USA, Mexico, Dominican Republic, and Costa Rica Open with Straight-Set Victories

SAN JOSÉ, Costa Rica, November 4, 2025. – The United States, Mexico, the Dominican Republic, and Costa Rica opened the 2025 NORCECA Girls' U17 Continental Championship with solid straight-set wins at the Gimnasio Nacional in San José, Costa Rica.

In Pool B, the United States earned a strong 3-0 (25-13, 25-17, 25-15) victory over Puerto Rico, while Mexico swept Cuba 3-0 (25-16, 25-17, 25-20).

In Pool A, the Dominican Republic began its campaign with a 3-0 (25-23, 25-22, 25-21) win against Canada, and host Costa Rica started off with a convincing 3-0 (25-14, 25-13, 25-16) triumph over Suriname.

United States 3, Puerto Rico 0

The United States opened with a solid 3-0 (25-13, 25-17, 25-15) victory over Puerto Rico in Pool B action. The tournament serves as a qualifier event for the 2026 FIVB Under-17 World Championship. On day two of the competition, the United States will face Mexico, while Puerto Rico meets Cuba in the continuation of Pool B play. The Americans started strong with a 4-1 run and capitalized on opponent errors to extend the lead to 11-5. Puerto Rico narrowed the gap to three points (11-14) with a big block from Anna Aquino and key kills, but the U.S. regained control thanks to the powerful attacks of Maya Ogbogu, maintaining their lead through the end of the first set. In the second set, Puerto Rico opened with a 3-0 run before the United States responded with a quick recovery behind McKenzie Andrews' strong offense and solid blocking. Puerto Rico's Arianna Pantojas and Viveca García kept the score close until midway through the set, when Madlen Gloessner and Ogbogu led the U.S. to pull ahead by four points, eventually sealing the frame 25-17. The United States stormed through the third set, leading 16-10 behind the serving and attacking power of team captain Lexi Coleman. Maintaining control, the Americans finished the match in straight sets for a convincing debut victory. Team USA outperformed Puerto Rico in all key skills, leading in kills (28-24), blocks (7-2), and aces (8-0). The U.S. also benefited from 32 opponent errors, while committing only 15 of their own. Outside hitter Maya Ogbogu led all scorers with 14 points (9 kills, 3 blocks, 2 aces), followed by team captain Lexi Coleman with 10 points (7 kills, 3 aces). Puerto Rico's Anna Aquino topped her team with 9 points (8 kills, 1 block).

Mexico 3, Cuba 0

Mexico delivered a strong performance to open with a straight-set victory, 3-0 (25-16, 25-17, 25-20), over Cuba. The event serves as a qualifier for the 2026 FIVB Under-17 World Championship. In day two Pool B action, Mexico (1-0) will face the United States (1-0), while Cuba (0-1) will meet Puerto Rico (0-1). Mexico opened the match in dominant fashion with a 7-0 run, taking advantage of Cuba's early unforced errors. Emily Camarena and Karina Campos led the way offensively, while Cuba's Yusdely Cabrera tried to respond but fell short of closing the gap. In the second set, Cuba responded with stronger defense, highlighted by Sahily Prats' impressive blocking. The score remained tight, but Mexico maintained a slim lead behind the spikes of Evelyn Díaz and Isabella Gallardo (16-14). With effective serving





from Louanne Negrete, Mexico extended the gap to 20-15 and went on to secure the 2-0 set advantage. Cuba showed greater consistency in the third set, starting with a 5-1 lead thanks to Cabrera's effective kills. Mexico, however, maintained pressure, tying the score at 6-6 and later pulling ahead 15-11 with strong attacks from Díaz and a key serving run by Sofía Rodríguez. Despite a late Cuban push led by Cabrera and Clara Alfonso's serves (20-22), Mexico closed out the match following two Cuban errors. Mexico dominated the offensive stats, holding an overwhelming 44-17 advantage in attacks and 12-5 in aces. Cuba led in blocks (7-2) and committed fewer unforced errors (17-24). Outside hitter Evelyn Díaz topped Mexico's scorers with 12 points, all on kills. Team captain and opposite hitter Emily Camarena and middle blocker Isabella Gallardo each added 11 points. For Cuba, outside hitter Yusdely Cabrera led with 11 points, while middle blocker Sahily Prats contributed 5 blocks, the highest of the match.

Dominican Republic 3, Canada 0

The Dominican Republic started with a straight-set victory 3-0 (25-23, 25-22, 25-21) over Canada in the opening Pool A match. Next, the Dominican Republic will face Suriname, while Canada will play against the host team, Costa Rica. The match was tightly contested, with thrilling finishes in every set. Both teams traded points early in the first set until the Dominicans pulled ahead with a kill from Jarolin Durán, a block by Rayni Mondesí, and an ace from Rosaris Peña to lead 13-9. Canada, led by Naya Grimm, Winji Magdi, and Chloe Dumont, fought back to close the gap. A powerful attack by Leandry Almonte brought the Dominican Republic to set point, but Shayla Byrnell denied it. Ultimately, Mondesí secured the set with a back-row kill to give her team a 1-0 lead. The Dominican Republic came out strong again in the second set with a 5-0 run, extending their momentum to 11-2 as Elizabeth García joined the offensive effort. Canada showed patience and tied the score at 12, led by Byrnell and Grimm, with Grimm pushing ahead 14-12 on her serves. A block by Elaina Grover gave Canada a 16-14 advantage, but the Dominicans rallied once more. Two Canadian errors helped them regain the lead 21-19, holding on to close another tight set 25-22. Canada opened the third set up 5-3 behind Dumont's offense and extended the lead to 7-4. With contributions from Magdi and Grover, Canada maintained a 16-11 advantage. However, the Dominicans fought back, fueled by Shanty Pérez's powerful kills to pull within one (18-17). Canada's Charlie Visser served effectively to hold the edge, but the Dominicans tied it at 21, with Mondesí dominant at the net. After a great defensive rally, Almonte sealed the victory with two kills. The Dominican Republic held advantages in attacks (37-31) and blocks (9-3), while Canada led in aces (7-2). Both teams had a similar number of unforced errors, with the Dominican Republic committing 25 and Canada 27. Leandry Almonte led the Dominican Republic with 19 points (18 kills, 1 block), followed by Rayni Mondesí with 17 points (14 kills, 3 blocks). For Canada, Naya Grimm and Elaina Grover led the scoring with 9 and 8 points, respectively.

Costa Rica 3, Suriname 0

Host nation Costa Rica opened with a convincing 3-0 (25-14, 25-13, 25-16) victory over Suriname in Pool A action. On the second day of competition, a qualifier for the 2026 FIVB Girls' U17 World Championship, Costa Rica (1-0) will face Canada (0-1), while Suriname (0-1) meets the Dominican Republic (1-0). The opening set was tightly contested early on; with





both teams trading points up to 11-all. Costa Rica then broke away with strong attacking from Luciana Vargas and effective serving by Charlotte Martínez, combined with several Suriname errors to take a 14-11 lead. Martínez added two consecutive blocks and Victoria Cobeña contributed from the service line as the home team secured the first set. Cobeña continued to be a key factor in the second set, helping Costa Rica jump ahead 8-4. With contributions from Martínez and Vargas, the hosts extended their lead to 16-9. A crucial block by Sofía Quesada over Suriname's Zoe Roethof further widened the gap. Costa Rica capitalized on 12 unforced errors from their opponents to take a 2-0 set advantage. Suriname started the third set with greater determination, keeping the score tied up to 6 points with Cherelle Meulenhof joining Roethof on offense. Livana Verheul's consistent serving helped Suriname stay close, leveling the actions at 12-all. However, Costa Rica once again pulled away behind Vargas' attacking and Cobeña's blocking, forcing additional Suriname errors to complete the straight-set victory. Costa Rica held the statistical edge in every skill: attacks (25-18), blocks (5-4), and service aces (11-3). The hosts also benefited from 34 opponent errors while committing only 18 themselves. Victoria Cobeña led Costa Rica with 11 points (7 kills, 1 block, 3 aces), followed by Luciana Vargas with 10 kills. Zoe Roethof of Suriname topped all scorers with 12 points.

EE. UU., México, Dominicana y Costa Rica Arrancan con Victorias en Sets Corridos

SAN JOSÉ, Costa Rica, 4 de noviembre de 2025.- Estados Unidos, México, República Dominicana y Costa Rica abrieron el Campeonato Continental NORCECA Femenino Sub-17 2025 con una sólidas victorias en el Gimnasio Nacional de San José, Costa Rica.

En el Grupo B, Estados Unidos obtuvo una sólida victoria 3-0 (25-13, 25-17, 25-15) sobre Puerto Rico y México venció a Cuba en sets corridos 3-0 (25-16, 25-17, 25-20).

En el Grupo A, República Dominicana inició su participación con una victoria en sets corridos 3-0 (25-23, 25-22, 25-21) sobre Canadá y Costa Rica abrió con un convincente 3-0 (25-14, 25-13, 25-16) frente a Surinam.

Estados Unidos 3, Puerto Rico 0

Estados Unidos abrió con una sólida victoria 3-0 (25-13, 25-17, 25-15) sobre Puerto Rico, en acción del Grupo B. El torneo sirve como clasificatorio para el Campeonato Mundial FIVB Sub-17 de 2026. En la segunda jornada de competencia, Estados Unidos enfrentará a México, mientras que Puerto Rico se medirá ante Cuba, en la continuación de la acción del Grupo B. Las estadounidenses iniciaron con fuerza, tomando ventaja 4-1 y aprovechando los errores de su rival para ampliar la diferencia a 11-5. Puerto Rico acortó la distancia a tres puntos (11-14) gracias a un gran bloqueo de Anna Aquino y ataques certeros, pero Estados Unidos retomó el control con los potentes remates de Maya Ogbogu, manteniendo la ventaja hasta el final del primer set. En el segundo parcial, Puerto Rico comenzó con una racha de 3-0 antes de que Estados Unidos reaccionara rápidamente con una ofensiva efectiva de McKenzie Andrews y un bloqueo sólido. Arianna Pantojas y Viveca García mantuvieron parejo el marcador hasta la mitad del set, cuando Madlen Gloessner y Ogbogu guiaron a su equipo para despegarse por cuatro puntos y cerrar el parcial 25-17. Estados Unidos dominó el tercer





set, tomando ventaja 16-10 impulsado por el servicio y los ataques de su capitana Lexi Coleman. Manteniendo el control de las acciones, las estadounidenses sellaron el encuentro en sets corridos para una convincente victoria en su debut. En la segunda jornada del Grupo B, México (1-0) enfrentará a Estados Unidos (1-0), mientras que Cuba (0-1) se medirá ante Puerto Rico (0-1). México inició el encuentro con dominio absoluto, tomando una ventaja de 7-0 y aprovechando los errores no forzados de Cuba. Emily Camarena y Karina Campos encabezaron la ofensiva mexicana, mientras que YUSDely Cabrera intentó mantener a Cuba en juego sin lograr reducir significativamente la diferencia. En el segundo set, Cuba mostró una mejor respuesta defensiva, destacando los impresionantes bloqueos de Sahily Prats. El marcador se mantuvo cerrado, pero México conservó una ligera ventaja gracias a los remates de Evelyn Díaz e Isabella Gallardo (16-14). Con una efectiva secuencia de saques de Louanne Negrete, México amplió la distancia a 20-15 y aseguró el parcial para ponerse 2-0 al frente. Cuba mostró un mejor desempeño en el tercer set, comenzando con ventaja 5-1 impulsada por los ataques de Cabrera. Sin embargo, México mantuvo la presión, empatando a 6 puntos y luego tomando el control 15-11 con potentes remates de Díaz y una buena serie de servicios de Sofía Rodríguez. Pese al intento final de Cuba con ataques de Cabrera y los saques efectivos de Clara Alfonso (20-22), México cerró el encuentro tras dos errores consecutivos de las cubanas. México dominó las estadísticas ofensivas con una amplia ventaja de 44-17 en ataques y 12-5 en saques directos. Cuba lideró en bloqueos (7-2) y cometió menos errores no forzados (17-24). La atacante de esquina Evelyn Díaz fue la máxima anotadora de México con 12 puntos, todos por ataque. La capitana y opuesta Emily Camarena y la central Isabella Gallardo aportaron 11 puntos cada una. Por Cuba, la punta YUSDely Cabrera lideró con 11 puntos, mientras que la central Sahily Prats sumó 5 bloqueos, la cifra más alta del encuentro.

República Dominicana 3, Canadá 0

República Dominicana inició su participación con una victoria en sets corridos 3-0 (25-23, 25-22, 25-21) sobre Canadá, en el primer partido del Grupo A. En su próximo compromiso, República Dominicana se enfrentará a Surinam, mientras que Canadá jugará ante el equipo anfitrión, Costa Rica. El encuentro fue muy disputado, con emocionantes cierres en cada set. Ambos equipos intercambiaron puntos al inicio del primer parcial, hasta que las dominicanas tomaron ventaja con un remate de Jarolin Durán, un bloqueo de Rayni Mondesí y un ace de Rosaris Peña para colocarse 13-9 arriba. Canadá, liderado por Naya Grimm, Winji Magdi y Chloe Dumont, reaccionó para acortar la distancia. Un potente ataque de Leandry Almonte





colocó a República Dominicana en punto de set, pero Shayla Byrnell lo salvó. Finalmente, Mondesí cerró el set con un remate desde la zona de atrás para el 1-0. República Dominicana arrancó fuerte nuevamente en el segundo set con una racha de 5-0, extendiendo su impulso hasta el 11-2, con Elizabeth García sumándose a la ofensiva. Canadá mostró paciencia y empató a 12 puntos, guiado por Byrnell y Grimm, quien además dio la ventaja 14-12 con sus saques. Un bloqueo de Elaina Grover dio ventaja a Canadá 16-14, pero las dominicanas se recuperaron. Dos errores canadienses ayudaron a las quisqueyanas a retomar el liderato 21-19 y cerrar otro ajustado parcial 25-22. Canadá inició el tercer set al frente 5-3, impulsado por la ofensiva de Dumont, y amplió la ventaja 7-4. Con el apoyo de Magdi y Grover, las canadienses se mantuvieron arriba 16-11. Sin embargo, las dominicanas reaccionaron, impulsadas por los potentes remates de Shanty Pérez para acercarse a un punto (18-17). Charlie Visser mantuvo la ventaja canadiense con su servicio, pero las dominicanas empataron a 21, con Mondesí efectiva en la red. Tras un gran esfuerzo defensivo, Almonte selló la victoria con dos potentes remates consecutivos. República Dominicana fue superior en ataques (37-31) y bloqueos (9-3), mientras que Canadá lideró en puntos directos de servicio (7-2). Ambos equipos tuvieron una cantidad similar de errores no forzados, con 25 para República Dominicana y 27 para Canadá. Leandry Almonte encabezó la ofensiva dominicana con 19 puntos (18 ataques, 1 bloqueo), seguida de Rayni Mondesí con 17 puntos (14 ataques, 3 bloqueos). Por Canadá, Naya Grimm y Elaina Grover fueron las más destacadas con 9 y 8 puntos, respectivamente.

Costa Rica 3, Surinam 0

La selección anfitriona de Costa Rica abrió con una convincente victoria 3-0 (25-14, 25-13, 25-16) sobre Surinam, en acción del Grupo A. En la segunda jornada de competencia, clasificatoria al Campeonato Mundial FIVB Sub-17 Femenino 2026, Costa Rica (1-0) enfrentará a Canadá (0-1), mientras que Surinam (0-1) se medirá ante República Dominicana (1-0). El primer set fue muy disputado en los inicios, con ambos equipos intercambiando puntos hasta el empate a 11. Luego, Costa Rica se despegó con potentes ataques de Luciana Vargas y el efectivo servicio de Charlotte Martínez, además de varios errores de Surinam para tomar ventaja 14-11. Martínez sumó dos bloqueos consecutivos y Victoria Cobeña aportó desde el saque para que el equipo local asegurara el primer parcial. Cobeña continuó siendo una pieza clave en el segundo set, ayudando a Costa Rica a tomar una cómoda ventaja de 8-4. Con los aportes de Martínez y Vargas, las anfitrionas ampliaron la diferencia 16-9. Un bloqueo crucial de Sofía Quesada sobre Zoe Roethof de Surinam aumentó la ventaja. Costa Rica aprovechó 12 errores no forzados de su rival para ponerse arriba 2-0. Surinam inició el tercer set con mayor determinación, manteniendo el marcador parejo hasta los 6 puntos, con Cherelle Meulenhof sumándose a Roethof en la ofensiva. El servicio consistente de Livana Verheul permitió a Surinam mantenerse cerca, igualando las acciones a 12. Sin embargo, Costa Rica volvió a tomar el control con los ataques de Vargas y el bloqueo de Cobeña, forzando más errores del rival para completar la victoria en sets corridos. Costa Rica dominó en todos los fundamentos: ataques (25-18), bloqueos (5-4) y servicios (11-3). Además, se benefició de 34 errores del oponente, cometiendo solo 18. Victoria Cobeña lideró a Costa Rica con 11 puntos (7 ataques, 1 bloqueo, 3 aces), seguida por Luciana Vargas con 10 ataques. Zoe Roethof, de Surinam, fue la máxima anotadora del encuentro con 12 puntos.
