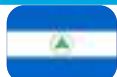

Costa Rica Crowned Champions of the 2025 Central American Games

GUATEMALA CITY, Guatemala, October 21, 2025.— Costa Rica claimed the gold medal in the men's volleyball tournament at the 12th Central American Games Guatemala 2025 after defeating Nicaragua 3-1 (25-22, 21-25, 25-17, 25-19) in the championship match.

With this victory, Costa Rica celebrates its third Central American Games title (1990, 2001, 2025), along with three silver medals (1986, 2010, 2013) and two bronze medals (1977, 1994). Nicaragua returned to the podium for the first time since 1990, when they earned their first silver medal; their previous medal was a bronze in 1986.

The opening set was intense, with Nicaragua jumping to an early 5-1 lead behind the offense of Axel Gutiérrez. Costa Rica responded with strong serving from Jeremy Vanega, rallying to tie and then move ahead 11-8 thanks to Stanley Grant's attacks. The teams remained neck and neck until 21-all, when contributions from Ignacio Morales and Nicaragua's unforced errors allowed Costa Rica to take the first set.

Nicaragua came back strong in the second, building a comfortable six-point lead (14-9) with effective blocking from Yerick Fabián García that stopped Costa Rica's offense. Costa Rica's substitutions steadied the team, tying the set at 17, but Gutiérrez, supported by Yader León, powered Nicaragua to even the match at one set apiece.

In the third set, Nicaragua once again started ahead, but Costa Rica tied at 10 points and turned the tide with Andrey Quintero's serves that disrupted Nicaragua's system. From there, the Costa Rican attack became unstoppable, led by Jason Brown as they built a seven-point lead (18-11) and comfortably took the set 25-17.

Costa Rica kept up their momentum in the fourth, dominating early 12-5 and turning the set into a scoring celebration. With complete control and efficient play, they extended their lead to 16-7 and closed out the set 25-19 to secure the championship.

Costa Rica held the edge in all key areas: attacks (58-51), blocks (13-6), serves (6-3), and committed fewer errors (19-23).

Five Costa Rican players scored in double digits: Stanley Grant with 26 points, Gilberth Solano with 15, Ignacio Morales with 14, and Jason Brown with 11. For Nicaragua, Axel Gutiérrez was the top scorer of the match with 28 points, followed by Yader León with 10.

Panama 3, Belize 2 – Bronze Medal

Panama captured the bronze medal with a thrilling five-set victory over Belize 3-2 (27-25, 23-25, 25-22, 21-25, 15-12). For Panama, this marks their second bronze medal in the history of the Central American Games, their first coming in 2013. Overall, Panama has earned three gold medals and one silver in the regional event's history. The opening set was a tight battle, with both teams displaying strong offense — Kaelen Ingram for Belize and Ludrik West for Panama — remaining tied at 10 points. Panama pulled ahead 18-15, but Belize fought back to force an extended finish. Panama sealed the set 27-25 with a sharp attack from Víctor Pérez that Elton Anderson couldn't control. The second set followed the same intensity.

Belize took a three-point lead at 20, powered by the offense of Francis Hauze and Ingram, and blocking of Kyron Sutherland. Panama tied at 23 after two Belize errors and a spectacular monster block by Félix Williams over Ingram, but Hauze closed the set with two powerful kills to level the match at one set apiece. In the third set, Panama came from behind to tie at 17 points. After a series of intense rallies, Williams led the offense as Panama gained a decisive lead. A service error by Sutherland handed Panama the 25-22 win. Belize answered back in the fourth, even though Panama jumped ahead 11-8 with the help of Gherson Ortiz. Belize tied the score at 19 with a Hauze spike and, with a strong finish, took the set 25-21 with a block by Sutherland and a winning hit by Ingram, forcing the tie-break. In the final set, both teams stayed neck and neck throughout. Panama secured victory after an error from Belize and a controversial play that ended the set 15-12, triggering Panama's celebration. The stats reflected the intensity of the contest: Panama controlled the service line (3-0) and made fewer errors (25-27), while Belize held a slight edge in attacks (72-71) and blocks (12-10). Top scorers for Panama were Félix Williams with 25 points, Gherson Ortiz with 22, and Ludrik West with 10. For Belize, Francis Hauze led all scorers with 27 points, followed by Kaelen Ingram with 25, Eleazar Mejía with 12, and Kerwin Palacio with 11.

El Salvador 3, Honduras 0 – Classification 6/7

El Salvador closed its participation with a 3-0 (25-21, 28-26, 25-21) victory over Honduras, securing sixth place in the competition. El Salvador ended with a 3-2 record, while Honduras finished winless, taking seventh place. The two teams had already met in the preliminary round, where El Salvador also prevailed in straight sets. The most dramatic moment came in the second set, when Honduras seemed ready to win after an Arturo Durán attack gave them a 24-23 lead. However, El Salvador tied it with a Favio López spike. The set continued neck-and-neck until Abner Cano scored with an attack, followed by a crucial block from Juan Carlos Vargas against David Villatoro to close it 28-26. El Salvador outperformed Honduras in attacks (50-37) and committed fewer errors (22-24), while Honduras led in blocking (8-4). Rodrigo Chávez led El Salvador with 22 points, followed by Abner Cano with 10. For Honduras, David Villatoro scored 12 and Rolando Aguilar added 11.

Costa Rica Campeón de los Juegos Centroamericanos 2025

CIUDAD DE GUATEMALA, Guatemala, 21 de octubre de 2025.— Costa Rica se consagró campeón del torneo de voleibol masculino de los XII Juegos Centroamericanos Guatemala 2025 tras imponerse a Nicaragua 3-1 (25-22, 21-25, 25-17, 25-19) en la gran final por la medalla de oro.

Con esta victoria, Costa Rica suma su tercer título centroamericano (1990, 2001, 2025), además de contar con tres medallas de plata (1986, 2010, 2013) y dos de bronce (1977, 1994). Nicaragua, por su parte, regresó al podio por primera vez desde 1990, cuando obtuvo su primera medalla de plata; en 1986 había ganado el bronce.

El primer set fue intenso desde el inicio, con Nicaragua tomando ventaja 5-1 bajo el liderazgo ofensivo de Axel Gutiérrez. Costa Rica reaccionó con el servicio de Jeremy Vanega, que permitió igualar el marcador y revertir la desventaja, tomando la delantera 11-8 con ataques de Stanley Grant. Ambos equipos se mantuvieron parejos hasta el punto 21, momento en que los aportes de Ignacio Morales y algunos errores de Nicaragua dieron el primer set a los costarricenses.

En el segundo parcial, Nicaragua fue contundente, logrando una cómoda ventaja de seis puntos (14-9) gracias al bloqueo efectivo de Yerick Fabián García, que contuvo el ataque rival. Costa Rica realizó ajustes para estabilizar su juego y empatar a 17, pero Gutiérrez, respaldado por Yader León, lideró a Nicaragua para igualar el encuentro.

El tercer set comenzó nuevamente con dominio nicaragüense, pero Costa Rica igualó a 10 puntos y, con el servicio de Andrey Quintero, desestabilizó la recepción rival. Los ticos tomaron una ventaja de siete puntos (18-11) con Jason Brown sumándose en ataque y cerraron cómodamente el parcial 25-17.

Costa Rica mantuvo su ímpetu en el cuarto set, tomando rápidamente una amplia ventaja 12-5. Con un desempeño sólido en todos los fundamentos, amplió el margen a 16-7 y cerró con autoridad el triunfo que les dio el campeonato regional.

Las estadísticas reflejan la superioridad costarricense: ventaja en ataque (58-51), bloqueo (13-6), servicio (6-3) y menos errores no forzados (19-23).

Cinco jugadores costarricenses anotaron en doble dígito: Stanley Grant con 26 puntos, Gilberth Solano con 15, Ignacio Morales con 14 y Jason Brown con 11. Por Nicaragua, Axel Gutiérrez fue el máximo anotador del partido con 28 puntos, seguido por Yader León con 10.

Panamá 3, Belice 2 – Medalla de Bronce

Panamá se llevó la medalla de bronce con una vibrante victoria en cinco sets sobre Belice 3-2 (27-25, 23-25, 25-22, 21-25, 15-12). Para Panamá, esta es su segunda medalla de bronce en la historia de los Juegos Centroamericanos; la primera la obtuvo en 2013. En total, Panamá suma tres medallas de oro y una de plata en la historia del certamen regional. El primer set fue un duelo cerrado, con ambas escuadras mostrando su fuerza ofensiva —Kaelen Ingram

por Belice y Ludrik West por Panamá— manteniéndose igualadas a 10 puntos. Panamá tomó ventaja 18-15, pero Belice respondió y forzó un final extendido que se definió 27-25 para Panamá con un ataque de Víctor Pérez que Elton Anderson no pudo controlar. El segundo set mantuvo la misma intensidad. Belice se adelantó por tres puntos al llegar a los 20, gracias a los ataques de Francis Hauze e Ingram y al bloqueo de Kyron Sutherland. Panamá empató a 23 tras dos errores beliceños y un bloqueo espectacular de Félix Williams sobre Ingram, pero Hauze cerró el parcial con dos potentes remates para igualar el encuentro a un set por lado. En el tercer set, Panamá vino de atrás para empatar a 17 puntos y, tras una serie de intercambios intensos, tomó la delantera definitiva con Williams como figura ofensiva. Un error de servicio de Sutherland selló el triunfo 25-22 para los panameños. Belice respondió en el cuarto set, pese a que Panamá comenzó al frente 11-8 impulsado por Gherson Ortiz. Los beliceños igualaron a 19 con un ataque de Hauze y, con un sólido cierre, ganaron 25-21 con bloqueo de Sutherland y remate ganador de Ingram, forzando así el set decisivo. En el tie-break, ambos equipos se mantuvieron empatados durante gran parte del parcial. Panamá aseguró la victoria tras una falta de Belice y una jugada controversial que cerró el marcador 15-12, desatando la celebración panameña. Los números reflejan la intensidad del duelo: Panamá dominó el servicio (3-0) y cometió menos errores (25-27), mientras que Belice tuvo ligera ventaja en ataque (72-71) y bloqueo (12-10). Los máximos anotadores por Panamá fueron Félix Williams con 25 puntos, Gherson Ortiz con 22 y Ludrik West con 10. Por Belice, Francis Hauze fue el máximo anotador del encuentro con 27 puntos, seguido por Kaelen Ingram con 25, Eleazar Mejía con 12 y Kerwin Palacio con 11.

El Salvador 3, Honduras 0 – Clasificación 6/7

El Salvador cerró su participación con una victoria 3-0 (25-21, 28-26, 25-21) sobre Honduras, asegurando la sexta posición del certamen. El Salvador finalizó con un récord de 3-2, mientras que Honduras se despidió sin victorias, ocupando el séptimo lugar. Ambos equipos ya se habían enfrentado en la fase de grupos, con triunfo también en sets corridos para los salvadoreños. El encuentro tuvo su momento más dramático en el segundo set, cuando Honduras parecía encaminado a ganarlo tras un ataque de Arturo Durán que los puso arriba 24-23. Sin embargo, El Salvador igualó con una ofensiva de Favio López. El marcador se mantuvo cerrado, intercambiando ventajas hasta que un ataque de Abner Cano y un bloqueo decisivo de Juan Carlos Vargas sobre David Villatoro sellaron el parcial 28-26 a favor de los salvadoreños. El Salvador fue superior en ataque (50-37) y cometió menos errores (22-24), mientras que Honduras dominó en bloqueo (8-4). Rodrigo Chávez fue la figura ofensiva de El Salvador con 22 puntos, seguido por Abner Cano con 10. Por Honduras, David Villatoro aportó 12 puntos y Rolando Aguilar sumó 11.
