Puerto Rico Crowned Back-to-Back NORCECA U17 Champions and Secures World Championship Berth

MANAGUA, Nicaragua, November 23, 2025.— Puerto Rico captured back-to-back titles at the NORCECA U17 Boys' Continental Championship and secured a berth to the FIVB 2026 World Championship after defeating Cuba 3-1 (25-23, 25-22, 18-25, 25-22) in the gold medal match.

In a tightly contested final, Puerto Rico managed its resources efficiently and prevailed over a resilient Cuban team that fought hard in every set but fell short of its title aspirations.

This is Puerto Rico's second consecutive championship; two years ago in Mexico, they claimed the inaugural title after defeating the hosts in four sets. In that edition, Cuba took home the bronze medal.

In the final, Puerto Rico dominated attacking (49-43) and blocking (8-5), while Cuba held a clear advantage from the service line (10-2). Both teams committed the same number of errors: 34.

Elvis González led Puerto Rico's offense with 20 points, followed by Jayden Figueroa with 8. For Cuba, three players finished in double figures: Víctor Contreras with 19, Reinaldo Márquez with 13 and Dalián La O with 12.

With 40 Points from Mbaitoloum, the United States Claims Bronze Against Mexico

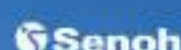
MANAGUA, Nicaragua, November 23, 2025.— With an impressive 40-point performance, Noah Mbaitoloum led the United States to the bronze medal with a 3-2 (25-22, 19-25, 25-18, 21-25, 18-16) victory over Mexico at the NORCECA U17 Boys' Continental Championship.

Mbaitoloum finished with 36 attack points, three blocks and one ace, the highest individual scoring output recorded in this category in the two editions of the tournament.

Mexico struggled to stop the American attacker, who was unable to finish the semifinal match against Cuba due to an ankle injury, but returned on Sunday to carry his team to the podium.

Nikodem Opiola and Jackson Real supported Mbaitoloum with 12 and 9 points, respectively. For Mexico, captain Francisco Merino Romero was outstanding with 35 points, followed by Yanis Medrano with 15.

The United States rallied from a 14-20 deficit to take the first set 25-22, though Mexico responded by claiming the second. In the third, USA jumped to a 10-5 lead and never looked back. Mexico forced a fifth set after winning the fourth, capitalizing on a wide early advantage of 13-5.





In the decider, the United States held a two-point lead for most of the set until Mexico tied it at 13-13. From that moment on, both teams exchanged powerful attacks and strong defensive plays, until Mbaitoloum sealed the match with two unstoppable kills.

Costa Rica Edges Barbados in Five Sets to Claim Fifth Place

Costa Rica defeated Barbados 3-2 (25-17, 16-25, 25-27, 25-13, 15-13) to secure fifth place at the NORCECA U17 Boys' Continental Championship.

Both teams battled intensely to close the tournament in a better position. Barbados showed strength at the net with effective blocking, while Costa Rica focused on applying pressure from the service line to disrupt the opponent's reception and limit their offensive rhythm.

After Costa Rica dominated the fourth set, the tie-break came down to the finer details. With the score tied at 13-13, two consecutive errors from Barbados, one on the block and another on attack, opened the door for Costa Rica to seal the victory. Barbados finished with superior numbers in attacks (59-54) and blocks (12-9), while Costa Rica held the edge in aces (5-4). The Costa Ricans committed 27 errors, compared to 31 from Barbados.

Kenneth Quirós led Costa Rica's scoring with 17 points, followed by Braulio Alvarado with 15 and Ignacio Alpízar with 14. For Barbados, John Isaiah tallied 18 points, Piere Gill contributed 17, and Joshua Ashby added 13.

Nicaragua Defeats Dominican Republic in Five Sets to Finish Seventh

Nicaragua earned a 3-2 victory (15-25, 25-19, 10-25, 25-21, 15-8) over the Dominican Republic to secure seventh place at the NORCECA U17 Boys' Continental Championship.

In a match full of momentum swings, Nicaragua came from behind twice, taking the second and fourth sets. In the decisive fifth, the hosts jumped to an early 5-1 lead and extended it to 10-4, a gap that proved impossible for the Dominicans.

The Dominican Republic showed strong control in the first and third sets, particularly in the third, where they produced runs of up to six unanswered points. However, the tide shifted in the fourth set as Nicaragua improved its reception and took the lead from point 18 onward, a key stretch that made the difference. The same pattern followed in the fifth set, with Nicaragua once again building a strong 5-1 start that set the tone for the win.

For Nicaragua, Carlos Gómez finished with 15 points and Dominic Quezada added 13. For the Dominican Republic, Enmanuel Ledezma delivered an outstanding performance with 34 points, the highest individual scoring mark recorded so far in the tournament, while teammates Darlin García and José Alcalá contributed 16 and 13 points, respectively, though their efforts were not enough to secure the win.



The Dominican Republic led the match statistics in attacks (54-37) and aces (10-7), while Nicaragua held the edge in blocks (7-4) and capitalized on 39 opponent errors, compared to 30 of their own.

Puerto Rico se corona Bicampeón NORCECA Sub-17 y asegura boleto al Mundial

MANAGUA, Nicaragua, 23 de noviembre de 2025.— Puerto Rico se proclamó Bicampeón del Campeonato Continental NORCECA Sub-17 Masculino y obtuvo el boleto al Campeonato Mundial 2026 de la FIVB tras vencer 3-1 (25-23, 25-22, 18-25, 25-22) a Cuba en la gran final.

En una final muy pareja, Puerto Rico manejó con eficacia sus recursos y logró imponerse a un combativo equipo cubano que luchó en cada set, pero no logró concretar su aspiración al título. Es el segundo campeonato consecutivo para los puertorriqueños, quienes dos años atrás, en México, conquistaron el primer trofeo tras vencer a los anfitriones en cuatro sets. En aquella edición, Cuba había obtenido la medalla de bronce.

En la final, Puerto Rico dominó el ataque 49-43 y el bloqueo 8-5, mientras que Cuba tomó ventaja en el servicio (10-2). Ambos equipos cometieron la misma cantidad de errores: 34.

Elvis González lideró la ofensiva puertorriqueña con 20 puntos, seguido por Jayden Figueroa con 8. Por Cuba, tres jugadores cerraron en doble dígito: Víctor Contreras con 19, Reinaldo Márquez con 13 y Dalián La O con 12.

Con 40 puntos de Mbaitoloum, Estados Unidos conquista el bronce ante México

Con una impresionante actuación de 40 puntos, Noah Mbaitoloum condujo a Estados Unidos a la medalla de bronce al superar 3-2 (25-22, 19-25, 25-18, 21-25, 18-16) a México en el Campeonato Continental NORCECA Sub-17 Masculino.

Mbaitoloum terminó con 36 puntos de ataque, tres de bloqueo y uno de servicio, la cifra más alta registrada por un jugador en esta categoría en las dos ediciones del torneo.

Costa Rica venció 3-2 (25-17, 16-25, 25-27, 25-13, 15-13) a Barbados para quedarse con el quinto puesto del Campeonato Continental NORCECA Sub-17 Masculino.

Ambas selecciones protagonizaron un intenso duelo por cerrar el torneo en una mejor posición. Barbados mostró solidez en la red con un bloqueo efectivo, mientras Costa Rica apostó por presionar con el servicio y complicar la recepción rival para limitar su ataque.

Luego de que Costa Rica dominara el cuarto set con claridad, el tie-break se definió en los detalles. Con el marcador igualado 13-13, dos errores consecutivos de Barbados, uno en el bloqueo y otro en ataque, le abrieron la puerta a Costa Rica para concretar la victoria.

Barbados terminó con mejores cifras en ataque (59-54) y bloqueo (12-9), mientras que Costa Rica fue superior en servicio (5-4). Los costarricenses cometieron 27 errores, frente a 31 de Barbados.

Kenneth Quirós lideró la ofensiva de Costa Rica con 17 puntos, seguido por Braulio Alvarado con 15 e Ignacio Alpízar con 14. Por Barbados, John Isaiah sumó 18 puntos, Piere Gill aportó 17 y Joshua Ashby registró 13 unidades.

Nicaragua vence a República Dominicana en cinco sets y concluye séptimo lugar

Nicaragua venció 3-2 (15-25, 25-19, 10-25, 25-21, 15-8) a República Dominicana para adjudicarse el séptimo lugar del Campeonato Continental NORCECA Sub-17 Masculino.

En un partido de marcados altibajos, Nicaragua se repuso en dos ocasiones después de ir abajo en el marcador, al llevarse el segundo y cuarto set. En el decisivo quinto parcial, los locales tomaron ventaja temprana de 5-1 y la ampliaron a 10-4, ventaja que resultó imposible de alcanzar para los dominicanos.

República Dominicana mostró dominio en el primero y tercer set, especialmente en este último, con rachas de hasta seis puntos consecutivos.
