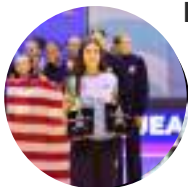

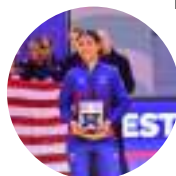

## USA Undefeated U17 Pan American Cup Champions

TEGUCIGALPA, Honduras, May 31, 2026. – The United States was crowned undefeated champion at the Girls' U17 Pan American Cup, after defeating Venezuela in the gold medal match 3-1 (25-14, 25-16, 20-25, 25-20) in Sunday's final at the Jorge Galeano Gymnasium in Tegucigalpa, Honduras.

In their tournament debut, USA finished undefeated with a 4-0 record, while Venezuela claimed silver with a 4-1 record, their second medal in the history of the event after winning bronze in 2024.

The Americans dominated the opening set with a disciplined and organized performance, led by Madlen Gloessner, Mary-Christine Crutcher, and Sophia Gregg, whose serving proved decisive. Jael Smith and Naomi Stevenson anchored the blocking line, helping USA secure a comfortable 25-14 win.

The second set was more competitive, with Venezuela briefly leading 10-8 thanks to Yalesca Colina's blocking. However, USA quickly regained control through Crutcher's kills and Smith's blocks. Gregg added an ace to reach set point, and Mesa Jameson sealed the set 25-16.

Venezuela fought back in the third set, overcoming an early deficit with strong contributions from Colina, Victoria Sanoja, and Claudia La Rosa. A powerful block from Antonella Lovera gave Venezuela their first lead of the match at 14-13. Despite an injury to opposite hitter Maria José Rondón, Venezuela maintained momentum, with Colina scoring the decisive kill to force a fourth set.

In the final set, USA never trailed, building a 21-15 lead with balanced offense from four different players. Venezuela attempted a late push through Angelina Zerpa's serves, but the Americans held firm. Stevenson delivered the championship point, securing USA's historic gold medal.

USA's blocking proved crucial, finishing with a 12-5 margin, alongside advantages in attacks (44-30) and aces (7-5). The United States benefited from 32 opponent errors, however they conceded 35.

Jameson and Gloessner led USA's scoring with 14 and 12 points respectively, while setter Gregg recorded a match-high five aces. Venezuela's Yalesca Colina stood out with 15 points, the only player in double digits for her team.

### **Bronze Medal Peru 3, Canada 2**

Peru secured the bronze medal after a dramatic five-set victory over Canada, prevailing 3-2 (25-18, 21-25, 21-25, 25-19, 15-10). This marks Peru's second medal in the history of the competition, following their silver in 2024. The South Americans closed the tournament with a 3-1 win-loss record, while Canada finished in fourth place with a 2-3 record. This was the



second time in the event that Peru beat Canada. Peru opened the match strongly, never trailing in the first set thanks to the offensive power of Fernanda Pinto and Nahir Cueva, who sealed the set with a decisive block over Adeline Manning. Canada responded in the second set with an early 6-1 lead, fueled by Seacret Schick's serving and Shayla Byrnell's blocking. Despite Peru's comeback attempt led by Cielo Quispe, Canada leveled the match with Byrnell's kill. The third set followed a similar pattern, with Canada racing ahead 4-0 behind Schick's serves. Peru fought back through Valentina Valera, but Canada's blocking unit of Ella Grapentine, Victoria Cheung, and Schick maintained control. A kill from Naya Grimm gave Canada a 2-1 lead. Determined to extend the contest, Peru rallied in the fourth set. With the score tied at 8-all, Kiara Lazo Pacheco, Valera, and Ana Marcela Manrique combined to push Peru ahead 14-10. The South Americans never looked back, forcing a decisive fifth set. In the tie-break, Peru surged to a 4-0 lead with Pinto's blocking and Canadian errors. Pacheco's relentless attack widened the gap to 10-5. Canada saved two match points, but Cueva's final kill sealed the bronze medal for Peru. Statistically, Peru held a slight edge in all areas: attacks (62-61), blocks (9-8), and aces (7-6). Peru benefited from 29 Canadian errors while committing 22 of their own. Nahir Cueva led Peru with 19 points, followed by Valentina Valera (16), Fernanda Pinto (15), and Kiara Lazo Pacheco (11). Canada's top scorers were Seacret Schick with 18 points, while Adeline Manning and Shayla Byrnell added 16 each.

### **Mexico 3, Puerto Rico 1**

Mexico claimed fifth place at the Girls' U17 Pan American Cup after defeating Puerto Rico 3-1 (16-25, 25-19, 25-20, 25-12). Mexico rebounded after dropping the opening set to finish with a 2-2 win-loss record in the tournament, while Puerto Rico closed in sixth place with a 1-3 balance. Puerto Rico started strong, racing to a 10-1 lead behind Arianna Pantojas, Elizmar Vázquez, and Anna Aquino. Effective blocking from Aquino and Carinialys Kuilan Roman kept Mexico's offense in check, and Eliany Quiñones added a block over Evelyn Díaz to reach set point. A kill from Kelysha Domínguez sealed the first set for Puerto Rico.

Mexico responded in the second set with improved blocking and powerful attacks from Rebeke Negrete. Maia Villalpando contributed key points at the net, helping Mexico establish an 18-12 lead. Despite a late surge from Pantojas and Aquino, Mexico held firm to even the match. The third set was tightly contested, with both teams exchanging the lead. Mexico pulled ahead 19-16 thanks to Emily Camarena's kill and opponent errors. Isabella Gallardo's offense in the middle proved decisive, and Negrete closed the set with a kill. In the fourth, Mexico surged to a double-digit advantage (20-10) with Villalpando's serves and Camarena's attacks. Puerto Rico saved two match points, but Díaz sealed the victory with a final kill. Mexico led in attacks (46-37) and serves (11-8), while Puerto Rico held a slim edge in blocks (9-8). Mexico committed 22 errors compared to Puerto Rico's 26. Five Mexican players scored in double digits: Emily Camarena (14), Evelyn Díaz (13), Isabella Gallardo and Maia Villalpando (12 each), and Rebeke Negrete. Puerto Rico's Carinialys Kuilan led all scorers with 15 points, followed by Aquino with 12.



## **Estados Unidos, Campeón Invicto de la Copa Panamericana U17**

TEGUCIGALPA, Honduras, 31 de mayo de 2026. – Estados Unidos se coronó campeón invicto de la Copa Panamericana Femenina U17, tras derrotar a Venezuela en la final por la medalla de oro 3-1 (25-14, 25-16, 20-25, 25-20) este domingo en el Gimnasio Jorge Galeano de Tegucigalpa, Honduras.

En su debut en el torneo, Estados Unidos finalizó invicto con récord de 4-0, mientras que Venezuela se quedó con la medalla de plata con marca de 4-1, su segundo podio en la historia del evento tras conquistar el bronce en 2024.

Las norteamericanas dominaron el primer set con un desempeño disciplinado y organizado, lideradas por Madlen Gloessner, Mary-Christine Crutcher y Sophia Gregg, cuyo servicio resultó decisivo. Jael Smith y Naomi Stevenson sostuvieron la línea de bloqueo, asegurando un cómodo triunfo 25-14.

El segundo set fue más disputado, con Venezuela tomando ventaja momentánea 10-8 gracias al bloqueo de Yalesca Colina. Sin embargo, Estados Unidos retomó el control con los remates de Crutcher y los bloqueos de Smith. Gregg sumó un ace para alcanzar el punto de set y Mesa Jameson cerró el parcial 25-16.

Venezuela reaccionó en el tercer set, remontando un inicio adverso con aportes de Colina, Victoria Sanoja y Claudia La Rosa. Un potente bloqueo de Antonella Lovera les dio su primera ventaja del partido 14-13. Pese a la lesión de la opuesta María José Rondón, las sudamericanas mantuvieron el ímpetu, y Colina concretó el remate decisivo para forzar un cuarto set.

En el parcial definitivo, Estados Unidos nunca estuvo abajo en el marcador, construyendo una ventaja de 21-15 con ofensiva balanceada de cuatro jugadoras distintas. Venezuela intentó una reacción tardía con los servicios de Angelina Zerpa, pero las estadounidenses se mantuvieron firmes. Stevenson anotó el punto del campeonato, asegurando el histórico oro para su país.

El bloqueo estadounidense fue clave, con margen de 12-5, además de ventajas en ataques (44-30) y aces (7-5). Estados Unidos se benefició de 32 errores rivales, aunque concedió 35.

Jameson y Gloessner lideraron la ofensiva de Estados Unidos con 14 y 12 puntos respectivamente, mientras que la armadora Gregg registró cinco aces, la mayor cifra del encuentro. Por Venezuela, Colina destacó con 15 puntos, la única jugadora en dobles dígitos para su equipo.

### **Medalla de Bronce Perú 3, Canadá 2**

Perú aseguró la medalla de bronce tras una dramática victoria en cinco sets sobre Canadá, imponiéndose 3-2 (25-18, 21-25, 21-25, 25-19, 15-10). Esta es la segunda medalla de Perú en la historia de la competencia, después de la plata obtenida en 2024. Las sudamericanas cerraron el torneo con marca de 3 victorias y 1 derrota, mientras que Canadá finalizó en el cuarto lugar con récord de 2-3. Fue además la segunda ocasión en el evento en que Perú derrotó a Canadá. Perú inició el encuentro con fuerza y nunca estuvo abajo en el marcador durante el primer set gracias al poder ofensivo de Fernanda Pinto y Nahir Cueva, quien cerró el parcial con un bloqueo decisivo sobre Adeline Manning. Canadá reaccionó en el segundo set tomando ventaja de 6-1 impulsado por el servicio de Seacret Schick y el bloqueo de Shayla

Byrnell. A pesar del intento de remontada peruano liderado por Cielo Quispe, Canadá igualó el partido con un remate ganador de Byrnell. El tercer set siguió un patrón similar, con Canadá adelantándose 4-0 gracias a los saques de Schick. Perú respondió por medio de Valentina Valera, pero el bloque canadiense conformado por Ella Grapentine, Victoria Cheung y Schick mantuvo el control. Un ataque ganador de Naya Grimm dio a Canadá ventaja de 2-1 en sets. Decidido a extender el partido, Perú reaccionó en el cuarto parcial. Con el marcador empatado a 8 puntos, Kiara Lazo Pacheco, Valera y Ana Marcela Manrique se combinaron para impulsar a su equipo a una ventaja de 14-10. Las sudamericanas no volvieron a mirar atrás y forzaron un quinto set decisivo. En el desempate, Perú se adelantó rápidamente 4-0 gracias a los bloqueos de Pinto y errores canadienses. El constante ataque de Pacheco amplió la diferencia a 10-5. Canadá salvó dos puntos de partido, pero un remate final de Cueva selló la medalla de bronce para Perú. En las estadísticas, Perú tuvo una ligera ventaja en todos los rubros: ataques (62-61), bloqueos (9-8) y servicios directos (7-6). Perú se benefició de 29 errores de Canadá y cometió 22 propios. Nahir Cueva lideró a Perú con 19 puntos, seguida por Valentina Valera con 16, Fernanda Pinto con 15 y Kiara Lazo Pacheco con 11. Por Canadá, Seacret Schick fue la máxima anotadora con 18 puntos, mientras que Adeline Manning y Shayla Byrnell aportaron 16 unidades cada una.

### **México 3, Puerto Rico 1**

México se quedó con el quinto puesto de la Copa Panamericana U17 femenina tras vencer a Puerto Rico 3-1 (16-25, 25-19, 25-20, 25-12). El conjunto mexicano reaccionó después de perder el primer set y cerró el torneo con balance de 2-2 en juegos ganados y perdidos, mientras que Puerto Rico finalizó en la sexta posición con registro de 1-3. Puerto Rico arrancó con fuerza, tomando ventaja 10-1 gracias a la presión ofensiva de Arianna Pantojas, Elizmar Vázquez y Anna Aquino. Los bloqueos de Aquino y Carinialys Kuilan Roman sobre Emily Camarena y Evelyn Díaz ampliaron la diferencia, y un bloqueo de Eliany Quiñones sobre Díaz dejó a las caribeñas con punto de set. Un remate de Kelysha Domínguez selló el 1-0. México mejoró en el segundo parcial con ataques potentes de Rebeka Negrete y mayor solidez en el bloqueo, destacando Maia Villalpando para mantener la ventaja 18-12. Aunque Puerto Rico se acercó con puntos de Pantojas y Aquino, México sostuvo el ritmo y empató el partido. El tercer set fue más disputado, con intercambios constantes en el marcador. México tomó ventaja 19-16 con un remate de Camarena y errores rivales. La ofensiva de Isabella Gallardo en el centro fue clave para cerrar el parcial, y Negrete lo selló con un remate. En el cuarto, México se adelantó 14-10 y luego amplió la diferencia a diez puntos (20-10) con los servicios de Villalpando y los ataques de Camarena. Puerto Rico salvó dos puntos de partido, pero Díaz cerró el triunfo con un remate final. México dominó en ataques (46-37) y servicios (11-8), mientras que Puerto Rico tuvo ligera ventaja en bloqueos (9-8). México cometió 22 errores y Puerto Rico 26. Cinco mexicanas anotaron en doble dígito: Emily Camarena (14), Evelyn Díaz (13), Isabella Gallardo y Maia Villalpando (12 cada una), y Rebeka Negrete. Por Puerto Rico, Carinialys Kuilan fue la máxima anotadora del encuentro con 15 puntos, seguida de Aquino con 12.
