PONCE, Puerto Rico, October 12th, 2025.- Canada finished in fifth place while Dominican Republic won Bronze and

This tournament awards world ranking points to teams not competing in the Volleyball Nations League (VNL) and serves as part of the qualification process for the Central American and Caribbean Games, awarding continental ranking points to all participating teams.

Canada defeated Suriname 3-0 (25-19, 25-18, 25-15), Dominican Republic swept Mexico (25-23, 25-21, 25-22) and

Canada 3, Suriname 0

Canada defeated Suriname in straight sets (25-19, 25-18, 25-15) to finish in fifth place of the NORCECA Men's Final Four at the Juan "Pachín" Vicéns Auditorium.

Canada Finished the tournament with a 2-4 win-loss record and fifth place while Suriname ended in sixth place with 0-6.

The Canadians started strong with an early 4-1 advantage. Suriname got close (7-8), but three consecutive points from Canada gave them an 11-7 lead. Canada continued the dominance mid-set with a comfortable margin (20-15). An ace from Matthew Siebenga closed the set 25-19.

Canada's pressure with their serves was key to maintaining the lead throughout the second set, building a 10-point advantage mid-set (19-9). Suriname tried to close the gap, but Canada sealed the set 25-18.

The same tactic was used in the third set, this time supported by Canada's blocking. They won the set 25-15, securing fifth place in the tournament.

Canada outscored Suriname in attacks (30-24), blocks (6-2) and serves (11-1) and committed fewer unforced errors than Suriname (25-28).

Matthew Siebenga, Canada's middle blocker was the top scorer of the match with 11 points (7 attacks, 3 blocks and 1 serve) with 58 % success in attacks. For Suriname, Gianni Ritfeld led the offensive with 7 points.

Dominican Republic 3, Mexico 0

Dominican Republic won the Bronze Medal at the NORCECA Men's Final Six after a straight set win over Mexico (25-23, 25-21, 25-22) at the Juan "Pachín" Vicéns Auditorium.

Dominican Republic finished in third place with a 3-4 win-loss record, to win their first medal in the tournament's history. Mexico ended with a 4-3 record and fourth place.

The Dominican Republic started strong in the first set (6-3) and maintained a six-point lead until mid-set (17-11). Mexico came from behind and tied the score at 22-22. Two consecutive errors from Mexico gave the Dominicans set point, and they ultimately won the set 25-23.

The Dominican Republic kept its momentum with a 9-5 margin at the start of the second set, maintaining a comfortable 17-12 lead. Mexico pushed back, and two consecutive points from Ridl Garay tied the action at 20-20. The Dominican offense prevailed, winning the set 25-21."

With great defense and assertive attacks, the Dominican Republic led all the way through the third set. Mexico gained momentum and tied the score at 20-20, but the Dominicans ultimately won the set 25-22 and the Bronze Medal.

Dominican Republic led in attacks 38-37 and blocks 7-5 while Mexico dominated in serves 6-2. Dominican Republic committed 18 unforced errors and Mexico 28.

Adrian Figueroa, opposite of the Dominican Republic, was the top scorer of the match with 19 points (17 attacks and 2 blocks). For Mexico, opposite Ridl Alexis Garay scored 16 points (13 attacks, 1 block and 2 aces).

United States 3, Puerto Rico 0

The United States defeated Puerto Rico in straight sets (27-25, 25-20, 25-21) to win their third tittle in a row in the NORCECA Men's Final Six at the Juan "Pachín" Vicéns Auditorium.

This is the fifth overall medal for the United States in the NORCECA Final Six, Bronze in 2021 and 2022, and Gold in 2023, 2024, and 2025. For Puerto Rico, this marks their first-ever medal in the tournament.

The match started close, with both teams trading one-point leads. Consecutive errors from Puerto Rico gave the United States a 15-13 lead through the first set, but Puerto Rico fought back and tied the score at 20-20. It was a tight finish, but the United States prevailed 27-25.

Puerto Rico gained a slight advantage at the start of the second set (5-3), but the United States gained momentum, tied the score (7-7), and later pulled ahead by four points (12-8). The USA maintained the lead through the remainder of the set, winning 25-20.

Puerto Rico took an early lead in the third set (6-4) and built a 5-point advantage midway through the set (15-10), prompting the United States to call a timeout to regroup. The USA came from behind and tied the score at 17-17. They kept up the pressure with strong serves and won the set 25-21, earning the gold medal.

The United States outplayed Puerto Rico in attacks (35-34), blocks (8-5) and serves (8-5) and committed fewer unforced errors (22) than Puerto Rico (29).

Opposite Kyler Wade with 13 points (8 attacks, 1 block and 4 aces) and outside hitter Patrick Rogers with 12 points (11 attacks and 1 ace) led the offensive for United States. For Puerto Rico, outside hitter Pedro Molina was the top scorer with 14 points (10 attacks, 3 blocks and 1 ace) followed by opposite Jamal Ellis with 11 points.

Individual Awards

Outside hitter Patrick Rogers from the United States was named the Most Valuable Player (MVP) of the 2025 NORCECA Men's Final Six held from October 6-12 at the Juan "Pachín" Vicéns Auditorium.

Patrick Rogers received the MVP recognition during the closing ceremony after the United States earn their third consecutive title at the tournament. Rogers contributed a total of 78 points over the seven matches his team played at the event on the way to the gold medal and was second best scorer of the USA in the championship match with 12 points (11 attacks and 1 ace).

Opposite Kyler Wade from the United States was named best server.

From Puerto Rico Pelegrin Vargas was distinguished with the award of 2nd Best Spiker, Best Setter to Howard García and Best Received to Angel Cabrera.

Dominican Republic received six individual recognitions. José Adrián Figueroa was the Best Scorer and Best Opposite, Luis David Reinoso earned the award for Best Outside Hitter, Moisés Ortíz was selected 2nd Best Blocker and Enger Miéses was selected as the Best Defense and Best Libero of the competition.

El torneo NORCECA Final Six Masculino otorga puntos de clasificación mundial a equipos que no compiten en la Liga de Naciones de Voleibol (VNL), y sirve como parte del proceso de clasificación para los Juegos Centroamericanos y del Caribe, otorgando puntos de clasificación continental a todos los equipos participantes.

Canadá derrotó a Surinam 3-0 (25-19, 25-18, 25-15), República Dominicana venció a México (25-23, 25-21, 25-22) y

Mexico 3, Surinam 0

Canadá derrotó a Surinam en sets seguidos (25-19, 25-18, 25-15) para terminar en quinto lugar del NORCECA Final Six Masculino en el Auditorio Juan “Pachín” Vicéns.

Canadá terminó el torneo con un récord de 2-4 en victorias y derrotas, quedando en quinto lugar, mientras que Surinam terminó en sexto lugar con 0-6.

Los canadienses comenzaron con fuerza con una ventaja inicial de 4-1. Surinam se acercó (7-8), pero tres puntos consecutivos de Canadá les dieron una ventaja de 11-7. Canadá continuó dominando a mitad del set con un margen cómodo (20-15). Un ace de Matthew Siebenga cerró el set 25-19.

República Dominicana 3, México 0

República Dominicana ganó la medalla de bronce en el NORCECA Final Six Masculino tras vencer a México en sets seguidos (25-23, 25-21, 25-22) en el Auditorio Juan “Pachín” Vicéns.

República Dominicana terminó en tercer lugar con un récord de 3-4 en victorias y derrotas, para obtener su primera medalla en la historia del torneo. México terminó con un récord de 4-3 y el cuarto lugar.

República Dominicana comenzó con fuerza el primer set (6-3) y mantuvo una ventaja de seis puntos hasta la mitad del set (17-11). México remontó y empató el marcador 22-22. Dos errores consecutivos de México le dieron a los dominicanos punto para set, y finalmente ganaron el set 25-23.

República Dominicana mantuvo el ritmo con un margen de 9-5 al inicio del segundo set, y luego manteniendo una cómoda ventaja de 17-12. México reaccionó y dos puntos consecutivos de Ridl Garay igualaron el marcador 20-20. El ataque dominicano prevaleció, ganando República Dominicana 25-21.

Con una gran defensa y ataques contundentes, República Dominicana dominó todo el tercer set. México tomó impulso y empató el marcador 20-20, pero finalmente los dominicanos ganaron el set 25-22 y la medalla de bronce.

República Dominicana lideró en ataques 38-37 y bloqueos 7-5, mientras que México dominó en servicios 6-2. República Dominicana cometió 18 errores no forzados y México 28.

Adrián Figueroa, opuesto de República Dominicana, fue el máximo anotador del partido con 19 puntos (17 ataques y 2 bloqueos). Por México, el opuesto Ridl, Alexis Garay, anotó 16 puntos (13 ataques, 1 bloqueo y 2 puntos directos de saque).

Estados Unidos 3, Puerto Rico 0

Estados Unidos derrotó a Puerto Rico en sets seguidos (27-25, 25-20, 25-21) para ganar su tercer título consecutivo del NORCECA Final Six Masculino en el Auditorio Juan “Pachín” Vicéns.

Esta es la quinta medalla para Estados Unidos en la NORCECA Final Six, bronce en 2021 y 2022, y oro en 2023, 2024 y 2025. Para Puerto Rico, esta marca su primera medalla en el torneo.

El partido comenzó reñido, con ambos equipos intercambiando ventajas de un punto. Errores consecutivos de Puerto Rico le dieron a Estados Unidos una ventaja de 15-13 durante el primer set, pero Puerto Rico reaccionó y empató el marcador 20-20. Fue un final de set ajustado, pero Estados Unidos se impuso 27-25.

total de 78 puntos en los siete partidos que su equipo disputó en el evento camino a la medalla de oro y fue el segundo mejor anotador de EE. UU. en el partido por el campeonato con 12 puntos (11 ataques y 1 ace).

Su oponente, Kyler Wade, de Estados Unidos, fue nombrado mejor al saque.

El puertorriqueño Pelegrín Vargas fue distinguido con el premio de Segundo Mejor Atacante. Mejor Colocador fue para su compañero Howard García y Mejor Recepción para Ángel Cabrera, líbero de Puerto Rico.
