2025 NORCECA SENIOR WOMEN FINAL SIX

United States and Mexico Remain Undefeated

GUADALAJARA, Jalisco, September 16, 2025. – The United States and Mexico remained undefeated after the completion of day two of the 2025 NORCECA Women's Final Six taking place in Guadalajara, Jalisco.

Day three of the competition opens with Dominican Republic (1-1) facing the United States (2-0), followed by Canada (0-2) against Puerto Rico (1-1), and concludes with Mexico (2-0) taking on Cuba (0-2).

The top four teams will advance to the semifinals.

United States 3, Cuba 2

The United States overcame a tough challenge from Cuba, earning a five-set victory 3-2 (25-20, 16-25, 25-18, 22-25, 15-10) to move to 2-0. The match was a roller-coaster battle, featuring powerful swings and strong blocking from both squads, with momentum shifting throughout the contest. In the opening set, two monster blocks from Laura Suárez and a strong start by Dayana Martínez gave Cuba early momentum. The score stayed tight until key blocks from Emily Thater and late Cuban errors allowed the U.S. to close out the set. Cuba responded in the second set, overcoming a three-point deficit (10-13) thanks to Whitney James' efforts, taking a 17-14 lead and eventually leveling the match 1-1 behind Suárez's offensive production. The U.S. regained control in the third set, building a four-point advantage (13-9) with attacks by Samantha Francis and dominating from the service line (3-0 in aces for the set). Despite strong kills from Lisania Grafort, Team USA stayed ahead to go up 2-1. Cuba fought back in the fourth, surging to a 20-14 lead behind Grafort's blocking and strong serving from Lysbeysis Hernández. The U.S. cut the deficit to one point (22-23) with Madison Kubik and Claire Chaussee scoring, but two decisive plays from Suárez – a kill and a block on Fields – forced a fifth set. Cuba started strong in the tie-break, leading 5-1 with Yalain De La Peña playing a key role. The U.S. fought back to tie the score at 8-all behind Francis and Kubik's net defense. Ella Powell's serving pushed the U.S. to an 11-9 lead, and with a kill from Fields and a Cuban error, USA sealed the victory. USA held the advantage in blocking (13-7) and service points (8-6), while Cuba led in kills (59-56). Both teams committed 26 unforced errors. Madison Kubik and Skylar Fields led the U.S. scoring with 20 points each. Samantha Francis and Emily Thater added 10 apiece, with Thater registering a match-high five blocks. For Cuba, Yalain De La Peña scored 15 points, all on kills, followed by Suárez with 11 and Grafort with 10. Next up, the United States faces the Dominican Republic, while Cuba takes on host Mexico.

Puerto Rico 3, Dominican Republic 0

Puerto Rico earned its first victory with a dominant 3-0 (25-16, 25-16, 25-22) sweep over defending champions Dominican Republic. With the win, Puerto Rico evened its record to 1-1, while Dominican Republic also stands at 1-1. The top four teams at the conclusion of round-robin play will advance to the crossover semifinals. Next, Puerto Rico will face Canada and the Dominican Republic goes against the United States. Puerto Rico's well-balanced offense, led by Diana Reyes, Valeria Vázquez, and Decelise Champion, powered them to a comfortable first-set win. Strong blocking and aggressive serving disrupted the Dominican

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system, keeping the reigning champions under pressure from the start. In the second set, Puerto Rico jumped to a commanding 16-9 lead, fueled by Champion's blocking presence and timely kills. Despite strong attacking from Florangel Terrero and Alondra Tapia, Puerto Rico held firm, with Alba Hernández's block on Tapia and Reyes' attack against Angélica Hinojosa closing out the set. The third set remained tight until 5-all, when Puerto Rico pulled ahead with a combination of Santiago's tip, a setter kill from Wilmarie Rivera, and a Dominican error to lead 8-5. Terrero's blocking and a late surge from Madeline Guillén kept the Dominican squad close, but Vázquez and Paola Santiago pushed Puerto Rico to a 22-19 advantage. Vázquez sealed the win with a decisive kill against Samaret Caraballo's block. Puerto Rico led in every scoring category: attacks (36-33), blocks (9-6), and aces (4-1), while also capitalizing on 26 Dominican errors compared to just 14 of their own. Valeria Vázquez and Decelise Champion topped Puerto Rico's scoring with 11 points each, including four blocks from Champion. Diana Reyes added 10 points. Madeline Guillén was the only Dominican player in double figures, leading all scorers with 16 points.

Mexico 3, Canada 1

Mexico rallied after dropping the opening set to defeat Canada 3-1 (21-25, 25-11, 25-17, 25-20) and remain unbeaten. Mexico now stands at 2-0, while Canada falls to 0-2. On day three of the event, Mexico (2-0) will face Cuba (1-1) and Canada (0-2) will take on Puerto Rico (1-1). Canada jumped to an early 10-4 lead in the first set behind Emma Boyd's offense and Veronica Dickson's tough serving. Despite Mexico's efforts, including a late surge led by Sofía Maldonado and Uxue Guereca, Canada held firm and sealed the set with a kill from Isabella Noble. Mexico responded with a commanding performance in the second set, racing to a 6-1 lead and never looking back. Arleth Márquez was dominant at the net, while Aime Topete contributed crucial points as Mexico evened the match in emphatic fashion. The third set saw a tight start, but Mexico surged ahead 11-6 by finding gaps in Canada's defense. Middle blocker Karina Flores joined Maldonado and Topete to keep Mexico in control. Despite a late Canadian rally led by Maryn Boldon, Gabrielle Attieh, and Boyd, Mexico closed the set with strong plays from Topete and Michelle Lizárraga. Canada once again took the lead early in the fourth set (10-6), with Noble, Attieh, and Sydney Grills powering the offense. Mexico fought back with Maldonado and Topete to tie the score at 10. Samantha Bricio came off the bench and delivered a crucial ace to give Mexico a two-point edge (20-18). Flores added a key attack, and two Canadian errors sealed the victory for the home team. Mexico dominated in attacks (50-35) and aces (8-3), while Canada led in blocks (10-8). Mexico handed out 25 points on unforced errors compared to Canada's 30. Sofía Maldonado once again led Mexico with 15 points (11 kills, 3 blocks, 1 ace), followed by Aime Topete with 13 (12 kills, 1 ace) and Uxue Guereca with 12. Canada was led by Emma Boyd and Maryn Boldon with 11 points each.

Estados Unidos y México Se Mantienen Invictas

GUADALAJARA, Jalisco, 16 de septiembre de 2025. – Las selecciones de Estados Unidos y México se mantuvieron invictas tras completarse el segundo día de competencia en el Final Six Femenino de NORCECA 2025 que se disputa en Guadalajara, Jalisco.



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La tercera jornada de competencia arranca con República Dominicana (1-1) frente a Estados Unidos (2-0), seguido por Canadá (0-2) ante Puerto Rico (1-1), y cierra con México (2-0) contra Cuba (0-2).

Los cuatro primeros lugares avanzarán a las semifinales.

Estados Unidos 3, Cuba 2

Estados Unidos superó un duro desafío ante Cuba, logrando una victoria en cinco sets 3-2 (25-20, 16-25, 25-18, 22-25, 15-10) para mejorar su récord a 2-0. El encuentro fue una auténtica montaña rusa, con potentes remates y sólidos bloqueos de ambos equipos, con el impulso cambiando de lado a lo largo del partido. En el primer set, dos enormes bloqueos de Laura Suárez y un buen arranque de Dayana Martínez dieron la ventaja inicial a Cuba. El marcador se mantuvo cerrado hasta que bloqueos claves de Emily Thater y errores de las cubanas permitieron a las estadounidenses cerrar el set. Cuba respondió en el segundo set, remontando una desventaja de tres puntos (10-13) gracias a los esfuerzos de Whitney James, tomando ventaja 17-14 y finalmente igualando el partido 1-1 con la ofensiva de Suárez. Estados Unidos retomó el control en el tercer set, construyendo una ventaja de cuatro puntos (13-9) con ataques de Samantha Francis y dominando desde la línea de servicio (3-0 en aces en el set). A pesar de los fuertes remates de Lisania Grafort, las norteamericanas se mantuvieron al frente para colocarse 2-1 en el encuentro. Cuba volvió a la carga en el cuarto set, tomando ventaja 20-14 gracias a los bloqueos de Grafort y al buen servicio de Lysbeysis Hernández. Estados Unidos se acercó a un punto (22-23) con ataques de Madison Kubik y Claire Chaussee, pero dos jugadas decisivas de Suárez –un remate y un bloqueo sobre Fields– forzaron el quinto set. Cuba inició fuerte el desempate, tomando ventaja 5-1 con Yalain De La Peña siendo clave. Estados Unidos reaccionó para empatar 8-8 con la defensa en la red de Francis y Kubik. El servicio de Ella Powell impulsó a las estadounidenses a tomar ventaja 11-9, y con un remate de Fields y un error de las cubanas, cerraron el triunfo. Estados Unidos dominó en bloqueo (13-7) y puntos por servicio (8-6), mientras que Cuba fue superior en ataques (59-56). Ambos equipos cometieron 26 errores no forzados. Madison Kubik y Skylar Fields lideraron la ofensiva de Estados Unidos con 20 puntos cada una. Samantha Francis y Emily Thater contribuyeron con 10 puntos, con Thater anotando el máximo de cinco bloqueos en el partido. Por Cuba, Yalain De La Peña anotó 15 puntos, todos en ataque, seguida por Suárez con 11 y Grafort con 10. En su próximo compromiso, Estados Unidos enfrentará a República Dominicana, mientras que Cuba se medirá ante las anfitrionas

Puerto Rico 3, República Dominicana 0

Puerto Rico consiguió su primera victoria con un contundente triunfo 3-0 (25-16, 25-16, 25-22) sobre las campeonas defensoras, República Dominicana. Con este resultado, Puerto Rico iguala su récord en 1-1, mientras que República Dominicana también queda con marca de 1-1. Los mejores cuatro equipos al finalizar la ronda preliminar avanzarán a las semifinales cruzadas. Puerto Rico se enfrentará a Canadá y República Dominicana jugará contra Estados Unidos en sus próximos partidos. El ataque bien balanceado de Puerto Rico, liderado por Diana Reyes, Valeria Vázquez y Decelise Champion, les dio una cómoda victoria en el primer set. El sólido bloqueo y el servicio agresivo desestabilizaron el sistema de juego dominicano, manteniendo bajo presión a las campeonas defensoras desde el inicio. En el segundo set, Puerto Rico tomó una amplia ventaja de 16-9, impulsado por la presencia de Champion en la

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red y ataques oportunos. A pesar de los fuertes ataques de Florangel Terrero y Alondra Tapia, Puerto Rico se mantuvo firme, con un bloqueo de Alba Hernández sobre Tapia y un ataque de Reyes contra Angélica Hinojosa para cerrar el set. El tercer set se mantuvo parejo hasta el 5-5, cuando Puerto Rico tomó ventaja gracias a un toque de Santiago, un remate de la colocadora Wilmarie Rivera y un error dominicano para ponerse 8-5. El bloqueo de Terrero y una ofensiva final de Madeline Guillén mantuvieron a República Dominicana cerca, pero Vázquez y Paola Santiago ampliaron la ventaja de Puerto Rico a 22-19. Vázquez selló la victoria con un remate decisivo ante el bloqueo de Samaret Caraballo. Puerto Rico dominó en todas las estadísticas: ataques (36-33), bloqueos (9-6) y aces (4-1), además de aprovechar 26 errores del rival, frente a 14 propios. Valeria Vázquez y Decelise Champion lideraron la ofensiva de Puerto Rico con 11 puntos cada una, incluyendo cuatro bloqueos de Champion. Diana Reyes aportó 10 puntos. Madeline Guillén fue la única jugadora dominicana en doble dígito, liderando a todas las anotadoras con 16 puntos.

México 3, Canadá 1

México se recuperó después de perder el primer set para derrotar a Canadá 3-1 (21-25, 25-11, 25-17, 25-20) y mantenerse invicto. México ahora tiene marca de 2-0, mientras que Canadá cae a 0-2. En el tercer día de competencia, México (2-0) enfrentará a Cuba (1-1) y Canadá (0-2) jugará contra Puerto Rico (1-1). Canadá tomó una temprana ventaja de 10-4 en el primer set gracias a la ofensiva de Emma Boyd y el agresivo servicio de Veronica Dickson. A pesar de los esfuerzos de México, incluyendo un cierre de set liderado por Sofía Maldonado y Uxue Guereca, Canadá mantuvo el control y selló el set con un remate de Isabella Noble. México respondió con una actuación dominante en el segundo set, tomando ventaja 6-1 desde el inicio y sin mirar atrás. Arleth Márquez fue determinante en la red, mientras que Aime Topete contribuyó con puntos clave para que México empatara el encuentro de manera contundente. El tercer set comenzó parejo, pero México se despegó 11-6 aprovechando los espacios en la defensa canadiense. La central Karina Flores se unió a Maldonado y Topete para mantener a México al frente. A pesar de un intento de reacción de Canadá liderado por Maryn Boldon, Gabrielle Attieh y Boyd, México cerró el set con buenas acciones de Topete y Michelle Lizárraga. Canadá nuevamente tomó la delantera en el cuarto set (10-6), con Noble, Attieh y Sydney Grills encabezando la ofensiva. México reaccionó con Maldonado y Topete para empatar a 10. Samantha Bricio ingresó desde la banca y consiguió un valioso ace para poner a México arriba por dos puntos (20-18). Flores añadió un ataque clave y dos errores de Canadá sellaron la victoria del equipo anfitrión. México fue dominante en ataques (50-35) y saques directos (8-3), mientras que Canadá lideró en bloqueos (10-8). México regaló 25 puntos por errores no forzados contra 30 de Canadá. Sofía Maldonado volvió a ser la máxima anotadora de México con 15 puntos (11 ataques, 3 bloqueos, 1 ace), seguida por Aime Topete con 13 (12 ataques, 1 ace) y Uxue Guereca con 12.
