Brazil and Argentina Remain Undefeated

ASUNCIÓN, Paraguay, August 11, 2025. – Brazil and Argentina remain unbeaten (2-0) after two matches, following the conclusion of the second day of the women's volleyball tournament at the II Junior Pan American Games Asunción 2025, taking place at the Arena COP.

Meanwhile, Mexico and Cuba earned their first victories.

On the final day of the preliminary round, Mexico (1-1) will open against Chile (0-2), followed by the match between Argentina (2-0) and Costa Rica (1-1). Brazil (2-0) will face the Dominican Republic (1-1), and the last match will feature Paraguay (0-2) against Cuba (1-1).

The first-place team in each pool advances directly to the semifinals, while the second- and third-place teams from each pool will cross over in the quarterfinals.

Mexico 3, Dominican Republic 1

Mexico bounced back from a rough start to defeat the Dominican Republic 3-1 (20-25, 25-20, 25-22, 25-16). With this result, Mexico improved its Pool B record to 1-1 and will close the group stage facing Chile. The Dominican Republic, with the same record, will play Brazil in its final match. In the first set, the Dominicans pulled ahead from point 16 onward, thanks to the blocking efficiency of Katielle Alonzo, Ambar Hernández, and Florangel Terrero, who contained Mexico's attack. The second set unfolded differently: Mexico showed greater consistency and stayed ahead on the scoreboard throughout, with opposite Andrea Félix leading the offense. The third set was an intense offensive battle. For Mexico, Marcela Herrera and Félix stood out, while for the Dominican Republic, Alondra Tapia and Alonzo shined. The set went to Mexico, who committed fewer errors (6 to 8). In the fourth set, Mexico was dominant from the start, powered by the strong serving of María Cruz, which gave them an early lead that only grew until they comfortably closed out the match. Mexico led in attacks 63-42 and in service points 6-1, while the Dominican Republic held the edge in blocking 14-2. Unforced errors totaled 26 for Mexico and 23 for the Dominican Republic. Mexico's offense was led by Marcela Herrera with 16 points, followed by Andrea Félix with 15 and Aimé Topete with 14. For the Dominican Republic, Alondra Tapia was the top scorer of the match with 22 points, supported by Katielle Alonzo (13) and Florangel Terrero (10).

Cuba 3, Costa Rica 0

Cuba earned a convincing victory over Costa Rica 3-0 (25-11, 25-14, 25-15). Cuba claimed its first win in Pool A for a 1-1 record, the same as Costa Rica. On the final day of the preliminary round, Cuba will face Paraguay, while Costa Rica will play against Argentina. From the opening set, Cuba displayed a varied and effective offense, while Costa Rica struggled to find answers. In the second set, the Cuban block, led by Yensy Kindelán, proved decisive in extending their lead. Despite committing more errors in the third set (9 to Costa Rica's 4), the Caribbean side sealed the match with a block from Lianet García against Ivanny Blackwood. Statistics highlighted Cuba's dominance in attack (45-15), blocking (9-3), and serving (9-0). Costa Rica, meanwhile, committed fewer unforced errors (12 compared to Cuba's 22). Lianet García led Cuba with 17 points from 8 attacks, 4 blocks, and 3 aces. Yalain De La Peña added 14 points (13 attacks, 1 block), and captain Whitney James contributed 11.



Brazil 3, Chile 0

Brazil defeated Chile 3-0 (25-13, 25-14, 25-12) to remain unbeaten. With a 2-0 record, Brazil leads Pool B and will face the Dominican Republic (1-1) in the final match of the preliminary round, with the pool winner advancing directly to the semifinals. Chile, standing at 0-2, will close the group stage against Mexico (1-1). The match began with Chile applying pressure through the powerful and well-placed serves of their captain, Florencia Giglio, which disturbed Brazil's reception. However, Juju's blocking efficiency gave Brazil a strong first set. In the second set, Chile showed greater offensive aggressiveness with Giglio, Esperanza Basualto, and Florencia Aguilera, managing to tie the score at 10 points. Brazil, with a different lineup, found an answer in Ana Luiza Rüdiger, who scored consecutive points to stop Chile's momentum. Brazil's quick and effective play closed out the match in straight sets. The winners led in attacking 49-25 and blocking 6-0, while Chile had the edge in serving points (3-2). Brazil committed 11 unforced errors compared to Chile's 18. Juju was Brazil's top scorer with 12 points, including a match-high 6 blocks. Ana Luiza Rüdiger contributed 11 points, all from attacks, and Stephany Gomes added 10. Florencia Giglio stood out for Chile with 16 points (14 kills, 2 aces), leading all scorers.

Argentina 3, Paraguay 0

Argentina defeated Paraguay 3-0 (25-16, 25-12, 25-21) to remain undefeated. With a 2-0 record in Pool A, Argentina is one step away from securing a spot in the semifinals and will close the preliminary round on Wednesday against Costa Rica (1-1). Paraguay (0-2) will seek its first victory against Cuba (1-1). In the closing moments of the first set, Argentina stopped a four-point run from Paraguay with key plays from Valentina Gartenbank, Josefina Ossvald, and Keila Llanos. Argentina dominated the second set comfortably, but in the third, the hosts jumped ahead 8-5 thanks to disciplined blocking from Tirsa Enríquez, solid defense, and the tactical serving of Sofía Paredes. Paraguay thrilled their home crowd by extending their lead to five points (15-10), capitalizing on changes in the Argentine lineup, but Argentina rallied to tie and secure the straight-set victory. Although Paraguay committed fewer errors (16-22), Argentina held the advantage in all other skills: attacks (42-20), blocks (10-3), and serves (7-4). Opposite hitter Paula Tomasa and outside hitter Keila Llanos led Argentina with 15 points each, with Llanos standing out from the service line with 7 aces. Gisela Otamendi added 10 points. For Paraguay, Sofía Paredes led with 8 points, followed by Mayra Pérez with 6.

Brasil y Argentina mantienen su marca invicta

ASUNCIÓN, Paraguay, 11 de agosto de 2025.- Brasil y Argentina se mantienen invictos (2-0) en igual número de partidos, tras completarse el segundo día del torneo de voleibol femenino de los II Juegos Panamericanos Junior Asunción 2025, que se desarrolla en la Arena COP.

Por su parte, México y Cuba consiguieron su primera victoria.

En el último día de la fase de grupos, México (1-1) abre con Chile (0-2), seguido del partido entre Argentina (2-0) y Costa Rica (1-1). Brasil (2-0) se enfrenta a la República Dominicana (1-1) y el último partido presenta a Paraguay (0-2) ante Cuba (1-1).



El primer lugar de cada grupo avanza a las semifinales, el segundo y tercer lugar de cada grupo se cruzarán en cuartos de final.

México 3, República Dominicana 1

México se recuperó de un inicio adverso para derrotar a República Dominicana 3-1 (20-25, 25-20, 25-22, 25-16). Con este resultado, México mejora su récord en el Grupo B a 1-1 y cerrará la fase de grupos enfrentando a Chile. República Dominicana, con la misma marca, se medirá ante Brasil en su último compromiso. En el primer set, las dominicanas lograron despegarse en el marcador a partir del punto 16, gracias a la efectividad en el bloqueo de Katielle Alonzo, Ambar Hernández y Florangel Terrero, que neutralizaron el ataque mexicano. El segundo parcial tuvo un desarrollo distinto: México mostró mayor consistencia y se mantuvo siempre arriba en el marcador, con la opuesta Andrea Félix liderando la ofensiva. El tercer set fue una intensa batalla ofensiva. Por México destacaron Marcela Herrera y Félix, mientras que por República Dominicana brillaron Alondra Tapia y Alonzo. El episodio terminó a favor de las mexicanas, que cometieron menos errores (6 contra 8). En el cuarto parcial, México fue contundente desde el arranque gracias al potente servicio de María Cruz, que le dio una ventaja temprana que solo aumentó hasta cerrar cómodamente el encuentro. México dominó en ataque 63-42 y en servicio 6-1, mientras que República Dominicana fue superior en bloqueo 14-2. Los errores no forzados fueron 26 para México y 23 para República Dominicana. La ofensiva mexicana estuvo liderada por Marcela Herrera con 16 puntos, seguida de Andrea Félix con 15 y Aimé Topete con 14. Por República Dominicana, Alondra Tapia fue la máxima anotadora del partido con 22 unidades, secundada por Katielle Alonzo (13) y Florangel Terrero (10).

Cuba 3, Costa Rica 0

Cuba logró una victoria contundente sobre Costa Rica por 3-0 (25-11, 25-14, 25-15). Cuba sumó su primera victoria en el Grupo A para un récord de 1-1, mismo balance que Costa Rica. En la última jornada de la fase de grupos, Cuba se medirá con Paraguay, mientras que Costa Rica enfrentará a Argentina. Desde el primer set, Cuba impuso su ataque variado y efectivo, mientras que Costa Rica no encontró respuestas. En el segundo parcial, el bloqueo cubano, liderado por Yensy Kindelan, fue determinante para ampliar la ventaja. Pese a cometer más errores en el tercer set (9 por 4 de Costa Rica), las caribeñas cerraron el encuentro con un bloqueo de Lianet García sobre Ivanny Blackwood. Las estadísticas reflejaron la superioridad cubana en ataque (45-15), bloqueo (9-3) y servicio (9-0). Costa Rica, en cambio, cometió menos errores no forzados (12 frente a 22 de Cuba). Lianet García encabezó la ofensiva cubana con 17 puntos, de 8 ataques, 4 bloqueos y 3 aces. Yalain De La Peña aportó 14 puntos (13 ataques, 1 bloqueo) y la capitana Whitney James contribuyó 11.

Brasil 3, Chile 0

Brasil venció a Chile 3-0 (25-13, 25-14, 25-12) para continuar invicto. Con récord de 2-0, Brasil lidera el Grupo B y se enfrentará a República Dominicana (1-1) en el último partido de la fase de grupos, donde el primer lugar avanzará directamente a las semifinales. Chile, con marca de 0-2, cerrará la ronda ante México (1-1). El encuentro inició con presión chilena gracias al servicio potente y dirigido de su capitana, Florencia Giglio, que complicó la recepción brasileña. Sin embargo, la efectividad de Juju en el bloqueo dio a Brasil un sólido primer set. En el segundo parcial, Chile mostró mayor agresividad ofensiva con Giglio,



Esperanza Basualto y Florencia Aguilera, logrando empatar a 10 puntos. Brasil, con una alineación diferente, encontró en Ana Luiza Rüdiger la respuesta, sumando puntos consecutivos que frenaron el impulso rival. El juego rápido y efectivo de las brasileñas sentenció el partido en tres sets. Las ganadoras dominaron el ataque 49-25 y el bloqueo 6-0, mientras que en servicio Chile sumó un punto más (3-2). Brasil cometió 11 errores no forzados frente a 18 de Chile. Juju fue la máxima anotadora de Brasil con 12 puntos, incluyendo un récord de 6 bloqueos en el partido. Ana Luiza Rüdiger aportó 11 unidades, todas por ataque, y Stephany Gomes agregó 10. Florencia Giglio se destacó por Chile con 16 puntos (14 ataques, 2 aces), liderando a todas las anotadoras del partido.

Argentina 3, Paraguay 0

Argentina venció a Paraguay 3-0 (25-16, 25-12, 25-21) para mantenerse invicta. Con récord de 2-0 en el Grupo A, Argentina está a un paso de clasificar a las semifinales y cerrará la fase de grupos el miércoles enfrentando a Costa Rica (1-1). Por su parte, Paraguay (0-2) buscará su primera victoria ante Cuba (1-1). En el cierre del primer set, Argentina detuvo una racha de cuatro puntos consecutivos de Paraguay gracias a las anotaciones de Valentina Gartenbank, Josefina Ossvald y Keila Llanos. Las argentinas dominaron cómodamente el segundo parcial, pero en el tercero las anfitrionas se adelantaron 8-5 con un bloqueo disciplinado de Tirsa Enríquez, buena defensa y el servicio táctico de Sofía Paredes. Paraguay llegó a tener una ventaja de cinco puntos (15-10) aprovechando cambios en el cuadro argentino, que reaccionó para alcanzarlas y cerrar el triunfo en sets corridos. Aunque Paraguay cometió menos errores (16-22), Argentina fue superior en el resto de los fundamentos: ataque (42-20), bloqueo (10-3) y servicio (7-4). La opuesta Paula Tomasa y la atacante de esquina Keila Llanos fueron las máximas anotadoras argentinas con 15 puntos cada una; Llanos brilló especialmente desde la línea de servicio con 7 aces. Gisela Otamendi sumó 10 puntos. Por Paraguay, Sofía Paredes lideró con 8 unidades y Mayra Pérez aportó 6.
