Los ganadores sacaron decisiva ventaja en ataque (41-36) y bloqueo (11-8), pues en los dos últimos parciales los centroamericanos presentaron férrea resistencia, pero los caribeños supieron aplacarla para sellar la victoria en poco más de una hora.

Otra vez el opuesto Jovan Thomas hizo honor a su liderazgo en el equipo al resultar el máximo anotador del encuentro (15), apoyado por Javarie James (13), Shavar James (11) y Andrew Jones (10). Por los ticos lograron doble dígitos los esquinas Manrique Carazo (13) y José Andrés Ortiz (11).

Por su parte, el director técnico de los ticos, Arturo Solano, consideró este desenlace como "una situación acumulada de partidos más la falta de garra de nuestro equipo, que a estas alturas del evento nos pasa factura, los demás son mucho más aguerridos y a nosotros nos cuesta reaccionar, es la propia carga de emociones".

Jamaica en su grupo B finalizó tercero con récord de 1-2 por victoria sobre Antigua y Barbuda (3-0), y reveses ante Cuba (0-3) y México (0-3), en tanto en cuartos de finales perdió frente a Nicaragua (0-3).

Costa Rica concluyó cuarto en el A tras perder contra República Dominicana (2-3), Estados Unidos (0-3) y Nicaragua (2-3).

La selección dominicana no afrontó dificultades para barrer al equipo de Antigua y Barbuda 3-0 (25-11, 25-18, 25-16) y será el rival de Jamaica mañana en la disputa del quinto escaño en el Torneo Continental NORCECA sub-16 (m), clasificatorio al Mundial 2017.

En una hora de juego, los de Antigua encajaron su cuarta derrota consecutiva, mientras sus rivales mejoraron su récord ahora con dos éxitos frente a tres fracasos después de este respiro.

El esquinero Bayron Valdéz nuevamente lideró la ofensiva dominicana, esta vez con 24 puntos, en un partido en el cual el ataque fue el arma fundamental de los ganadores (30-13).

Vicente Paniagua, director técnico de República Dominicana, manifestó que "finalmente tuvimos un partido relajado, esperando a mañana para asumir el compromiso contra Jamaica, un rival difícil porque juega mucho por el centro y no tenemos muchachos grandes en esta posición".

Cuba domina a Nicaragua y asegura boleto al Mundial sub-19

La Habana.- La escuadra cubana dominó a la de Nicaragua 3-0 (25-18, 25-18, 25-14) en la ronda semifinal y aseguró el primero de los dos boletos al Mundial del 2017 que concede el Torneo Continental NORCECA sub-19, con escenario en la Ciudad Deportiva.

De esta forma los locales igualan su actuación del anterior certamen en el 2014, en Tulsa, donde lograron la medalla de plata al caer en cerrado choque contra Estados Unidos.

Los cubanos comenzaron un tanto desorganizados, lo que aprovecharon los nicaragüenses para irse arriba en el marcador, aunque finalmente predominó el potente servicio de los de casa (6-1) y eficiente bloqueo (10-0), que unido a su habitual ataque (36-30) les aseguró el pase a la gran final.

José Carlos Romero (13) y Cristian Rojas (12) encabezaron la ofensiva antillana, pero el máximo acumulador fue el espigado Jonny Zeledón (15), quien se echó al equipo sobre sus hombros, ayudado por su compañero Byron Hernández (11).

Nicolás Vives, director técnico anfitrión, comentó que sus muchachos comenzaron muy desesperados, como casi siempre. "Luego el partido fue yéndose a nuestro lado, pienso que contribuyeron al éxito los jugadores de cambio y que se organizó el bloqueo, así como los contraataques".

El zurdo Cristian manifestó que "no debemos confiarnos ante ningún rival, también comunicarnos más porque de lo contrario afecta a la unidad del grupo y por el oro debemos entrar mañana con todo si queremos ganar, no conformarnos solo con el boleto al mundial".

Osma Hernández, DT nicaragüense, señaló que "ya algunos muestran cansancio, principalmente los atacadores de esquina, además Bayron sintió dolores en un hombro y Jonny se exigió al máximo, eso me alegra porque fue una ardua tarea que cumplió frente a un bloqueo como el de Cuba. No estamos conformes, pero contentos de discutir el bronce".

Zeledón realmente ha hecho un buen torneo, convirtiéndose en puntal para su colectivo. "Siento dolores en el cuerpo, pero alegre porque le hemos dado lucha a todos los equipos y voy a seguir apoyando al mío, Cuba nos desconcertó con su saque, no obstante mañana vamos a despedirnos con un buen espectáculo".

Cuba lideró el grupo B invicto tras imponerse a Antigua y Barbuda (3-0), Jamaica (3-0) y México (3-1) y avanzó directo a semifinales.

Nicaragua en tanto ocupó el segundo lugar en la zona A con triunfos sobre los dominicanos (3-1) y los costarricenses (3-2), y derrota frente a Estados Unidos (0-3) para luego sobrevivir al superar a Jamaica (3-0) en cuartos de finales.

EE.UU ganó a México y defenderá la corona vs. Cuba en Sub-19

Estados Unidos necesitó cinco parciales (17-25, 25-18, 25-23, 23-25, 17-15) para rendir a México en las semifinales y llevarse a casa el segundo y último boleto al Campeonato Mundial 2017 que otorga el Torneo Continental NORCECA sub-19.

Se repetirá entonces la final del 2014 en Tulsa, cuando los estadounidenses vencieron a los cubanos, lo que esta vez el choque por el título será en el coliseo de la Ciudad Deportiva, donde está previsto a las 9 de la noche (hora local).

En el partido más reñido y de mayor nivel hasta esta jornada, ambos equipos se mostraron agresivos por el triunfo, más que todo porque de hecho se jugaban el pase directo al Mundial, cuya tercera plaza de la NORCECA se pondrá en disputa en la Copa Panamericana del propio 2017.

Muy parejos rindieron Estados Unidos y México en ataque (52-53), bloqueo (14-15) y errores no forzados (36-33), en tanto los ganadores aventajaron en el servicio (8-2) a unos rivales de menor estatura, pero mucha garra y disposición.

Repartida estuvo la ofensiva de los estadounidenses, liderada por Brandon Browning, Jaylen Jasper y Joel Schneidmiller, todos con 17 puntos, y 11 por parte de Samuel Lewis, aunque el máximo anotador resultó el mexicano Raymond Stephens (19), escoltado por Jesús Valenzuela (16) y Miguel Sarabia (13).

Samuel Shweisky, entrenador de Estados Unidos, elogió el sistema de defensa utilizado por el colectivo técnico de México, el que calificó de increíble, así como la disciplina de sus alumnos.

"Trabajar con chicos de esta edad es muy difícil, también siento mucho orgullo por los míos, que a pesar de la tensión, lograron mantener la calma mientras los sustitutos apoyaban todo el tiempo y esa lección de armonía es lo que más me toca a mi corazón, cuando no jueguen más serán mejores hombres, padres y esposos", sentenció.

El capitán Kyler Presho reconoció y felicitó a México por su destacada actuación. "Pero nosotros levantamos el juego en los momentos más difíciles y creo que con este partido ya estamos listos para enfrentar a Cuba por la medalla de oro".

Gabri Alarcón, entrenadora mexicana, dijo que "fue un juego muy competitivo, los dos queríamos el pase al Mundial, seguimos con alguna inestabilidad, pero hubo una mayor constancia, un planteamiento táctico en ambos equipos muy bueno y con mucha idea del voleibol de gran nivel".

El capitán Jesús Flores expresó que "no hay palabras para estos momentos cuando se nos escapa por ahora el boleto mundialista, pero lo buscaremos en la Copa Panamericana. Siento que no cerramos lo fuerte que requería el momento a pesar de que hicimos cosas muy buenas, estamos contentos con el trabajo, pero no feliz con el resultado".

Estados Unidos llegó directo a la semifinal al imponerse invicto en el grupo A con triunfos sobre Nicaragua, Costa Rica y República Dominicana, todos por 3-0.

Los mexicanos, por su parte, accedieron a esta penúltima ronda al barrer a los dominicanos (3-0) en cuartos de finales, a donde avanzaron al ocupar el segundo puesto en el lote A por triunfos ante Jamaica (3-0) y Antigua y Barbuda (3-0), y revés frente a Cuba (1-3).

Jamaica defeats Costa Rica and goes for fifth place

Jamaican team defeated Costa Rica 3-0 (25-17, 28-26, 27-25) and will go for the fifth place of the NORCECA Boys U-19 Championship on the closing day scheduled for this Wednesday at the Sports City Coliseum.

The winners took a decisive lead in attack (41-36) and block (11-8), as in the last two sets the Central Americans presented fierce resistance, but the Caribbean knew to appease it to achieve the victory in more than an hour.

Once more, the opposite hitter Jovan Thomas lived up to his leadership in the team by becoming the match best scorer (15), followed by Javarie James (13), Shavar James (11) and Andrew Jones (10). On the Costa Rica side, the outside hitters Manrique Carazo (13) and José Andrés Ortiz (11) scored double-digits.

Fairly, the team captain Thomas did have a big smile on his face. "It was a good game. We have improved and fortunately we showed ourselves better than yesterday when we were defeated by Nicaragua."

Steve Davis, coach of Jamaica admitted that "Costa Rica put up a good fight, but we were stronger and more efficient. Today we did not make as many faults in the net as yesterday when they added up to 15, but only 2 in this match. Likewise the block was better."

Arturo Solano, Costa Rican coach, considered this ending as "a result of a series of problems piled up in a set of games in addition to the lack of fighting spirit which at this stage of the event is affecting us. The other squads are more aggressive, but we have had trouble reacting; as a consequence of the emotions.

Carazo, the team best scorer, stated "actually, we were not so combative, particularly against a uneasy opponent. We decreased our playing level a lot and we were not able to react to it. Anyway, we must continue to better ourselves."

In B Pool, Jamaica finished third one (1-2) with a win over Antigua and Barbuda (3-0) and loses against Cuba (0-3) and Mexico (0-3); whereas in quarterfinals they lost versus Nicaragua (0-3).

In A Pool, Costa Rica was fourth one after losing against Dominican Republic (2-3), United States (0-3) and Nicaragua (2-3).

Dominicans breath again versus Antigua and Barbuda

Dominican team did not have difficulty to sweep Antigua and Barbuda 3-0 (25-11, 25-18, 25-16) to become the rival of Jamaica tomorrow in the game for the fifth place of the NORCECA Boys U-19 Championship, also Qualifying Tournament for the World Championship in 2017.

In an hour-match, Antigua and Barbuda took their fourth defeat in a row; whereas their opponents attained to get better their record (2-3) after this break.

Bayron Valdéz, outside hitter, led again the Dominican offensive (24) in a match where the attack was the main winners' weapon (30-13).

Vicente Painagua, coach of Dominican Republic, stated "finally we had a relaxed game to wait up for tomorrow to assume the commitment against Jamaica who is a tough rival as they play through the centre of the court a lot and for which we do not have tall middle blockers."

Bayron, captain, also said it was an easy match. "Although our opponents do not have much level, we tried to improve what we made wrong against the others. So, hopefully we will enjoy next match in search of the victory.

Olsen Joseph, coach of Antigua and Barbuda, explained unhappily "today my pupils were really confused. They missed many balls and did not pay attention to the instructions I gave. We tried to make the players follow them as instructed, but it was in vain."

Cairon Davis, captain, a middle blocker who is more than two meters tall, confessed the head coach called their attention constantly. "We made errors in the defence, service and pass. In fact, nothing went off smoothly. What is worse, when we tried to react to it it was too late."

Cuba dominates Nicaragua to assure ticket to WCH U-19

Cuban squad dominated Nicaragua 3-0 (25-18, 25-18, 25-14), in the semi-final round, guaranteeing them the one of the two tickets to the World Championship, 2017, available in the NORCECA Boys U-19 Volleyball Championship at the Sports City Coliseum.

That brings the host team about to equal their performance in the previous tournament in Tulsa, 2014, when they were runner-up after being defeated in a close clash by United States.

Cubans started some disorganized and the Nicaraguans took advantage of it to take the lead. However, finally, it prevailed the local powerful service (6-1) and efficient block (10-0) which jointly with their usual attack (36-30) guaranteed them to reach the great final.

José Carlos Romero (13) and Christian Rojas (12) led the Caribbean offensive, but the match best scorer was the tall and slim player Jonny Zeledón (15) who shouldered his team supported by his team mate Byron Hernández (11).

Nicolás Vives, host coach, commented his boys started really desperate, as almost always. "Afterwards the match was on our side. The substitutes, having organized the block and the counterattacks contributed to the triumph."

The left-handed player, Cristian expressed “we should not be overconfident against any rival and we need much communication. Otherwise, it will affect the team unity. For the title, we must enter go in for the kill if we want to win. We should not be pleased with the ticket to the World Championship.”

Osma Hernández, coach of Nicaragua, stated “some players are looking tired, mainly the outside hitters. Moreover, Bayron was suffering from pain in one shoulder and Jonny was doing his utmost. I liked it as it was a hard task he fulfilled against a block like Cuba’s. We are not satisfied, but glad to go for bronze medal.”

Actually Zeledón has played a good tournament, turning into a pillar of his team. “My whole body aches, but I am happy as we have done battle to every team and I will keep on supporting mine. We were disconcerted by Cuba’s service. Nevertheless tomorrow we will farewell with a good sports show.”

Cuba led B Pool undefeated after prevailing over Antigua and Barbuda (3-0), Jamaica (3-0) and Mexico (3-1), which made them to go through to semi finals directly.

Nicaragua finished second-placed in A Pool with wins over the Dominicans (3-1) and the Costa Ricans (3-2) and losses against United States (0-3); and then they survived after beating Jamaica (3-0) in quarterfinals.

United States overcome Mexico to defend U-19 crown vs. Cuba

United States needed five sets(17-25, 25-18, 25-23, 23-25, 17-15) to surrender Mexico and take back home the second and last ticket to the World Championship, 2017, available in the NORCECA Boys U19 Championship whose match for the title will be played against Cuba.

The final match in Tulsa, 2014, when the Americans defeated Cubans will repeat itself, but on this occasion the clash for the title will take place at the Sports City Coliseum as scheduled at 9:00 pm (local time).

In the closest and top-level match up date, both squads showed themselves aggressive to the victory, but mainly as they were fighting for the direct ticket to the World Championship whose third quota place in the NORCECA area will be available in the Pan American Cup, 2017.

United States and Mexico performed quite similarly in attack (52-53), block (14-15) and unforced errors (36-33); whereas the winners led in service (8-2) against less tall opponents, but with fighting spirit and willingness.

The American offensive was distributed. It was led by Brandon Browning, Jaylen Jasper and Joel Schneidmiller with 17 points each and Samuel Lewis (11). However the Mexican player, Raymond Stephens (19) was the match best scorer followed by Jesús Valenzuela (16) and Miguel Sarabia (13).

Samuel Shweisky, coach of United States, praised the defensive system used by the Mexican coaching staff which considered unbelievable as much as their pupils’ discipline.

“Working with boys who are this age is quite hard. I also feel very proud for my boys who, in spite of the pressure, were able to keep calm while their substitutes were supporting at all times. This lesson of harmony is what has touched me in my heart the more. When they decide not play anymore, they will be better men, fathers and husbands”, declared.

Kyler Presho, team captain, recognized and congratulated Mexico for their outstanding performance. “However we came up the game at hardest times and after this match we feel ready to meet Cuba for the gold medal.”

Gabri Alarcón, Mexican coach, said “it was a really competitive game where both of us wanted to obtain the boarding pass to the World Championship. We continued playing with some instability, but there was much more perseverance, a very good top-level Volleyball tactical thinking on both sides.”

Jesús Flores, team captain, expressed "words can not be found at this moment when we have passed up the ticket to the major event. Nevertheless we will go for it in the Pan American Cup. We were not able to finish the match as strong as required at that time despite having made very good things. We are pleased with our performance, but unhappy with the result."

United States came directly to semi finals by winning undefeated in A Pool with victories against Nicaragua, Costa Rica and Dominican Republic in straight sets (3-0).

The Mexicans succeeded to this penultimate round by sweeping the Dominicans (3-0) in quarterfinals to where they went through after reaching the second place in A Pool with wins over Jamaica (3-0) and Antigua and Barbuda (3-0) and a loss against Cuba (1-3).
