United States and Canada Advance Directly to Semifinals

GUATEMALA CITY, Guatemala, June 25, 2026. – The United States and Canada secured first place in their respective pools to advance directly to the semifinals of the 2026 Men's U21 Pan American Cup. On the final day of the pool phase, the United States defeated Mexico to claim the top spot in Pool A, while Canada beat host Guatemala to finish unbeaten in Pool B. Costa Rica and Venezuela also sealed their quarterfinal berths with victories over Nicaragua and the Dominican Republic, respectively.

Venezuela 3, Dominican Republic 0

Venezuela claimed its first victory, defeating the Dominican Republic in straight sets 3-0 (25-18, 25-17, 25-21) to secure third place in Pool A and advance to the quarterfinals, where it will face the second-place team from Pool B. On behalf of the Pan American Volleyball Union (UPV), the NORCECA Confederation and the South American Volleyball Confederation (CSV), a moment of silence was observed prior to the match between Venezuela and the Dominican Republic in memory of the victims and in solidarity with all those affected by the devastating earthquakes in Venezuela. Venezuela built its victory on a dominant blocking performance, holding an 11-3 advantage in that category. The South Americans also led in attacks (34-29), aces (2-1), and committed fewer unforced errors (23-28). Jean Franco Sanabria led Venezuela's offense with 14 points, followed by Yoisbel Galeno with 11. Malik Britton was the Dominican Republic's leading scorer with 13 points. Although the teams battled evenly through the early stages of all three sets, Venezuela gradually took control behind the offensive production of Sanabria and Galeno, Harold Larez's serving, and an effective blocking scheme that consistently disrupted the Dominican attack. The Dominicans mounted a late push in the third set, but Venezuela remained composed to complete the straight-set victory.

United States 3, Mexico 0

The United States secured first place in Pool A and a direct berth in the semifinals with a straight-set 3-0 (25-23, 25-15, 25-20) victory over Mexico. The defending champions completed pool play undefeated to advance directly to Saturday's semifinals. Mexico finished second in Pool A and will face the third-place team from Pool B in the quarterfinals. The difference came at the net, where the United States dominated in blocking 11-1 while also holding a 6-3 advantage in aces. The Americans capitalized on 23 Mexican errors while committing 17 of their own. Mexico held a slight edge in attacks, 36-35. USA's captain Kyler Wade led the winners with 10 points, while Blake Fahlbusch and Jackson Cryst added nine points each. Mexico's Cristian Cadena was the match's leading scorer with 15 points, followed by Eduardo Garza with 12. The opening set was the closest of the match. After several ties, the United States built a 20-16 lead behind the offensive and defensive efforts of Jackson Cryst and Blake Fahlbusch. Mexico responded through Eduardo Garza and Cristian Cadena to level the score at 22, but an attack by Aleksey Mikhailenko and a Mexican attacking error allowed the Americans to close out the set. The United States took control from the start of the second set. Strong blocking and serving pressure neutralized Mexico's offense, allowing the Americans to stretch their lead to eight points (22-14) before taking a two-set advantage. The third set followed a similar pattern, with the United States dictating play through its solid blocking and defensive system. Substitutes Trevell Jordan and Grant Lamoureux maintained the team's intensity as the Americans secured the victory and a direct ticket to the semifinals.



Costa Rica 3, Nicaragua 0

Costa Rica secured its place in the quarterfinals with a commanding 3-0 (25-17, 25-12, 25-20) victory over Nicaragua. With a 2-1 record, Costa Rica advanced to the knockout stage and awaits the outcome of the Canada-Guatemala match to determine its final standing in Pool B. Nicaragua, which finished winless in pool play, will compete in the classification matches for fifth through eighth places. Costa Rica controlled the Central American matchup by leading 31-21 in attacks, 12-5 in blocks, and 6-0 in aces. The Costa Ricans also capitalized on 26 Nicaraguan errors while committing 18 of their own. Stanley Grant led Costa Rica with 14 points, followed by Ignacio Morales with 10. Nicaragua's top offensive performer was Inti Zapata. Costa Rica established control from the opening set behind the powerful attacks of Edser Barrantes and Stanley Grant, quickly building a seven-point advantage. Nicaragua responded through Inti Zapata and Elías Zeledón but was unable to slow the Costa Rican momentum, as the winners capitalized on their opponents' errors to take the opening set. The second set followed a similar pattern. Although Zapata found openings in the Costa Rican defense, Costa Rica strengthened its blocking and defensive system through Roberto Zúñiga, Denzel Jiménez, and Jeremy Vanega to extend its lead and move within one set of victory. Nicaragua showed greater resistance late in the third set, scoring three consecutive points, including a block by Álvaro Quesada on Ignacio Morales. However, Costa Rica remained in control and sealed the victory with a kill by Stanley Grant followed by a powerful ace from Morales.

Canada 3, Guatemala 0

Canada secured first place in Pool B and a direct berth to the semifinals after defeating host Guatemala 3-0 (25-21, 25-13, 26-24). With the victory, Canada completed the pool stage undefeated and advanced straight to the semifinals. Guatemala finished third in the pool and will face Mexico in Friday's quarterfinals at 5:00 p.m. Costa Rica, which placed second in Pool B, will take on Venezuela at 7:00 p.m. Canada held the advantage in every skill, leading 40-22 in attacks, 14-6 in blocks and 10-0 in aces. However, Guatemala capitalized on Canada's unforced errors, scoring 30 points off them, while committing just 12 of its own. Marcus Barrett led the Canadian offense with 19 points, followed by Cole Czepuryk with 14 and Massimiliano Riolino with 13. Guatemala's José Luis Samayoa finished as his team's top scorer with 13 points. The opening set was highly competitive, fueled by the enthusiastic support of the home crowd. Canada built a 10-6 lead behind the attacks and serving of Matthew Brown, along with a block by Finn Hughes on Santiago Mena. Guatemala responded through José Luis Samayoa and Christian Álvarez to narrow the gap, but Canada remained in control. A huge block by Juan David Zúñiga denied Canada's first set point before Marcus Barrett closed the set with a powerful attack. After an even start to the second set, Canada broke away thanks to a Guatemalan error and two consecutive aces from Cole Czepuryk to move ahead 7-4. The Canadian outside hitter continued to make an impact with two more service winners and an attack, while Barrett kept leading the offense. Consecutive blocks by Massimiliano Riolino and Matthew Siebenga helped Canada pull away and comfortably extend its lead. Guatemala played its best volleyball in the third set. After several ties, the hosts took their first lead of the match at 12-10, capitalizing on Canadian errors and attacks by Gerson Carranza and José Luis Samayoa. Barrett and Czepuryk answered to level the score several times, including at 22-all. Canada reached match point on a Barrett attack (24-22), but a service error followed by an attack error allowed Guatemala to tie the score. Koray Low-Ring restored Canada's advantage, and Barrett sealed the victory and the top spot in the pool with an attack off the block.



Estados Unidos y Canadá Avanzan Directo a Semifinales

CIUDAD DE GUATEMALA, Guatemala, 25 de junio de 2026. – Estados Unidos y Canadá aseguraron el primer lugar de sus respectivos grupos para avanzar directamente a las semifinales de la Copa Panamericana U21 Masculina 2026. En la última jornada de la fase de grupos, los estadounidenses superaron a México para quedarse con el liderato del Grupo A, mientras que Canadá derrotó al anfitrión Guatemala para finalizar invicto en el Grupo B. Además, Costa Rica y Venezuela sellaron su clasificación a los cuartos de final victoria sobre Nicaragua y República Dominicana respectivamente.

Venezuela 3, República Dominicana 0

Venezuela consiguió su primera victoria al derrotar a República Dominicana por 3-0 (25-18, 25-17, 25-21), resultado que le aseguró el tercer lugar del Grupo A y el pase a los cuartos de final, donde enfrentará al segundo clasificado del Grupo B. En nombre de la Unión Panamericana de Voleibol (UPV), la Confederación NORCECA y la Confederación Sudamericana de Voleibol (CSV), previo al encuentro entre Venezuela y República Dominicana se guardó un minuto de silencio en memoria de las víctimas y en solidaridad con todas las personas afectadas por los devastadores terremotos ocurridos en Venezuela. Venezuela construyó su triunfo sobre un sólido desempeño en el bloqueo, dominando ese renglón 11-3. Además, superó a su rival en ataques (34-29), servicios (2-1) y cometió menos errores no forzados (23-28). Jean Franco Sanabria encabezó la ofensiva venezolana con 14 puntos, seguido por Yoisbel Galeno con 11. Por República Dominicana, Malik Britton fue el máximo anotador con 13 unidades. Aunque ambos equipos protagonizaron inicios parejos en los tres parciales, Venezuela tomó el control gracias a la efectividad ofensiva de Sanabria y Galeno, el liderazgo de Harold Larez en el servicio y un bloqueo que neutralizó constantemente el ataque dominicano. República Dominicana intentó reaccionar en el cierre del tercer set, pero los venezolanos mantuvieron la calma para sellar el triunfo en sets corridos.

Estados Unidos 3, México 0

Estados Unidos aseguró el primer lugar del Grupo A y el pase directo a las semifinales al derrotar a México en sets corridos 3-0 (25-23, 25-15, 25-20). Como campeón defensor, Estados Unidos cerró invicto la fase de grupos y avanzó directamente a las semifinales del sábado. México finalizó segundo del Grupo A y disputará los cuartos de final frente al tercer lugar del Grupo B. La diferencia estuvo en el bloqueo estadounidense, que dominó ampliamente 11-1, además de una ventaja de 6-3 en aces. Estados Unidos también capitalizó 23 errores de México, mientras que cometió 17. En ataque, los mexicanos tuvieron una ligera ventaja de 36-35. El capitán Kyler Wade lideró a Estados Unidos con 10 puntos, mientras Blake Fahlbusch y Jackson Cryst aportaron nueve unidades cada uno. Por México, Cristian Cadena fue el máximo anotador del encuentro con 15 puntos, seguido por Eduardo Garza con 12. El primer set fue el más disputado. Tras varios empates, Estados Unidos logró una ventaja de 20-16 gracias al trabajo ofensivo y defensivo de Jackson Cryst y Blake Fahlbusch. México reaccionó con Eduardo Garza y Cristian Cadena para igualar el marcador a 22, pero un ataque de Aleksey Mikhailenko y un error ofensivo mexicano permitieron a los estadounidenses cerrar el parcial. En el segundo set, Estados Unidos tomó el control desde el inicio. El bloqueo y la presión en el servicio neutralizaron el ataque mexicano, permitiendo ampliar la diferencia hasta ocho puntos (22-14) antes de colocarse arriba dos sets a cero. El tercer parcial siguió el mismo guión, con Estados Unidos imponiendo el ritmo del encuentro a



partir de un sólido sistema de bloqueo y defensa. Los ingresos de Trevell Jordan y Grant Lamoureux mantuvieron la intensidad del equipo, que aseguró el triunfo y el boleto directo a semifinales.

Costa Rica 3, Nicaragua 0

Costa Rica aseguró su clasificación a los cuartos de final tras vencer con autoridad a Nicaragua en sets corridos 3-0 (25-17, 25-12, 25-20). Con marca de 2-1, Costa Rica aseguró su lugar en la siguiente ronda y quedó a la espera del resultado entre Canadá y Guatemala para definir su posición final en el Grupo B. Nicaragua, sin victorias en la fase de grupos, disputará los partidos por las posiciones del quinto al octavo lugar. Los costarricenses dominaron el duelo centroamericano con ventaja de 31-21 en ataques, 12-5 en bloqueos y 6-0 en servicios directos. Además, se beneficiaron de 26 errores no forzados de Nicaragua, mientras concedieron 18 puntos por esa vía. Stanley Grant lideró la ofensiva de Costa Rica con 14 puntos, seguido por Ignacio Morales con 10. Por Nicaragua, Inti Zapata fue el jugador más destacado en ataque. Costa Rica impuso condiciones desde el primer set gracias al poder ofensivo de Edser Barrantes y Stanley Grant, construyendo rápidamente una ventaja de siete puntos. Nicaragua respondió con Inti Zapata y Elías Zeledón, pero no logró frenar el ritmo de los costarricenses, que aprovecharon los errores rivales para tomar ventaja en el marcador. El segundo parcial mantuvo la misma tendencia. Aunque Nicaragua encontró algunos espacios con Zapata, Costa Rica fortaleció su sistema de defensa y bloqueo con Roberto Zúñiga, Denzel Jiménez y Jeremy Vanega para ampliar la diferencia y colocarse a un set del triunfo. En el tercer set, Nicaragua mostró una mejor reacción en la recta final con tres puntos consecutivos, incluyendo un bloqueo de Álvaro Quesada sobre Ignacio Morales. Sin embargo, Costa Rica mantuvo el control y selló la victoria con un ataque de Stanley Grant y un potente servicio de Ignacio Morales.

Canadá 3, Guatemala 0

Canadá aseguró el primer lugar del Grupo B y el pase directo a las semifinales tras vencer al anfitrión Guatemala por 3-0 (25-21, 25-13, 26-24). Con el triunfo, Canadá concluyó invicto la fase de grupos y avanzó directamente a las semifinales. Guatemala terminó en el tercer lugar del grupo y enfrentará a México este viernes a las 5:00 p.m. en los cuartos de final. Costa Rica, segundo del Grupo B, se medirá a Venezuela a las 7:00 p.m. Canadá dominó en los principales fundamentos del juego con ventaja de 40-22 en ataques, 14-6 en bloqueos y 10-0 en aces. Sin embargo, Guatemala sacó provecho de los 30 puntos otorgados por errores no forzados de su rival, mientras que el equipo local cedió solo 12. Marcus Barrett encabezó la ofensiva canadiense con 19 puntos, seguido por Cole Czepuryk con 14 unidades y Massimiliano Riolino con 13. Por Guatemala, José Luis Samayoa fue el máximo anotador con 13 puntos. El primer set fue muy disputado, impulsado por el constante apoyo del público local. Canadá tomó ventaja de 10-6 con los ataques y el servicio de Matthew Brown, además de un bloqueo de Finn Hughes sobre Santiago Mena. Guatemala reaccionó con José Luis Samayoa y Christian Álvarez para reducir la diferencia, pero los canadienses mantuvieron el control. Un gran bloqueo de Juan David Zúñiga evitó el primer punto de set, aunque Marcus Barrett selló el parcial con un potente ataque. En el segundo set, tras un inicio igualado, Canadá rompió el equilibrio gracias a un error guatemalteco y dos aces consecutivos de Cole Czepuryk para colocarse 7-4. El atacante canadiense volvió a marcar diferencia con otros dos servicios ganadores y un remate, mientras Barrett continuó liderando la ofensiva. Dos bloqueos consecutivos de Massimiliano Riolino y Matthew Siebenga encaminaron a Canadá hacia una cómoda ventaja que le permitió ampliar la diferencia en el marcador. Guatemala



ofreció su mejor versión en el tercer parcial. Después de varios empates, el conjunto local tomó por primera vez la delantera en el partido (12-10), aprovechando errores de Canadá y los ataques de Gerson Carranza y José Luis Samayoa. Barrett y Czepuryk respondieron para igualar el marcador en repetidas ocasiones hasta el 22-22. Canadá llegó al punto de partido con un ataque de Barrett (24-22), pero un error de saque y otro de ataque permitieron el empate. Koray Low-Ring volvió a darle ventaja a los canadienses y, finalmente, Barrett definió el encuentro con un ataque sobre el bloqueo para asegurar la victoria y el liderato del grupo.
