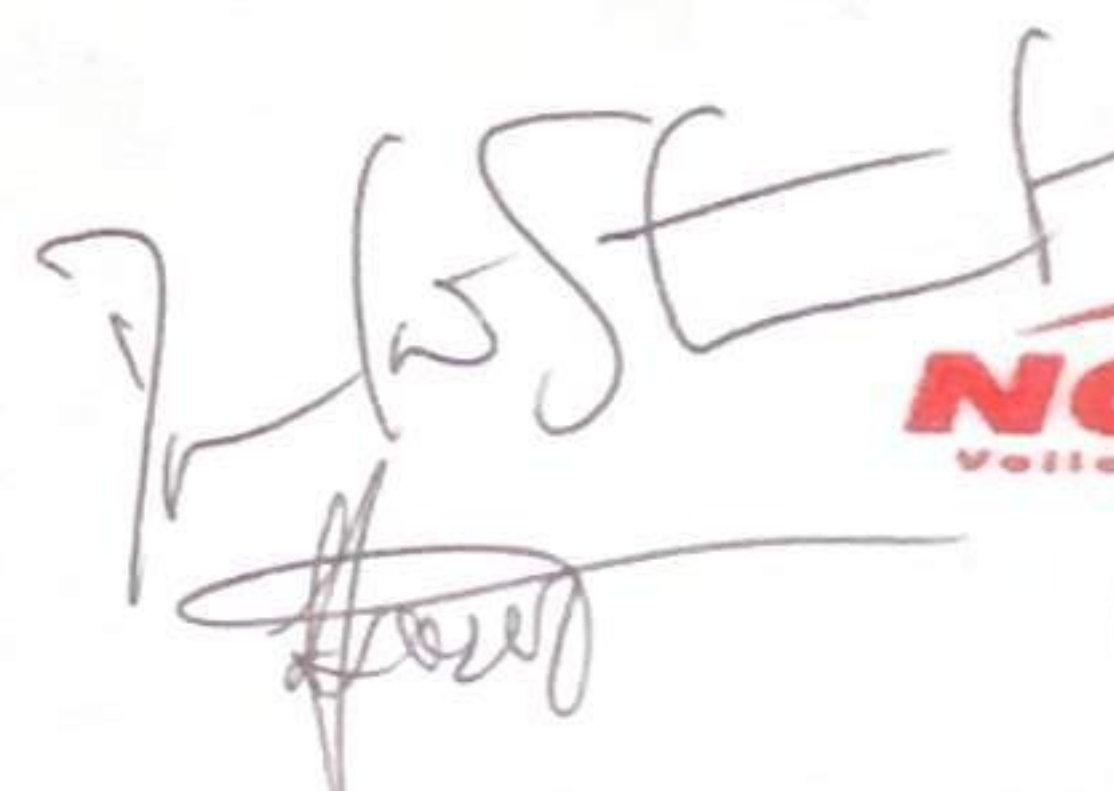
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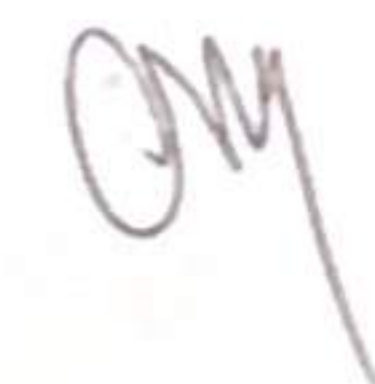

Positive outlook from coaches before the start of NORCECA Women's Final Four

MANATÍ, Puerto Rico, July 17th, 2025.- Coaches of the teams at the NORCECA Women's Final Four taking place at Manatí, Puerto Rico from July 18-20 commented about their expectations ahead of the competition during the preliminary inquiry expecting a high-level competition and to gain experience for their future events.

Juan Carlos Núñez, Head coach of Puerto Rico: Our first home tournament begins with high expectations, with our goals this summer is to have a strong representation and earn points in pursuit of qualification for the 2026 FIVB Volleyball Nations League.

My team is a mix of veteran and young players. It's an interesting mix, and it's important for these young players to gain experience. We have several training sessions before tomorrow's match to get off to a good start. It's a deeper team than last year's because we have more experienced players to take on the challenge of the summer.

Nicola Negro, Head coach of Mexico: This is our first event of the season where we have a young group, and we've been making a lot of changes. It's the beginning of an Olympic cycle, and the goal is to start building our game. Prior this event, we had a training camp at the high-performance center in Mexico, as well as several friendly matches with teams from the United States, all with the goal of having a strong season.

We have a stable roster, the addition of about four athletes coming from college, and the return of Samantha Bricio, a very important player for our team, and we are very positive.

José Miguel Briceño Torres, Head coach Costa Rica: We begin our national team participation phase with an eye toward this year's regional tournaments, which include the Final Four and the Central American Games.

We have an experienced team and young players, and we want to prepare them to develop their game in this event. Since the beginning of the year, we've been training twice a week and have also used the national tournament to give the players a rhythm. Our goal is for the players to experience what it's like to play against teams that will demand technical and tactical demands from them, expecting a progressive performance in this event.

Daymian Stewart, Head coach Trinidad and Tobago: We are honor to be here and play at this level and for us is a big initial of our international season. Our main goal is the Caribbean championship in the Bahamas, so this is part of our preparation. We will face very tough opponents, but we expect Costa Rica to be the closes to our level and give them a challenge and to put our best foot forward against Puerto Rico and Mexico.

It is a new team. We are transitioning from the team that qualified from the world championship in 2018. We have some young players as young as 15 years old so this is an opportunity to give them exposure at this level, and this will really prepare us to continue dominating in our zone.



Participating teams will be awarded FIVB World Ranking points valid for the qualification process to the 2026 FIVB Volleyball Nations League and the FIVB World Championship 2027 and the champion will earn the qualification to Senior NORCECA Women's Continental Championship.

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Perspectiva positiva de los entrenadores antes del inicio de la Final Four Femenina de NORCECA

MANATÍ, Puerto Rico, 17 de julio de 2025.- Los entrenadores de los equipos que participarán en el NORCECA Final Four Femenino 2025 que se celebrará en Manatí, Puerto Rico, del 18 al 20 de julio, comentaron sus expectativas de cara a la competencia durante la entrevista preliminar, anticipando una competencia de alto nivel y la posibilidad de ganar experiencia para sus futuros eventos.

Juan Carlos Núñez, entrenador de Puerto Rico: Nuestro primer torneo en casa comienza con grandes expectativas. Nuestro objetivo este verano es tener una sólida representación y sumar puntos para clasificar a la Liga de Naciones FIVB 2026.

Mi equipo es una mezcla de jugadoras veteranas y jóvenes. Es una combinación interesante, y es importante que estas jóvenes adquieran experiencia. Tenemos varias sesiones de entrenamiento antes del partido de mañana para empezar con buen pie. Es un equipo más completo que el del año pasado porque contamos con jugadoras más experimentadas para afrontar el reto del verano.

Nicola Negro, Entrenador de México: Este es nuestro primer evento de la temporada con un grupo joven y hemos estado haciendo muchos cambios. Es el comienzo de un ciclo olímpico y el objetivo es empezar a desarrollar nuestro juego. Antes de este evento, tuvimos un campamento de entrenamiento en el centro de alto rendimiento de México, así como varios partidos amistosos con equipos de Estados Unidos, todo con el objetivo de tener una temporada sólida.

Contamos con una plantilla estable, la incorporación de unas cuatro atletas universitarias y el regreso de Samantha Bricio, una jugadora muy importante para nuestro equipo, y estamos muy optimistas.

José Miguel Briceño Torres, Entrenador de Costa Rica: Comenzamos nuestra fase de participación con la selección nacional con la vista puesta en los torneos regionales de este año, que incluyen la Final Four y los Juegos Centroamericanos.

Contamos con un equipo experimentado y jugadoras jóvenes, y queremos prepararlas para que desarrollen su juego en este evento. Desde principios de año, hemos estado entrenando dos veces por semana y también hemos aprovechado el torneo nacional para darles ritmo. Nuestro objetivo es que las atletas experimenten lo que se siente jugar contra equipos que les exigirán técnica y tácticamente, y esperamos un rendimiento de menos a más en este evento.

Daymian Stewart, Entrenador de Trinidad y Tobago: Es un honor estar aquí y jugar a este nivel; para nosotros es un gran comienzo de nuestra temporada internacional. Nuestro principal objetivo es el



campeonato del Caribe en las Bahamas, así que esto es parte de nuestra preparación. Nos enfrentaremos a oponentes muy duros, pero esperamos que Costa Rica esté a nuestro nivel y seamos un reto para ellas además de dar lo mejor de nosotros contra Puerto Rico y México.

Es un equipo nuevo. Estamos en transición desde el equipo que clasificó al campeonato mundial en 2018. Tenemos algunos jugadores jóvenes de tan solo 15 años, así que esta es una oportunidad para darles exposición en este nivel, lo que realmente nos preparará para seguir dominando en nuestra zona.

Los equipos participantes recibirán puntos del Ranking Mundial FIVB válidos para el proceso de clasificación a la Liga de Naciones de Voleibol FIVB 2026 y al Campeonato Mundial FIVB 2027 y el campeón obtendrá la clasificación al Campeonato Continental Feme
