, kills (43-31), blocking (11-8), and serves (3-1). Both teams committed 19 unforced errors. Outside hitter Yonkaira Peña led the Dominican offense with 13 points, followed by opposite Gaila González with 12 points and outside hitter Brayelin Martínez with 11 points. The top scorer of the match was Brazilian Sabrina Machado with 14 points. Middle blocker Lorena Viezel scored a match-high of 5 points on blocks.

Bronze Medal Mexico 3, Argentina 2

After 48 years, Mexico won a medal at the Pan American Games by defeating Argentina in five sets 3-2 (22-25, 25-23, 22-25, 25-18, 15-13) for the bronze medal. The last time Mexico reached a Pan American Games podium was in 1975 when they won the bronze medal against Canada. Mexico also won bronze medals in Cali 1971 and Sao Paulo 1955. Their first-ever medal was gold in 1955. Mexico recovered from an unstable start in the first set. Argentina, led by their captain Daniela Bulaich and outside hitter Candela Salinas, took a 6-point lead (14-8). However, Mexico managed to stabilize their attack with Grecia Castro and Karen Rivera. Argentina's blocks stopped them from recovering and led them to commit consecutive errors. Despite Argentina resistance to Mexico's pressure evening the score to 19 in the second set, Mexico, led by opposite hitter Karen Rivera and captain Jocelyn Urías, evened the match to one set each. Opposite hitter María De La Paz Corbalán, along with middle blockers Bianca Farriol and Avril García, helped Argentina win the third set. But in the fourth set, Mexican outside hitter Aimé Topete played a crucial role in forcing a tie-break by scoring three consecutive attack points. Mexico won the fifth set and the bronze medal with a 78-65 advantage in attacking points and 6-0 in service points. Argentina dominated in blocking 12-8 and made fewer unforced errors 17-27. Grecia Castro of Mexico led all scorers with 26 points (22 attacks, one block, 3 aces). Karen Rivera also contributed to the victory with 23 points (19 attacks, one block, 3 aces), and Aimé Topete scored 20 points from direct attacks. Daniela Bulaich and María De La Paz Corbalán scored 15 points each from direct attacks for Argentina. Avril García added 14 points, including a match-high of 8 blocks.

Puerto Rico 3, Cuba 0

Puerto Rico swept Cuba (25-23, 26-24, 25-19) for seventh place. Puerto Rico finished the event with a 2-4 record and Cuba 0-5. Puerto Rico also beat Cuba in pool-play. Despite Cuba's 13-5 huge margin in blocking, Puerto Rico earned the win leading 43-42 in attacks, 6-1 in aces and scoring on 22 opponent errors against 10 of their own. Ivania Ortiz topped Puerto Rico's scorers with 15 points all on kills. Destiny Skerrett followed with 13 points all on kills as well and Neira Ortiz registered 12 points on 8 kills, 2 blocks and 2 aces. Ivy Vila led Cuba with 14 points all on kills. Dayana Martinez added 11 points on 6 kills, 4 blocks and one ace and Yalain De La Peña contributed 10 points on 7 kills and 3 blocks.

Dominicana vino de abajo 14-17 en el primer set que lideraba Brasil comandado por la atacante de esquina Sabrina Machado y la central Lorena Viezel, gracias a la ofensiva de las hermanas Brayelin y Jineiry Martínez, junto a Candida Arias que empataron a 17 puntos, para encaminarse al emocionante cierre 26-24. En el segundo set, la opuesta Gaila González y la atacante de esquina Yonkaira Peña se sumaron a la ofensiva dominicana neutralizando a Brasil y avanzando a una amplia ventaja de 15-7, que fue imposible superar. Sumado a errores de ofensiva por parte de la República Dominicana, Sabrina Machado y Tainara apoyaron a Brasil a recuperarse de un déficit de cuatro puntos (6-10) en el tercer set. Lorena, con bloqueo preciso se sumó al esfuerzo brasileño para mantener el marcador empatado a 13 puntos. Finalmente, República Dominicana tomó nuevamente control sellando la medalla de oro con punto directo de saque de Brayelin Martínez y por cómoda ventaja 25-19. Las dominicanas superaron a Brasil en todos los elementos de juego, ataque (43-31), bloqueo (11-8) y servicio (3-1). Ambos equipos cometieron 19 errores no

forzados. La atacante de esquina Yonkaira Peña encabezó la ofensiva dominicana con 13 puntos, seguida de la opuesta Gaila González con 12 puntos y la jugadora de esquina Brayelin Martínez con 11 puntos. La máxima anotadora del partido fue la brasileña Sabrina Machado con 14 puntos. La central Lorena Viezel anotó el máximo de 5 puntos de bloqueo.

Medalla de Bronce México 3, Argentina 2

Después de 48, México ganó una medalla en Juegos Panamericanos venciendo en cinco sets 3-2 (22-25, 25-23, 22-25, 25-18, 15-13) a Argentina por la medalla de bronce. La última vez que México subió al podio de los Juegos Panamericanos fue en 1975 cuando ganó la medalla de bronce a Canadá. México además ganó las medallas de bronce en Cali 1971 y Sao Paulo 1955. Su primera medalla fue el oro en 1955. México se recuperó de caer en el primer set, luciendo desordenado. Argentina con la ofensiva de su capitana Daniela Bulaich y la atacante de esquina Candela Salinas alcanzó una ventaja de 6 puntos (14-8), aunque México supo estabilizar su ataque con Grecia Castro y Karen Rivera, el bloqueo las argentinas les impidió recuperarse y cometer errores consecutivos. A pesar de que Argentina soportó la presión de México empatando a 19 puntos en el segundo set, México, comandado por la opuesta Karen Rivera y su capitana Jocelyn Urías empataron el partido. La opuesta María De La Paz Corbalán, junto a las centrales Bianca Farriol y Avril García llevaron a la Argentina a ganar el tercer parcial. Pero en el cuarto set, la atacante de esquina Aimé Topete de México fue clave para forzar el tie-break, anotando tres puntos de ataque al hilo. México ganó el quinto set y la medalla de bronce con ventaja de 78-65 en puntos de ataques y 6-0 en puntos de servicio. Argentina dominó el bloqueo 12-8 y cometió menor cantidad de errores no forzados 17-27. Grecia Castro de México fue la máxima anotadora del partido con 26 puntos (22 ataques, un bloqueo, 3 saques directos). También contribuyeron al triunfo Karen Rivera con 23 puntos (19 ataques, un bloqueo, 3 saques directos) y Aimé Topete con 20 puntos de ataques directos. Daniela Bulaich y María De La Paz Corbalán anotaron 15 puntos de ataques directos para Argentina. Avril García sumó 14 puntos incluyendo el máximo de 8 bloqueos.

Puerto Rico 3, Cuba 0

Puerto Rico venció a Cuba en sets corridos (25-23, 26-24, 25-19) por el séptimo lugar. Puerto Rico terminó el evento con un récord de 2-4, mientras que Cuba quedó en 0-5. Puerto Rico también venció a Cuba en la fase de grupos. A pesar de la amplia ventaja de Cuba de 13-5 en bloqueos, Puerto Rico ganó liderando 43-42 en ataques, 6-1 en saques directos y anotando 22 errores del oponente contra 10 propios. Ivania Ortiz lideró a las anotadoras de Puerto Rico con 15 puntos, todos en ataques. Destiny Skerrett le siguió con 13 puntos, también todos en ataques y Neira Ortiz registró 12 puntos, con 8 ataques, 2 bloqueos y 2 saques directos. Ivy Vila encabezó a Cuba con 14 puntos, todos en ataques. Dayana Martinez sumó 11 puntos con 6 ataques, 4 bloqueos y un saque directo, mientras que Yalain De La Peña contribuyó con 10 puntos, con 7 ataques y 3 bloqueos.
