Puerto Rico Claims Third Straight NORCECA Men's Final Four Title

LEÓN, Guanajuato, Mexico, June 14, 2026. – Defending champion Puerto Rico captured its third consecutive NORCECA Men's Final Four title by defeating host Mexico in straight sets, 3-0 (25-18, 25-23, 25-23), in the tournament's closing day at the Domo de la Feria in León, Guanajuato.

The Puerto Rican squad completed a perfect campaign to earn its third consecutive gold medal, following the titles won in 2024 and 2025, reaffirming its dominance in the competition. With the championship, Puerto Rico finished the tournament undefeated.

Mexico, meanwhile, claimed the silver medal for the second consecutive edition, once again reaching the final against Puerto Rico and falling just short of the title.

Puerto Rico opened the first set by building a comfortable 12-8 lead behind the effective offense of Eliel David Salva and Antonio Feliciano. Mexico responded with a block by Juan García on Jair Santiago and another against Klistan Lawrence to cut the deficit to 11-13. However, the Puerto Ricans remained in control and extended their advantage to 20-13 with attacks from Santiago and Lawrence, along with a solid blocking effort by Danieal Henwood and Ismael Alomar that the hosts could not overcome.

The second set was more balanced, although Puerto Rico never surrendered the lead. Axel Téllez played a key role in keeping Mexico within striking distance and, with a powerful serve, reduced the margin to one point at 20-21. An attack by Lawrence that Miguel García could not handle gave Puerto Rico set point at 24-22, but Mauro Fuentes answered with a spike to keep Mexico alive. Ultimately, an attack by Jair Santiago sealed the 25-23 victory and gave Puerto Rico a two-set advantage.

Mexico moved ahead 10-8 in the third set with consecutive attacks from Mauro Fuentes and Franky Hernández. Puerto Rico quickly responded and tied the score at 12-all through Feliciano's offense and a Mexican error. The set remained close, with both teams exchanging the lead, until the Puerto Ricans opened a two-point gap at 19-17 after a Mexican service error and a powerful serve by Santiago. The opposite hitter then added two consecutive attacks to increase the lead to 21-17.

Mexico answered with a four-point run, sparked by a Puerto Rican service error, a successful attack by Juan García through the block, and two points from Mauro Fuentes, first on an ace and then with a spike, to level the score at 21-all. After another tie at 22, Puerto Rico regained control with back-to-back blocks by Alomar and Salva, both against Josué López, to reach championship point at 24-22. Téllez kept Mexico alive with a powerful attack, but another block by Salva on Yasutaka Sanay sealed the Puerto Rican victory.

Puerto Rico held advantages of 39-35 in attacks and 10-7 in blocks, while Mexico led 4-2 in aces. The Puerto Ricans also capitalized on 24 Mexican errors while committing 18 of their own.

Opposite hitter Jair Santiago led all scorers with 18 points for the champions. Eliel David Salva added 9 points, while Klistan Lawrence and Ismael Alomar contributed 8 points each.

For Mexico, Juan García and Franky Hernández paced the offense with 12 and 10 points, respectively.

Guatemala 3, Dominican Republic 2

Guatemala staged a spectacular comeback to defeat the Dominican Republic 3-2 (27-29, 19-25, 30-28, 25-22, 15-11) and capture a historic bronze medal. The Guatemalan squad reached the podium of the NORCECA Men's Final Four for the first time in its history after recovering from a two-set deficit against a Dominican Republic team that concluded the tournament with three losses, all in dramatic five-set matches. Opposite hitter Andy Leonardo was the key figure in the victory, leading Guatemala with 30 points. Team captain Carlos López added 21 points, while Javier Lucero contributed 13. For the Dominican Republic, opposite Adrián Figueroa led the offense with 28 points, outside hitter Héctor Cruz scored 22, and middle blocker Moisés Ortiz added 13. The opening set was fiercely contested with constant lead changes. The Dominican Republic pulled ahead 16-13 behind attacks from Héctor Cruz, following contributions from Adrián Figueroa and Wilfrido Hernández. Guatemala responded through Javier Lucero, Rodrigo Carrillo, and Carlos López to tie the score at 21-all. After an exciting finish with several missed opportunities on both sides, a Guatemalan error handed the set to the Dominicans, 29-27. The Dominican Republic controlled the second set, building a five-point advantage (18-13) with strong attacking from Figueroa, Moisés Ortiz, and Cruz. Despite the offensive efforts of Andy Leonardo, the Caribbean side maintained control, and a back-row attack by Cruz earned set point before another Guatemalan error gave the Dominicans a 2-0 lead. Both teams made adjustments for the third set, and Guatemala quickly moved ahead 10-7 with attacks from Carlos López and Dominican errors. Figueroa kept his team within striking distance, and the score was tied several times down the stretch. Andy Leonardo earned Guatemala's first set point, but the Dominican Republic answered immediately. In another dramatic finish, the Dominicans saved four set points before an attacking error by Héctor Cruz allowed Guatemala to extend the match. Four consecutive points gave Guatemala a 12-8 lead in the fourth set, with contributions from López and Lucero, along with Dominican errors. The Central Americans maintained their offensive pressure to stay in front 16-11. Although the Dominican Republic closed the gap to two points (23-21) behind Cruz, a reception error following a powerful attack by Andy Leonardo sent the match to a deciding fifth set. Guatemala controlled the tiebreak from start to finish. The Dominican Republic saved one match point with an attack by Wilfrido Hernández, but Andy Leonardo answered with a powerful spike through the block to seal the 15-11 victory and secure the historic bronze medal. Guatemala outscored its opponent 78-65 in attacks. The Dominican Republic held the advantage in blocks (12-5) and aces (2-1), while committing fewer errors (32-36), but it could not prevent the Central Americans from completing a memorable comeback to claim the first podium finish in their history at the NORCECA Men's Final Four.

Puerto Rico conquista su tercer título consecutivo del NORCECA Final Four Masculino

LEÓN, Guanajuato, México, 14 de junio de 2026.– El campeón defensor Puerto Rico se proclamó tricampeón del NORCECA Final Four Masculino al derrotar al anfitrión México en sets corridos por 3-0 (25-18, 25-23, 25-23), en la jornada de cierre del torneo disputado en el Domo de la Feria de León, Guanajuato.

El conjunto puertorriqueño completó una campaña perfecta para conquistar su tercera medalla de oro consecutiva, luego de los títulos obtenidos en 2024 y 2025, reafirmando su dominio en la competencia. Con el título, Puerto Rico cerró el torneo invicto México, por su parte, obtuvo la medalla de plata por segundo año consecutivo, repitiendo la final frente a Puerto Rico y quedándose nuevamente a un paso del campeonato.

El primer set comenzó con Puerto Rico tomando una cómoda ventaja de 12-8 gracias a la efectividad ofensiva de Eliel David Salva y Antonio Feliciano. México reaccionó con un bloqueo de Juan García sobre Jair Santiago y otro frente a Klistan Lawrence para acercarse 11-13. Sin embargo, los boricuas mantuvieron el control del parcial y ampliaron la diferencia a 20-13 con los ataques de Santiago y Lawrence, además de un sólido bloqueo conformado por Danieal Henwood e Ismael Alomar, sin respuesta del conjunto mexicano.

El segundo set fue más equilibrado, aunque Puerto Rico nunca perdió la ventaja. Axel Téllez fue clave para mantener a México cerca y, con un potente servicio, redujo la diferencia a un punto (20-21). Un ataque de Lawrence que Miguel García no pudo controlar dio a Puerto Rico el punto de set (24-22), pero Mauro Fuentes respondió con un remate para prolongar el parcial. Finalmente, un ataque de Jair Santiago selló el 25-23 y colocó a Puerto Rico con ventaja de dos sets.

México logró adelantarse 10-8 en el tercer parcial con ataques consecutivos de Mauro Fuentes y Franky Hernández. Puerto Rico no cedió terreno y empató a 12 puntos gracias a la ofensiva de Feliciano y a un error mexicano. El marcador se mantuvo parejo, con ambos equipos alternando la ventaja, hasta que los boricuas tomaron una diferencia de dos puntos (19-17) tras un error de servicio de México y un potente saque de Santiago. El propio Santiago amplió la ventaja con dos ataques consecutivos para el 21-17.

La reacción mexicana llegó con una racha de cuatro puntos consecutivos: un error de servicio puertorriqueño, un ataque de Juan García sobre el bloqueo y dos anotaciones de Mauro Fuentes, primero con un servicio directo y luego con un remate, igualaron el marcador a 21 puntos. Tras otro empate a 22, Puerto Rico recuperó el control con dos bloqueos consecutivos, uno de Alomar y otro de Salva, ambos sobre Josué López, para alcanzar el punto de campeonato (24-22). Téllez descontó con un potente ataque, pero un nuevo bloqueo de Salva sobre Yasutaka Sanay sentenció el triunfo boricua.

Guatemala 3, República Dominicana 2

Guatemala protagonizó una espectacular remontada para derrotar a República Dominicana por 3-2 (27-29, 19-25, 30-28, 25-22, 15-11) y conquistar una histórica medalla de bronce. El conjunto guatemalteco logró por primera vez subir al podio del NORCECA Final Four, luego de recuperarse de una desventaja de dos sets ante una República Dominicana que cerró el torneo con tres derrotas, todas en dramáticos encuentros a cinco parciales. El opuesto Andy Leonardo fue la gran figura del triunfo al liderar a Guatemala con 30 puntos. El capitán Carlos López lo respaldó con 21 unidades y Javier Lucero aportó 13. Por República Dominicana, el opuesto Adrián Figueroa encabezó la ofensiva con 28 puntos, mientras que el atacante de esquina Héctor Cruz sumó 22 y el central Moisés Ortiz agregó 13. El primer set se disputó con gran intensidad y constantes cambios en el marcador. República Dominicana logró despegarse 16-13 gracias al ataque de Héctor Cruz, luego de que Adrián Figueroa y Wilfrido Hernández impulsaran la ofensiva caribeña. Guatemala reaccionó con Javier Lucero, Rodrigo Carrillo y Carlos López para igualar a 21 puntos. Tras un cierre lleno de emociones y varias oportunidades desperdiciadas por ambos equipos, un error guatemalteco definió el parcial 29-27 para los dominicanos. En el segundo set, República Dominicana tomó el control con una ventaja de cinco puntos (18-13), apoyada en los ataques de Figueroa, Moisés Ortiz y Cruz. A pesar del esfuerzo ofensivo de Andy Leonardo, los caribeños mantuvieron el dominio y un ataque zaguero de Cruz les dio el punto de set antes de que un nuevo error de Guatemala colocara el partido 2-0. Ambos equipos realizaron ajustes para el tercer parcial y Guatemala encontró una rápida ventaja de 10-7 con ataques de Carlos López y errores dominicanos. Figueroa mantuvo a su equipo en la pelea y el marcador se igualó en múltiples ocasiones hasta el cierre. Andy Leonardo consiguió el primer punto de set para Guatemala, pero República Dominicana respondió de inmediato. En otro dramático desenlace, los dominicanos salvaron cuatro puntos de set antes de que un error ofensivo de Héctor Cruz permitiera a Guatemala extender el partido. Cuatro puntos consecutivos dieron a Guatemala una ventaja de 12-8 en el cuarto set, con aportes de López y Lucero, además de errores rivales. El conjunto centroamericano sostuvo la presión ofensiva para mantenerse arriba 16-11. Aunque República Dominicana redujo la diferencia a dos puntos (23-21) impulsada por Cruz, un error de recepción tras un potente ataque de Andy Leonardo envió el encuentro al quinto set. Guatemala dominó el desempate de principio a fin. República Dominicana evitó un primer punto de partido con un ataque de Wilfrido Hernández, pero Andy Leonardo respondió con un potente remate sobre el bloqueo para sellar el 15-11 definitivo y asegurar la histórica medalla de bronce. Guatemala superó a su rival 78-65 en ataques. República Dominicana dominó en bloqueos (12-5) y servicios directos (2-1), además de cometer menos errores (32-36), pero no pudo evitar que los centroamericanos completaran una memorable remontada para alcanzar el primer podio de su historia en el NORCECA Final Four Masculino.
