## **Nicaragua no se dejó rendir por Costa Rica**

La Habana, 26 junio, 2016.- La selección nicaragüense pasó apuros pero no se dejó rendir por Costa Rica, al que venció en cinco sets (28-26, 25-20, 13-25, 20-25, 15-13) para sumar su segundo triunfo en el grupo A del Torneo Continental NORCECA sub-19 que tiene lugar en el coliseo de la Ciudad Deportiva.

El equipo vencedor hizo valer su condición de campeón centroamericano de la categoría, en el que también se impuso a los ticos, terceros en ese evento eliminatorio para este NORCECA clasificatorio al Campeonato Mundial del 2017.

Jonny Zeledón, con 32 puntos, fue el máximo anotador del partido que se extendió a casi dos horas, en tanto el otro jugador de esquina, Byron Hernández, también con doble dígitos, al aportar a Nicaragua 14 tantos. Este equipo fue superior en ataque (51-44) y bloqueo (12-6), pero no en el saque (3-5).

Igual por Costa Rica los atacadores auxiliares José Andrés Ortiz y Manrique Carazo con 17 y 14, respectivamente, fueron los únicos que llegaron a las dos cifras.

Osma Hernández, director técnico nicaragüense, está contento por la real posibilidad de avanzar a cuartos de finales, "tenemos que trabajar en función de eso pues los contrarios de la zona B también veo que poseen alcance y fuerza, y si mis muchachos logran ganar mañana considero que es un buen papel subir un peldaño más, el reconocimiento se lo merecen ellos".

Su capitán, Zeledón, de los más altos de los titulares (1,79 m), reconoció que "fue un partido muy duro, nos desconcentramos y perdimos la ventaja, pero en el tie-break nos dedicamos a sacar de paso a nuestros rivales porque se pegaron en el marcador 14-13 luego de estar delante nosotros 14-8, felizmente supimos cerrar el choque".

El DT costarricense Arturo Solano comentó que "constituyó un partido muy duro, es un contrario de nuestra zona geográfica con buenos jugadores, y otra vez a los míos les afectó esa "montaña rusa" de emociones, en el Torneo Centroamericano igual perdimos en cinco parciales".

Nicolás Velluti, un central de buena talla (1,84), señaló estar contento a pesar de que no pudieron rendir a sus rivales y terminar la preliminar con tres reveses, "porque confirmamos que sabemos luchar, remontar diferencias y casi ganar el tie-break, hay que seguir aprendiendo y trabajando duro".

## **Jamaica ganó a Antigua y avanzó a cuartos de finales**

El equipo de Jamaica superó a Antigua y Barbuda 3-0 (25-11, 25-20, 25-16) y tras su único triunfo avanzó a los cuartos de finales del Torneo Continental NORCECA sub-19, ronda que se jugará mañana a partir de las 3 de la tarde.



En 55 minutos los jamaicanos aseguraron el tercer puesto del grupo B en partido en el cual solo el central de Antigua, Cairon Davis, consiguió doble dígitos al marcar 10 puntos. Por los ganadores, Shavar James y Javarie James, aportaron 8 cada uno.

Steve Davis, entrenador de Jamaica, felicitó a sus alumnos, "pues pienso que trabajaron fuerte, igual nuestros rivales, quienes supieron venir de atrás y darnos batalla en el segundo set, lo cual muestra su capacidad mental, nosotros hemos mejorado en cada partido, ojalá esta competencia fuera más extensa".

El capitán Jovan Thomas consideró que "ha sido parte del proceso de aprendizaje de los muchachos por eso creo que jugamos bien y fue un buen resultado".

Olsen Joseph, director técnico de Antigua y Barbuda, manifestó que "resultó un buen encuentro para ambos equipos, aunque perdimos los tres desafíos hoy fue nuestra mejor demostración, pero lamentablemente al final decayó el ritmo de juego".

Su líder, Cairon, expresó que "este choque no estuvo tan complicado como los anteriores, pero no nos fue bien en la defensa del campo, aprendimos que necesitamos mayor agresividad en los partidos y confianza entre nosotros mismos".

### **Cuba detuvo ímpetu de México y avanzó a semifinal**

Cuba avanzó a la ronda semifinal tras detener el ímpetu de México para ganar en cuatro parciales (22-25, 25-23, 25-20, 25-16), así como el grupo B del Torneo Continental NORCECA sub-19 (m) que transcurre en la legendaria Ciudad Deportiva.

En el juego más excitante y de buen nivel hasta la fecha encabezaron la ofensiva de los anfitriones Rey Issac Flores (18), y Cristian Rojas y José Carlos Romero (cada uno con 16), aunque el máximo acumulador resultó el mexicano Miguel Sarabia (19), a quien siguió su compañero Raymond Stephens (12).

Los locales fueron más eficientes en el ataque (49-37) y en el bloqueo (14-7), pero en el servicio los visitantes mostraron mejor balance (1-6), y estuvieron bastante parejos en errores no forzados (32-34).

Nicolás Vives, director técnico de los cubanos, dijo que los jugadores entraron un poco desesperados. "Mucha ansiedad, pero poco a poco fueron alcanzando su ritmo y lo muestra la victoria, que es lo más importante para el equipo, México comenzó muy inteligente, nos tiró fintas, hasta que nosotros logramos organizar el juego".

El líbero Lázaro Yudiel Arrechea, escogido por su entrenador para que hablara en nombre de sus compañeros, expresó que "iniciamos el desafío un poco confiados y nuestros rivales nos entraron por los ojos, pero logramos recuperarnos y a pesar de los errores pudimos superarlos".

Gabri Alarcón, DT mexicana, está contenta, aunque no ganaron hoy, cree que están preparados incluso para mantener las esperanzas de llegar a la final.

"Por ser tan jóvenes son juegos de altas y bajas, y perder el segundo set los desconcentró, hicieron cosas buenas en el tercero y cuarto, pero muy inestables. Sin embargo, no hay que demeritar a Cuba, un equipo muy fuerte físicamente, que en el servicio nos atacó muy duro".

Sarabia, el más productivo del excitante duelo, piensa que fueron muy aguerridos, principalmente en el set inicial. "Luego nos equivocamos, pero si a buen tiempo aprendemos de los errores creo que nos esperan cosas mejores mañana, no dejamos de aspirar a llegar a las semifinales e incluso a la discusión del oro".

### **Estados Unidos, el otro clasificado a semifinal**

La selección de Estados Unidos dominó en sets continuos (25-16, 25-17, 25-21) a República Dominicana para ganar el grupo A y la otra plaza a las semifinales del martes del Torneo Continental NORCECA sub-19 (m), que otorga dos boletos al Mundial del 2017.

Los vencedores fueron superiores en todos los aspectos del juego: en ataque (36-16), en bloqueo (6-2) y en servicio (8-1), cometieron 25 errores no forzados por 35 los caribeños.

Jaylen Jasper, Samuel Lewis y Kyler Presho fueron los únicos con doble dígitos, cada uno con 10 puntos, mientras por los perdedores su líder Bayron Valdéz (9) resultó el de mayor aporte.

"Empezamos a jugar muy bien, los chicos están mejorando en el aprendizaje del sistema de defensa que le estamos enseñando. En el tercer set estuvieron perezosos y les digo que hay que jugar con fuego cada momento, pero a esta edad es muy difícil mantenerse enfocados todo el tiempo", manifestó Samuel Shweisky, entrenador del país ganador del certamen en el 2014.

El capitán Presho, un gigante de California de 2,03 metros, se mostró muy contento por lo que han avanzado. "Todavía nos faltan algunos detalles, lo lograremos en la medida que avance el torneo, pero sin dudas estamos en el camino correcto".

Vicente Paniagua, director técnico de los dominicanos, reconoció que su rival es un equipo mucho más alto y de experiencia, "por eso pienso que mis alumnos jugaron bien y preparándonos a la vez para el choque contra México este lunes en cuartos de finales".

El capitán Valdéz coincidió con su entrenador al asegurar que "lo hicimos bien, es un contrario difícil, pero gozamos cada parcial, en especial el último cuando le anotamos más puntos".

Estados Unidos y Cuba observarán mañana desde las gradas sus respectivos oponentes del martes en los cuartos de finales, donde se verán las caras

Nicaragua-Jamaica (15 horas local) y México-Dominicana (17:00 h). Los ganadores obtendrán los otros dos espacios a la ronda semifinal.

### **Nicaragua does not give in to Costa Rica**

Nicaraguan team had an uphill struggle, but never gave in to Costa Rica to whom defeated in five sets (28-26, 25-20, 13-25, 20-25, 15-13) to add their second triumph in A Pool in the NORCECA Boys U-19 Championship at the Sports City Coliseum.

The winning team asserted itself as Central American champion at this age category where they also won the Costa Ricans who were third ones in that previous qualifying phase for this NORCECA tournament prior to World Championship in 2017.

Jonny Zeledón (32) as the best scorer of a match which lasted almost two hours, and another outside hitter with double-digits, Byron Hernández (14), contributed to Nicaraguan victory. This team was superior in attack (51-44) and block (12-6), except in service (3-5).

On Costa Rican side, the outside hitters José Andrés Ortiz and Manrique Carazo, with 17 and 14, respectively, were the only ones who reached double figures.

Osma Hernández, coach of Nicaragua, is glad with the actual chance of going through to quarterfinals “we have to work on it as in B Pool the rivals also have strength and height. So if my boys get to win tomorrow it would be a good result as we would be climbing a higher step. They are the ones who deserve the recognition”.

Captain, Zeledón, one of the tallest starting players (1.79 m) admitted “it was a really hard match. We lost concentration and therefore the point difference we had. However, in the tie-break, we devoted to drive our rivals out of their mind as they approached in the score (14-13) after we had been leading (14-8). Finally we happily knew how to finish the match”.

Arturo Solano, coach of Costa Rica, commented “it constituted a very tough game. Nicaragua is an opponent, from our geographical zone, who has good players; and once more mine were affected by that “roller coaster” of emotions. In the Central American Tournament, we also lost with them in five sets”.

Nicolás Velluti, a middle blocker with good height (1.84), expressed to be happy despite not being able to defeat their rivals and having finished the preliminary phase with three losses “as we confirmed we do know to fight, come from behind and almost win the tie-break. However we are called to keep on learning and working hard”.

### **Jamaica overcomes Antigua and Barbuda to reach quarterfinals**

The Jamaican team overcame Antigua and Barbuda 3-0 (25-11 25-20, 25-16) and with their unique victory they have gone through to quarterfinals, of the

NORCECA Boys U-19 Volleyball Championship; an event phase which will be held tomorrow from 3:00 pm.

In 55 minutes, Jamaicans assured the third place in B Pool in a match where only the middle blocker Cairon Davis, from Antigua and Barbuda, reached double-digits (10). On the winning side, Shavar James and Javarie James contributed with 8 each.

Steve Davis, coach of Jamaica, congratulated his pupils “as they worked hard as much as our rivals who knew how to make up a point difference and do battle in the second set which demonstrated their mind capacity. We have improved in each match. I would have rather this tournament to be longer”.

Captain Jovan Thomas considered “it has been part of the boys’ learning process. That’s why I think we played well and it was a good result”.

Olsen Joseph, coach of Antigua and Barbuda, expressed “it was a good clash for both squads. In spite of having lost the three matches today’s match was my boys’ best performance although sadly in the end the pace fell down”.

Captain, Cairon, stated “it was an easier game, but it did not go well with our defence. We have learned we must be more aggressive and self-confident”.

### **Cuba stops Mexican impetus to advance on semi finals**

Cuba advanced on semi finals after stopping the Mexican impetus to win in four sets (22-25, 25-23, 25-20, 25-16) and the Pool B of the NORCECA Boys U-19 Volleyball Championship at the legendary Ciudad Deportiva Coliseum.

In the most exciting match and top-level up date the offensive was led by the host players Rey Issac Flores (18), y Christian Rojas and José Carlos Romero with 16 each. However the match best scorer was the Mexican athlete Miguel Sarabia (19) who was followed by his team-mate Raymond Stephens (12).

The local players were more efficient in attack (49-37) and block (14-7), but in service the visitants showed better balance (1-6) and both were similar in unforced errors (32-34).

Nicolás Vives, Cuban coach, said the players entered a little desperate. “A lot of anxiety, but step by step they reached their pace and win which what matters to the team. Mexico started playing quite intelligently, making feints until we were able to organize the playing system”.

Libero Lázaro Yudiel Arrechea, designated by his coach to be talk on behalf of his team-mates, expressed “we started the game a little overconfident and our rivals went in for the kill, but we got to recover from it and in spite of the errors we were able to overcome them.”

Gabri Alarcón, Mexican coach, is glad. Despite not winning today, she thinks they are ready even to hold a hope of reaching the final.



“Given their young age, these are games with ups and downs. So losing the second set made them lose concentration. Then they did some good things in the third and fourth sets, but really instable. However, we can not discredit Cuba, a squad which is very strong physically, who attacked us powerfully with their service.”

Sarabia, the best scorer of this exciting match, classified themselves as very aggressive, especially in the first set. “Then we made errors. Nevertheless if we are able to learn from these errors the future will bring us better things tomorrow. We do not give up reaching the semi finals and even the final match.”

### **United States, the other qualified team to semi final**

United States overpowered Dominican Republic in straight sets (25-16, 25-17, 25-21) to win the A Pool and the other berth to the semi finals of the NORCECA Boys U19 Championship where two tickets are available to the World Championship in 2017.

The winners were superior in all the match performance items: attack (36-16), block (6-2), service (8-1), and made 25 unforced errors whereas the Caribbean made 35.

Jaylen Jasper, Samuel Lewis and Kyler Presho were the only ones who scored double-digits with 10 each, while on the losing side the captain Bayron Valdés (9) was the best one.

“We started by playing very well as the boys have been improving the learning of the playing system we are teaching them. In the third set, they were lazy and I tell them it has to be played with fire at all times”, stated Samuel Schweisky, coach of the reigning country in the tournament held in 2014.

Captain, Presho, a Californian 2.03-meter giant, looked really happily because of their progress. “There are some details left yet, but we will achieve them as the event goes on as obviously we are on the right direction.”

Vicente Paniagua, Dominican coach, admitted his rival is a much taller and experienced team. “Therefore I think my boys played well preparing themselves for the match against Mexico tomorrow in quarterfinals.”

Captain, Valdés, coincided with his coach when stating “we did it well. They are a tough rival, but we got fun in each set, especially in the last one where we scored more points.”

United States and Cuba will follow from the seats tomorrow their respective opponents who will come up from quarterfinals between Nicaragua-Jamaica (15:00 local time) and Mexico-Dominican Republic (17:00 h). The winners will obtain the other two place quotas for semi finals.
