Dominican Republic Makes History at Home with Seventh Consecutive Central American and Caribbean Games Title

SANTO DOMINGO, Dominican Republic, August 7, 2026.- Dominican Republic made history in front of its home crowd by claiming its seventh consecutive women's volleyball gold medal at the Central American and Caribbean Games, defeating Colombia 3-0 (25-19, 25-19, 25-21) in the gold medal match of the 25th edition of the Games, Santo Domingo 2026.

In a packed Ricardo Gioriver Arias Volleyball Palace, with fans chanting "¡Vamos Reinas!" in support of Las Reinas del Caribe, Dominican Republic extended its historic streak to seven consecutive titles at the Games.

The gold medal also made the Dominican Republic the most successful women's volleyball team in the history of the Central American and Caribbean Games, reaching nine gold medals and surpassing Cuba's eight titles. The Dominicans have also won one silver and four bronze medals.

Dominican Republic took control of the match from the opening set. Their pressure from the service line and strength at the net allowed them to build a lead and keep Colombia at a distance on their way to a 25-19 win.

The second set followed a similar pattern. Colombia tried to stay within reach, but the Dominicans once again imposed their game in the second half of the set to repeat the 25-19 score and move within one set of making history in front of their home crowd.

Colombia put up its strongest resistance in the third set. The score remained close for much of the set, reaching a 14-14 tie before Dominican Republic began to pull away. The Dominicans entered the closing stretch with a 23-20 advantage and eventually reached championship point at 24-21.

With the entire Volleyball Palace on its feet, Jineiry Martínez brought the tournament to an end with a block on Laura Olaya for the 25-21 victory, setting off the celebration for Las Reinas del Caribe and the Dominican fans.

Blocking was one of the key elements in Dominican Republic's victory, with a 12-5 advantage and also led 8-2 in aces. The champions committed 17 unforced errors compared to Colombia's 21, while the Colombians held a slight 35-34 edge in attacks.

Yonkaira Peña led the Dominican offense with 16 points, while Gaila González contributed 13. For Colombia, Ivonne Montaña was the top scorer with 14 points.

For Colombia, the silver medal was the second medal in its history in women's volleyball at the Central American and Caribbean Games. Both have been silver medals, and on both occasions, Colombia faced Dominican Republic in the gold medal match.

Puerto Rico 3, Cuba 0 – Bronze Medal

Puerto Rico claimed the bronze medal after defeating Cuba 3-0 (26-24, 25-23, 25-18). The victory gave Puerto Rico its third bronze medal in the history of the Central American and

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Caribbean Games. The Puerto Ricans have also won six silver medals for a total of nine medals in the competition. Puerto Rico avenged its loss to Cuba in the group stage, when the Cubans won in straight sets. The first two sets were the most closely contested of the match. In the first, Cuba reached set point with a 24-23 lead, but Puerto Rico responded with three consecutive points to turn the score around and take the set 26-24. The second set remained even through a 10-10 tie before Puerto Rico began to pull ahead. The Puerto Ricans built a five-point advantage and reached set point at 24-21. Cuba saved two set points before Puerto Rico closed it out 25-23 to take a 2-0 lead. Puerto Rico took control early in the third set, establishing a 7-3 advantage. Cuba tried to close the gap, but the Puerto Ricans maintained their lead and extended the margin in the second half of the set before closing it 25-18 to secure the bronze medal. Puerto Rico held the advantage in every skill, outscoring Cuba 42-39 in kills, 9-7 in blocks and 5-2 in aces. Puerto Rico also committed 17 unforced errors compared to Cuba's 20. Decelise Champion led Puerto Rico's offense with 15 points, while Valeria Vázquez and Adriana Rodríguez contributed 11 points each. Greisy Fine was Cuba's only player in double figures with 10 points. For Cuba, the result meant finishing outside the podium. The Cubans have won eight gold medals, two silver medals and two bronze medals in the history of the Central American and Caribbean Games.

Mexico 3, Venezuela 1 – Positions 5/6

Mexico finished in fifth place after defeating Venezuela 3-1 (25-15, 25-18, 23-25, 25-20). Mexico took control of the match from the opening set, relying on its offense and blocking to build a comfortable lead. The Mexicans maintained control throughout the remainder of the set and won it 25-15. Mexico continued to set the pace in the second set. After a more balanced start, the team pulled away on the scoreboard and maintained the advantage until closing it 25-18 to move one set away from victory. Venezuela responded in the third set in a closely contested battle that reached a 20-20 tie. From that point on, neither team was able to pull away, with the score tied again at 21, 22 and 23, before Venezuela scored the final two points to take the set 25-23 and extend the match. The fourth set also began evenly and reached a 9-9 tie. Mexico gradually built an advantage and, although Venezuela stayed within reach for much of the set, the Mexicans entered the final stretch ahead 22-18 and closed it 25-20 to secure fifth place. Mexico held a huge advantage in attacks 57-37 and was also superior in blocks 15-9, although it committed 26 errors compared to Venezuela's 23. Venezuela led in aces 6-3. Grecia Castro led Mexico's offense with 21 points, followed by Sofía Maldonado with 20 and Uxue Guereca with 16. Karina Flores recorded a match-high five blocks. For Venezuela, Mariangel Vivas was the only player in double figures with 14 points, including a match-high four aces.

Costa Rica 3, Trinidad and Tobago 0 – Positions 7/8

Costa Rica closed its participation with a 3-0 (25-11, 25-20, 30-28) victory over Trinidad and Tobago to finish in seventh place. Costa Rica dominated the first set, putting pressure from the service line and showing greater offensive efficiency to quickly take control of the score. The Costa Ricans maintained a comfortable lead throughout the set before closing it 25-11. The second set was more closely contested. Trinidad and Tobago stayed within reach for much of the set, but Costa Rica found better solutions down the stretch to extend its lead and go up 2-0 with a 25-20 win. Trinidad and Tobago responded in the third set and built a seven-point lead at



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21-14. Costa Rica gradually cut into the deficit and tied the score at 24, extending the set. Both teams had opportunities to close it before the Costa Ricans prevailed 30-28 to complete the straight-set victory. Serving was one of the keys for Costa Rica, which held a 9-0 advantage in aces, also led in attacks 42-30 and committed 21 unforced errors compared to 23 by its opponents. Trinidad and Tobago held a 6-4 advantage in blocks. Krystel Vargas led Costa Rica's offense with 22 points, including a match-high five aces. Tannia Carazo added 13 points. For Trinidad and Tobago, Kiune Fletcher was the top scorer with 18 points.

República Dominicana hace historia en casa con su séptimo título consecutivo en los Juegos Centroamericanos y del Caribe

SANTO DOMINGO, República Dominicana, 7 de agosto de 2026.- República Dominicana hizo historia ante su público al conquistar su séptima medalla de oro consecutiva en el voleibol femenino de los Juegos Centroamericanos y del Caribe, tras derrotar a Colombia 3-0 (25-19, 25-19, 25-21) en el partido por el título de la vigésima quinta edición de las Justas, Santo Domingo 2026.

Ante un Palacio de Voleibol Prof. Ricardo Gioriver Arias lleno y una afición que acompañó a Las Reinas del Caribe al grito de "¡Vamos Reinas!", República Dominicana extendió a siete su histórica racha de títulos consecutivos en los Juegos.

La medalla también convirtió a República Dominicana en la selección de voleibol femenino más ganadora en la historia de los Juegos Centroamericanos y del Caribe, al alcanzar su noveno oro y superar los ocho títulos de Cuba. Las dominicanas suman además una medalla de plata y cuatro de bronce.

República Dominicana tomó el control del partido desde el primer set. Su presión desde el servicio y la fortaleza en la red le permitieron establecer ventaja y mantener a Colombia a distancia para quedarse con el parcial 25-19.

El segundo set siguió un desarrollo similar. Colombia intentó mantenerse cerca en el marcador, pero las dominicanas volvieron a imponer su juego en la segunda mitad del parcial para repetir el 25-19 y colocarse a un set de hacer historia frente a su público.

Colombia presentó su mayor resistencia en el tercer set. El marcador se mantuvo cerrado durante buena parte del parcial, llegando igualado a 14 puntos, antes de que República Dominicana lograra desprenderse. Las dominicanas llegaron a la recta final con ventaja de 23-20 y finalmente alcanzaron el punto para campeonato 24-21.

Con todo el Palacio de Voleibol de pie, Jineiry Martínez puso punto final al torneo con un bloqueo sobre Laura Olaya para el 25-21 que desató la celebración de Las Reinas del Caribe y de la afición dominicana.

El bloqueo fue uno de los elementos fundamentales en la victoria de República Dominicana, que dominó 12-5 y también tuvo ventaja de 8-2 en servicios ace. Las campeonas cometieron 17



errores no forzados frente a 21 de Colombia, mientras que las colombianas tuvieron una ligera ventaja en ataques 35-34.

Yonkaira Peña encabezó la ofensiva dominicana con 16 puntos y Gaila González aportó 13. Por Colombia, Ivonne Montaña fue la máxima anotadora con 14 puntos.

Para Colombia, la medalla de plata fue la segunda presea de su historia en el voleibol femenino de los Juegos Centroamericanos y del Caribe. Sus dos medallas han sido de plata y en ambas ocasiones disputó el partido por el título frente a República Dominicana.

Puerto Rico 3, Cuba 0 – Bronze Medal

Puerto Rico se quedó con la medalla de bronce al derrotar a Cuba 3-0 (26-24, 25-23, 25-18). La victoria significó la tercera medalla de bronce de Puerto Rico en la historia de los Juegos Centroamericanos y del Caribe. Las puertorriqueñas también han ganado seis medallas de plata para un total de nueve preseas en la competencia. Puerto Rico se tomó la revancha del encuentro entre ambos equipos en la fase de grupos, cuando Cuba se impuso en sets corridos. Los dos primeros sets fueron los más disputados del encuentro. En el primero, Cuba llegó a punto para set con ventaja de 24-23, pero Puerto Rico respondió con tres puntos consecutivos para darle vuelta al marcador y quedarse con el parcial 26-24. El segundo set se mantuvo equilibrado hasta el empate a 10 puntos, cuando Puerto Rico comenzó a tomar distancia. Las puertorriqueñas llegaron a tener una ventaja de cinco puntos y alcanzaron el punto para set 24-21. Cuba salvó dos oportunidades antes de que Puerto Rico cerrara 25-23 para colocarse arriba 2-0. Puerto Rico tomó el control desde temprano en el tercer set, estableciendo una ventaja de 7-3. Cuba intentó acercarse, pero las puertorriqueñas mantuvieron la diferencia y ampliaron su ventaja en la segunda mitad del parcial para cerrarlo 25-18 y asegurar la medalla de bronce. Puerto Rico terminó con ventaja en los principales fundamentos, superando a Cuba 42-39 en ataques, 9-7 en bloqueos y 5-2 en servicios ace. Además, cometió 17 errores no forzados frente a 20 de Cuba. Decelise Champion encabezó la ofensiva de Puerto Rico con 15 puntos, mientras que Valeria Vázquez y Adriana Rodríguez aportaron 11 puntos cada una. Por Cuba, Greisy Fine fue la única jugadora en doble dígito con 10 puntos. Para Cuba, el resultado significó finalizar fuera del podio. Las cubanas cuentan con ocho medallas de oro, dos de plata y dos de bronce en la historia de los Juegos Centroamericanos y del Caribe.

México 3, Venezuela 1 – Posiciones 5/6

México finalizó en la quinta posición tras derrotar a Venezuela 3-1 (25-15, 25-18, 23-25, 25-20). México tomó el control del encuentro desde el primer set, apoyado en su ofensiva y bloqueo para establecer una cómoda ventaja. Las mexicanas mantuvieron el dominio durante el resto del parcial y se impusieron 25-15. El conjunto mexicano continuó marcando el ritmo en el segundo set. Después de un inicio más equilibrado, logró separarse en el marcador y mantuvo la ventaja hasta cerrarlo 25-18 para colocarse a un set de la victoria. Venezuela reaccionó en el tercero en un cerrado duelo que llegó igualado a 20 puntos. A partir de allí ninguno de los dos equipos logró separarse y el marcador volvió a empatarse a 21, 22 y 23, hasta que las venezolanas consiguieron los dos puntos finales para llevarse el set 25-23 y extender el encuentro. El cuarto set también comenzó equilibrado y llegó empatado a nueve puntos. México logró tomar ventaja progresivamente y, aunque Venezuela se mantuvo cerca durante



buena parte del parcial, las mexicanas llegaron con ventaja de 22-18 a la recta final y cerraron 25-20 para asegurar el quinto lugar. México tuvo una amplia ventaja en ataque 57-37 y también fue superior en bloqueos 15-9, aunque cometió 26 errores frente a 23 de Venezuela. Las venezolanas dominaron en servicios ace 6-3. Grecia Castro encabezó la ofensiva mexicana con 21 puntos, seguida por Sofía Maldonado con 20 y Uxue Guereca con 16. Karina Flores registró cinco bloqueos, la mayor cantidad del partido. Por Venezuela, Mariangel Vivas fue la única jugadora con doble dígito, con 14 puntos, incluyendo cuatro servicios ace, el máximo del encuentro.

Costa Rica 3, Trinidad y Tobago 0 – Posiciones 7/8

Costa Rica cerró su participación con una victoria 3-0 (25-11, 25-20, 30-28) sobre Trinidad y Tobago para finalizar en la séptima posición. Costa Rica dominó ampliamente el primer set, imponiendo presión desde el servicio y mostrando mayor efectividad ofensiva para tomar rápidamente el control del marcador. Las costarricenses mantuvieron una cómoda ventaja durante todo el parcial hasta cerrarlo 25-11. El segundo set fue más disputado. Trinidad y Tobago logró mantenerse cerca en el marcador durante buena parte del parcial, pero Costa Rica encontró mejores soluciones en la recta final para ampliar su ventaja y colocarse arriba 2-0 con un 25-20. Trinidad y Tobago reaccionó en el tercer set y llegó a establecer una ventaja de siete puntos, 21-14. Costa Rica fue descontando la diferencia hasta igualar el marcador a 24 puntos y extender el parcial. Ambos equipos tuvieron oportunidades de cerrarlo antes de que las costarricenses se impusieran 30-28 para completar la victoria en sets corridos. El servicio fue una de las claves para Costa Rica, que dominó 9-0, también fue superior en ataques 42-30 y cometió 21 errores no forzados frente a 23 de sus rivales. Trinidad y Tobago tuvo ventaja en bloqueos 6-4. Krystel Vargas encabezó la ofensiva de Costa Rica con 22 puntos, incluyendo cinco servicios ace, la mayor cantidad del encuentro.
