Chile, Canada, Venezuela, Colombia and Mexico Remain Undefeated

LEÓN, Guanajuato, August 27, 2025. – Chile, Canada, Venezuela, Colombia and Mexico closed the second day of competition at the 18th Men's Senior Pan American Cup with undefeated records.

Venezuela leads Pool A and will face Antigua and Barbuda, still searching for their first win. The battle for second place will be decided between Cuba and the United States. Meanwhile, the top spot in Pools B and C will come down to direct clashes: Colombia vs. Canada, and Mexico vs. Chile, respectively.

United States 3, Antigua and Barbuda 0

The United States earned its first victory in Pool A after beating Antigua and Barbuda 3-0 (25-12, 25-11, 25-17). The U.S. with 1-1 record will close pool-play against Cuba, while Antigua and Barbuda (0-2) will face Venezuela. The top place in the pool will have to wait until the results are complete to learn if they advance directly to semifinals or they will go through the quarterfinals alongside the second place in each pool. USA sealed the win with advantage in every skill: attacks (43-20), blocks (5-2) and service aces (8-1). They committed a similar number of errors, the United States with 19 and Antigua and Barbuda with 17. Kaleb Jenness of USA was the only player with double digits, with 14 points, as the U.S. used all its players.

Chile 3, Suriname 0

The Chilean National Team kept its perfect record defeating Suriname in straight sets 3-0 (25-15, 25-13, 25-14). Chile now holds a 2-0 undefeated record in Pool C, while Suriname is still searching for its first win (0-2). The pool stage will conclude on Thursday with Chile facing Mexico and Suriname taking on the Dominican Republic. Afterward, the two best pool winners will move directly into the semifinals. Chile's attacking power and serving were key factors in the victory. The South Americans dominated in kills (41-23), service aces (9-0), and blocks (8-2). Both teams handed out 17 points apiece through unforced errors. Vicente Parraguirre, Chile's opposite, topped all scorers with 13 points (10 kills, 2 blocks, 1 ace). Followed by Noe Aravena with 12 points (10 kills, 1 block, 1 ace) and Tomás Gago with 10 (6 kills, 2 blocks, 2 aces). For Suriname, Shemar Jameson led the way with 6 points.

Canada 3, Guatemala 1

Canada had to work hard to overcome Guatemala 3-1 (26-24, 25-19, 26-28, 25-19) and remain unbeaten. The defending champion now holds a 2-0 record in Pool B and will close the preliminary round on Thursday against Colombia. Guatemala, still seeking its first win, will face Puerto Rico in its next match. The match turned out to be tougher than expected for the Canadians. In the first set, Guatemala surprised by staying ahead until reaching set point (24-23), with Andy Leonardo and Gerardo González leading the offense. However, Erik Siksna tied the score with a spike and then scored on a block to give Canada the advantage, eventually taking the set 26-24. In the second frame, Canada showed more control, building a five-point lead (17-12) and maintaining it thanks to the effectiveness of Siksna and Jonas Van Huizen, securing the set 25-19. Guatemala bounced back in the third set, taking a 20-17 lead with Leonardo at the front. The Central Americans forced a fourth set after edging Canada 28-26, with José Samayoa also contributing to the effort. Canada closed the match in the fourth (25-19), capitalizing on its opponent's errors and spreading the offense among Kristjanson, Canham, Van Huizen, and Duncanson. Statistically, Canada outperformed Guatemala in attacks (54-35), blocks (10-3), and service points (7-3), though committed more



errors (49-31). Canadian Liam Kristjanson led all scorers with 17 points (10 kills, 2 blocks, and a match-high 5 aces). He was supported by Cole Duncanson with 13 points (10 kills, 3 blocks), Erik Siksna with 12 (8 kills, 3 blocks, 1 ace), and Jonas Van Huizen with 11, all on attacks. For Guatemala, Andy Leonardo stood out with 16 points (13 kills, 1 block, 2 aces), while team captain Carlos López added 10 points, all on attacks.

Venezuela 3, Cuba 0

Venezuela earned a solid 3-0 (25-23, 25-17, 25-21) victory over Cuba. Venezuela remains perfect in Pool A with a 2-0 record, while Cuba drops to 1-1. In the final day of pool play, Venezuela will face Antigua and Barbuda (0-2) and Cuba will go up against the United States (1-1). Cuba started strong in the opening set, taking a 4-0 lead with the attack of Alejandro González. However, Venezuela responded steadily, led by Willner Rivas and Emerson Rodríguez, building a comfortable advantage. Although Cuba tried to rally, closing the gap to 21-23, consecutive errors cost them the set. The second set was completely dominated by Venezuela, with a huge lead and consistent pressure from the service line through Ronald Fayola, Jean Herrera, and Emerson. In the third set, the score was tied at 15 points before Venezuela pulled away with the offense of Rivas and Emerson, along with José Carrasco's blocking at the net. Two consecutive kills from Emerson sealed the Venezuelan victory. Venezuela capitalized on 32 Cuban errors and was superior from the service line (9-2). Cuba held a slight edge in attacking (31-30) and blocking (5-4). Emerson Rodríguez led all scorers with 15 points (12 kills, 3 aces). For Cuba, Alejandro González contributed 13 points (12 kills, 1 block).

Colombia 3, Puerto Rico 1

Colombia defeated Puerto Rico 3-1 (18-25, 25-18, 25-18, 25-20) to remain unbeaten. Colombia and Canada both hold perfect records (2-0) and will face each other on Thursday to decide the top spot in Pool B. Puerto Rico, meanwhile, will play against Guatemala, with both teams still searching for their first win. Puerto Rico controlled the first set comfortably. At set point (24-14), Colombia responded with three kills from Ronald Jiménez and a block by Juan Castañeda against Jamal Ellis, before Ángel Rivera sealed the set with a powerful spike, 25-18. Colombia answered back in the second set, taking a five-point lead (10-5), with Castañeda, Andrés Piza, and Jiménez effective on offense, and Leandro Mejía contributing at the net with blocks. Puerto Rico pushed back and denied three set points, but Piza leveled the match with a decisive attack. In the third set, Colombia maintained a three-point lead throughout. Mejía's blocking was key down the stretch, while Puerto Rican errors allowed Colombia to close the set in their favor. The fourth set followed a similar pattern, with Puerto Rico committing 11 errors and Colombian middle blocker Daniel Aponza dominating at the net to secure the win. Colombia held the edge in all aspects of the game: 52-49 in kills, 10-5 in blocks, and 5-4 in service aces. Errors were nearly even, with Colombia committing 23 and Puerto Rico 26. Five Colombian players scored in double figures: Ronald Jiménez, Leandro Mejía, and Juan Castañeda with 13 points each, and Daniel Aponza with 10. Puerto Rico's Pelegrin Vargas was the top scorer of the match with 15 points, followed by Pedro Molina and Jamal Ellis with 14 apiece.

Mexico 3, Dominican Republic 0

Mexico defeated the Dominican Republic 3-0 (25-20, 25-19, 25-19) to earn their second straight-set victory. The top spot in Pool C will be decided on Thursday in the clash between Mexico and Chile, both undefeated so far in the tournament. Meanwhile, the Dominican



Republic will close the preliminary round against Suriname, with both teams still seeking their first win. Mexico took the lead in the opening set with powerful attack from Franky Hernández and a solid block by Axel Téllez against Dominican captain Héctor Cruz, securing the early advantage. In the second set, the home team doubled their rivals in points (10-5) thanks to consecutive attacks from Alexis Garay, supported by Mauro Fuentes, effectively containing the efforts of Luis Reinoso and Luther Rosario. The Dominican Republic came out strong in the third set, going up 6-3 behind solid blocking from Rafael Burgos and Cruz. However, Mexico turned the score around and, with an effective performance from Téllez, extended the gap to four points (20-16). With Garay leading the offense and Téllez dominant at the net, the hosts sealed the win after a Dominican error. Mexico's superiority in attack (47-29) was crucial to the victory. The home side also held the edge in serving (4-0) and had a slight advantage in blocking (5-4). The Dominican Republic committed fewer unforced errors (19 to Mexico's 25). Alexis Garay led Mexico with 14 points, all from attacks. Téllez contributed 11 (6 attacks, 2 blocks, 3 aces), while Hernández added 10. For the Caribbean team, captain Héctor Cruz was the only player in double digits with 10 points.

Chile, Canadá, Venezuela, Colombia y México mantienen récord invicto

LEÓN, Guanajuato, 27 de agosto de 2025. – Chile, Canadá, Venezuela, Colombia y México cerraron el segundo día de competencia de la décimo octava Copa Panamericana Mayor Masculina con récord invicto.

Venezuela encabeza el Grupo A y enfrentará a Antigua y Barbuda, que aún no suma victorias. La disputa por el segundo lugar será entre Cuba y Estados Unidos. En tanto, el liderato de los Grupos B y C se definirá en duelos directos: Colombia ante Canadá, y México frente a Chile, respectivamente.

Estados Unidos 3, Antigua y Barbuda 0

Estados Unidos consiguió su primera victoria en el Grupo A tras vencer a Antigua y Barbuda 3-0 (25-12, 25-11, 25-17). Estados Unidos con récord 1-1 cerrará la ronda de grupos frente a Cuba, mientras Antigua y Barbuda (0-2) se enfrentará a Venezuela. El primer lugar del grupo esperará que se completen los resultados para conocer si avanza directamente a semifinales o si disputará la ronda de cuartos de final junto a los segundos lugares de cada grupo. Estados Unidos selló la victoria con ventaja en todos los rubros: ataque (43-20), bloqueo (5-2) y servicio (8-1). En errores estuvieron similares, Estados Unidos con 19 y Antigua y Barbuda con 17. Kaleb Jenness de Estados Unidos fue el único jugador con doble dígito, con 14 puntos, luego de los Estados Unidos utilizara a todos sus jugadores.

Chile 3, Surinam 0

La selección de Chile mantuvo su paso perfecto al derrotar con autoridad a Surinam 3-0 (25-15, 25-13, 25-14). Chile mantiene récord invicto de 2-0 en el Grupo C, mientras que Surinam sigue sin conocer la victoria (0-2). La fase de grupos concluirá el jueves con los duelos Chile frente a México y Surinam contra República Dominicana. Posteriormente, se definirán los dos mejores primeros lugares de grupo, quienes avanzarán directamente a semifinales. El ataque y servicio de Chile fueron determinantes en el triunfo. Los sudamericanos dominaron en ataques (41-23), servicios (9-0) y bloqueos (8-2). Ambos equipos cometieron regalaron 17

puntos por errores no forzados. Vicente Parraguirre, opuesto de Chile, fue el máximo anotador del encuentro con 13 puntos (10 ataques, 2 bloqueos y un ace). Lo siguieron Noe Aravena con 12 unidades (10 ataques, un bloqueo y un ace) y Tomás Gago con 10 (6 ataques, 2 bloqueos y 2 aces). Por parte de Surinam, Shemar Jameson fue el máximo anotador con 6 puntos.

Canadá 3, Guatemala 1

Canadá tuvo que esforzarse para vencer a Guatemala 3-1 (26-24, 25-19, 26-28, 25-19) y mantener su récord invicto. El campeón defensor suma ahora marca de 2-0 en el Grupo B y cerrará la fase de grupos el jueves enfrentando a Colombia. Guatemala, que aún no conoce la victoria, se medirá a Puerto Rico en su próximo compromiso. El encuentro fue más complicado de lo esperado para los canadienses. En el primer set, Guatemala sorprendió manteniéndose arriba en el marcador hasta alcanzar punto de set (24-23) con Andy Leonardo y Gerardo González liderando la ofensiva. Sin embargo, Erik Siksna igualó con un ataque y un bloqueo consecutivo para darle la ventaja a Canadá, que terminó imponiéndose 26-24. En el segundo parcial, Canadá mostró mayor contundencia, alcanzando una diferencia de cinco puntos (17-12) y manteniéndola con la efectividad de Siksna y Jonas Van Huizen, asegurando el 25-19. Guatemala reaccionó en el tercer set, tomando ventaja de 20-17 con Leonardo al frente. El conjunto centroamericano forzó un cuarto set al ganar 28-26, apoyado también en los ataques de José Samayoa. Finalmente, Canadá cerró el partido en el cuarto set (25-19), aprovechando los errores de su rival y con una ofensiva balanceada entre Kristjanson, Canham, Van Huizen y Duncanson. En cifras, Canadá dominó en ataques (54-35), bloqueos (10-3) y puntos de servicio (7-3), aunque cometió más errores que su rival (49-31). Liam Kristjanson fue el máximo anotador canadiense y del partido con 17 puntos (10 ataques, 2 bloqueos y 5 aces, la mayor cifra del partido). También destacaron Cole Duncanson con 13 unidades (10 ataques, 3 bloqueos), Erik Siksna con 12 (8 ataques, 3 bloqueos, un ace) y Jonas Van Huizen con 11 puntos, todos en ataque. Por Guatemala, Andy Leonardo destacó con 16 puntos (13 ataques, un bloqueo, 2 aces), mientras que el capitán Carlos López aportó 10 unidades, todas en ataque.

Venezuela 3, Cuba 0

Venezuela logró una sólida victoria 3-0 (25-23, 25-17, 25-21) sobre Cuba. Venezuela mantiene paso perfecto en el Grupo A con récord de 2-0, mientras Cuba queda con marca de 1-1. En la última jornada de la fase de grupos, los sudamericanos enfrentarán a Antigua y Barbuda (0-2) y Cuba se medirá ante Estados Unidos (1-1). Cuba arrancó con fuerza en el primer set, tomando ventaja de 4-0 con el ataque de Alejandro González. Sin embargo, Venezuela respondió con solidez, liderados por Willner Rivas y Emerson Rodríguez, construyendo una ventaja cómoda. Aunque los cubanos intentaron reaccionar acercándose 21-23, errores consecutivos les costaron el set. El segundo parcial fue dominado de principio a fin por Venezuela, con amplio margen y presión desde el servicio gracias a Ronald Fayola, Jean Herrera y Emerson. En el tercer set, la paridad se mantuvo hasta el 15-15, momento en que Venezuela se despegó con la ofensiva de Rivas y Emerson, además de la defensa en la red de José Carrasco. Dos remates consecutivos de Emerson sellaron el triunfo venezolano. Venezuela aprovechó 32 errores de sus rivales y fue superior en servicio (9-2). Cuba superó apenas a Venezuela en ataque (31-30) y en bloqueo (5-4). Emerson Rodríguez fue el máximo anotador del encuentro con 15 puntos (12 ataques y 3 aces). Por Cuba, Alejandro González sumó 13 unidades (12 ataques y 1 bloqueo).



Colombia 3, Puerto Rico 1

Colombia venció a Puerto Rico 3-1 (18-25, 25-18, 25-18, 25-20) para conservar su invicto. Colombia y Canadá mantienen récord perfecto (2-0) y se medirán el jueves para definir al líder del Grupo B. Por su parte, Puerto Rico enfrentará a Guatemala, ambos en busca de su primera victoria. Puerto Rico dominó con amplitud el primer parcial. En el cierre, con el marcador (24-14), Colombia reaccionó con tres ataques de Ronald Jiménez y un bloqueo de Juan Castañeda sobre Jamal Ellis, antes de que Ángel Rivera cerrara el set con un potente remate 25-18. Colombia respondió en el segundo set con ventaja de cinco puntos (10-5), liderados en el ataque por Castañeda, Andrés Piza y Jiménez, además del bloqueo de Leandro Mejía. Puerto Rico volvió a resistir y anuló tres puntos de set, pero Piza concretó el empate del partido. En el tercer parcial, los colombianos mantuvieron una diferencia de tres puntos durante todo el desarrollo. Mejía con su bloqueo fue determinante en la recta final, mientras los errores boricuas facilitaron el cierre a favor de Colombia. El cuarto set repitió la tónica, con 11 errores de Puerto Rico y la presencia dominante del central Daniel Aponza en la red, asegurando el triunfo colombiano. Colombia mostró superioridad en todos los fundamentos: 52-49 en ataques, 10-5 en bloqueos y 5-4 en saques directos. En errores, ambos equipos estuvieron parejos, con Colombia cometiendo 23 y Puerto Rico 26. Cinco jugadores colombianos terminaron con doble dígito: Ronald Jiménez, Leandro Mejía y Juan Castañeda con 13 puntos cada uno; Daniel Aponza con 10. El máximo anotador del encuentro fue Pelegrin Vargas de Puerto Rico con 15 unidades, seguido de Pedro Molina y Jamal Ellis con 14 cada uno.

México 3, República Dominicana 0

México derrotó a República Dominicana 3-0 (25-20, 25-19, 25-19) para lograr su segunda victoria consecutiva en sets corridos. El liderato del Grupo C se definirá este jueves en el duelo entre México y Chile, ambos invictos en lo que va de la competencia. Por su parte, República Dominicana cerrará la fase de grupos frente a Surinam, ambos equipos aún sin triunfos. México tomó ventaja en el primer set gracias a el potente ataque de Franky Hernández y un sólido bloqueo de Axel Téllez sobre el capitán dominicano Héctor Cruz, asegurando la ventaja inicial. En el segundo parcial, los anfitriones duplicaron en puntos a sus rivales (10-5) con ataques consecutivos de Alexis Garay, respaldado por Mauro Fuentes, logrando contener el ímpetu de Luis Reinoso y Luther Rosario. República Dominicana reaccionó en el tercer set, adelantándose 6-3 con un buen trabajo de bloqueo de Rafael Burgos y Cruz. Sin embargo, México revirtió el marcador y, con desempeño efectivo de Téllez, amplió la diferencia hasta cuatro puntos (20-16). México cerró el triunfo con potencia ofensiva de Garay y la solidez en la red de Téllez, hasta que un error dominicano selló el marcador. La superioridad de México en el ataque (47-29) fue clave para la victoria. Los locales también dominaron en servicio (4-0) y tuvieron ligera ventaja en bloqueo (5-4). República Dominicana registró menos errores propios (19 por 25 de México). Alexis Garay lideró a México con 14 puntos, todos por ataque. Téllez aportó 11 unidades (6 ataques, 2 bloqueos y 3 aces), mientras que Hernández sumó 10. Del lado caribeño, el capitán Héctor Cruz fue el único en alcanzar doble dígito con 10 puntos.
