Mexico and Brazil remain unbeaten; Cuba and Colombia celebrate first victory

ASUNCIÓN, Paraguay, August 18, 2025. – Mexico and Brazil remain unbeaten in Pools A and B, respectively, while Cuba and Colombia secured their first victories in the men's volleyball tournament of the II Junior Pan American Games Asunción 2025.

The pool stage will be completed on Tuesday, when final standings and the teams advancing directly to the semifinals will be determined.

Cuba 3, Dominican Republic 0

Cuba claimed its first win defeating the Dominican Republic in straight sets 3-0 (25-23, 25-18, 25-23). With the result, Cuba improved its record in Pool B to 1-1 and will face Brazil in its final group-stage match. Dominican Republic, still winless, will play its last preliminary round match against Argentina. The opening set featured several ties, although Cuba always held the edge. The Cubans reached set point following an attack error by Ronny Molina (24-22), but Moisés Ortiz responded with a block on Alejandro González (24-23). In the end, a Dominican service error sealed the set for Cuba. In the second set, Cuba was more dominant. With strong offense from Thiago Suárez and Yusniel González, along with solid net defense by Alejandro González, the Cubans pulled away starting at point 11, building a comfortable five-point advantage (16-11) that allowed them to close out the set securely. The third set unfolded much like the first, with the Dominican Republic staying close on the scoreboard (20-23). However, another error from the opponent handed Cuba the victory in straight sets. The stats highlighted Cuba's offensive edge, leading in attacks 43-32. The Dominican Republic was superior in serving (6-4), while both sides tallied 8 points from blocks. Cuba committed 18 errors, while the Dominican Republic totaled 20. Individually, Cuban opposite hitter Alejandro González topped all scorers with 16 points, followed by team captain Bryan Camino with 12. On the Dominican side, opposite Adrián Figueroa contributed 15 points and Ronny Molina added 12.

Mexico 3, Guatemala 0

Mexico defeated Guatemala 3-0 (25-11, 25-17, 25-23) to remain unbeaten in Pool A. With a 2-0 record, Mexico will play its final pool match against hosts Paraguay, while Guatemala (1-1) will face Colombia. The Mexican squad controlled the match from the start, taking the first set with a huge margin and showcasing four different scorers leading the offense. Their blocking game was key to establishing the early advantage. In the second set, Guatemala fought back and tied the score at 9 points, led by Yefferson Zavala and capitalizing on Mexico's errors. However, the power of Alexis Alvarado, Jared Toy, and Leonardo Maldonado allowed Mexico to regain control and extend the lead to go up 2-0 in the match. The third set was the most competitive. With lineup adjustments, Guatemala stayed close and engaged in a battle at the net between Jerry Durán and Lorenzo Martínez. Pablo Pérez and Daniel Ralón tied the score at 15, and later Guatemala leveled again at 21. Still, attacks from Bryan Vásquez and Diego Ruiz pushed Mexico ahead (24-22). Although Guatemala closed the gap, a reception error sealed the win for Mexico. Mexico held the advantage in attacks (46-30), blocks (7-2), and aces (3-2), while also committing fewer errors (17-19). Mexico's outside hitter Jared Toy led all scorers with 17 points, while Pablo Pérez topped Guatemala with 12. They were the only players to reach double digits.



Brazil 3, Argentina 2

Brazil came out on top in a thrilling five-set match, defeating Argentina 3-2 (27-25, 19-25, 25-14, 22-25, 15-12) to remain unbeaten in Pool B. On Tuesday, Brazil (2-0) will close the preliminary round against Cuba (1-1), while Argentina (1-1) will face the Dominican Republic (0-2). The group winner will earn a direct berth to the semifinals. The opening set had a dramatic finish, with Argentina pulling ahead 21-19 thanks to the attacks of Nicolás Oldani. However, Brazil rallied and sealed the set 27-25 with a block by Witallo de Sousa over Nahuel García. In the second set, Argentina took control behind the leadership of team captain Denis Cabañas, supported by Samuel Guidi and Oldani, prevailing 25-19 to level the match. Brazil regained momentum in the third, led by Maicon dos Santos on offense along with contributions from Samuel de Morais and Sousa, dominating with a convincing 25-14 win. Argentina forced a decisive fifth set after controlling the fourth with solid blocking, highlighted by Nahuel Rojas and Nahuel García. Brazil narrowed the gap with an ace from Guilherme da Silva, but Argentina held firm to close 25-22. In the tiebreak, the score was tied at 8 before Brazil surged ahead with back-to-back points from Maicon dos Santos. Guilherme da Silva added key points down the stretch, and after an Argentine service error, Brazil secured the 15-12 victory. Brazil led in attacks (58-48) and service points (7-5), while Argentina held the edge in blocks (14-8). Errors were nearly even, with Brazil committing one fewer (34-35).

Colombia 3, Paraguay 2

Colombia earned its first victory defeating Paraguay in a thrilling five-set battle 3-2 (30-32, 25-21, 25-18, 20-25, 18-16). Colombia evened its record to 1-1 in Pool A, while Paraguay dropped to 0-2. Standings will be decided on Tuesday with Colombia (1-1) facing Guatemala (1-1) and Paraguay (0-2) taking on Mexico (2-0). The host team struck first after a tightly contested opening set that extended to 32 points, led by Alejandro López. Colombia answered in the second, capitalizing on Paraguayan errors and maintaining control after a 16-16 tie. In the third set, middle blocker Dainer Ocoro made the difference at the net, and although Paraguay rallied late, Colombia closed strongly. Paraguay refused to back down, forcing a fifth set by dictating the rhythm in the fourth, with Tobías Brizuela earning set point and López sealing it with a back-row attack. The decider was dramatic: Paraguay reached match point at 14-12, but Colombia held on with a block by Kevin Villamizar and an attack from Miguel Ángel Rodríguez. In the end, Jhon Mosquera blocked López for 17-16, and a Paraguayan error sealed the 18-16 win. Colombia dominated in blocks (21-8) and edged in service points (5-4), while Paraguay held the advantage in attacks (68-60). Both teams committed 32 unforced errors. Colombian captain Jhon Mosquera was the standout of the match with 30 points, the tournament-high so far. Ocoro and Rodríguez each added 12 points, while Santiago Ramírez and Kevin Villamizar contributed 11 apiece. For Paraguay, López led with 24 points, followed by Brizuela and Ángel Sánchez with 12 each, and José Gaete along with Milton Martínez with 10 apiece.

México y Brasil se mantienen invictos; Cuba y Colombia celebran su primera victoria

Cuba 3, República Dominicana 0

Cuba sumó su primera victoria al superar en sets corridos a República Dominicana 3-0 (25-23, 25-18, 25-23). Con este resultado, Cuba mejora su récord en el Grupo B a 1-1 y cerrará la fase de grupos frente a Brasil. República Dominicana, que aún no conoce la victoria, se medirá en su último compromiso de la fase preliminar, ante Argentina. El primer set estuvo marcado por constantes empates, aunque Cuba siempre mantuvo la ventaja. Los cubanos alcanzaron el punto de set con un error de ataque de Ronny Molina (24-22), pero Moisés Ortiz respondió con un bloqueo sobre Alejandro González (24-23). Finalmente, un error de servicio dominicano selló el parcial para los cubanos. En el segundo episodio, Cuba fue más dominante. Con marca de 2-0, México disputará su último partido de la fase de grupos ante el anfitrión Paraguay, mientras que Guatemala (1-1) se medirá a Colombia. El sexteto mexicano dominó con solidez desde el arranque, imponiéndose en el primer set con amplia ventaja y destacando con cuatro jugadores diferentes al frente de la ofensiva. Su bloqueo fue clave para tomar la delantera en el marcador. En el segundo set, Guatemala reaccionó y logró igualar a 9 puntos, con Yefferson Zavala liderando el ataque y aprovechando errores del rival. Sin embargo, la contundencia de Alexis Alvarado, Jared Toy y Leonardo Maldonado permitió a México recuperar el control y ampliar la ventaja para colocarse 2-0 en el encuentro. Brasil 3, Argentina 2

Brasil salió victorioso en un vibrante partido a cinco sets 3-2 (27-25, 19-25, 25-14, 22-25, 15-12) frente a Argentina, para conservar su condición de invicto en el Grupo B. El martes Brasil (2-0) cerrará la ronda preliminar ante Cuba (1-1), mientras que Argentina (1-1) se enfrentará a República Dominicana (0-2). El primer lugar obtendrá el pase directo a semifinales. El primer set tuvo un cierre dramático, con Argentina tomando ventaja 21-19 gracias a los ataques de Nicolás Oldani. Sin embargo, Brasil reaccionó y se llevó el parcial 27-25 con un bloqueo de Witallo de Sousa sobre Nahuel García. Colombia 3, Paraguay 2

Colombia consiguió su primera victoria al superar a Paraguay en un emocionante partido a cinco sets 3-2 (30-32, 25-21, 25-18, 20-25, 18-16). Colombia iguala su récord a 1-1 en el Grupo A, mientras que Paraguay queda con 0-2. Las posiciones se definirán el martes con los enfrentamientos Colombia (1-1) frente a Guatemala (1-1) y Paraguay (0-2) contra México (2-0). El equipo anfitrión se adelantó tras un disputado primer set que se extendió hasta los 32 puntos, liderado por Alejandro López. Colombia respondió en el segundo parcial aprovechando los errores paraguayos y manteniendo la ventaja tras el empate a 16. En el tercero, el central Dainer Ocoro marcó diferencia en la defensa de la red, y aunque Paraguay reaccionó, los colombianos se impusieron con solidez. Paraguay no bajó los brazos y forzó el quinto set imponiendo su ritmo en el cuarto, con Tobías Brizuela asegurando el punto de set y Alejandro López cerrando con un ataque de zaguero. El desenlace fue dramático: Paraguay alcanzó punto de partido (14-12), pero Colombia resistió con un bloqueo de Kevin Villamizar y la ofensiva de Miguel Ángel Rodríguez. Finalmente, Jhon Mosquera bloqueó a López para el 17-16 y un error paraguayo selló el triunfo 18-16. Colombia dominó en bloqueos (21-8) y superó en servicios (5-4), mientras que Paraguay fue más efectivo en ataque (68-60). Ambos equipos cometieron 32 errores no forzados. El capitán colombiano Jhon Mosquera fue la gran figura del encuentro con 30 puntos, la mayor cifra en lo que va del torneo. También destacaron Ocoro y Rodríguez con 12 puntos cada uno, además de Santiago Ramírez y Kevin Villamizar con 11. Por Paraguay, López lideró con 24 tantos, seguido por Brizuela y Ángel Sánchez con 12, y José Gaete junto a Milton Martínez con 10 cada uno.
