Dominican Republic and Colombia to Play for Gold at Santo Domingo 2026

SANTO DOMINGO, Dominican Republic, August 6, 2026. – The Dominican Republic and Colombia advanced to the gold medal match of the women's volleyball tournament at the 25th Central American and Caribbean Games Santo Domingo 2026 after winning their respective semifinal matches on Thursday at the Prof. Ricardo Gioriver Arias Volleyball Palace.

Defending champions Dominican Republic defeated Puerto Rico in straight sets and moved one victory away from claiming their seventh consecutive title and making history with a ninth gold medal. Colombia, meanwhile, secured its place in the final with a victory over Cuba and will look to reach the top of the podium.

The final day of competition will feature the Dominican Republic and Colombia in the gold medal match, while Puerto Rico and Cuba will battle for bronze.

Dominican Republic 3, Puerto Rico 0

The Dominican Republic moved one victory away from making history at the Central American and Caribbean Games after defeating Puerto Rico 3-0 (25-21, 25-15, 28-26) in the semifinals of Santo Domingo 2026. The Dominicans will face Colombia in the gold medal match, marking only the second time in Games history that the two countries will meet in the final. A victory would give the Dominican Republic its seventh consecutive title and ninth women's volleyball gold medal, allowing it to surpass Cuba as the country with the most championships in tournament history. Puerto Rico will face Cuba for the bronze medal and will seek its third podium finish in Games history after previously earning bronze in 2006 and 2018. The Dominican Republic took control of the first set after an even start. Puerto Rico stayed close for much of the set, but the hosts pulled away in the closing stages and finished it 25-21. The Dominican advantage was more pronounced in the second set. The Dominican Republic opened with a 5-0 lead and used pressure from the service line and strength at the net to gradually widen the gap. Puerto Rico tried to respond, but the Dominicans remained in control and took the set 25-15. Puerto Rico delivered its best performance in the third set and put the defending champions under pressure. After a tightly contested battle, the Puerto Ricans had opportunities to extend the match when they moved ahead 25-24 and again 26-25. The Dominican Republic responded in the decisive moments, tied the score and won three consecutive points to close the set 28-26, with an ace from team captain Brayelin Martínez sealing the team's place in the final. Yonkaira Peña led the Dominican offense with 18 points, while Brayelin Martínez and Gaila González added 12 points each. Decelise Champion was Puerto Rico's leading scorer with 8 points. The Dominican Republic held significant advantage in attacks, 43-30, and blocks, 14-2, while both teams recorded two aces. Puerto Rico limited its errors to 19, compared with 28 by the Dominican Republic.

Colombia 3, Cuba 1 – Semifinal

Colombia advanced to the women's volleyball gold medal match at the Central American and Caribbean Games for the second time in history after defeating Cuba 3-1 (25-19, 25-19, 17-25,



25-23) in the semifinals. Colombia's only previous appearance in a Central American and Caribbean Games final came at Barranquilla 2018, when they earned the silver medal after falling to the Dominican Republic. Cuba, meanwhile, will play for the bronze medal and will look to claim its third bronze in Games history, following those won in 2014 and 2023. Both teams await their respective opponents. Colombia took control of the match by winning the first two sets by identical 25-19 scores, relying on its blocking while limiting Cuba's offense. Cuba changed the course of the match in the third set. The Cubans increased their offensive pressure and controlled the set to win 25-17, cutting the deficit and sending the match to a fourth set that produced a dramatic finish. Cuba carried that momentum into the fourth set and built a six-point lead at 22-16, putting itself in position to force a fifth set. Colombia, however, responded at the decisive moment. The Colombians applied pressure from the service line, strengthened their defense and tied the score at 22-22 before completing the comeback 25-23 to secure their return to the gold medal match. Blocking proved decisive for Colombia, which held a 12-4 advantage in that category. Cuba had a slight edge in attacks (54-50), while both teams recorded two aces. The teams were also close in unforced errors, with Colombia committing 26 and Cuba 28. Ivonne Montaña led Colombia with 17 points, Ana Karina Olaya added 14 and Laura Grajales contributed 12. For Cuba, Yalain Regla De La Peña was the top scorer with 21 points and the only player on her team to reach double figures.

Mexico 3, Trinidad and Tobago 0 – Classification 5/8

Mexico advanced to the fifth-place match after defeating Trinidad and Tobago in straight sets 3-0 (25-10, 25-12, 25-17). Mexico controlled the match from the outset behind a strong offensive performance and effective serving. The Mexicans outscored Trinidad and Tobago 31-19 in attacks and held a commanding 12-2 advantage in aces. They also edged their opponents in blocking (6-5) while committing only 13 unforced errors compared to Trinidad and Tobago's 26. With the victory, Mexico will face the winner of the Costa Rica-Venezuela match for fifth place. Trinidad and Tobago will meet the loser for seventh place. Uxue Guereca led Mexico's offense with 11 points, while María Ximena Cruz added 10. Trinidad and Tobago's Kiune Fletcher finished as the match's leading scorer with 16 points.

Venezuela 3, Costa Rica 1 – Classification 5/8

Venezuela recovered after dropping the opening set to defeat Costa Rica 3-1 (23-25, 25-18, 25-21, 25-9) and advance to the fifth-place match. Venezuela will face Mexico for fifth place, while Costa Rica will play Trinidad and Tobago for seventh place. Costa Rica finished the opening set strongly after a slow start that saw Venezuela build an early lead. The Costa Ricans rallied with solid offensive play to take the set. From the second set onward, Venezuela settled into its rhythm, becoming more consistent in attack and at the net. The South Americans controlled the fourth set from start to finish, limiting Costa Rica to just nine points to seal the victory. Venezuela held the advantage in every major scoring category, leading 53-44 in kills, 11-6 in blocks, and 5-3 in aces. They also committed fewer unforced errors than Costa Rica (20-29). Meriyen Maiz led all scorers with 22 points for Venezuela. Isabella Sibada added 16 points, while Mariangel Vivas contributed 13. Costa Rica's Nhya Barley paced her team with 13 points.



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República Dominicana y Colombia Disputarán el Oro en Santo Domingo 2026

SANTO DOMINGO, República Dominicana, 6 de agosto de 2026. – República Dominicana y Colombia avanzaron al partido por la medalla de oro del torneo femenino de voleibol de los XXV Juegos Centroamericanos y del Caribe Santo Domingo 2026, tras superar este jueves sus respectivos compromisos de semifinales en el Palacio de Voleibol Prof. Ricardo Gioriver Arias.

Las campeonas defensoras de República Dominicana derrotaron a Puerto Rico en sets corridos y quedaron a una victoria de alcanzar su séptimo título consecutivo y hacer historia con una novena medalla de oro. Colombia, por su parte, aseguró su lugar en la final al imponerse a Cuba y buscará subir a lo más alto del podio.

La jornada final enfrentará a República Dominicana y Colombia por la medalla de oro, mientras que Puerto Rico y Cuba disputarán el bronce.

República Dominicana 3, Puerto Rico 0

República Dominicana quedó a una victoria de hacer historia en los Juegos Centroamericanos y del Caribe, tras derrotar a Puerto Rico 3-0 (25-21, 25-15, 28-26) en las semifinales de Santo Domingo 2026. Las dominicanas enfrentarán a Colombia en el partido por la medalla de oro, en lo que será apenas la segunda ocasión en la historia de los Juegos en que ambos países disputen la final. Una victoria le daría a República Dominicana su séptimo título consecutivo y su novena medalla de oro en el voleibol femenino, con lo que superaría a Cuba como el país con más títulos en la historia del torneo. Puerto Rico disputará la medalla de bronce frente a Cuba y buscará subir al podio por tercera ocasión en su historia, después de conquistar el bronce en las ediciones de 2006 y 2018. República Dominicana tomó el control del primer set después de un inicio equilibrado. Puerto Rico se mantuvo cerca durante buena parte del parcial, pero las anfitrionas lograron establecer una ventaja en la recta final y cerraron 25-21. El dominio dominicano fue más marcado en el segundo set. República Dominicana comenzó con ventaja de 5-0 y utilizó la presión desde el servicio y su fortaleza en la red para ampliar progresivamente la diferencia. Puerto Rico intentó reaccionar, pero las dominicanas mantuvieron el control hasta imponerse 25-15. Puerto Rico mostró su mejor versión en el tercer set y puso en aprietos a las campeonas defensoras. Después de un desarrollo muy disputado, las puertorriqueñas llegaron a tener oportunidades de extender el encuentro al colocarse arriba 25-24 y nuevamente 26-25. República Dominicana respondió en los momentos decisivos, igualó el marcador y consiguió tres puntos consecutivos para cerrar el parcial 28-26, con un ace de su capitana Brayelin Martínez que selló la clasificación a la final. Yonkaira Peña encabezó la ofensiva dominicana con 18 puntos, mientras que Brayelin Martínez y Gaila González aportaron 12 puntos cada una. Decelise Champion fue la máxima anotadora de Puerto Rico con 8 tantos. República Dominicana dominó ampliamente en ataques 43-30 y en bloqueos 14-2, mientras ambos equipos consiguieron dos puntos directos de servicio. Puerto Rico limitó sus errores a 19, frente a 28 de las dominicanas.



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Colombia 3, Cuba 1 – Semifinal

Colombia avanzó por segunda vez en su historia al partido por la medalla de oro del voleibol femenino de los Juegos Centroamericanos y del Caribe, tras derrotar a Cuba 3-1 (25-19, 25-19, 17-25, 25-23) en las semifinales. La única participación anterior de Colombia en una final de los Juegos fue en Barranquilla 2018, cuando obtuvo la medalla de plata tras caer ante República Dominicana. Cuba, por su parte, disputará el partido por la medalla de bronce e intentará sumar su tercer bronce en la historia de los Juegos, después de los obtenidos en 2014 y 2023. Ambos equipos esperan conocer a sus respectivos rivales. Colombia tomó el control del encuentro al imponerse por idéntico marcador de 25-19 en los dos primeros sets, apoyándose en su bloqueo y limitando la ofensiva cubana. Cuba cambió el rumbo del partido en el tercer set. Las cubanas aumentaron la presión ofensiva y dominaron el parcial para imponerse 25-17, recortar la diferencia y llevar el encuentro a un cuarto set que tuvo un cierre dramático. El equipo cubano mantuvo el impulso y llegó a tomar una ventaja de seis puntos, 22-16, en el cuarto parcial, encaminándose a extender el partido a un quinto set. Colombia, sin embargo, reaccionó en el momento decisivo. Las colombianas presionaron con el servicio, fortalecieron su defensa y consiguieron empatar el marcador 22-22 antes de completar la remontada 25-23 y asegurar su regreso al partido por la medalla de oro. El bloqueo fue determinante para Colombia, que dominó ese fundamento 12-4. Cuba tuvo una ligera ventaja en ataques (54-50), mientras ambos equipos anotaron dos puntos directos de servicio. También estuvieron muy parejos en errores no forzados, con 26 de Colombia y 28 de Cuba. Ivonne Montaña encabezó la ofensiva colombiana con 17 puntos, Ana Karina Olaya aportó 14 y Laura Grajales sumó 12. Por Cuba, Yalain Regla De La Peña fue la máxima anotadora con 21 puntos y la única jugadora de su equipo que alcanzó doble dígito.

México 3, Trinidad y Tobago 0 – Clasificación 5/8

México avanzó al partido por el quinto lugar al derrotar con autoridad a Trinidad y Tobago en sets corridos 3-0 (25-10, 25-12, 25-17). El conjunto mexicano controló el encuentro desde el inicio apoyado en la solidez de su ataque y la efectividad desde la línea de servicio. México superó a Trinidad y Tobago 31-19 en puntos de ataque y estableció una amplia diferencia con 12 aces contra dos de su rival. Además, dominó ligeramente el bloqueo (6-5) y cometió apenas 13 errores no forzados, frente a los 26 de las caribeñas. Con la victoria, México disputará el encuentro por el quinto lugar ante el ganador del partido entre Costa Rica y Venezuela. Trinidad y Tobago se enfrentará al perdedor por el séptimo lugar. Uxue Guereca encabezó la ofensiva mexicana con 11 puntos, mientras que María Ximena Cruz aportó 10. Por Trinidad y Tobago, Kiune Fletcher fue la máxima anotadora del partido con 16 unidades.

Venezuela 3, Costa Rica 1 – Clasificación 5/8

Venezuela se recuperó tras ceder el primer set y derrotó a Costa Rica 3-1 (23-25, 25-18, 25-21, 25-9) para avanzar al partido por el quinto lugar. Venezuela enfrentará a México por la quinta posición, mientras que Costa Rica disputará el séptimo lugar frente a Trinidad y Tobago. Costa Rica tuvo un mejor cierre en el primer set. Después de un inicio en el que Venezuela tomó la delantera, las costarricenses reaccionaron con una sólida ofensiva para remontar y quedarse con el parcial. A partir del segundo set, Venezuela ajustó su juego, encontró mayor consistencia en ataque y bloqueo, y fue ampliando su dominio. Las sudamericanas controlaron el cuarto set



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de principio a fin, limitando a Costa Rica a solo nueve puntos para sellar la victoria. Venezuela fue superior en los principales fundamentos del juego, con ventaja de 53-44 en ataques, 11-6 en bloqueos y 5-3 en servicios. Además, cometió menos errores no forzados que Costa Rica (20-29). Meriyen Maiz fue la máxima anotadora del encuentro con 22 puntos para Venezuela. Isabella Sibada contribuyó con 16 unidades y Mariangel Vivas agregó 13. Por Costa Rica, Nhya Barley lideró la ofensiva con 13 puntos.
