## **Cuba and Argentina to clash for the Lima 2019 Pan American Games Gold Medal**

LIMA, Peru, August 3, 2019.- Cuba and Argentina will clash for the eighteenth Lima 2019 Pan American Games Gold Medal Match on Sunday at the Multisport Complex El Callao in Lima, Peru.

Cuba swept Brazil 3-0 (25-16, 25-22, 25-21) and Argentina won to Chile 3-1 (25-21, 23-25, 28-26, 25-17) in Saturday's semifinals.

This is Cuba's tenth title match, winning on five occasions while Argentina has reached the Pan American Games title match on other two occasions, winning them both (1995, 2015), aiming to win twice in a row.

In the bronze medal match, Brazil will face Chile.

In placing matches, Puerto Rico won fifth place over United States and Mexico beat host Peru for seventh place.

### **Semifinal Cuba 3, Brazil 0**

Cuba swept Brazil 3-0 (25-16, 25-22, 25-21) on Saturday's first semifinal. Cuba advances to their tenth Pan American Games Gold medal match, winning on five occasions; the last time they reached the final match was in 2011 at the Guadalajara Games where they lost to Brazil. Cuba waits for the winner of the other semifinal between defending champion Argentina and Chile. Cuba's dominant display over the net slowed down Brazil from start to finish with advantage in attacks 39-37 and in blocks 7-3. Brazil controlled the serving category by a 6-1 margin. Cuba scored on 29 Brazil errors while limiting theirs to 12. Cuba's scoring attack was led by Osniel Mergarejo with 17 points all on kills; Miguel Angel Lopez registered 12 points on 9 kills and 3 aces, while Marlon Yang scored 11 points on 9 kills and 2 aces. Carlos Eduardo Barreto (Kadu) with 12 point all on kills was Brazil's only player with double-figures.

### **Semifinal Argentina 3, Chile 1**

Argentina won their semifinal match to Chile 3-1 (25-21, 23-25, 28-26, 25-17). Argentina has reached the Pan American Games title match on other two occasions, winning them both (1995, 2015), aiming to win twice in a row after battling strong against a resilient Chilean squad. Chile will meet Brazil in their first ever Pan American Games medal match. Over four thousand spectators witnessed Argentina's semifinal victory, overcoming Chile with 65-57 advantage in kills, 3-1 margin in aces and finished with fewer errors (23-30). Chile outblocked Argentina 8-3. Argentina's top hitter and the only one with double-figures was captain Nicolas Bruno who scored 16 points all on kills. Chilean outside hitter Vicente Parraguirre scored a match-high of 20 points all on kills; middle blocker Gabriel

Araya contributed with 14 points including four blocks, while opposite player Tomas Parraguirre and captain Dusan Bonasic registered 12 points apiece.

### **Mexico 3, Peru 1**

Mexico beat Peru 3-1 (27-25, 26-24, 25-27, 25-13) to finish seventh place. Mexico found their way to outplay host Peru up to set four with a comfortable scoring margin to finish their Pan American Games campaign with 1-3 win-loss record. Mexico held 59-50 margin in attacks and a slim 5-4 advantage in aces, while both teams scored 13 points on blocks. Mexico committed 22 unforced errors against 26 by Peru. Opposite player Daniel Vargas of Mexico scored a match-high of 25 points including 22 kills and 2 aces. Outside hitter Jorge Barajas added 17 points to Mexico's victory, while middle blocker Jonathan Martinez and outside hitter Gonzalo Ruiz tallied 11 and 10 points accordingly. Middle blocker Alvaro Urueña and opposite Eduardo Romay scored 20 points apiece in Peru's loss.

### **Puerto Rico 3, United States 2**

Puerto Rico won fifth place over United States 3-2 (22-25, 25-21, 25-22, 20-25, 15-8). Today's performance was slower than what both Puerto Rico and United States showed in their previous matches. Puerto Rico led 60-58 in kills and 8-7 in aces; USA led in blocks 9-6. Puerto Rico scored on 33 USA errors while committing 27. Puerto Rican captain Maurice Torres topped all scorers with 23 points on 21 kills and 2 aces; Pablo Guzman contributed with 18 points, Jonathan Rodriguez with 13 points and Pelegrin Sanchez added 10 points. Outside hitter Samuel Holt scored 11 points as USA leading hitter, followed by 10 points by Colt Cowell, playing only three sets. Puerto Rico finishes the competition with 2-2 record for fifth place; United States ends with 1-3 record.

## **Cuba y Argentina se enfrentarán por la Medalla de Oro de los Juegos Lima 2019**

LIMA, Perú, 3 de agosto de 2019.- Cuba y Argentina se enfrentarán en el juego por la Medalla de Oro de los décimos octavos Juegos Panamericanos Lima 2019 el domingo en el Polideportivo El Callao en Lima, Perú.

Cuba se impuso a Brasil en sets seguidos 3-0 (25-16, 25-22, 25-21) y Argentina ganó ante Chile 3-1 (25-21, 23-25, 28-26, 25-17) en las semifinales del sábado.

Esta es la décima final que disputa Cuba, ganando en cinco ocasiones, mientras que Argentina ha alcanzado el juego por el título en Juegos Panamericanos en otras dos ocasiones, ganando en ambas (1995, 2015), buscando obtener su segundo título consecutivo.

En el juego por la medalla de bronce, Brasil se medirá con Chile.

En juegos por posiciones, Puerto Rico ganó el quinto lugar sobre Estados Unidos y México venció al anfitrión por el séptimo lugar.

### **Semifinal Cuba 3, Brasil 0**

Cuba se impuso a Brasil en sets seguidos 3-0 (25-16, 25-22, 25-21) en la primera semifinal del sábado. Cuba avanza a su décimo juego por la medalla de oro en Juegos Panamericanos, ganando en cinco ocasiones; la última vez que alcanzó la final fue en 2011 en los Juegos de Guadalajara donde perdió ante Brasil. Cuba espera por el ganador de la otra semifinal entre el campeón defensor Argentina y Chile. El dominio cubano sobre la red detuvo a Brasil de inicio a fin con una ventaja de 39-37 en ataques y 7-3 en bloqueos. Brasil controló la categoría del servicio con un margen de 6-1. Cuba anotó 29 puntos por errores de Brasil y limitó los propios a 12. El ataque de Cuba lo encabezó Osniel Mergarejo con 17 puntos todos por ataque; Miguel Ángel López registró 12 puntos a través de 9 ataques y 3 aces, en tanto que Marlon Yang anotó 11 puntos con 9 ataques y 2 aces. Carlos Eduardo Barreto (Kadu) con 12 puntos por ataques directos, fue el único jugador con dígitos dobles por parte de Brasil.

### **Semifinal Argentina 3, Chile 1**

Argentina ganó el juego de semifinal ante Chile 3-1 (25-21, 23-25, 28-26, 25-17). Argentina ha alcanzado el juego por el título en Juegos Panamericanos en otras dos ocasiones, ganando en ambas (1995, 2015), buscando obtener su segundo título consecutivo tras luchar fuertemente ante un aguerrido Chile. Chile se enfrentará a Brasil en su primer juego por medalla en la historia de Juegos Panamericanos. Más de cuatro mil espectadores fueron testigo de la victoria Argentina en semifinales, superando a Chile con ventaja 65-57 en ataques, 3-1 en servicios y cometiendo menos cantidad de errores (23-30). Chile superó a Argentina 8-3 en bloqueos. El máximo anotador de Argentina y el único con dígitos dobles fue el capitán Nicolás Bruno con 16 puntos todos de ataque. El atacante chileno Vicente Parraguirre fue el máximo anotador del encuentro con 20 puntos todos de ataque; el central Gabriel Araya contribuyó con 14 puntos incluyendo cuatro bloqueos, mientras que el opuesto Tomás Parraguirre y el capitán Dusan Bonasic registraron 12 puntos cada uno.

### **México 3, Perú 1**

México venció a Perú 3-1 (27-25, 26-24, 25-27, 25-13) para finalizar séptimo lugar. México encontró la manera de superar a Perú hasta el cuarto set con un marcador más cómodo y así finalizar su participación de los Juegos Panamericanos con record 1-3 en juegos ganados. México tuvo un margen de 59-50 en ataques y una mínima diferencia de 5-4 en puntos de servicio, ambos equipo anotaron 13 puntos de bloqueo. México cometió 22 errores no forzados contra 26 de Perú. El jugador opuesto Daniel Vargas de México fue el máximo anotador del juego con 25 puntos incluyendo 22 ataques y 2 aces. El atacante de esquina Jorge Barjas agregó 17 puntos en la victoria mexicana, mientras que el central Jonathan Martínez y el atacante Gonzalo Ruiz anotaron 11 y 10 unidades

respectivamente. En la derrota de Perú, el central Alvaro Urueña y el opuesto Eduardo Romay anotaron 20 puntos cada uno.

### **Puerto Rico 3, United States 2**

Puerto Rico ganó el quinto lugar sobre Estados Unidos 3-2 (22-25, 25-21, 25-22, 20-25, 15-8). Hoy el nivel de juego de ambos equipos Puerto Rico y Estados Unidos fue más lento que sus presentaciones anteriores. Puerto Rico lideró 60-58 en ataques y 8-7 en puntos de saque; EEUU en bloqueos 9-6. Puerto Rico anotó 33 puntos por errores de EEUU mientras cometió 27. El puertorriqueño Maurice Torres fue el máximo anotador con 23 puntos a través de 21 ataques y 2 puntos de servicio; Pablo Guzmán contribuyó con 18 puntos, Jonathan Rodríguez con 13 puntos y Pelegrin Sánchez aportó 11 puntos. El atacante de esquina Samuel Holt anotó 11 puntos encabezando el ataque de Estados Unidos, seguido por 10 puntos de Colt Cowell, que jugó únicamente tres sets. Puerto Rico finaliza la competencia con record 2-2 para el quinto lugar; Estados Unidos termina con record 1-3.
