Colombia and Mexico Complete the List of Semifinalists

LEÓN, Guanajuato, August 29, 2025.- Colombia and Mexico advanced to the semifinals of the 18th Men's Pan American Cup, taking place at the Domo de la Feria in León, Guanajuato.

Colombia survived a dramatic five-set battle to defeat Chile 3-2 (25-21, 25-22, 22-25, 23-25, 15-12) and secure its spot in the semifinals, while Mexico earned its place by defeating the United States 3-1 (25-21, 18-25, 25-20, 25-23) in the quarterfinals.

Mexico will face defending champion Canada in the semifinals, while Venezuela and Colombia will clash in the other bracket.

Quarterfinals – Mexico 3, United States 1

Mexico claimed its place in the semifinals after defeating the United States 3-1 (25-21, 18-25, 25-20, 25-23) in the quarterfinals. The Mexican squad will face defending champion Canada in the semifinals, while Venezuela and Colombia will battle in the other bracket. The United States, meanwhile, will play in the classification round for positions 5 to 8, starting against Puerto Rico. The first set was tight up to an 11-point tie, when Mexico took control thanks to American errors and the attack of Alexis Garay. With Axel Téllez and Garay leading the offense, the home team maintained the edge. Franky Hernández, first from the service line and then with a back-row attack, pushed the score to 24-20. Ryan Barnett saved one set point, but Oziel Aguirre sealed the set for Mexico. In the second set, the United States dominated from start to finish with a powerful attack led by Isaiah Preuitt, Nolan Flexen, and Parker Van Buren, leaving Mexico unable to catch up. Parity returned in the third set until the 10-10 mark, when Mexico managed to pull ahead and hold the lead. Hernández's serve proved decisive, complicating the U.S. reception and putting the hosts up 22-19. Daniel Wetter closed the gap with a kill, but Hernández struck again, and two U.S. errors handed the set to Mexico. The fourth set saw the United States fighting to even the score, but Mexico held on to a slim advantage after taking a 15-13 lead. Although Kyle Hobus, Cameron Thorne, and Flexen tried to force a fifth set with consecutive points, it wasn't enough. Aguirre, from the wing, sealed Mexico's victory with the match-winning point. Oziel Aguirre led all scorers with 17 points, followed by Hernández with 15 and Garay with 13. For the United States, Flexen tallied 16 points and Barnett added 11.

Quarterfinals – Colombia 3, Chile 2

Colombia survived a dramatic five-set battle to defeat Chile 3-2 (25-21, 25-22, 22-25, 23-25, 15-12) and secure its place in the semifinals. Colombia built a two-set lead, but Chile fought back strongly to tie the match and force a decisive fifth set. In the semifinals, the Colombians await their opponent, either Venezuela or Canada, while Chile will play for positions five through eight. The opening set was intense, with both teams exchanging points. Tied at 10, Colombia pulled ahead with the push of Andrés Piza and Chilean errors, before Leandro Mejía's blocking stopped Dusan Bonacic from scoring comfortably to close the set. The second set was equally tight, tied at 21 when Piza powered through the Chilean block, followed by Juan Felipe Castañeda who stopped Vicente Mardones. Mejía was once again crucial to bring Colombia to set point, and Ronald Jiménez denied Vicente Parraguirre to give Colombia a 2-0 lead. Chile responded in the third set with Bonacic and Ibarra applying pressure from



the start. Although Colombia cut the deficit, Chile held on and sealed the set 25-22 after an Ibarra attack and an Amaranto error. The fourth set was just as close, reaching 23-23. Bonacic took advantage of a deflection off Colombia's reception, followed by a block from Gabriel Araya and a Colombian mistake that leveled the match 2-2. In the tiebreak, Colombia came out strong and built a 6-0 lead, but Chile refused to give in and rallied to within 13-9. It was Daniel Aponza who finally sealed the win with an attack for the 15-12 finish. The statistics reflected the tightness of the match: Colombia led in attacks 65-64 and in blocks 8-7, while Chile held the edge in service points 3-1. Errors were also close, with Chile committing 36 and Colombia 31. Leandro Mejía led Colombia with 16 points, followed by Juan Castañeda with 15 and Andrés Piza with 12. For Chile, captain Dusan Bonacic topped all scorers with 22 points, all on attacks, with Vicente Parraguirre adding 20 and Vicente Ibarra 15.

Puerto Rico 3, Dominican Republic 0

Puerto Rico secured its place in the battle for positions 5 to 8 after defeating the Dominican Republic 3-0 (25-20, 25-18, 25-19). The Puerto Ricans will continue fighting for fifth place in the tournament, while the Dominican Republic will compete between 9th and 12th. Puerto Rico took control of the first set from point seven, with Jamal Ellis and Pelegrin Vargas leading the offense. In the second set, the lead grew to six points (13-7), thanks to contributions from Ellis and Pedro Molina, along with consecutive errors by the Dominican side. Although Ronny Molina responded with kills, Puerto Rico held on firmly to the advantage. In the third set, the Dominicans rallied after trailing 13-16, cutting the gap to 15-16 with attacks from Rafael Burgos, Bryan Turbides, and Luther Rosario. However, Puerto Rico regained control with Vargas and Ellis, pulling ahead 23-17. After a long rally, Ellis put his team at match point, and Omar Hoyos sealed the victory with a spike that deflected off the Dominican defense. Puerto Rico dominated in attack (43-30) and service (6-1), while the Dominican Republic held a slight edge in blocking (6-5). Errors were nearly even, 20 for Puerto Rico and 21 for the Dominicans. Ellis led Puerto Rico with 18 points (14 attacks, 4 blocks), followed by Vargas with 13 (11 attacks, 2 aces). For the Dominican Republic, Luther Rosario scored 11 points (8 attacks, 3 blocks).

Cuba 3, Guatemala 0

Cuba defeated Guatemala 3-0 (25-23, 25-21, 25-23) in a classification match for positions 7 to 10. With the victory, Cuba moves on to compete for positions 5 to 8, while Guatemala will play in the bracket for places 9 to 12. The match was closely contested, with both teams staying within reach on the scoreboard. In the first set, Guatemala saved three set points (19-24) with the offense and blocking of Andy Leonardo, before an error and a kill by Carlos Yoandrys Charles sealed the set for Cuba. In the second frame, Guatemala held a three-point lead (14-11) behind the blocking of Andy Leonardo and Gerardo González, but Cuba responded through the attacks of Thiago Suárez and Yusniel González, combined with errors from the Central American squad. The third set remained tied until 13 points apiece, when Cuba gained a slight edge with the contribution of Endriel Pedroso. Guatemala caught up again at 19-all, but in another tight finish, the Cubans closed the match. Cuba led in attacks 46-32 and in aces 4-2, while both sides were even in blocking with 6 apiece. Guatemala committed fewer errors (19 to Cuba's 27). Carlos Yoandrys Charles led Cuba's offense with 19 points, followed by Thiago Suárez with 13 and Endriel Pedroso with 12. For Guatemala,

Andy Leonardo was the top scorer with 18 points.

Colombia y México completan la lista de Semifinalistas

LEÓN, Guanajuato, 29 de agosto de 2025.- Colombia y México avanzaron a las semifinales de la décimo octava Copa Panamericana Mayor Masculina, que se disputa en el Domo de la Feria en León, Guanajuato.

Colombia sobrevivió a un dramático partido de cinco sets para vencer a Chile 3-2 (25-21, 25-22, 22-25, 23-25, 15-12) y asegurar su lugar en las semifinales, mientras que México conquistó su lugar en las semifinales al superar en cuartos de final a Estados Unidos 3-1 (25-21, 18-25, 25-20, 25-23).

El conjunto mexicano se enfrentará en semifinales al campeón defensor Canadá, mientras que Venezuela y Colombia disputarán la otra llave.

Cuartos de Final – México 3, Estados Unidos 1

México conquistó su lugar en las semifinales al superar en cuartos de final a Estados Unidos 3-1 (25-21, 18-25, 25-20, 25-23). El conjunto mexicano se enfrentará en semifinales al campeón defensor Canadá, mientras que Venezuela y Colombia disputarán la otra llave. Estados Unidos, por su parte, jugará la clasificación por las posiciones 5 al 8, comenzando contra Puerto Rico. El primer set fue cerrado hasta el empate a 11 puntos, cuando México tomó el control gracias a errores del rival y el ataque de Alexis Garay. Con Axel Téllez y Garay en ofensiva, el cuadro local mantuvo la ventaja. Franky Hernández con un saque y luego con un ataque de zaguero puso el marcador 24-20; aunque Ryan Barnett salvó una pelota, Oziel Aguirre selló el triunfo parcial. En el segundo set, Estados Unidos dominó de principio a fin con un ataque sólido encabezado por Isaiah Preuitt, Nolan Flexen y Parker Van Buren, que impidieron a México acercarse en el marcador. La paridad volvió en el tercer parcial hasta el 10-10, cuando México consiguió despegarse. El servicio de Hernández fue clave para incomodar la recepción estadounidense y colocar a los locales 22-19. Daniel Wetter recortó distancia, pero Hernández volvió a aparecer con un ataque y dos errores de Estados Unidos entregaron el set a México. El cuarto set tuvo a Estados Unidos luchando por empatar, pero México sostuvo una ventaja mínima tras colocarse 15-13. Aunque Kyle Hobus, Cameron Thorne y Flexen intentaron forzar un quinto parcial, el esfuerzo no fue suficiente. Aguirre, desde la esquina, selló la victoria mexicana con el punto definitivo. Oziel Aguirre fue el máximo anotador del encuentro con 17 puntos, acompañado por Hernández con 15 y Garay con 13. Por Estados Unidos, Flexen aportó 16 unidades y Barnett contribuyó con 11.

Cuartos de Final – Colombia 3, Chile 2

Colombia sobrevivió a un dramático partido de cinco sets para vencer a Chile 3-2 (25-21, 25-22, 22-25, 23-25, 15-12) y asegurar su lugar en las semifinales. Colombia tomó una ventaja de dos sets a cero, pero Chile reaccionó con fuerza para empatar el encuentro y forzar el decisivo quinto set. En semifinales, los colombianos esperan por su rival, Venezuela o Canadá, mientras que Chile peleará por las posiciones del quinto al octavo lugar. El arranque fue intenso, con ambos equipos luchando punto a punto. Tras el empate a 10, Colombia tomó

ventaja con el empuje de Andrés Piza y errores chilenos, hasta que Leandro Mejía, con su bloqueo, impidió que Dusan Bonacic anotara con comodidad para cerrar el primer parcial. El segundo set fue reñido, alcanzando empatados a 21, cuando Piza superó el bloqueo chileno con potencia, seguido de Juan Felipe Castañeda que frenó a Vicente Mardones. Mejía volvió a ser clave para poner a Colombia en punto de set, y Ronald Jiménez detuvo a Vicente Parraguirre para el 2-0. Chile respondió en el tercer parcial con Bonacic e Ibarra presionando desde el inicio. Aunque Colombia recortó la diferencia, Chile se sostuvo y cerró el set 25-22 tras un ataque de Ibarra y un error de Amaranto. El cuarto set fue igualmente parejo, llegando al 23-23. Bonacic aprovechó un desvío en la recepción colombiana, seguido de un bloqueo de Gabriel Araya y un error rival que empataron el duelo 2-2. En el tie-break, Colombia salió con fuerza y tomó ventaja 6-0, pero Chile no bajó los brazos y se acercó peligrosamente 13-9. Fue Daniel Aponza quien selló la victoria con un ataque para el 15-12 final. Las estadísticas reflejaron lo cerrado del encuentro: Colombia lideró en ataque 65-64 y en bloqueo 8-7, mientras que Chile fue superior en servicio 3-1. Los errores también fueron similares, con 36 de Chile frente a 31 de Colombia. Leandro Mejía fue el máximo anotador colombiano con 16 puntos, seguido de Juan Castañeda con 15 y Andrés Piza con 12. Por Chile, Dusan Bonacic fue el máximo anotador del partido con 22 puntos, todos de ataque, acompañado por Vicente Parraguirre con 20 y Vicente Ibarra con 15.

Puerto Rico 3, República Dominicana 0

Puerto Rico aseguró su lugar en la disputa por las posiciones 5 a 8 tras vencer este viernes a República Dominicana por 3-0 (25-20, 25-18, 25-19). Los boricuas continuarán en la batalla por el quinto lugar del torneo, mientras que República Dominicana competirá entre las posiciones 9 a 12. Puerto Rico tomó el control del primer set a partir del punto 7, con Jamal Ellis y Pelegrin Vargas como principales figuras ofensivas. En el segundo parcial, la ventaja se amplió hasta seis puntos (13-7), gracias al aporte de Ellis y Pedro Molina, además de errores consecutivos del cuadro dominicano. Aunque Ronny Molina descontó con sus ataques, los boricuas no cedieron el dominio. En el tercer set, los dominicanos reaccionaron tras ir abajo 13-16, acortando la diferencia a 15-16 con ataques de Rafael Burgos, Bryan Turbides y Luther Rosario. Sin embargo, Puerto Rico retomó la ventaja con Vargas y Ellis para colocarse 23-17. Tras un intenso rally, Ellis llevó a su equipo al punto de partido y Omar Hoyos cerró el triunfo con un remate que rozó la defensa dominicana. Puerto Rico fue superior en ataque (43-30) y servicio (6-1), mientras que República Dominicana tuvo una ligera ventaja en bloqueo (6-5). Los errores se mantuvieron parejos, 20 para Puerto Rico y 21 para los dominicanos. Ellis lideró la ofensiva boricua con 18 puntos (14 ataques, 4 bloqueos), secundado por Vargas con 13 (11 ataques, 2 aces). Por República Dominicana, Luther Rosario aportó 11 puntos (8 ataques, 3 bloqueos).

Cuba 3, Guatemala 0

Cuba derrotó a Guatemala 3-0 (25-23, 25-21, 25-23) en un partido correspondiente a la clasificación por las posiciones 7 a 10. Con este triunfo, Cuba avanzará a la llave de clasificación por los puestos 5 al 8, mientras que Guatemala competirá en la lucha por las posiciones 9 a 12. El encuentro fue de constante paridad, con ambos equipos siempre cerca en el marcador. En el primer set, Guatemala salvó tres puntos de set (19-24) gracias a la ofensiva y defensa en la red de Andy Leonardo, antes de que un error y el ataque de Carlos



Yoandrys Charles sellaran la ventaja cubana. En el segundo parcial, Guatemala llegó a tomar ventaja de tres puntos (14-11) con los bloqueos de Andy Leonardo y Gerardo González, pero Cuba reaccionó con los ataques de Thiago Suárez y Yusniel González, sumado a los errores del conjunto centroamericano. El tercer set se mantuvo igualado hasta el 13-13, cuando Cuba logró una ligera ventaja con el aporte ofensivo de Endriel Pedroso. Aunque Guatemala igualó nuevamente a 19, un cierre ajustado inclinó la balanza a favor de los cubanos. Cuba dominó en ataque 46-32 y en servicio 4-2, mientras que ambos equipos se igualaron con 6 bloqueos cada uno. Guatemala cometió menos errores (19 por 27 de Cuba). Carlos Yoandrys Charles lideró la ofensiva cubana con 19 puntos, acompañado por Thiago Suárez con 13 y Endriel Pedroso con 12. Por Guatemala, Andy Leonardo fue el máximo anotador con 18 unidades.



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
