United States, No. 2 ranked in the world, topped pool B after defeating Dominican Republic 3-0 (27-25, 25-17, 25-14) and hosts Puerto Rico swept Canada 3-0 (25-23, 25-22, 25-18) winning pool A and sealed their ticket to the NORCECA final four Olympic Qualifier in January.

In Friday's quarterfinals, Dominican Republic will face Cuba and Canada plays against Mexico.

### **Cuba 3, Costa Rica 3**

Cuba defeated Costa Rica 3-0 (25-17, 25-15, 25-16) to finish pool A in third place and moving into quarterfinals. Cuba with 1-2 record moved into quarterfinals to face the loser between United States and Dominican Republic; Costa Rica (0-3) will play position matches. Cuba overpowered Costa Rica 40-27 in kills; they also dominated 10-3 in blocks and 9-4 in aces. Cuba allowed 14 points on errors against 16. Cuba's outside hitter Claudia Tarin scored a match-high of 13 points on 11 kills, one block and one ace, accompanied by middle blocker Melanies Arcia who topped with 4 blocks of her 11 points. ### **Mexico 3, Trinidad and Tobago 0**

Mexico moved into the quarterfinal round after beating Trinidad and Tobago in straight sets 25-14, 25-7, 25-10. Mexico (1-2), third place in pool B, will face the loser between Puerto Rico and Canada in the quarterfinal round. Mexico is aiming to win one of the three spots available for the NORCECA final four Olympic qualifier in January. Trinidad and Tobago (0-3) will play for placing matches. Mexico managed to control the actions with huge margin in every skill of the game, attacks (37-14), blocks (4-0) and service points (14-3). Mexico benefited from 20 opponent errors and committed 14. Mexican Karina Flores with 11 points was the only player with double-digits. Also contributing in Mexico's first victory, Grecia Castro with 9 points, Maria Fernanda Rodriguez and Sirenia Gomez tallied 8 points apiece. Kiune Fletcher scored 7 points for Trinidad and Tobago.

### **United States 3, Dominican Republic 0**

United States topped pool B after defeating Dominican Republic 3-0 (27-25, 25-17, 25-14) and advanced to semifinals. United States, No. 2 ranked in the world, with 3-0 record advanced directly to Saturday's semifinals; Dominican Republic (2-1) will play Cuba in quarterfinals. The U.S. bounced back from 20-22 in the first set coordinating their blocking defense to reach a thrilling 27-25 ending. In sets two and three the U.S. blockers managed to hold off Dominicans active offense. The Americans led with sizeable 50-32 advantage in attacks and 10-3 in blocks. The U.S. held a slim 2-1 margin in aces. Dominican Republic committed fewer (15-20) errors than United States. The U.S. balanced their scoring offense with opposite Karsta Lowe scoring 16 points on 15 kills and one block, outside hitter Michelle Bartsch-Hackley added 13 points, 12 from kills and outside hitter Kimberly Hill contributed with 11 points. Opposite Gaila Gonzalez led Dominican Republic with 17 points all on kills.

### **Puerto Rico 3, Canada 0**

Host Puerto Rico advanced to semifinals sweeping Canada 3-0 (25-23, 25-22, 25-18) and sealed their ticket to the NORCECA Olympic Qualifier. After finishing first in pool A, Puerto Rico (3-0) advanced directly into Saturday's semifinals and also booked their spot for January to battle for the Olympic qualification at the NORCECA final four. Canada will play Mexico in the Friday's quarterfinals. The host came from behind 7-11 in the first set, taking control on their powerful serves. In set two the crowd enjoyed longer rallies while Puerto Rico kept on leading by comfortable four points; having no difficulties to end with a straight set win. Puerto Rico dominated Canada on 10-2 margin in service points and Canada led 9-6 in blocks; both teams scored 34 points on attacks. Puerto Rico benefited on 25 Canadian errors, allowing 18 points. Three players scored double-figures for Puerto Rico, Stephanie Enright (13pts), Karina Ocasio (10pts) and Paulina Prieto (10pts); Diana Reyes scored 4 aces. Kiera Van Ryk topped Canada's hitters with 11 points, and Alexa Gray along with Emily Maglio added 9 points apiece.

EEUU utilizó balanceó su ofensiva con la opuesta Karsta Lowe que anotó 16 puntos a través de 15 ataques y un bloqueo, la atacante Michelle Bartsch-Hackley sumó 13 puntos, 12 de ataques y la atacante Kimberly Hill contribuyó con 11 puntos. La opuesta Gaila González encabezó a República Dominicana con 17 puntos de ataque.

### **Puerto Rico 3, Canadá 0**

Las anfitrionas Puerto Rico avanzaron a las semifinales dominando a Canadá 3-0 (25-23, 25-22, 25-18) y sellaron su boleto a la eliminatoria Olímpica de NORCECA. Luego de finalizar primer lugar del grupo A, Puerto Rico (3-0) avanza directo a las semifinales del sábado y también aseguraron su espacio en la eliminatoria Olímpica NORCECA final four que se jugará en enero. Canadá se enfrentará el viernes a México en cuartos de final. Las anfitrionas vinieron de atrás 7-11 en el primer set, tomando control a través de su potente saque. En el segundo set, el público disfrutó de rallies más largos mientras que Puerto Rico tomó una cómoda ventaja de cuatro puntos y no tuvieron dificultades para cerrar el triunfo en sets seguidos. Puerto Rico dominó a Canadá el servicio por margen 10-2 y Canadá lideró el bloqueo 9-6; ambos equipos anotaron 34 puntos de ataques. Puerto Rico se benefició de 25 errores de Canadá, permitiendo 18 puntos. Tres jugadoras de Puerto Rico anotaron dígitos-dobles, Stephanie Enright (13pts), Karina Ocasio (10pts) y Paulina Prieto (10pts); Diana Reyes aportó 4 aces. Kiera Van Ryk lideró a Canadá con 11 puntos, y Alexa Gray junto con Emily Maglio agregaron 9 puntos cada una.
