Costa Rica and Nicaragua to Square Off in the Gold Medal Match

GUATEMALA CITY, Guatemala, October 20, 2025.— Costa Rica and Nicaragua will face each other in the gold medal match of the men's volleyball tournament at the 12th Central American Games Guatemala 2025.

Both teams dominated their respective semifinals, with Costa Rica defeating Panama and Nicaragua overpowering Belize, both in straight sets. Panama and Belize will play for the bronze medal.

Nicaragua 3, Belize 0 – Semifinal

Nicaragua dominated Belize 3-0 (25-21, 25-21, 25-21) to advance to the gold medal match, where they will face Costa Rica. Nicaragua had not reached the podium at the Central American Games since 1990, when they won the silver medal. The Nicaraguan team has never claimed gold, with one silver and one bronze in its history. Belize, meanwhile, will play for the bronze medal against Panama; their last podium finish was in 1997, also a bronze. From the start, Nicaragua set the pace in the first set, with Axel Gutiérrez leading the offense, supported by Jonny Zeledón and Víctor Fonseca. The effort from Belizean Francis Hauze wasn't enough to stop the Nicaraguan momentum. Zeledón closed the set with a powerful spike past Kyron Sutherland's block. The second set was a close battle, with several ties on the scoreboard. From point 19 onward, Nicaragua built a two-point lead that they held to the end. With the score at 22-21, a spike by Gutiérrez that Michael Jenkins couldn't control, followed by two Belize errors, gave Nicaragua a 2-0 set advantage. In the third set, Nicaragua jumped to a comfortable 13-8 lead and stayed ahead until the end. Two strong kills by Zeledón and a service ace from Gutiérrez sealed the victory and a historic spot in the gold medal match. Statistically, Nicaragua led in attacks (52-43), service points (2-0), and committed fewer errors (13-16), while Belize was superior in blocks (7-5). Top scorers for Nicaragua were Axel Gutiérrez with 20 points, Jonny Zeledón with 18, and Víctor Fonseca with 10. Francis Hauze was the only Belizean in double digits, scoring 18 points.

Costa Rica 3, Panama 0 – Semifinal

Costa Rica advanced to the gold medal match defeating Panama in straight sets 3-0 (25-22, 25-21, 25-18) in the semifinals. The last time both teams reached the podium was in 2013, when Costa Rica claimed silver and Panama bronze. This time, Costa Rica awaits the winner between Nicaragua and Belize for the gold medal match, while Panama will play for bronze against the loser. The opening set was tight, with both sides trading points until 16-all, when Costa Rica began to pull away thanks to Ignacio Morales Sánchez and Gilberth Solano. A series of unforced errors from Panama allowed Costa Rica to widen the gap, reaching set point at 24-20 after a strong attack by Solano. Morales Sánchez sealed the set 25-22. In the second set, Costa Rica maintained control with a steady two to three-point lead. Stanley Grant pushed his team to a 19-16 advantage, and with a block from Jeremy Vanega, a Panamanian error, and another powerful hit from Grant, Costa Rica closed the set 25-21 to go up 2-0. Costa Rica continued its dominance in the third set, jumping to a 4-0 lead and showing solid defense and fluid offense. Grant and Solano remained the main offensive weapons, and two consecutive kills from Solano sealed the match 25-18. Costa Rica outperformed Panama in attacks (50-35) and blocks (5-3), while both teams registered one ace. Panama committed fewer errors (19 to 22). Top scorers for Costa Rica were Stanley Grant with 24 points and Gilberth Solano with 16, while Gherson Ortiz led Panama with 14 points, the only player from his team in double digits.

Guatemala 3, El Salvador 0 – Classification 5/7

Guatemala closed its participation in fifth place, after a solid 3-0 (25-13, 32-30, 25-23) victory over El Salvador. With the result, Guatemala finished with a 1-2 record, securing fifth place in the standings. El Salvador will face Honduras on the final day of competition for 6th/7th place. The home team came out strong in the opening set, jumping to an 8-0 lead led by José Pablo Pérez and Carlos López, who guided Guatemala's offensive rhythm. El Salvador responded in the second set, taking a 15-7 advantage with solid performances from Rodrigo Chávez and Abner Cano, helped by Guatemalan errors. However, Guatemala rallied to tie at 23 points and won a thrilling 32-30 finish, with López attacking from the wing, Jason Hernández contributing through the middle, and a consistent blocking effort from multiple players. In the third set, El Salvador came back from a six-point deficit (14-20) to tie the score at 20, but Guatemala maintained composure. Andy Blanco blocked Franklin Flores for set point, and a following attack error by Flores sealed the match for Guatemala. Guatemala dominated in attacks (45-34) and had a wide advantage in blocks (17-6). In unforced errors, Guatemala committed 25 to El Salvador's 20. Top scorers for Guatemala were Carlos López with 14 points, José Pablo Pérez and Andy Blanco with 13 each, and Jason Hernández with 10. For El Salvador, Abner Cano scored 13 points and Rodrigo Chávez 12.

Costa Rica y Nicaragua se enfrentarán en el partido por la medalla de oro

CIUDAD DE GUATEMALA, Guatemala, 20 de octubre de 2025.– Costa Rica y Nicaragua se enfrentarán en el partido por la medalla de oro del torneo de voleibol masculino de los XII Juegos Centroamericanos Guatemala 2025.

Ambos equipos dominaron sus respectivas semifinales, con Costa Rica venciendo a Panamá y Nicaragua superando a Belice, ambos por marcador de 3-0. Panamá y Belice disputarán la medalla de bronce.

Nicaragua 3, Belice 0 – Semifinal

Nicaragua dominó a Belice 3-0 (25-21, 25-21, 25-21) y avanzó al partido por la medalla de oro, donde se enfrentará a Costa Rica. Nicaragua no subía al podio de los Juegos Centroamericanos desde 1990, cuando obtuvo la medalla de plata. El conjunto nicaragüense nunca ha ganado el oro y cuenta en su historial con una plata y un bronce. Belice, por su parte, disputará el partido por la medalla de bronce ante Panamá; su último podio fue en 1997, cuando se quedó con el bronce. Desde el inicio, Nicaragua impuso su ritmo en el primer set, con Axel Gutiérrez liderando las anotaciones, respaldado por Jonny Zeledón y Víctor Fonseca. Costa Rica 3, Panamá 0 – Semifinal

Costa Rica avanzó a la gran final tras superar a Panamá con marcador de 3-0 (25-22, 25-21, 25-18) en la primera semifinal. La última vez que Costa Rica y Panamá subieron al podio fue en la edición de 2013, cuando los ticos se quedaron con la medalla de plata y los panameños con el bronce. En esta ocasión, Costa Rica espera conocer a su rival por el oro entre Nicaragua y Belice, mientras que Panamá disputará el bronce ante el perdedor de esa serie. El encuentro fue parejo en los primeros compases, con ambos equipos empatando en múltiples ocasiones hasta el punto 16, cuando Costa Rica se despegó gracias a la ofensiva de Ignacio Morales Sánchez y Gilberth Solano. Algunos errores no forzados de Panamá facilitaron la ventaja tica, que alcanzó el set point 24-20 tras un potente ataque de Solano. Finalmente, Morales Sánchez cerró el parcial 25-22. En el segundo set, Costa Rica mantuvo el control con una ventaja constante de dos a tres puntos. Stanley Grant lideró el ataque y llevó a su equipo al 19-16, mientras que un bloqueo de Jeremy Vanega, un error panameño y otro potente remate de Grant sentenciaron el 25-21 para el 2-0. Costa Rica dominó el tercer set desde el inicio (4-0), mostrando solidez defensiva y consistencia en el ataque. Grant y Solano fueron nuevamente los protagonistas, y con dos ataques consecutivos de Solano, los ticos sellaron el triunfo y su boleto a la final con un claro 25-18. Las estadísticas destacaron la superioridad costarricense en ataque (50-35) y bloqueo (5-3), con igualdad en aces (1-1). Panamá cometió menos errores no forzados (19 frente a 22 de Costa Rica). Guatemala 3, El Salvador 0 – Clasificación 5/7

Guatemala cerró su participación en la quinta posición, tras imponerse con autoridad 3-0 (25-13, 32-30, 25-23) sobre El Salvador. Con el triunfo, Guatemala finalizó con récord de 1-2, asegurando el quinto puesto del certamen, mientras que El Salvador enfrentará a Honduras en la jornada final por las posiciones 6/7. El equipo anfitrión dominó desde el inicio del primer set con una racha de 8-0, impulsado por José Pablo Pérez y Carlos López, quienes lideraron la ofensiva guatemalteca. El Salvador mostró una mejor versión en el segundo set, tomando una ventaja de 15-7 gracias a la dupla ofensiva de Rodrigo Chávez y Abner Cano, además de aprovechar errores del conjunto local. Sin embargo, Guatemala reaccionó con fuerza, igualando a 23 puntos y sellando un emocionante cierre 32-30, apoyado por López desde la esquina y Jason Hernández por el centro, junto al trabajo defensivo de varios bloqueadores. En el tercer parcial, El Salvador remontó una desventaja de seis puntos (14-20) para empatar a 20, pero Guatemala recuperó el control. Andy Blanco logró un bloqueo clave sobre Franklin Flores, quien luego cometió un error que selló el triunfo local. Guatemala fue superior en ataque (45-34) y mostró una gran diferencia en bloqueo (17-6). En errores no forzados, Guatemala registró 25 por 20 de El Salvador. Los máximos anotadores por Guatemala fueron Carlos López con 14 puntos, José Pablo Pérez y Andy Blanco con 13 cada uno, y Jason Hernández con 10. Por El Salvador, Abner Cano sumó 13 puntos y Rodrigo Chávez 12.
