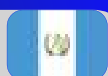

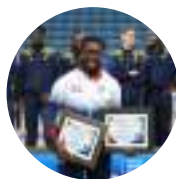

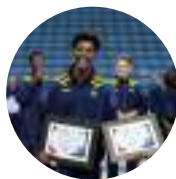

Colombia Makes History with Its First Central American and Caribbean Games Title

SANTO DOMINGO, Dominican Republic, July 30, 2026. – Colombia captured the first title in its history in the men's volleyball tournament at the XXV Central American and Caribbean Games Santo Domingo 2026 with a 3-2 (25-20, 25-21, 16-25, 17-25, 15-12) victory over Puerto Rico in a thrilling final that shifted from Colombia's dominance in the opening two sets to a remarkable Puerto Rican comeback before the South Americans regained control in the decisive fifth set.

Colombia claimed its first-ever Central American and Caribbean Games men's volleyball title, adding the gold medal to the silver it earned at Barranquilla 2018. The championship capped an outstanding tournament for the South Americans, who played four of their five matches in five sets. Puerto Rico, meanwhile, collected its sixth silver medal, to go along with five golds and five bronze medals, for a total of 16 medals.

Colombia set the tone from the opening whistle with an efficient offense led by opposite Miguel Ángel Martínez and a solid performance at the net to take the first two sets, 25-20 and 25-21. Puerto Rico responded with determination, significantly raising the intensity of its blocking while relying on outside hitter Klistan Lawrence to lead its offense, winning the third and fourth sets 25-16 and 25-17 to force a tiebreaker.

In the fifth set, the team coached by Paolo Montagnani regained its composure and built an early advantage. Although Puerto Rico cut the deficit to a single point, Colombia answered in the decisive moments, extended its lead once again, and sealed the historic 15-12 victory.

Colombia held a 60-55 advantage in attacks, while Puerto Rico dominated blocking 14-8. Both teams recorded four aces, and the Puerto Ricans committed fewer unforced errors (26-30).

Opposite Miguel Ángel Martínez paced Colombia with 22 points, while outside hitter Juan Felipe Castañeda added 18 and middle blocker Daniel Aponza contributed 13. For Puerto Rico, outside hitter Klistan Lawrence led all scorers with 24 points, opposite Jair Santiago added 14, and middle blocker Eliel Salva finished with 12.

Cuba 3, Mexico 0 – Bronze Medal

Cuba claimed the bronze medal with a straight-set 3-0 (25-22, 26-24, 25-16) victory over Mexico. The medal marks Cuba's fifth bronze in the history of the Central American and Caribbean Games. The Cubans also remain the most successful team in the history of the men's tournament with a total of 19 medals: 11 gold, three silver and five bronze. Cuba showed greater composure in the decisive moments of the opening two sets. Mexico held a 21-19 lead in the first before Cuba closed on a 6-1 run to take the set. In the second, the Mexicans again moved ahead late at 20-19 and later tied the score at 24-24, but Cuba once more proved more effective in the closing points to build a two-set advantage. With that momentum, the Cubans controlled the third set from start to finish to seal the victory. The teams finished even with 33 attack points each, but Cuba made the difference with a slight edge in blocks (6-5), stronger pressure from the service line (6-1 in aces) and fewer unforced errors (23-31). Miguel Ángel López led the Cuban offense with 15 points, while Daniel Martínez added 13, including a match-high five aces. For Mexico, Josué López was the team's leading scorer with 12 points.



Dominican Republic 3, Venezuela 2 – Positions 5/6

Dominican Republic claimed fifth place after defeating Venezuela in thrilling five sets 3-2 (27-29, 25-23, 20-25, 26-24, 15-12). The match remained in doubt from start to finish. Venezuela claimed a tightly contested opening set, but the hosts answered to level the match. After the Venezuelans regained the lead by taking the third set, Dominican Republic responded once again with a dramatic 26-24 win in the fourth before prevailing in the deciding fifth set to close the tournament with a victory in front of its home crowd. Venezuela held a narrow advantage in attacks (65-62) and also led in aces (6-4), while Dominican Republic made the difference at the net with a 13-12 edge in blocks and by committing 21 unforced errors compared to Venezuela's 29. Adrián Figueroa led the Dominican offense with 20 points, followed by Moisés Ortíz with 16, Luther Rosario with 14 and Edward Rojas with 13. Venezuela's Emerson Rodríguez led all scorers with 27 points, all on kills. Carlos Eduardo Beroes added 20 points, Jesús Gómez scored 12 and Paul Viloria finished with 11.

Guatemala 3, Suriname 0 – Positions 7/8

Guatemala concluded its campaign with a convincing 3-0 (25-20, 25-13, 25-19) victory over Suriname to finish in seventh place. After a closely contested opening set, the Guatemalans settled into their rhythm, showing greater consistency in every aspect of the game and taking control of the next two sets to earn their first victory of the tournament and close their campaign on a positive note. Guatemala held the advantage in attacks (42-34) and blocks (8-5), while Suriname edged in aces with a narrow 2-1 advantage in aces. The Guatemalans also limited their unforced errors to just 11 points, compared to 24 committed by their opponents. Outside hitter José Pablo Pérez led Guatemala's offense with 14 points, while team captain and outside hitter Carlos López added 12. For Suriname, outside hitter Anfernee Lee A Leong was the only player to score in double figures with 13 points.

Colombia Hace Historia con su Primer Título en los Juegos Centroamericanos y del Caribe

SANTO DOMINGO, República Dominicana, 30 de julio de 2026. – Colombia conquistó el primer título de su historia en el torneo masculino de voleibol de los XXV Juegos Centroamericanos y del Caribe Santo Domingo 2026 al derrotar a Puerto Rico por 3-2 (25-20, 25-21, 16-25, 17-25, 15-12) en una emocionante final que pasó del dominio colombiano en los dos primeros sets a una espectacular reacción puertorriqueña, antes de que los sudamericanos recuperaran el control en el decisivo quinto parcial.

Colombia conquistó el primer título de su historia en el voleibol masculino de los Juegos Centroamericanos y del Caribe y añadió la medalla de oro a la plata obtenida en Barranquilla 2018. El campeonato culminó una extraordinaria campaña del conjunto sudamericano, que disputó cuatro de sus cinco partidos en cinco sets. Puerto Rico, por su parte, alcanzó su sexta medalla de plata, además de cinco oros y cinco bronce, para un total de 16 preseas. Colombia marcó el ritmo del encuentro desde el inicio con un ataque efectivo encabezado por Miguel Ángel Martínez y un sólido desempeño en la red para adjudicarse los dos primeros parciales por 25-20 y 25-21. Sin embargo, Puerto Rico respondió con determinación, elevó



considerablemente la intensidad de su bloqueo y encontró en Klistan Lawrence a su principal referente ofensivo para dominar el tercer y cuarto sets por marcadores de 25-16 y 25-17, forzando el desempate.

En el quinto set, los dirigidos por Paolo Montagnani recuperaron la serenidad y tomaron ventaja desde los primeros puntos. Aunque Puerto Rico logró reducir la diferencia a una unidad, Colombia respondió en los momentos decisivos para ampliar nuevamente la ventaja y sellar la histórica victoria por 15-12.

Colombia lideró el ataque con ventaja de 60-55 puntos, mientras que Puerto Rico dominó ampliamente el bloqueo por 14-8. Ambos equipos registraron cuatro puntos de servicios directos, y los puertorriqueños cometieron menos errores no forzados (26-30).

El opuesto Miguel Ángel Martínez encabezó la ofensiva colombiana con 22 puntos, acompañado por el punta Juan Felipe Castañeda con 18 y el central Daniel Aponza con 13. Por Puerto Rico, Klistan Lawrence fue el máximo anotador del encuentro con 24 puntos, Jair Santiago aportó 14 y el central Eliel Salva añadió 12.

Cuba 3, México 0 – Medalla de Bronce

Cuba conquistó la medalla de bronce al derrotar a México en sets corridos 3-0 (25-22, 26-24, 25-16). La presea representa el quinto bronce para Cuba en la historia de los Juegos Centroamericanos y del Caribe. Además, la selección cubana continúa siendo la más laureada del torneo masculino con un total de 19 medallas: 11 de oro, tres de plata y cinco de bronce. Los cubanos mostraron mayor determinación en los momentos decisivos de los dos primeros sets. México llegó con ventaja de 21-19 en el primer parcial, pero Cuba respondió con un cierre de 6-1 para adelantarse en el marcador. En el segundo episodio, los mexicanos volvieron a tomar la iniciativa y llegaron al tramo final arriba 20-19 antes de igualar 24-24, pero nuevamente Cuba fue más efectiva en los puntos decisivos para colocarse 2-0. Con esa ventaja, dominó el tercer set de principio a fin para asegurar la victoria. Ambos equipos terminaron igualados con 33 puntos de ataque, mientras que Cuba marcó la diferencia con una ligera ventaja en bloqueo (6-5), una efectiva presión desde la línea de servicio (6-1) y un menor número de errores no forzados (23-31). Miguel Ángel López encabezó la ofensiva cubana con 15 puntos, mientras que Daniel Martínez sumó 13, incluidos cinco servicios directos, la mayor cantidad del encuentro. Por México, Josué López fue el máximo anotador con 12 unidades.

República Dominicana 3, Venezuela 2 – Posiciones 5/6

República Dominicana se quedó con el quinto lugar del torneo al imponerse a Venezuela en un disputado encuentro que se definió en cinco sets 3-2 (27-29, 25-23, 20-25, 26-24, 15-12).

El encuentro mantuvo la incertidumbre de principio a fin. Venezuela se llevó un ajustado primer set, pero los anfitriones respondieron para igualar el marcador. Después de que los venezolanos recuperaran la ventaja en el tercer parcial, República Dominicana volvió a reaccionar con un dramático triunfo por 26-24 en el cuarto set y terminó imponiéndose en el desempate para cerrar el torneo con una victoria ante su afición. Venezuela dominó el ataque por un estrecho margen (65-62) y también tuvo ventaja en servicios directos (6-4), mientras que República Dominicana marcó la diferencia con su trabajo en bloqueo (13-12) y al cometer 21



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errores no forzados, frente a los 29 de los venezolanos. Adrián Figueroa encabezó la ofensiva dominicana con 20 puntos, acompañado por Moisés Ortiz con 16, Luther Rosario con 14 y Edward Rojas con 13. El máximo anotador del encuentro fue el venezolano Emerson Rodríguez, quien sumó 27 puntos, todos en ataque. Carlos Eduardo Beroes aportó 20 unidades, Jesús Gómez agregó 12 y Paul Vilorio finalizó con 11.

Guatemala 3, Surinam 0 – Posiciones 7/8

Guatemala cerró su participación con una convincente victoria por 3-0 (25-20, 25-13, 25-19) sobre Surinam para finalizar en el séptimo lugar de la competencia. Luego de un primer set muy disputado, el conjunto guatemalteco encontró mayor solidez en todas las líneas y dominó los dos parciales siguientes para asegurar su primera victoria del torneo y despedirse con una nota positiva. Guatemala fue superior en ataque (42-34) y bloqueo (8-5), mientras que Surinam tuvo una ligera ventaja puntos de servicios directos (2-1). La diferencia también estuvo en los errores no forzados, ya que los guatemaltecos concedieron únicamente 11 puntos, en contraste con los 24 de su rival. El atacante de esquina José Pablo Pérez lideró la ofensiva de Guatemala con 14 puntos, seguido por el capitán Carlos López con 12 unidades. Por Surinam, el atacante de esquina Anfernee Lee A Leong fue el único jugador en alcanzar doble dígito, con 13 puntos.
