Mexico and Venezuela to Battle for Men's Pan American Cup Gold

LEÓN, Guanajuato, August 30, 2025. Mexico and Venezuela will face off for the gold medal of the 18th Senior Men's Pan American Volleyball Cup, which concludes this Sunday at the Domo de la Feria in León, Guanajuato.

Canada and Colombia will fight for a place on the podium in the bronze medal match.

Semifinal – Mexico 3, Canada 1

Mexico advanced to the final after defeating Canada 3-1 (25-21, 25-22, 22-25, 25-22). The host team will play for the gold medal this Sunday against Venezuela, while Canada will face Colombia for the bronze. The home crowd enjoyed a thrilling start in the opening set, as Mexico jumped ahead 20-12 thanks to the offense of Alexis Garay and Franky Hernández. Canada responded with a spectacular comeback led by Erik Siksna and Cole Duncanson, closing the gap to 23-21, but a blocking error and a stuff block from Axel Téllez sealed the set for the hosts. The second set remained tight up to 17 points, when two Canadian errors opened the door for Mexico. In the final stretch, Cory Schoenherr extended the suspense, but a kill from Oziel Aguirre secured the 2-0 lead. Canada controlled the third set with a comfortable 16-10 advantage and, despite a late push from Mexico, Jordan Canham led his side to force a fourth set. In the decisive set, Mexico rallied from a three-point deficit with Yasutaka Sanay coming off the bench and the contribution of Brandon López. Two late errors from the home team made it dramatic, but captain Mauro Fuentes clinched the victory with a powerful hit off the block of Jonas Van Huizen. Although Canada led the stats in attacks (48-40), blocks (8-7), and service points (5-4), their high number of errors (46 to Mexico's 30) proved costly. For Mexico, Axel Manuel Téllez and Yasutaka Sanay led with 9 points apiece. Three Canadians finished in double digits: Erik Siksna (21), Jordan Canham (11), and Jonas Van Huizen (10).

Semifinal – Venezuela 3, Colombia 2

Venezuela secured a spot in the gold medal match after edging Colombia in a thrilling five-set semifinal 3-2 (25-22, 28-26, 19-25, 15-25, 15-12). The Venezuelan team will battle for the gold medal against the winner of the other semifinal between defending champion Canada and Mexico, while Colombia will play for bronze against the loser of that clash. The semifinal was a true battle, with a tight start, fast play, and plenty of highlights. In the opening set, Venezuela pulled ahead 23-20 with a key block from captain Willner Rivas, and after a dramatic finish, a Colombian net touch error sealed the 1-0 lead for Venezuela. In the second set, Colombia staged a spectacular comeback from 19-24 to level at 24, saving seven set points along the way. Still, an attack from Rivas and a block by Moisés Vásquez against Andrés Piza gave Venezuela a commanding 2-0 advantage. Colombia answered strongly in the third and fourth sets with lineup adjustments. Miguel Ramírez "Amaranto," backed by Juan Castañeda and Daniel Aponza, took control offensively to close out 25-19 and 25-15, forcing a decisive fifth set. In the tie-break, Venezuela surged ahead 10-6 thanks to the serving of Ronald Fayola and the attacking of Vásquez, with Rivas leading the charge. Colombia tried to rally with Amaranto and Marlon Mendoza, but a reception error after Fayola's attack sealed Venezuela's victory and celebration of their ticket to the final. Venezuela benefited from 36 Colombian errors against 31 of their own and held the edge in service points (5-3), while Colombia led in

attacks (60-57) and blocks (11-9). Willner Rivas led Venezuela with 16 points, followed by Emerson Rodríguez with 15 and Moisés Vásquez with 11. For Colombia, Miguel Ramírez “Amaranto” and Juan Castañeda tallied 17 points each, Daniel Aponza added 13, and Marlon Mendoza, who came off the bench from the third set onward, chipped in 10.

United States 3, Puerto Rico 1

The United States defeated Puerto Rico 3-1 (28-26, 23-25, 25-18, 25-13) and will compete for fifth place. The Americans will face Chile for fifth place, while Puerto Rico will meet Cuba for seventh. The opening set was tightly contested. The U.S. came back from a three-point deficit to tie at 18, and after several exchanges, closed it 28-26 with a Nolan Flexen attack followed by a Michael Wright serve. Puerto Rico responded in the second, surging ahead 14-7 with the firepower of Jamal Ellis and Pelegrin Vargas. Despite U.S. pressure, a service error handed Puerto Rico the set 25-23. Momentum shifted back to the U.S. in the third, opening with a 7-1 lead thanks to Flexen's effective serving. Kyle Hobus led the attack to secure the set 25-18. In the fourth, the teams were tied at 21 when a spike from Andrew Deardorff and two Puerto Rican errors pushed the U.S. to match point. A service error by Kevin Rodríguez sealed the 25-13 victory. The U.S. led in blocks (10-4), service points (4-2), and committed fewer errors (24-37). Puerto Rico held the edge in attacks (52-20). Kyle Hobus was the top scorer for the U.S. with 16 points, supported by Flexen with 14, Matthew Gentry with 12 including a match-high six blocks, and Cameron Thorne with 10. For Puerto Rico, Ellis scored 17 points and Vargas added 13.

Chile 3, Cuba 0

Chile defeated Cuba in straight sets 3-0 (25-20, 25-21, 25-20) in a classification match for positions 5 to 8. Chile will play for fifth place against the winner between Puerto Rico and the United States, while Cuba will face the loser for seventh place. The Chilean squad dominated the first set by capitalizing on Cuba's errors. The second set was more balanced, with both teams trading points until 18-all, when a block from Dusan Bonacic and the attacks of Vicente Parraguirre gave Chile the edge. In the third, Chile's dynamic offense allowed them to build a comfortable lead and secure the win. Chile led in attacks 41-35 and service aces 3-0, committing 18 unforced errors. Cuba outperformed in blocks 8-4 but totaled 27 errors. Vicente Parraguirre topped the Chilean scoring with 14 points, followed by Noe Aravena with 10. For Cuba, Endriel Pedroso, Lázaro Portes, and Carlos Charles each contributed 9 points.

Suriname 3, Guatemala 1

Suriname captured its first win defeating Guatemala 3-1 (25-21, 29-27, 17-25, 27-25). With this victory, Suriname advanced to the 9th/10th place match against the Dominican Republic, marking its best historical performance in the competition. Guatemala, meanwhile, will face Antigua and Barbuda for 11th/12th place. The Surinamese side displayed character in crucial moments, particularly in the second and fourth sets, where they denied Guatemala multiple set points thanks to the leadership of captain Keven Sporkslede, who switched from his usual libero position —where he had played throughout the tournament— to outside hitter. Blocking proved decisive for Suriname, outscoring Guatemala by a wide margin (13-5). Although Guatemala held the edge in attacking (60-50) and serving (5-1), they committed more errors (34-28), which ultimately tipped the balance. Sporkslede was the match's top scorer with 18

points (14 attacks, 4 blocks), supported by Zefanio Breinburg with 13 (11 attacks, 2 blocks) and Anfernee Lee A Leong with 10. For Guatemala, Andy Leonardo led with 17 points, followed by Gerardo González with 13, while Yeferson Zavala and Jason Hernández each contributed 11. Team captain Carlos López, a key player, was unable to compete due to an injury sustained in the previous match.

Dominican Republic 3, Antigua and Barbuda 0

Dominican Republic cruised past Antigua and Barbuda 3-0 (25-17, 25-9, 25-10). The Dominicans will play for ninth place against the winner of the match between Guatemala and Suriname, while Antigua and Barbuda will compete for eleventh place against the loser. The Dominican squad faced no trouble in securing the win, dominating in attacks (38-20) and service points (5-0). Antigua and Barbuda held the edge in blocking (5-3), but the Dominicans capitalized on 23 opponent errors compared to their 10. Dominican team captain Héctor Alexis Cruz led all scorers with 11 points, while Ronny Molina and Rafael Brugos added 10 points each in the triumph. Adrian Constant topped Antigua and Barbuda's offense with 10 points.

México y Venezuela por el Oro de la Copa Panamericana Masculina

LEÓN, Guanajuato, 30 de agosto de 2025.- México y Venezuela se enfrentarán en el partido por la medalla de oro de la décimo octava Copa Panamericana Mayor Masculina de Voleibol, que culminará este domingo en el Domo de la Feria en León, Guanajuato.

Canadá y Colombia buscarán subir al podio en el duelo por la medalla de bronce.

Semifinal – México 3, Canadá 1

México avanzó la final tras derrotar a Canadá 3-1 (25-21, 25-22, 22-25, 25-22). El equipo anfitrión disputará la medalla de oro este domingo frente a Venezuela, mientras que Canadá se enfrentará Colombia por el bronce. El público disfrutó de un arranque electrizante en el primer set, cuando México tomó ventaja 20-12 gracias a la ofensiva de Alexis Garay y Franky Hernández. Canadá reaccionó con una espectacular remontada impulsada por Erik Siksna y Cole Duncanson, acercándose 23-21, pero un error de bloqueo canadiense y un bloqueo de Axel Téllez cerraron el parcial para los locales. El segundo set fue parejo hasta los 17 puntos, cuando dos errores de Canadá abrieron la brecha. En el tramo final, Cory Schoenherr alargó el suspenso, pero un remate de Oziel Aguirre aseguró el 2-0. Canadá tomó el control del tercer episodio con amplia ventaja 16-10 y, pese al intento de remontada mexicana, Jordan Canham lideró a su equipo para forzar un cuarto set. En el último parcial, México se recuperó de un déficit de tres puntos con el ingreso de Yasutaka Sanay y el aporte de Brandon López. Un cierre dramático con dos errores propios fue superado por el capitán Mauro Fuentes, quien definió el triunfo atacando contra el bloqueo de Jonas Van Huizen. Aunque Canadá dominó en las estadísticas de ataque (48-40), bloqueo (8-7) y servicio (5-4), el alto número de errores cometidos (46 contra 30 de México) fue determinante en el resultado. Por México, Axel Manuel Téllez y Yasutaka Sanay encabezaron la ofensiva con 9 puntos cada uno. Tres canadienses terminaron en doble dígito: Erik Siksna (21), Jordan Canham (11) y Jonas Van Huizen (10).



Semifinal – Venezuela 3, Colombia 2

Venezuela se instaló en la gran final tras vencer en una emocionante semifinal a cinco sets 3-2 (25-22, 28-26, 19-25, 15-25, 15-12) a Colombia. El conjunto venezolano disputará la medalla de oro frente al ganador de la otra semifinal entre el campeón defensor Canadá y México, mientras que Colombia buscará el bronce contra el perdedor de ese duelo. La semifinal fue una auténtica batalla, con inicio parejo, juego rápido y abundancia de puntos. En el primer parcial, Venezuela tomó ventaja con un gran bloqueo de su capitán Willner Rivas para colocarse 23-20, y tras un cierre dramático, un error colombiano de toque de red sentenció el 1-0 para los venezolanos. En el segundo set, Colombia remontó espectacularmente desde el 19-24 para empatar a 24, anulando siete puntos de set. Sin embargo, un ataque de Rivas y un bloqueo de Moisés Vásquez sobre Andrés Piza dieron a Venezuela el 2-0 parcial. Con ajustes en su alineación, Colombia reaccionó en el tercero y cuarto sets. Miguel Ramírez “Amaranto”, apoyado por Juan Castañeda y Daniel Aponza, encabezó la ofensiva para cerrar con autoridad 25-19 y 25-15, forzando el decisivo quinto set. En el tie-break, Venezuela se adelantó 10-6 gracias al servicio de Ronald Fayola y la efectividad de Moisés Vásquez, con Rivas liderando en ataque. Colombia intentó descontar con Amaranto y Marlon Mendoza, pero un error de recepción tras ataque de Fayola dio el triunfo a Venezuela, que celebró su pase a la final. Venezuela se benefició de 36 errores colombianos contra 31 propios y dominó en servicio (5-3), mientras que Colombia superó en ataque (60-57) y bloqueo (11-9). Willner Rivas encabezó a Venezuela con 16 puntos, seguido por Emerson Rodríguez con 15 y Moisés Vásquez con 11. Por Colombia, Miguel Ramírez “Amaranto” y Juan Castañeda aportaron 17 tantos cada uno, Daniel Aponza sumó 13 y Marlon Mendoza, quien entró de cambio a partir del tercer set, contribuyó 10.

Estados Unidos 3, Puerto Rico 1

Estados Unidos derrotó a Puerto Rico 3-1 (28-26, 23-25, 25-18, 25-13) y disputará el quinto lugar. Los estadounidenses enfrentarán a Chile por la quinta posición, mientras que Puerto Rico se medirá ante Cuba por el séptimo puesto. El primer set fue muy disputado. Estados Unidos remontó un déficit de tres puntos para igualar a 18 y, tras varios empates, cerró 28-26 gracias a un ataque de Nolan Flexen y un servicio de Michael Wright. Puerto Rico respondió en el segundo episodio, tomando ventaja 14-7 con el empuje de Jamal Ellis y Pelegrin Vargas; pese a la presión estadounidense, un error de saque les dio el set 25-23. El impulso regresó del lado norteamericano en el tercero, con un inicio de 7-1 tras la efectividad de Flexen en el servicio. Kyle Hobus lideró el ataque para asegurar el parcial 25-18. En el cuarto set, ambos equipos llegaron igualados a 21, pero un ataque de Andrew Deardorff y dos errores boricuas llevaron a Estados Unidos al punto de partido. Chile 3, Cuba 0

Chile derrotó a Cuba en sets corridos 3-0 (25-20, 25-21, 25-20) en partido de clasificación por las posiciones 5 a 8. Chile disputará la quinta posición ante el ganador del encuentro entre



Puerto Rico y Estados Unidos, mientras que Cuba enfrentará al perdedor por el séptimo lugar. El conjunto chileno dominó el primer set aprovechando los errores de Cuba. En el segundo, ambos equipos intercambiaron puntos hasta alcanzar 18 iguales, cuando un bloqueo de Dusan Bonacic y los remates de Vicente Parraguirre marcaron la diferencia. En el tercero, la dinámica ofensiva de Chile les permitió mantener una cómoda ventaja hasta cerrar el triunfo. Chile superó en ataque 41-35 y en servicios directos 3-0, cometiendo 18 errores no forzados. Cuba dominó en el bloqueo 8-4, pero acumuló 27 errores. Vicente Parraguirre encabezó la ofensiva chilena con 14 puntos, seguido por Noe Aravena con 10. Por Cuba, Endriel Pedroso, Lázaro Portes y Carlos Charles aportaron 9 unidades cada uno.

Surinam 3, Guatemala 1

La selección de Surinam conquistó su primera victoria al derrotar a Guatemala 3-1 (25-21, 29-27, 17-25, 27-25). Con este triunfo, Surinam avanzó al duelo por la posición 9/10 del certamen frente a República Dominicana, asegurando así su mejor actuación histórica en la competencia. Guatemala, por su parte, disputará el juego por los lugares 11/12 ante Antigua y Barbuda. El equipo surinamés mostró carácter en los momentos decisivos, especialmente en el segundo y cuarto sets, donde salvó múltiples puntos de set gracias al liderazgo de su capitán Keven Sporkslede, quien cambió de la posición de líbero —donde había jugado durante todo el torneo— a la de esquina. El bloqueo resultó determinante en la victoria de Surinam, superando ampliamente a los guatemaltecos (13-5). Aunque Guatemala dominó en ataque (60-50) y en servicio (5-1), los centroamericanos cometieron más errores (34-28), factor que inclinó la balanza. Sporkslede fue el máximo anotador del encuentro con 18 puntos (14 ataques, 4 bloqueos), respaldado por Zefanio Breinburg con 13 unidades (11 ataques, 2 bloqueos) y Anfernee Lee A Leong con 10. Por Guatemala, Andy Leonardo lideró la ofensiva con 17 puntos, seguido por Gerardo González con 13, mientras que Yeferson Zavala y Jason Hernández aportaron 11 cada uno. El capitán de Guatemala, Carlos López, elemento valioso, no pudo jugar por una lesión que sufrió en el partido previo.

República Dominicana 3, Antigua y Barbuda 0

República Dominicana se impuso con autoridad a Antigua y Barbuda por 3-0 (25-17, 25-9, 25-10). Los dominicanos disputarán el partido por el noveno lugar ante el ganador del encuentro entre Guatemala y Surinam, mientras que Antigua y Barbuda jugará por la undécima posición contra el perdedor de ese duelo. El equipo dominicano controló el partido de principio a fin, mostrando superioridad en ataque (38-20) y servicio (5-0). Antigua y Barbuda dominó en el bloqueo (5-3), pero los dominicanos sacaron provecho de 23 errores de su rival frente a 10 propios. El capitán dominicano Héctor Alexis Cruz fue el máximo anotador del encuentro con 11 puntos, respaldado por Ronny Molina y Rafael Brugos, quienes sumaron 10 unidades cada uno. Por el lado de Antigua y Barbuda, Adrian Constant destacó con 10 puntos.
