United States and Dominican Republic Remain Undefeated

SAN JOSÉ, Costa Rica, November 5, 2025. – The United States in Pool B and the Dominican Republic in Pool A remain undefeated after the completion of the second day of competition at the 2025 NORCECA Girls' U17 Continental Championship, being held at the Gimnasio Nacional in San José, Costa Rica.

Pool-play will conclude on Thursday, with the first-place teams from each pool advancing directly to Saturday's semifinals.

Meanwhile, Puerto Rico and Canada earned their first victories in Pools B and A, respectively.

United States 3, Mexico 0

The United States defeated defending champion Mexico in straight sets 3-0 (25-16, 25-22, 25-15) in Pool B action. This is the United States' second win in the tournament, which also serves as a qualifier for the 2026 FIVB Girls' U17 World Championship. The U.S. will face Cuba on Thursday, the final day of pool play, while Mexico will go up against Puerto Rico. The top team in each pool advances directly to the semifinals. The match was full of energy, with the U.S. leading in kills (33-25), blocks (10-3), and serves (9-6). The United States committed 19 unforced errors to Mexico's 23. Mary-Christine Crutcher and Taylor Johnson led the U.S. scoring with 12 points each, followed by Madison Middleton with 11 points. Madlen Gloessner contributed significantly at the net as the top blocker in the match (4 blocking points). For Mexico, outside hitter Evelyn Díaz scored a match-high 13 points. The U.S. pulled ahead early in the first set (13-7) with powerful kills from Johnson and Julia Masselink, and strong blocking from Gloessner. Despite efforts from Díaz and Louanne Negrete to close the gap, the Americans maintained control to take the first set. Mexico started strong in the second set (4-1), but the U.S. quickly recovered with solid blocking and offensive contributions from Crutcher. Mexico rallied late behind Negrete's serves to narrow the gap (18-19), but the Americans held firm. Middleton sealed the set with a kill and an ace for a 2-0 lead. In the third set, the U.S. jumped to a 6-1 lead before Mexico leveled at 11-all, powered by Díaz and opponent errors. However, the Americans regained momentum with key plays from Ellie Enger, Crutcher, and Johnson, pulling away 17-13. Two consecutive blocks from Gloessner and Crutcher closed out the sweep.

Puerto Rico 3, Cuba 1

Puerto Rico earned its first win after defeating Cuba 3-1 (25-13, 25-19, 22-25, 25-16). With the win, Puerto Rico improved its record to 1-1 in Pool B, while Cuba dropped to 0-2. Puerto Rico (1-1) will close pool play against Mexico (1-1), and Cuba (0-2) will face undefeated USA (2-0). The top team in each pool advances directly to the semifinals. Puerto Rico held the advantage in attacks (44-28) and serves (12-4), while Cuba led in blocks (6-3). Both teams committed a similar number of errors, 35 for Puerto Rico and 38 for Cuba. Puerto Rican outside hitter Anna Aquino led all scorers with 17 points (14 attacks, 1 block, 2 aces), followed by opposite hitter Viveca García with 11 points (6 attacks, 1 block, 4 aces). Anelys Morales led Cuba with 9 points. Puerto Rico opened the match strongly, capitalizing on Cuba's errors





and a balanced offense from at least four players to lead 10-4. With Kamila Colón and Viveca García guiding the offense, Puerto Rico controlled the pace to comfortably win the first set. Cuba improved in the second set, keeping the score even up to 12 points, led by Yusdely Cabrera's powerful swings and Sahily Prats' blocking that pushed them ahead 15-13. Puerto Rico maintained pressure, tying the score several times and finally pulling away with the efforts of Aquino and García. A decisive play by Daniela Echeandía sealed the 25-19 win for Puerto Rico and a 2-0 lead. Set three began as a duel between Aquino and Prats, tied early at 5-5. Carinialys Román added key attacks for Puerto Rico, while Alicia Sengstack's blocking kept Cuba in contention. Puerto Rico took a 12-9 lead thanks to Eliany Quiñones' block, an Aquino attack, and a strong serve from García. Cuba responded with huge blocks from Vizcaíno, coming from behind to tie at 22 points and then scoring three points in a row, capped by Amanda Mayor's serve, to take the set 25-22 and force a fourth. Puerto Rico jumped ahead 10-5 in the fourth set, with Aquino leading the charge and Román adding support, as Cuba struggled with consecutive errors. Despite Cuba's late offensive push from Clara Alfonso, Mayor, and Hernández, Puerto Rico maintained control and closed the match 25-16 to secure their first victory of the tournament.

Dominican Republic 3, Suriname 0

The Dominican Republic earned its second victory defeating Suriname 3-0 (25-13, 25-8, 25-13). The Dominican Republic improved to 2-0 in Pool A and will face host nation Costa Rica in their final pool-play match. Suriname, now 0-2, will meet Canada. The first-place team in each pool advances directly to the semifinals in the tournament, which also serves as a qualifier for the 2026 FIVB Girls' U17 World Championship. The Dominicans led in every skill category: 35-12 in attacks, 4-2 in blocks, and 10-5 in serves. They benefited from 26 opponent errors while committing 15 of their own. Dominican captain Rayni Mondesi topped all scorers with 15 points (12 kills, 3 aces), followed by setter Shanty Pérez with 12 points (9 kills, 3 aces). Zoë Roethof led Suriname with 9 points. The Dominican Republic dominated the match from start to finish. In the first set, Pérez and Mondesi led the offensive charge, while in the second set, Leandry Almonte contributed effectively on attack as the team maintained total control. Strong serving was key, giving the Dominicans a 4-0 advantage and preventing Suriname's main players, Cherelle Meulenhof and Zoe Roethof, from finding rhythm. The third set followed the same pattern, with Mondesi delivering powerful serves early on to seal the sweep.

Canada 3, Costa Rica 0

Canada earned a straight-set victory (25-18, 25-22, 25-18) over Costa Rica in Pool A action. On the final day of the preliminary round, Canada (1-1) will face Suriname (0-2), while Costa Rica (1-1) will take on undefeated Dominican Republic (2-0). The event serves as a qualifier for the 2026 FIVB Girls' U17 World Championship. Canada led in attacking points (42-20) and service aces (9-1), while Costa Rica held the advantage in blocking (7-5) and committed fewer unforced errors (19-30). Middle blocker Shayla Byrnell topped Canada's offense with 10 points (6 kills, 4 blocks). Outside hitter Naya Grimm and middle blocker Chloe Dumont added 9 points apiece. For Costa Rica, outside hitter Sofía Quesada scored 9 points, all from kills. The opening set was tight early on, tied at 3 points, before Canada surged ahead 10-6 behind the offense of Grimm and Winji Magdi, capitalizing on Costa Rica's errors. Despite strong blocking





from Charlotte Martinez and Esmeralda Ugalde, Canada maintained control, with Elaina Grover scoring key points on kills and blocks. Ella Grapentine sealed the set with an ace. In the second set, Costa Rica took a 6-4 lead with efforts from Luciana Vargas and Sofía Quesada, but Canada quickly responded with Grover and Byrnell powering ahead 10-8. The score remained close until Canada broke an 18-18 tie with consecutive attacks from Izabela Sajda and Grapentine, who once again closed the set with an ace. Canada built a comfortable 11-6 lead in the third set, fueled by Dumont and Sajda. Costa Rica fought back to within one point (14-15) thanks to Vargas's offense, but Canada extended the lead again, with Byrnell contributing over the net. Dumont secured the final point with a kill to complete the sweep.

Estados Unidos y República Dominicana Mantienen Récord Invicto

SAN JOSÉ, Costa Rica, 5 de noviembre de 2025. – Estados Unidos en el Grupo B y República Dominicana en el Grupo A mantienen su récord invicto tras completarse el segundo día de competencia del Campeonato Continental NORCECA Femenino Sub-17, que se celebra en el Gimnasio Nacional de San José, Costa Rica.

El jueves se completará la ronda de grupos; el primer lugar de cada grupo avanzará a las semifinales del sábado.

Por su parte, Puerto Rico y Canadá obtuvieron su primera victoria, en los Grupos B y A respectivamente.

Estados Unidos 3, México 0

Estados Unidos derrotó al campeón defensor México en sets corridos 3-0 (25-16, 25-22, 25-15) en la acción del Grupo B. Este es el segundo triunfo de Estados Unidos en el torneo, que además sirve como clasificatorio al Campeonato Mundial Femenino Sub-17 de la FIVB 2026. El conjunto estadounidense enfrentará a Cuba el jueves, en el último día de la fase de grupos, mientras que México se medirá ante Puerto Rico. El primer lugar de cada grupo avanzará directamente a las semifinales. El partido estuvo lleno de energía, con Estados Unidos dominando en ataques (33-25), bloqueos (10-3) y servicios (9-6). Las estadounidenses cometieron 19 errores no forzados contra 23 de México. Mary-Christine Crutcher y Taylor Johnson lideraron la ofensiva estadounidense con 12 puntos cada una, seguidas por Madison Middleton con 11. Madlen Gloessner tuvo una destacada actuación en la red como la mejor bloqueadora del encuentro (4 puntos de bloqueo). Por México, la atacante de esquina Evelyn Díaz fue la máxima anotadora del encuentro con 13 puntos. Estados Unidos tomó ventaja temprano en el primer set (13-7) con potentes ataques de Johnson y Julia Masselink, y sólidos bloqueos de Gloessner. A pesar de los esfuerzos de Díaz y Louanne Negrete por acortar la diferencia, las estadounidenses mantuvieron el control para llevarse el parcial. México inició con fuerza el segundo set (4-1), pero Estados Unidos reaccionó rápidamente con un bloqueo efectivo y el aporte ofensivo de Crutcher. México se acercó en el marcador (18-19) gracias a los servicios de Negrete, pero las norteamericanas se mantuvieron firmes. Middleton selló el set con un ataque y un ace para poner el 2-0. En el tercer set, Estados Unidos arrancó con ventaja de 6-1 antes de que México empatara a 11, impulsado por Díaz y errores rivales.





Sin embargo, las estadounidenses retomaron el impulso con jugadas clave de Ellie Enger, Crutcher y Johnson, alejándose 17-13. Dos bloqueos consecutivos de Gloessner y Crutcher completaron la barrida.

Puerto Rico 3, Cuba 1

Puerto Rico obtuvo su primera victoria tras derrotar a Cuba 3-1 (25-13, 25-19, 22-25, 25-16). Con el triunfo, Puerto Rico mejoró su registro a 1-1 en el Grupo B, mientras que Cuba cayó a 0-2. Puerto Rico (1-1) cerrará la fase de grupos ante México (1-1), y Cuba (0-2) se enfrentará a Estados Unidos (2-0), que se mantiene invicto. El primer lugar de cada grupo avanzará directamente a las semifinales. Puerto Rico dominó en ataques (44-28) y servicios (12-4), mientras que Cuba fue superior en bloqueos (6-3). Ambos equipos cometieron una cantidad similar de errores: 35 de Puerto Rico y 38 de Cuba. La atacante de esquina puertorriqueña Anna Aquino fue la máxima anotadora del encuentro con 17 puntos (14 ataques, un bloqueo, 2 aces), seguida por la opuesta Viveca García con 11 puntos (6 ataques, un bloqueo, 4 aces). Anelys Morales lideró a Cuba con 9 puntos. Puerto Rico inició con fuerza, aprovechando los errores de Cuba y una ofensiva equilibrada de al menos cuatro jugadoras para tomar ventaja de 10-4. Con Kamila Colón y Viveca García guiando el ataque, Puerto Rico controló el ritmo del juego para llevarse cómodamente el primer set. Cuba mejoró en el segundo set, manteniendo el marcador parejo hasta los 12 puntos, impulsada por los potentes ataques de Yusdely Cabrera y los bloqueos de Sahily Prats, que las pusieron arriba 15-13. Puerto Rico mantuvo la presión, empatando en varias ocasiones y finalmente despegándose gracias al trabajo de Aquino y García. Una jugada decisiva de Daniela Echeandía selló el triunfo 25-19 para el 2-0 parcial. El tercer set comenzó como un duelo entre Aquino y Prats, empatadas 5-5 en el inicio. Carinialys Román aportó ataques clave para Puerto Rico, mientras que Alicia Sengstack con su bloqueo mantuvo a Cuba en la lucha. Puerto Rico se adelantó 12-9 con un bloqueo de Eliany Quiñones, un ataque de Aquino y un servicio efectivo de García. Cuba respondió con grandes bloqueos de Vizcaíno, viniendo de atrás para empatar a 22 puntos y luego anotar tres seguidos, cerrando el set 25-22 con un servicio de Amanda Mayor, para extender el partido a un cuarto parcial. Puerto Rico tomó ventaja 10-5 en el cuarto set, liderado por Aquino y con el apoyo de Román, mientras Cuba cometía errores consecutivos. A pesar de la reacción final de Cuba con ataques de Clara Alfonso, Mayor y Hernández, Puerto Rico mantuvo el control y cerró el partido 25-16 para asegurar su primera victoria del torneo.

República Dominicana 3, Surinam 0

República Dominicana consiguió su segunda victoria tras derrotar a Surinam 3-0 (25-13, 25-8, 25-13). Con este resultado, República Dominicana mejora su récord a 2-0 en el Grupo A y enfrentará al país anfitrión, Costa Rica, en su último partido de la fase de grupos. Surinam, con marca de 0-2, se medirá ante Canadá. El primer lugar de cada grupo avanzará directamente a las semifinales en este torneo que también sirve como clasificatorio al Campeonato Mundial Femenino Sub-17 de la FIVB 2026. Las dominicanas dominaron en todos los fundamentos del juego: 35-12 en ataques, 4-2 en bloqueos y 10-5 en servicios. Además, se beneficiaron de 26 errores del rival, cometiendo solo 15 propios. La capitana dominicana Rayni Mondesi fue la máxima anotadora del encuentro con 15 puntos.





(12 ataques, 3 aces), seguida por la colocadora Shanty Pérez con 12 puntos (9 ataques, 3 aces). Zoe Roethof lideró a Surinam con 9 puntos. República Dominicana dominó el partido de principio a fin. En el primer set, Pérez y Mondesi encabezaron la ofensiva, mientras que en el segundo parcial Leandry Almonte aportó efectivamente en ataque, manteniendo el control total del juego. El servicio fue clave, otorgando una ventaja de 4-0 que impidió a las principales jugadoras de Surinam, Cherelle Meulenhof y Zoe Roethof, encontrar su ritmo. El tercer set siguió el mismo patrón, con Mondesi mostrando efectividad desde la línea de servicio desde el inicio para sellar la victoria en sets corridos.

Canadá 3, Costa Rica 0

Canadá logró una victoria en tres sets consecutivos (25-18, 25-22, 25-18) sobre Costa Rica en la acción del Grupo A. En la última jornada de la ronda preliminar, Canadá (1-1) enfrentará a Surinam (0-2), mientras que Costa Rica (1-1) se medirá ante la invicta República Dominicana (2-0). El evento es clasificatorio al Campeonato Mundial Femenino Sub-17 de la FIVB 2026. Canadá dominó en puntos de ataque (42-20) y en servicios directos (9-1), mientras que Costa Rica fue superior en el bloqueo (7-5) y cometió menos errores no forzados (19-30). La central Shayla Byrnell lideró la ofensiva canadiense con 10 puntos (6 ataques, 4 bloqueos). La atacante de esquina Naya Grimm y la central Chloe Dumont aportaron 9 puntos cada una. Por Costa Rica, la atacante de esquina Sofía Quesada consiguió 9 puntos, todos por ataque. El primer set fue parejo en sus inicios, empatado a 3 puntos, hasta que Canadá tomó ventaja 10-6 gracias a la ofensiva de Grimm y Winji Magdi, además de errores del rival. Pese al efectivo bloqueo de Charlotte Martínez y Esmeralda Ugalde, Canadá mantuvo el control con Elaina Grover destacando en ataque y bloqueo. Ella Grapentine cerró el set con un ace. En el segundo parcial, Costa Rica tomó ventaja 6-4 con las acciones de Luciana Vargas y Sofía Quesada, pero Canadá respondió rápidamente con Grover y Byrnell para adelantarse 10-8. El marcador se mantuvo ajustado hasta que Canadá rompió el empate a 18 puntos con potentes ataques de Izabela Sajda y Grapentine, quien nuevamente cerró el set con un ace. En el tercer set, Canadá tomó una cómoda ventaja 11-6 impulsada por Dumont y Sajda. Costa Rica reaccionó con ofensiva de Vargas para acercarse a un punto (14-15), pero Canadá volvió a ampliar la diferencia con la contribución de Byrnell en ataque y defensa. Dumont cerró el encuentro con un remate para completar la victoria en sets corridos.
