Clashes between undefeated teams in Honduras

TEGUCIGALPA, Honduras, August 28, 2018 – Wednesday is a decisive day at the U18 NORCECA Girls Continental Championship as the pools winners will be decided in much anticipated matches.

Tw-time defending champions Dominican Republic will clash with Cuba for the top position in Pool A while host Honduras will meet United States. The winners will earn direct tickets to the semifinal phase.



United States 3, Barbados 0

The United States won 3-0 (25-10, 25-7, 25-16) over Barbados for its second victory in Group B. Emily Londot and Allysa Batenhorts got 10 points each, while for Barbados Tenneille Chapman had seven. United States had the advantage in attacks (37-11), blocking (4-0) and services (11-1).

Dominican Republic 3, Canada 0

The Dominican Republic got its second victory by going 3-0 (25-19, 25-21, 25-19) over Canada. Flormarie Heredia with 12 points was the best for Dominican, with nine of Yanelys Cabada. For Canada, Anna Smrek had nine marks.



Cuba 3, Costa Rica 0

Cuba showed one of its weapons, getting 27 points from services to obtain a 3-0 victory (25-11, 25-15, 25-12) against Costa Rica. Led by Tainalien Castillo and Yaimaris García, both with 14 points, including 11 and 8 aces, respectively, the Cubans did not give freedom to the Costa Ricans who were outdone in everything.



Honduras 3, Nicaragua 0

Honduras continues with a perfect march (2-0) after defeating Nicaragua 3-0 (25-18, 25-18, 25-12) in the last game of the second day. Andrea Aceituno with 13 points was the top scorer of Honduras and Rocío Durán contributed 12 points. María Belén Arcia scored 6 for Nicaragua.
