Mexico and Costa Rica Advance to Men's U21 Pan American Cup Semifinals

GUATEMALA CITY, Guatemala, June 26, 2026. – Mexico and Costa Rica secured the final two semifinal spots at the 2026 Men's U21 Pan American Cup on Friday after defeating Guatemala and Venezuela, respectively. Mexico will face Canada, winner of Pool B, while Costa Rica will play defending champion United States for a place in the final.

Mexico 3, Guatemala 0

Mexico defeated Guatemala in straight sets 3-0 (25-23, 25-13, 25-22) in the quarterfinals of the Men's U21 Pan American Cup to secure its place in the semifinals, joining the United States and Canada, who had already advanced as pool winners. The semifinal matchups, scheduled for Saturday, will be determined following the conclusion of the match between Costa Rica and Venezuela. Mexico held the advantage in attacks (48-35) and aces (2-1), while Guatemala led in blocks (5-3). Mexico committed 17 unforced errors compared to Guatemala's 22. Cristian Cadena led Mexico with 13 points, while José Luis Samayoa also scored 13 points to pace Guatemala. They were the only players to reach double figures in scoring. The opening set was tightly contested, with both teams exchanging points until a 23-23 tie. Mexico earned set point after a Guatemala attack error by opposite hitter José Luis Samayoa, and Carlos Grajeda sealed the set with a successful attack to give Mexico a 1-0 lead. After a 2-2 tie in the second set, Mexico pulled ahead 5-2 with the help of a Guatemala error, a block by Axel Vicencio on Samayoa, and a powerful spike from Grajeda. The Mexicans remained in control, extending the lead to 12-5 by capitalizing on Guatemala's errors while Cadena, Vicencio, and Grajeda fueled the offense to comfortably close the set 25-13. Like the first, the third set was evenly matched. Following a 7-7 tie, Mexico moved ahead 10-8 behind the efforts of Steben Arévalo and Daniel Cravioto. Guatemala responded to level the score at 11-11 with quick attacks through the middle by Christian Álvarez and Samayoa. The teams continued to trade points until Mexico built a 16-14 advantage with an attack by Arévalo and another Guatemala attack error. Samayoa answered with a kill before Álvarez added a block to tie the set at 16-16. The battle remained close from there, but Santiago Granados produced three consecutive points to propel Mexico to the victory.

Costa Rica 3, Venezuela 2

Costa Rica staged a remarkable comeback to defeat Venezuela 3-2 (25-17, 25-27, 18-25, 25-20, 15-10) and secure its place in the semifinals. With the victory, Costa Rica will face defending champion United States in one of Saturday's semifinals, while Canada will take on Mexico in the other. Venezuela will play Nicaragua in the classification round for positions five through eight. The match featured a memorable battle between opposite hitters. Stanley Grant led Costa Rica with 29 points, while Venezuela's Yoisbel Galeno delivered a spectacular performance with 33 points, the highest individual scoring output of the tournament so far. Denzel Jiménez added 14 points for Costa Rica, Ignacio Morales finished with 11, and Antoine Molina contributed 10. Ángel Matute scored 14 points for Venezuela. Costa Rica held the advantage in blocks (13-11) and aces (6-2), while Venezuela narrowly led in kills (59-57). Costa Rica committed 27 unforced errors compared to Venezuela's 32. Costa Rica controlled the opening set by capitalizing on Venezuela's errors (10-5). Led offensively by Stanley Grant and Antoine Molina, the Central Americans built a comfortable 22-14 lead. Venezuela attempted a late comeback with three consecutive points, but Costa Rica responded confidently as Molina, Grant, and Denzel Jiménez closed out the set. The second set was far more evenly contested. Venezuela built a 16-13 lead behind solid blocking and the powerful attacking of Yoisbel Galeno. Costa Rica tied the score at 17 through a kill from Jiménez, a



block from Grant on Galeno, and a Venezuelan error. From there, the teams traded points in a series of ties. Venezuela let two set points slip away before Galeno delivered the attack for 26-25 and Harold Larez sealed the set 27-25 with a block on Grant to level the match. Riding that momentum, Venezuela controlled the third set from the start and built a five-point advantage (14-9). Galeno continued to dominate both offensively and at the net, and the South Americans never surrendered the lead to move ahead two sets to one. Costa Rica responded with determination in the fourth set. Denzel Jiménez, Antoine Molina, and Jeremy Vanega strengthened the blocking to neutralize Venezuela's attack, while Stanley Grant regained his offensive rhythm as Costa Rica extended its lead to 19-12. Venezuela cut the deficit to three points behind Galeno and Matute, but a block from Venega on Matute forced a decisive fifth set. Costa Rica opened the tiebreak with a 3-0 lead thanks to a powerful block from Molina on Galeno, a kill from Grant, and a Venezuelan error. Although Venezuela fought back, Costa Rica remained in control. A back-row attack by Grant made it 11-8, Molina recorded another key block, and Denzel Jiménez earned match point before a Venezuelan error sealed Costa Rica's place in the semifinals.

México y Costa Rica Avanzan a Semifinales de la Copa Panamericana U21 Masculina

CIUDAD DE GUATEMALA, Guatemala, 26 de junio de 2026. – México y Costa Rica sellaron este viernes los dos últimos boletos a las semifinales de la Copa Panamericana U21 Masculina 2026 tras superar a Guatemala y Venezuela, respectivamente. Los mexicanos enfrentarán a Canadá, ganador del Grupo B, mientras que Costa Rica buscará el pase a la final ante el campeón defensor, Estados Unidos.

México 3, Guatemala 0

México derrotó a Guatemala 3-0 (25-23, 25-13, 25-22) en los cuartos de final de la Copa Panamericana U21 Masculina para asegurar su lugar en las semifinales, donde se une a Estados Unidos y Canadá, clasificados previamente como ganadores de grupo. Al concluir el partido entre Costa Rica y Venezuela, se conocerán los cruces de semifinales programados para el sábado. México superó a Guatemala 48-35 en ataques y 2-1 en aces, mientras que Guatemala tuvo ventaja en bloqueos 5-3. Los mexicanos cometieron 17 errores no forzados y Guatemala 22. Cristian Cadena lideró a México con 13 puntos, mientras que José Luis Samayoa encabezó a Guatemala también con 13 unidades. Ambos fueron los únicos jugadores del partido en alcanzar doble dígito. El primer set fue intenso, con intercambio constante de puntos hasta el empate 23-23. México alcanzó punto de set tras un error de ataque del opuesto guatemalteco José Luis Samayoa, y Carlos Grajeda selló el parcial con un ataque para poner a México arriba 1-0. Tras un empate 2-2 en el segundo set, México tomó ventaja de tres puntos (5-2) con un error rival, un bloqueo de Axel Vicencio sobre Samayoa y un potente ataque de Grajeda. El equipo mexicano mantuvo el control y amplió la diferencia 12-5, beneficiándose de errores de Guatemala y apoyado por la ofensiva de Cristian Cadena, Vicencio y Grajeda, hasta cerrar el set 25-13. Como en el primer parcial, el tercer set fue equilibrado, con puntos para ambos lados. Tras el empate 7-7, México se separó 10-8 con aportes de Steben Arévalo y Daniel Cravioto. Guatemala igualó nuevamente 11-11 con ataques por el centro de Christian Álvarez y Samayoa. El intercambio continuó, hasta que México tomó ventaja 16-14 con un ataque de Arévalo y un error ofensivo de Guatemala. Un



ataque de Samayoa y un bloqueo de Álvarez empataron el marcador 16-16. Desde allí, el duelo se mantuvo cerrado, pero Santiago Granados respondió con tres puntos consecutivos para empujar a México al triunfo.

Costa Rica 3, Venezuela 2

Costa Rica protagonizó una espectacular remontada para derrotar a Venezuela por 3-2 (25-17, 25-27, 18-25, 25-20, 15-10) y asegurar su clasificación a las semifinales. Con el triunfo, Costa Rica enfrentará al campeón defensor Estados Unidos en una de las semifinales del sábado, mientras que Canadá se medirá ante México. Venezuela disputará los encuentros por las posiciones del quinto al octavo lugar, iniciando frente a Nicaragua. El encuentro tuvo un memorable duelo entre opuestos. Stanley Grant encabezó a Costa Rica con 29 puntos, mientras que el venezolano Yoisbel Galeno firmó una extraordinaria actuación con 33 unidades, la mayor cifra individual registrada en el torneo hasta el momento. Denzel Jiménez aportó 14 puntos para Costa Rica, Ignacio Morales sumó 11 y Antoine Molina añadió 10. Por Venezuela, Ángel Matute contribuyó con 14 tantos. Costa Rica dominó el bloqueo (13-11) y el servicio (6-2), mientras que Venezuela tuvo ligera ventaja en ataques (59-57). Los costarricenses cometieron 27 errores no forzados y los venezolanos 32. Costa Rica tomó el control desde el primer set aprovechando los errores venezolanos (10-5). Con Stanley Grant y Antoine Molina liderando el ataque, los centroamericanos construyeron una cómoda ventaja de 22-14. Venezuela intentó reaccionar con tres puntos consecutivos, pero Costa Rica respondió con autoridad para cerrar el parcial con ataques de Molina, Grant y Denzel Jiménez. El segundo set fue mucho más equilibrado. Venezuela llegó a tener ventaja de 16-13 con un sólido trabajo en bloqueo y el poder ofensivo de Yoisbel Galeno. Costa Rica igualó a 17 gracias a un ataque de Jiménez, un bloqueo de Grant sobre Galeno y un error rival. A partir de ahí el parcial fue de constantes empates. Venezuela desperdició dos puntos de set antes de que Galeno atacara para el 26-25 y Harold Larez sellara el 27-25 con un bloqueo sobre Grant para empatar el encuentro. Empujada por ese impulso anímico, Venezuela dominó el tercer parcial desde el inicio y llegó a tener ventaja de cinco puntos (14-9). Galeno continuó marcando diferencias tanto en ataque como en bloqueo y los sudamericanos nunca cedieron la ventaja para colocarse arriba dos sets a uno. Costa Rica reaccionó con determinación en el cuarto parcial. Ajustó su bloqueo con Denzel Jiménez, Antoine Molina y Jeremy Vanega neutralizando el ataque venezolano, mientras Stanley Grant recuperó protagonismo ofensivo para ampliar la ventaja hasta 19-12. Venezuela redujo la diferencia a tres puntos gracias a Galeno y Matute, pero un bloqueo de Vanega sobre Matute permitió a los costarricenses forzar el quinto set. En el desempate, Costa Rica arrancó con ventaja de 3-0 gracias a un contundente bloqueo de Molina sobre Galeno, un ataque de Grant y un error venezolano. Aunque Venezuela se acercó, los centroamericanos conservaron el control. Un potente ataque de zaguero de Grant colocó el marcador 11-8, Molina volvió a imponerse en el bloqueo y Denzel Jiménez consiguió el punto de partido antes de que un error venezolano sellara la clasificación costarricense a semifinales.
