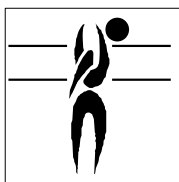

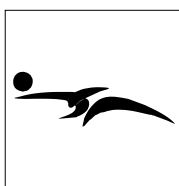

Nathaly Pérez, capitana de Honduras: “Yo les hablo a mis compañeras, les digo que no tenemos que entrar a la cancha con temor, aunque el otro equipo sea superior, que tenemos que defender los colores de nuestro país, estamos en nuestra cancha, con nuestro público”.

“Llevamos más de un año entrenando, tenemos que jugar con confianza por lo que hemos trabajado. A pesar de mi lesión no he podido jugar, pero siempre estoy con ellas animándolas y a total disposición para cualquier consejo”.

Osiel Vásquez, entrenador de Honduras: “Estamos en la segunda fase de la competencia y mañana iremos por el quinto lugar ante Costa Rica que es la potencial de Centroamérica, donde pensamos que será un buen partido, muy exigente para los dos equipos y trataremos de obtener la victoria”.

“El equipo de Costa Rica es alto, bien organizado y con buena recepción, ataque bien dirigido, pero trataremos de hacer lo mejor posible”.

Anthazia Mason, entrenador de Barbados: “Como te he dicho es un equipo joven, necesitamos más partidos, ha sido una gran experiencia estar aquí porque es su primera competencia internacional. Estoy muy feliz de lo que han hecho mis jugadoras con poco tiempo y pocos fogueos. Jugar estos nos da motivación para seguir trabajando”.

Honduras will play for the fifth to win in Barbados

Tegucigalpa, Honduras. August 31, 2018. Honduras had as its main weapon its service and is 18 aces won 3-0 (25-14, 25-16, 25-16) to Barbados and will play tomorrow for the fifth place of the NORCECA Continental Championship U18 women's against Costa Rica.

Rocío Durón with 14 and Andrea Aceituno with 12, were the best scorers for Honduras, and for Barbados, Tannelie Chapman was 12. Aceituno got 8 "ace", while Isabella Rosa contributed six for the locals.

Honduras made the difference with the service (18-4) and in the attack (23-20), in addition to Barbados committed 31 unforced errors, by 15 of the Honduran. Barbados was better in blocking (7-3).

Nathaly Pérez, captain of Honduras: "I told my teammates, I told them we do not have to enter the court with fear, although the other team is superior, that we are in our country, we are in our court, with our public" .

"We have been training for more than a year, we have to play with confidence because of what we have worked in. Despite my injury it was not possible to play, but I am always with them and I am totally ready for any advice."

Osiel Vasquez, coach of Honduras: "We are in the second phase of the competition and tomorrow", for the fifth place against Costa Rica which is the potential of Central America, where we think it is a good match, very demanding for the teams and we will try to obtain the victory " .

"The Costa Rican team is tall, well organized and with good reception, attack well directed, but treatable to do the best possible".

Anthazia Mason, Barbados coach: "As you said it is a young team, it needs more games, it has been a great experience to be here because it is its first international competition, I am very happy with what I have done with my times with little time and few warm-ups, playing these gives us motivation to keep working " .

Canadá gana batalla a Cuba y clasifica al Mundial Sub 18

Tegucigalpa, Honduras. 31 de agosto 2018. Canadá consiguió uno de los dos boletos al Mundial Sub 18 en Egipto y jugará su primera final en los torneos NORCECA al superar en una emocionante batalla de cinco set 3-2 (18-25, 25-19, 20-25, 25-23, 16-14) a Cuba, en el Campeonato Continental NORCECA U18 femenino.

Las canadienses se recuperaron en el cuarto set de una desventaja de 4 puntos para empatar el juego a dos set por bando, y en el quinto también vinieron de atrás al ir perdiendo 10-14, para ganar 16-14 y avanzar a su primer final en esta categoría, asegurando medalla de plata, superando la de bronce lograda hace 20 años.

Cuatro jugadoras de Canadá superaron el doble dígito, con Katarina Pantovic y Anna Smrek logrando 13 y Raekelle Powell y Emma Mckinnon, con 12, quienes no fueron titulares en el primer set.

Thainalien Castillo con 22 puntos fue la mejor anotadora del juego, 15 por ataque, mientras la capitana Thalia Moreno aportó 16, Dezirett Madan con 14 y 13 de Dayana Martínez. Cuba lideró el ataque 56-37, el servicio 14-10, pero quedaron atrás en bloqueo 8-14, además le concedieron 43 puntos por errores no forzados a su oponente, que solo cometió 28.

Hannah Duchesneau, capitana de Canadá: “Lo que nos pasó esta noche fue que creímos, siempre creíamos... Nuestro equipo confió en que podíamos obtener el triunfo... nosotros creíamos... en el cuarto set estábamos cuatro puntos abajo y creímos, queríamos esta victoria”.

“Estaba en la banca en los últimos set, pero también hay que estar preparada para estar en la banca y entrar al juego, debes llegar con un trabajo muy fuerte, tener concentración, pero todas estábamos apoyando, tanto las que estábamos afuera, así como el público”.

Dale Melnick, entrenadora de Canadá, con lágrimas en el rostro y su voz cortada por la emoción dijo que “estoy muy orgullosa, con solamente siete semanas, esta generación, estas 12 jugadoras y dos más que están en casa es la mejor, es el equipo élite que tenemos en Canadá. Sólo me siento muy orgullosa de estas chicas”.

“Hace 20 años ganamos medalla de bronce, esta medalla es para esa generación. Canadá está de vuelta a lo más alto”, dijo muy emocionada Melnick.

Thalia Moreno, capitana de Cuba: “Tanto Canadá como nosotros jugamos muy bien, tal vez en el primer partido (en la fase de grupo) ellas estaban nerviosas, Canadá es un buen equipo, juegan en conjunto y ahora demostraron lo fuerte que son. Vamos a tratar de no cometer los mismo errores que cometimos hoy en el partido por la medalla de bronce”.

Jaime Echevarri, entrenador de Cuba: "Canadá es un equipo que vino de menos a más, es un gran equipo. Presentó una defensa impresionante, las nuestras estuvieron un poco desconcentradas, el momento no se cumplió el plan táctico, se perdió porque no salió el recibo".

"El saque de los primeros set fue un poco inestable, fallaron mucho. En todo sentido Canadá presentó una combatividad admirable. Se ve que nos estudiaron muy bien, al final tuvimos la victoria dos veces en el quinto set y nos falló el recibo de jugadoras claves".

Canadá enfrentará al ganador del juego entre Estados Unidos y República Dominicana.

Canada wins battle against Cuba and qualifies for World Champ U 18

Tegucigalpa, Honduras. August 31, 2018. Canada got one of the two tickets to the U18 World Championship in Egypt and will play its first NORCECA tournament final by beating in an exciting five-set battle 3-2 (18-25, 25-19, 20- 25, 25-23, 16-14) to Cuba, in the NORCECA U18 Women's Continental Championship.

The Canadians recovered in the fourth set of a disadvantage of 4 points to tie the game to two sets per side, and in the fifth they also came back as they went losing 10-14, to win 16-14 and advance to their first final in this category, securing a silver medal, surpassing the bronze medal achieved 20 years ago.

Four players from Canada got the double digit, with Katarina Pantovic and Anna Smrek achieving 13 and Raekelle Powell and Emma Mckinnon, with 12, who were not starters in the first set.

Thainalien Castillo with 22 points was the best scorer of the game, 15 per attack, while captain of Cuba Thalia Moreno contributed 16, 14 for Dezirett Madan and 13 for Dayana Martínez. Cuba led the attack 56-37, service 14-10, but they were behind in blocking 8-14, in addition they awarded 43 points for unforced errors to their opponent, who only committed 28.

Hannah Duchesneau, captain of Canada: "What happened to us tonight was that we believed, we always believed ... Our team trusted that we could get the win ... we believed... in the fourth set we were down four points and we believed, we wanted this victory".

"I was on the bench in the last set, but you also have to be prepared to be on the bench and enter the game, you must come with a very strong work, have concentration, but we were all supporting, both those who were outside, and the public".

Dale Melnick, coach of Canada, with tears on her face and her voice cut off by emotion said "I'm very proud, with only seven weeks, this generation, these 12 players and two

more that are at home is the best, it's the elite team that we have in Canada. I'm just very proud of these girls. "

"20 years ago we won a bronze medal, this medal is for that generation. Canada another back to the top, "said very excited Melnick.

Thalia Moreno, captain of Cuba: "Both Canada and we beat each other very well, maybe in the first match (In pool phase) they were nervous, Canada is a good team, they play together. Let's try not to make the same mistakes we made today tomorrow for the bronze medal".

Jaime Echevarri, coach of Cuba: "Canada is a team that came from less to more, it is a great team. It presented an impressive defense, ours were a little deconcentrated, the moment the tactical plan was not fulfilled, it was lost because the reception did not good".

"The serve of the first set was a bit unstable, they failed a lot. In all respects Canada presented an admirable combativeness. You can see that they studied us very well, in the end we had the victory twice in the fifth set and the receipt of key players failed us ".

Canada will face the winner of the game between the United States and the Dominican Republic for the gold medal.

Estados Unidos a la final y al Mundial Sub 18 al vencer a Dominicana

Tegucigalpa, Honduras. 31 de agosto 2018. Estados Unidos se quedó con el segundo boleto al Mundial Sub 18 en Egipto al vencer 3-0 (25-12, 20-17, 25-17) a República Dominicana, y avanzó a la final del Campeonato Continental NORCECA U18 femenino donde enfrentará a Canadá.

El equipo de Estados Unidos no dio lugar a que Dominicana mostrara lo mejor de su juego, tomando ventaja desde el primer set, la que no pudo remontar el equipo caribeño que fue superado en ataque 38-16, bloqueo 12-5 y servicio 4-0, y cometió 21 errores no forzados, por 25 de las estadounidenses.

Estados Unidos ha estado en las 10 finales previas, ganando siete títulos desde 1998, de ellos seis consecutivos entre 2002 y 2012, mientras Dominicana ganó las dos últimas finales disputadas ante las norteamericanas en 2014 y 2016.

Jessica Mruzik con 14 puntos y 13 de Emily Londot fueron las mejores de Estados Unidos, mientras Dominicana apenas contó con seis puntos de Flormarie Heredia.

Allison Jacobs, capitana de Estados Unidos: “No puedo decir como me siento, es algo de otro mundo. No estábamos intimidadas por Dominicana, sabíamos que es un buen equipo, pero estábamos más concentradas en lo que haríamos nosotras como equipo, jugar nuestro juego, sin pensar en el contrario”.

“El pase estuvo muy bueno, el recibo también, eso mejoramos bastante desde el inicio del torneo. Aunque no habíamos entrenado mucho tiempo juntas, ahora nos vemos como un equipo que se conoce desde hace mucho y eso es importante”.

James Stone, entrenador de Estados Unidos: “No fue un partido fácil. Dominicana es un muy bueno, pero también las niñas sostuvieron bien el bloqueo, servimos bien y metimos la bola como queríamos, pero no fue un partido fácil; tengo un buen equipo y estoy orgulloso de ellas”.

“El plan era clasificar al Mundial, no será fácil mañana ante Canadá, pero vamos a jugar para ganar, eso es lo que tenemos que hacer, buscaremos cómo terminar bien el torneo”.

Geraldine González, capitana de Dominicana: “Me siento muy mal, porque a pesar que Estados Unidos es una potencia, teníamos para estar en la final. Siempre hemos dado el todo, arriesgamos muchísimo, yo creía que estaríamos en la final, pero estas son lecciones que Dios da. Estoy muy orgullosa de mi equipo, llegamos a semifinales y me siento feliz por eso”.

Alexandre Ceccato, entrenador de Dominicana: “Primero tengo que felicitar a Estados Unidos, hicieron un gran partido. Su saque y su bloqueo es muy difícil, marcaron mejor a

nuestro equipo, ahora nos queda ir a luchar por la medalla de bronce en otro partido que no será fácil ante Cuba”.

“Estados Unidos fue mejor en los fundamentos, un equipo que no había jugado un partido difícil, hoy se preparó mejor y ganó”.

Estados Unidos enfrentará a Canadá por la medalla de oro del NORCECA U18 a las 8:00 p.m. en el Gimnasio #2 Jorge Galeano, de la Villa Olímpica de Tegucigalpa.

United States to the final and the U18 World Cup to beat Dominican Republic

Tegucigalpa, Honduras. August 31, 2018. The United States took the second ticket to the U18 world championship in Egypt by winning 3-0 (25-12, 20-17, 25-17) to the Dominican Republic, and advanced to the NORCECA Continental Championship final. U18 female where she will face Canada.

The United States team did not allow the Dominican to show the best of their game, taking advantage from the first set, which could not overcome the Caribbean team that was overcome in attack 38-16, block 16-5 and 4- service 0, and committed 21 unforced errors, for 25.

The United States has been in the previous 10 finals, winning seven titles since 1998, six consecutive between 2002 and 2012, while Dominican won the last two finals played against USA.

Jessica Mruzik with 14 points and 13 from Emily Londot were the best in the United States, while the Dominican Republic had only six points from Flormarie Heredia.

Allison Jacobs, captain of the United States: "I can not say how I feel, it's something from another world. Ww were not intimidated by the Dominican Republic, we knew it was a good team, but we were more focused on what we would do as a team, play our game, without thinking about the opposite ".

"The pass was very good, the reception also, that improved a lot since the start of the tournament. Although we had not trained much time together, now we see ourselves as a team that has been known for a long time and that is important ".

James Stone, coach of the United States: "It was not an easy match. The Dominican Republic is a very good one, but also the girls held the blockade well, we served well and got the ball as we wanted, but it was not an easy game; I have a good team and I am proud of them. "

"The plan was to qualify for the World Cup, it will not be easy tomorrow against Canada, but we will play to win, that is what we have to do, we will look for how to finish the tournament well".

Geraldine González, captain of the Dominican Republic: "I feel very bad, because even though the United States is a potency, we had to be in the final. We have always given everything, we risk a lot, I thought we would be in the final, but these are lessons that God gives. I am very proud of my team, we reached the semifinals and I feel happy about that".

Alexandre Ceccato, coach of Dominican: "First I have to congratulate the United States, they played a great game. His serve and his blocking is very difficult, they marked our team better, now we have to go to fight for the bronze medal in another match that will not be easy against Cuba. "

"The United States was better in the basics, a team that had not played a difficult game, today it prepared better and won."

The United States will face Canada for the NORCECA U18 gold medal at 8:00 p.m. in Gym # 2 Jorge Galeano, of the Olympic Village of Tegucigalpa.
