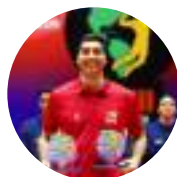

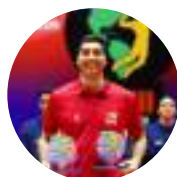

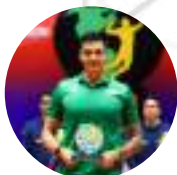

Venezuela Crowned Undefeated Champion of the Men's Pan American Cup

LEÓN, Guanajuato, August 31, 2025.— Venezuela was crowned undefeated champion of the 18th Senior Men's Pan American Volleyball Cup after defeating Mexico 3-1 (25-23, 25-20, 20-25, 25-19) in the gold medal match that closed the event at the Domo de la Feria in León, Guanajuato.

This title marks Venezuela's first-ever gold medal in the history of the Pan American Cup, adding to the bronze medal they earned in 2015.

Host nation Mexico claimed the silver medal, the second in its history, bringing their overall tally to four medals: one gold, one silver, and two bronze.

Venezuela finished undefeated with six victories, 15 sets won and only three lost. Mexico closed the tournament with a record of four wins and two losses, placing second.

Venezuela prevailed in attack (50-42) and blocking (10-8), while Mexico outperformed in service points (5-2). In errors, the Venezuelan side committed one fewer than the hosts (32-33).

Team captain Willner Rivas stood out as the top scorer of the match with 20 points. He was supported offensively by Emerson Rodríguez with 16, Jean Herrera with 12, and Eduardo Vásquez with 10. For Mexico, Axel Téllez led with 12 points, including a match-high 4 aces, followed by Yasutaka Sanay with 11 and Mauro Fuentes with 10.

Bronze Medal – Canada 3, Colombia 0

Canada swept Colombia 3-0 (27-25, 25-22, 25-14) to claim the bronze medal. The Canadian team, the defending champion, was aiming for a historic three-peat. Although they fell short of reaching the final, they closed the tournament in third place with a record of 4 wins and 1 loss. In the history of the event, Canada now holds 2 gold, 3 silver, and 4 bronze medals. Colombia finished in fourth place with a record of three wins and three losses, marking the first time in the history of the tournament that they reached a medal match. The first set was the tightest, tied at 17 points. Colombia gained the lead with a block by Andrés Piza, but Canada quickly responded. After leveling the score at 22, Jonas Van Huizen spikes pushed Canada ahead in a dramatic finish to take the set 27-25. In the second set, Canada pulled away 17-13 with strong plays from Cory Schoenherr and Erik Siksna. Piza and Miguel Martínez led the Colombian push late in the set, but a service error handed the North Americans the 25-22 win. In the third set, powerful serves from Jordan Canham set the tone and paved the way for a wider lead. The blocking duo of Siksna and Matthew Duncanson sealed the sweep (25-14) and the bronze medal. Canada outperformed in blocking (12-5), attacking (38-24), and serving (6-1). Colombia committed fewer errors (21 to Canada's 31). Jordan Canham led all scorers with 16 points (12 attacks, 1 block, 3 aces), followed by Erik Siksna with 13 (8 attacks, 4 blocks, 1 ace), and Jonas Van Huizen with 12 (11 attacks, 1 ace). For Colombia, Andrés Piza and Miguel "Amaranto" Martínez each contributed 8 points.

Chile 3, United States 0

Chile defeated the United States in straight sets 3-0 (25-23, 25-23, 25-18) to secure fifth place. Chile closed its campaign with a strong record of five wins and only one loss, while the United States finished with three victories and three defeats. The match was highly contested in the first two sets, decided by small details. In the opening set, the score was tied at 22 when Tomás Gago blocked Kyle Hobus to give Chile a 24-22 lead. A service error extended the set, but a reception error by the U.S. following another attack from Gago sealed the win. In the third set, Chile built a clear five-point lead (15-10) and maintained control until closing out the sweep. Chile outperformed the United States in attacks (40-34) and service points (4-1). Both teams scored seven points from blocking, while Chile committed fewer errors (22-24). Dusan Bonacic led Chile with 13 points, closely followed by Vicente Parraguirre with 12. For the United States, Daniel Wetter topped the scorers and was the only player in double digits with 14 points.

Cuba 3, Puerto Rico 1

Cuba claimed seventh place after defeating Puerto Rico 3-1 (25-20, 19-25, 25-23, 25-21). Cuba finished the tournament with a 3-3 record, while Puerto Rico ended with 2-4, placing seventh and eighth respectively. It was a close match, with neither team able to dominate clearly. Cuba took the first set, while Puerto Rico controlled the second after point 10, relying on its blocking to even the score. In the third, despite the Puerto Ricans holding a two-point lead late in the set, Cuba closed it out by capitalizing on their opponent's errors. In the fourth, the Cubans took definitive control to secure the victory. Cuba led in attacks 52-41, while Puerto Rico dominated blocking 13-8. Both teams scored 2 service points and committed a similar number of errors: Cuba 33, Puerto Rico 32. For Cuba, Yusniel González and Endriel Pedroso led the scoring with 14 points each, followed by Thiago Suárez with 11. On Puerto Rico's side, opposite hitter Jamal Ellis topped all scorers with 16 points, Pedro Molina added 13, Ángel Rivera tallied 11 including a match-high 5 blocks, and Peligrín Vargas contributed 10.

Dominican Republic 3, Suriname 2

The Dominican Republic survived a five-set battle to defeat Suriname 3-2 (25-13, 25-15, 23-25, 24-26, 15-11) and secure ninth place. The Dominicans closed the tournament with a record of three wins and three losses, while Suriname finished with 1-4, settling for tenth place. After dominating the first two sets with ease, the Dominican Republic endured Suriname's push that forced a tight tie-break. Suriname took a two-point lead in the third set and, with great momentum, extended the match into a decisive fifth set, where the Dominicans finally prevailed thanks to their blocking and steadier performance. The Dominican team made the difference at the net with a 19-8 blocking advantage, in addition to being more effective in attack (62-60), service (4-1), and committing fewer unforced errors (21-27). Dominican Republic's team captain Héctor Cruz was the top scorer of the match with 24 points (20 attacks, 3 blocks, and one ace). Ronny Molina added 20 points (19 attacks, one block), while Luther Molina contributed 15. Four players of Suriname scored in double digits: Shemar Jameson with 19 points, Gianni Ritfeld with 13, Zefanio Breinburg with 12, and Keven Sporkslede with 11.

Guatemala 3, Antigua and Barbuda 0

Guatemala concluded with a 3-0 (25-10, 25-16, 25-17) victory over Antigua and Barbuda. Guatemala finished in 11th place of the competition with a 1-5 record, while Antigua and Barbuda ended the tournament winless. The Central American squad celebrated the victory by dominating in attacks 43-22, in blocks 8-5, and committing fewer errors (15-23). Both teams scored one direct service ace. Andy Leonardo led all scorers with 15 points (13 attacks, one block, one ace), while Yeferson Zavala added 13 points (12 attacks, one block) for Guatemala. On the other side, Adrian Constant stood out for Antigua and Barbuda with 9 points, all from attacks.

Venezuela Campeón Invicto de la Copa Panamericana Masculina

LEÓN, Guanajuato, 31 de agosto de 2025.- Venezuela se coronó campeón invicto de la décimo octava Copa Panamericana Mayor Masculina de Voleibol al derrotar a México 3-1 (25-23, 25-20, 20-25, 25-19) en el partido por la medalla de oro que cerró el evento en el Domo de la Feria en León, Guanajuato.

Este título representa la primera medalla de oro en la historia de Venezuela en la Copa Panamericana, que se suma a la presea de bronce obtenida en 2015.

México, anfitrión del torneo, se quedó con la medalla de plata, la segunda en su historial, con lo que acumula ahora cuatro preseas: un oro, una plata y dos bronce.

Venezuela finalizó invicto con seis victorias, 15 sets ganados y solo tres perdidos. México, por su parte, cerró su participación con récord de cuatro triunfos y dos derrotas para ubicarse en el segundo lugar.

Venezuela fue superior en ataque (50-42) y en bloqueo (10-8), mientras que México dominó en puntos de saque (5-2). En errores, el conjunto venezolano cometió uno menos que los locales (32-33).

El capitán Willner Rivas brilló como máximo anotador del encuentro con 20 puntos. Lo acompañaron en la ofensiva Emerson Rodríguez con 16, Jean Herrera con 12 y Eduardo Vásquez con 10. Por México, Axel Téllez lideró con 12 puntos, incluidos el máximo de 4 aces, seguido por Yasutaka Sanay con 11 y Mauro Fuentes con 10.

Medalla de Bronce – Canadá 3, Colombia 0

Canadá barrió a Colombia 3-0 (27-25, 25-22, 25-14) para conquistar la medalla de bronce. El conjunto canadiense, campeón defensor del torneo, buscaba un histórico triplete, y aunque no logró avanzar a la final, cerró su participación con el tercer lugar y un balance de 4 victorias y una derrota. En la historia del certamen, Canadá suma ahora 2 medallas de oro, 3 de plata y 4 de bronce. Colombia en cuarto lugar con récord de tres victorias y tres derrotas, en la primera vez en la historia del evento en alcanzar un partido por medalla. El primer set fue el más reñido, con empate a 17 puntos. Colombia tomó ventaja con un bloqueo de Andrés Piza, pero la reacción canadiense fue inmediata. Tras igualar a 22, un ataque de Jonas Van Huizen encaminó a Canadá hacia el cierre dramático del parcial (27-25). En el segundo set, Canadá tomó la delantera 17-13 con la ofensiva de Cory Schoenherr y Erik Siksna. Piza y Miguel Martínez empujaron la reacción colombiana, pero un error de servicio en los instantes finales entregó el parcial a los norteamericanos (25-22). En el tercer episodio, los potentes servicios

de Jordan Canham marcaron el rumbo y abrieron el camino para una ventaja más amplia. El bloqueo de Siksna y Matthew Duncanson terminó por sentenciar la barrida canadiense (25-14) y la medalla de bronce. Canadá fue superior: bloqueo (12-5), ataque (38-24) y servicio (6-1). Colombia cometió menos errores (21 por 31 de Canadá). Jordan Canham fue el máximo anotador con 16 puntos (12 ataques, 1 bloqueo, 3 aces), seguido por Erik Siksna con 13 (8 ataques, 4 bloqueos, 1 ace) y Jonas Van Huizen con 12 (11 ataques, 1 ace). Por Colombia, Andrés Piza y Miguel "Amaranto" Martínez aportaron 8 puntos cada uno.

Chile 3, Estados Unidos 0

Chile derrotó a Estados Unidos en sets corridos 3-0 (25-23, 25-23, 25-18) para quedarse con el quinto lugar. Chile cerró su participación con un sólido récord de cinco victorias y una sola derrota, mientras que Estados Unidos finalizó con tres triunfos y tres derrotas. El partido fue muy disputado en los dos primeros sets, definidos por detalles mínimos. En el parcial inicial, ambos equipos llegaron empatados a 22; un bloqueo de Tomás Gago sobre Kyle Hobus dio a Chile ventaja de 24-22, aunque un error de saque prolongó el cierre. Finalmente, un fallo en la recepción estadounidense tras un ataque de Gago selló el set. En el tercero, Chile logró tomar una ventaja clara de cinco puntos (15-10), controlando el marcador hasta cerrar el triunfo. Chile superó a Estados Unidos en puntos de ataque (40-34) y de servicio (4-1). Ambos equipos anotaron siete puntos de bloqueo. Chile cometió menos errores (22-24). Dusan Bonacic encabezó a Chile con 13 puntos, seguido de cerca por Vicente Parraguirre con 12. Por Estados Unidos, Daniel Wetter fue el máximo anotador y único en doble dígito, con 14 puntos.

Cuba 3, Puerto Rico 1

Cuba se quedó con el séptimo lugar al vencer a Puerto Rico 3-1 (25-20, 19-25, 25-23, 25-21). El récord final de Cuba fue de 3-3, mientras que Puerto Rico terminó con 2-4, ocupando las posiciones siete y ocho respectivamente. Fue un partido parejo, sin que ninguno de los dos equipos pudiera dominar claramente al otro. Cuba se llevó el primer set y Puerto Rico tomó el control a partir del punto 10 en el segundo, gracias a su bloqueo, clave para igualar el marcador. En el tercero, pese a que los boricuas tenían ventaja de dos puntos en la recta final, Cuba logró cerrar aprovechando los errores de su rival. En el cuarto parcial, los cubanos tomaron el control definitivo. Cuba superó en ataques 52-41, mientras que Puerto Rico dominó el bloqueo 13-8. Ambos equipos anotaron 2 puntos de servicio y cometieron errores similares: Cuba 33, Puerto Rico 32. Yusniel González y Endriel Pedroso encabezaron la ofensiva cubana con 14 puntos cada uno, seguidos por Thiago Suárez con 11. Del lado de Puerto Rico, el opuesto Jamal Ellis fue el máximo anotador con 16 unidades, Pedro Molina aportó 13, Ángel Rivera 11 con el mayor registro de 5 bloqueos, y Peligrín Vargas sumó 10.

República Dominicana 3, Surinam 2

República Dominicana sobrevivió un partido a cinco sets para imponerse 3-2 (25-13, 25-15, 23-25, 24-26, 15-11) a Surinam y quedarse con el noveno lugar. Los dominicanos cerraron el torneo con récord de tres victorias y tres derrotas, mientras que Surinam finalizó con 1-4, ocupando la décima posición. Tras dominar con claridad los dos primeros parciales, República Dominicana sufrió el empuje surinamés que obligó a definir el encuentro en un

ajustado tie-break. Surinam tomó ventaja de dos puntos en el tercer set y, con gran ímpetu, extendió la batalla hasta el quinto episodio, donde los dominicanos finalmente lograron imponer su bloqueo y mayor regularidad. El equipo dominicano marcó la diferencia en la red con una superioridad de 19-8 en bloqueos, además de ser más efectivo en ataque (62-60), servicio (4-1) y con menos errores no forzados (21-27). El capitán de República Dominicana, Héctor Cruz, fue el máximo anotador del partido con 24 puntos (20 ataques, 3 bloqueos y un ace). Ronny Molina aportó 20 unidades (19 ataques, un bloqueo), mientras que Luther Molina contribuyó con 15. Andy Leonardo fue el máximo anotador del encuentro con 15 puntos (13 ataques, un bloqueo y un ace), seguido por Yeferson Zavala con 13 unidades (12 ataques y un bloqueo). Por el lado de Antigua y Barbuda, Adrian Constant destacó con 9 puntos, todos en ataque.
