Venezuela and United States to play for U17 Pan American Gold

TEGUCIGALPA, Honduras, May 30, 2026. – Venezuela and the United States will play for the gold medal at the Girls' U17 Pan American Cup in Tegucigalpa, Honduras.

The championship match will feature two undefeated teams, as Venezuela and the United States battle for the title.

The tournament marks the first-ever appearance of the U.S. in the Girls' U17 Pan American Cup. Venezuela, meanwhile, captured the bronze medal at the inaugural edition in 2024 after defeating the Dominican Republic. The bronze medal match will be a rematch between Canada and Peru. Peru defeated Canada in four sets during pool play and returns seeking another podium finish after winning silver at the 2024 tournament. Canada is also making its debut appearance in the event.

SF Venezuela 3, Peru 0

Venezuela earned a hard-fought 3-0 (32-30, 26-24, 25-20) victory over Peru in an all-South American semifinal on Saturday to advance to the gold medal match. Venezuela will face the winner of the second semifinal between the United States and Canada, while Peru will play for the bronze medal against the loser. The opening set was a dramatic battle that kept fans on the edge of their seats. Peru erased a six-point deficit (16-22) and fought back to level the score at 23-all. Valentina Valera and Kiara Lazo led Peru's comeback with powerful attacks and solid net play, forcing the set into extended points. Venezuela responded behind the offensive leadership of Fabianny Carima, Yalesca Colina and Amanda Pacheco, eventually closing the marathon set 32-30. The second set was equally competitive. After several ties, including at 18-all, Peru managed to gain a two-point advantage as Sofia Olavarria and Tamara Galdos joined the offense. A block by Kiara Lazo on Arleidi Salas gave Peru a 23-20 lead and put the team within reach of evening the match. However, Venezuela rallied behind Carima's serving pressure and clutch attacking to tie the score at 23. Venezuela then capitalized on its second set point opportunity, sealing the set with a Carima kill and a Peruvian error for a 2-0 advantage. Venezuela took control early in the third set, racing to a 9-4 lead with Carima and Pacheco setting the pace offensively. Effective serving by team captain Andrea Paez helped maintain constant pressure on Peru's reception line as Venezuela steadily increased its advantage. The South Americans never trailed, and Victoria Sanoja closed the match with a service ace to secure the victory. Venezuela held advantages in kills (48-43) and service aces (7-1), while both teams recorded six blocks. Venezuela scored 22 points from Peru's errors, while Peru benefited from 24 Venezuelan unforced errors. Yalesca Colina led Venezuela with 18 points, including a match-high 16 kills. Fabianny Carima and Amanda Pacheco added 13 points each in the winning effort.

Peru was led by Valentina Valera with 13 points, while Kiara Lazo contributed 10 points.

SF United States 3, Canada 0

The United States advanced to the gold medal match after defeating Canada in straight sets, 3-0 (25-21, 25-11, 25-17), on Saturday night. The championship match will feature two undefeated teams, as the United States and Venezuela battle for the title. The tournament marks the first-ever appearance of the U.S. in the Girls' U17 Pan American Cup. Venezuela, meanwhile, captured the bronze medal at the inaugural edition in 2024 after defeating the Dominican Republic. The bronze medal match will be a rematch between Canada and Peru. Peru defeated Canada in four sets during pool play and returns seeking another podium finish



after winning silver at the 2024 tournament. Canada is also making its debut appearance in the event. The opening set was closely contested. The United States built an 18-12 advantage behind strong blocking from Madlen Gloessner and effective attacking by Mary-Christine Crutcher. Canada battled back to keep the set competitive. Mikayla Matuszko earned the first set point with a kill, but Canada responded through Naya Grimm. The Americans finally secured the set on a kill by Gloessner. The United States dominated the second set, quickly creating a comfortable lead and capitalizing on 11 Canadian errors. Gloessner and Crutcher continued to lead the offense, while Matuszko also made a significant impact. The third set followed a similar pattern as the Americans raced to a 13-6 advantage. Effective blocking from Gloessner, Matuszko, and Sophia Gregg limited Canada's offense throughout the frame. Although the United States struggled briefly to close out the match after leading 24-15, the victory was sealed when Shiloh Braddick blocked Canadian outside hitter Ana Glavacic for match point. The United States held advantages in attacks (39-15) and blocks (10-5), while both teams recorded seven service aces. Canada committed fewer errors (22-25). Madlen Gloessner led the United States with 11 points, followed by Mary-Christine Crutcher with 10. Naya Grimm paced Canada with nine points.

Costa Rica 3, Dominican Republic 2

Costa Rica defeated Dominican Republic 3-2 (25-11, 25-15, 11-25, 18-25, 15-9) on Saturday to secure seventh place. Costa Rica concluded the tournament with a 2-3 record, while Dominican Republic finished in eighth place with 0-3. Costa Rica dominated the opening set, led by the offensive efficiency of Victoria Cobeña, Luciana Vargas, and Charlotte Martínez. Despite efforts from Shanty Pérez and team captain Leandry Almonte, Costa Rica's strong blocking pressure allowed them to control the match and take the set comfortably. The Dominican Republic settled into the second set and kept the score tied at 10-10. Costa Rica then surged ahead with a two-point advantage (12-10) after Vargas blocked Paola De Jesús and followed with a powerful kill. Costa Rica never relinquished the lead, combining solid blocking with effective attacking to move ahead 2-0. The Dominican Republic responded in the third set with aggressive serving that disrupted Costa Rica's rhythm. Pérez and Almonte became more effective offensively, while Paola De Jesús gained confidence at the net, helping the Caribbean side build a commanding 20-9 lead on the way to extending the match. The fourth set followed a similar pattern, with the Dominican Republic opening on a 4-0 run behind the leadership of Pérez and Almonte. Costa Rica narrowed the gap from 6-13 to 9-13 through consecutive points, including a block from Vargas on De Jesús, but could not complete the comeback. Guided by Pérez and supported by De Jesús, the Dominicans forced a decisive fifth set. Costa Rica took control early in the tiebreaker, jumping to a 9-3 lead with key blocks from Esmeralda Ugalde and Martínez that neutralized the Dominican attack. Cobeña remained relentless at the net, helping extend the advantage to 11-6. Costly Dominican errors down the stretch allowed Costa Rica to close out the victory. Costa Rica held the advantage in kills (50-38) and blocks (10-8), while Dominican Republic led in service aces (11-8). Both teams committed a similar number of unforced errors, with Costa Rica recording 28 and Dominican Republic 26. Costa Rica's Luciana Vargas led all scorers with 21 points. Charlotte Martínez added 16 points, Esmeralda Ugalde contributed 14, and Victoria Cobeña finished with 11 points. For Dominican Republic, Shanty Pérez was the top scorer with 17 points, including a match-high five aces. Leandry Almonte added 13 points, while Paola De Jesús Dionicio contributed 12 points.



Venezuela y Estados Unidos disputarán el oro de la Copa Panamericana Sub-17

TEGUCIGALPA, Honduras, 30 de mayo de 2026. – Venezuela y Estados Unidos jugarán por la medalla de oro de la Copa Panamericana Sub-17 Femenina en Tegucigalpa, Honduras.

El partido por el campeonato enfrentará a dos equipos invictos, ya que Venezuela y Estados Unidos se medirán por el título.

El torneo marca la primera participación de Estados Unidos en la Copa Panamericana Sub-17 Femenina. Venezuela, por su parte, conquistó la medalla de bronce en la edición inaugural de 2024 al derrotar a República Dominicana.

El encuentro por la medalla de bronce será una revancha entre Canadá y Perú. Perú venció a Canadá en cuatro sets durante la fase de grupos y regresa en busca de otro lugar en el podio después de haber obtenido la medalla de plata en el torneo de 2024. Canadá también está participando por primera vez en esta competencia.

SF Venezuela 3, Perú 0

Venezuela logró una trabajada victoria 3-0 (32-30, 26-24, 25-20) sobre Peru en una semifinal totalmente sudamericana disputada el sábado, para avanzar al partido por la medalla de oro. Venezuela enfrentará al ganador de la segunda semifinal entre Estados Unidos y Canadá, mientras que Peru disputará la medalla de bronce contra el perdedor.

El primer set fue una batalla dramática que mantuvo a los aficionados al borde de sus asientos. Peru remontó una desventaja de seis puntos (16-22) y logró empatar 23-23. Venezuela, por su parte, obtuvo la medalla de bronce en la edición inaugural de 2024 al vencer a República Dominicana. El partido por la medalla de bronce será una revancha entre Canadá y Perú. Perú derrotó a Canadá en cuatro sets durante la fase de grupos y buscará nuevamente subir al podio tras haber ganado la medalla de plata en 2024. Canadá también participa por primera vez en este torneo. El primer set fue muy disputado. Estados Unidos tomó ventaja de 18-12 gracias al sólido bloqueo de Madlen Gloessner y al efectivo ataque de Mary-Christine Crutcher. Canadá reaccionó para mantener el parcial cerrado. Mikayla Matuszko consiguió el primer punto de set con un remate, pero Canadá respondió por medio de Naya Grimm. Finalmente, las estadounidenses se llevaron el set con un ataque ganador de Gloessner. Estados Unidos dominó el segundo parcial, construyendo rápidamente una amplia ventaja y aprovechando 11 errores cometidos por Canadá. Gloessner y Crutcher continuaron liderando la ofensiva, mientras que Matuszko también aportó de manera importante. El tercer set siguió una tendencia similar, con las estadounidenses adelantándose 13-6. El efectivo bloqueo de Gloessner, Matuszko y Sophia Gregg limitó el ataque canadiense durante todo el parcial. Aunque Estados Unidos tuvo algunas dificultades para cerrar el encuentro después de estar arriba 24-15, la victoria quedó sellada cuando Shiloh Braddick bloqueó a la atacante canadiense Ana Glavacic para el punto del partido. Estados Unidos superó a Canadá en ataques (39-15) y bloqueos (10-5), mientras que ambos equipos registraron siete saques directos. Canadá cometió menos errores no forzados (22-25). Madlen Gloessner lideró a Estados Unidos con 11 puntos, seguida por Mary-Christine Crutcher con 10. Naya Grimm fue la máxima anotadora

Costa Rica 3, República Dominicana 2

Costa Rica derrotó a República Dominicana 3-2 (25-11, 25-15, 11-25, 18-25, 15-9) este sábado para asegurar el séptimo lugar. Costa Rica concluyó el torneo con récord de 2-3, mientras que República Dominicana terminó en la octava posición con 0-3. Costa Rica dominó el primer set, liderado por la efectividad ofensiva de Victoria Cobeña, Luciana Vargas y Charlotte Martínez. A pesar de los esfuerzos de Shanty Pérez y la capitana Leandry Almonte, la fuerte presión en el bloqueo permitió a Costa Rica controlar el juego y llevarse el parcial con comodidad. En el segundo set, República Dominicana logró mantener el marcador igualado 10-10. Costa Rica tomó ventaja de dos puntos (12-10) tras un bloqueo de Vargas sobre Paola De Jesús, seguido de un potente remate. Costa Rica nunca cedió la ventaja, combinando solidez en el bloqueo con ataques efectivos para colocarse 2-0. La reacción dominicana llegó en el tercer set con un servicio agresivo que desestabilizó a Costa Rica. Pérez y Almonte se mostraron más efectivas en la ofensiva, mientras Paola De Jesús ganó confianza en la red, impulsando a su equipo caribeño a una amplia ventaja de 20-9 para extender el partido. El cuarto set siguió un patrón similar, con República Dominicana arrancando 4-0 bajo el liderazgo de Pérez y Almonte. Costa Rica redujo la diferencia de 6-13 a 9-13 con puntos consecutivos, incluyendo un bloqueo de Vargas sobre De Jesús, pero no logró completar la remontada. Con Pérez al frente y el apoyo de De Jesús, las dominicanas forzaron el quinto set decisivo. Costa Rica tomó el control temprano en el desempate, adelantándose 9-3 con bloqueos clave de Esmeralda Ugalde y Martínez que neutralizaron el ataque dominicano. Cobeña se mantuvo implacable en la ofensiva, ampliando la ventaja a 11-6. Los errores dominicanos en la recta final resultaron costosos y Costa Rica cerró la



victoria. Costa Rica tuvo ventaja en ataques (50-38) y bloqueos (10-8), mientras que República Dominicana lideró en saques directos (11-8). Ambos equipos cometieron una cantidad similar de errores no forzados: Costa Rica 28 y República Dominicana 26. Luciana Vargas de Costa Rica fue la máxima anotadora del encuentro con 21 puntos. Charlotte Martínez aportó 16 unidades, Esmeralda Ugalde 14 y Victoria Cobeña 11. Por República Dominicana, Shanty Pérez encabezó la ofensiva con 17 puntos, incluyendo un máximo de cinco aces en el partido. Leandry Almonte sumó 13 puntos y Paola De Jesús Dionicio contribuyó con 12.
