Guatemala Takes Seventh Place at the U17 Pan American Cup

GUATEMALA CITY, Guatemala, August 9, 2026.- Guatemala defeated Honduras 3-0 (25-22, 25-20, 25-13) to finish in seventh place at the Boys' U17 Pan American Cup, held at the Domo Polideportivo in Guatemala City.

Guatemala controlled the match, although that dominance was not clearly reflected in the scores of the first two sets. In the third, Guatemala built a big lead, allowing some players who had not yet taken the court to make their tournament debut.

Guatemala led the match statistics with advantages of 43-20 in attacks, 5-2 in blocks and 8-3 in serves. Guatemala committed 22 unforced errors, while Honduras recorded 19.

Guatemala finished the tournament with a 2-4 win-loss record, while Honduras finished 0-5. Guatemala's Oscar Velásquez was led all scorers with 17 points, followed by teammates Javier Pérez with 11 and Eduardo Palala with 10.

For Honduras, Josué Ávila was the leading scorer with 6 points.

Juan David Zúñiga, captain of Guatemala: "We did not achieve our initial goal, but we gave everything we had. It was a great experience. We played against very strong teams, and that helps us improve and do things better in future tournaments."

Puerto Rico Defeats Costa Rica and Finishes Fifth at the U17 Pan American Cup

GUATEMALA CITY, Guatemala, August 9, 2026.- Puerto Rico defeated Costa Rica 3-1 (25-20, 19-25, 25-11, 25-18) to finish in fifth place at the Boys' U17 Pan American Cup, at the Domo Polideportivo in Guatemala City.

Puerto Rico won the first set thanks to good coordination at the net. The match remained quite even until point 17, when Puerto Rico managed to pull away and take the lead in the match.

Costa Rica took control of the second set from the start, and Puerto Rico was never able to challenge the Central Americans, who tied the match. The third set was the opposite, as the Caribbean side imposed its rhythm from the opening points and comfortably managed its advantage to move back in front.

The fourth set was more evenly contested and, although Puerto Rico encountered some difficulties at times, it managed to maintain the advantage and close out the match in four sets.

Puerto Rico led the statistics in attacks 58-37 and blocks 9-5, while both teams finished tied with 5 points from serves.

Puerto Rico's Antonio Figueroa was the standout performer with 21 points, while teammate Sebastián Colón contributed 17. For Costa Rica, Braulio Alvarado was the leading scorer with 10 points.

Héctor Lavergne, captain of Puerto Rico: "We feel pretty good. It was a long summer with a lot of training. Maybe we didn't get the result we expected in the tournament, but we worked hard, stayed together the entire time and played as a team."

U17 Pan American Cup Bronze Goes to the United States

GUATEMALA CITY, Guatemala, August 9, 2026.- The United States captured the bronze medal at the Boys' U17 Pan American Cup after defeating Mexico 3-0 (25-17, 25-21, 25-19) at the tournament being held at the Domo Polideportivo in Guatemala City.



All three sets were closely contested. The United States strengthened its blocking, which allowed them to counter Mexico's attack. It was in the first set that the Americans managed to build a wider lead and take control on their way to victory.

In the second and third sets, the score remained close for most of the way, and it was not until the final points that the United States managed to pull away and close out both sets. In the team statistics, the United States outperformed Mexico in attacks 52-38 and blocks 8-2, while both teams finished tied with 2 aces.

Gabriele Desiderio of the United States was the match's leading scorer with 23 points, Jackson Real contributed 15, and Siddanth Saikanth finished with 13. For Mexico, Sebastián Merino stood out with 19 points.

The United States finished the tournament in third place with a 4-2 win-loss record, while Mexico finished fourth with a 2-3 record.

Carter Tchaikovsky, captain of the United States: "Obviously, the goal was to win. Coming back from a loss and taking third place is huge; it's hard to battle back from a tough loss like that. We did a good job rallying and still fighting hard at the end."

Regarding the semifinal loss to Venezuela, he added: "I think we weren't as prepared as we should have been and, honestly, Venezuela is a good team. They came in with a lot of energy and built the momentum to make sure we couldn't get back in there."

Venezuela Crowned Boys' U17 Pan American Cup Champion

GUATEMALA CITY, Guatemala, August 9, 2026.- Venezuela was crowned champion of the second Boys' U17 Pan American Cup after defeating Canada 3-0 (25-22, 25-22, 25-19) in the final at the Domo Polideportivo in Guatemala City.

Venezuela came out strong and built a 19-12 lead in the first set. Canada regrouped and managed to cut the deficit down the stretch, but the comeback fell short as the South Americans took the set 25-22.

Venezuela remained ahead on the scoreboard for the rest of the match. Canada battled to stay close, but Venezuela's defense, along with the difference in serving and unforced errors, proved decisive as the South Americans closed out the match in straight sets. Despite the loss, Canada outperformed Venezuela 36-31 in attacks and 10-5 in blocks, with Liam Bendavid accounting for seven of Canada's blocks. The champions held a commanding 7-1 advantage in aces. Unforced errors also made a significant difference, with Canada committing 32 compared to only 16 by Venezuela.

Marín Pérez, head coach of Venezuela: "We are very happy and proud. The boys did an excellent job, believed in themselves, had faith and achieved it with a lot of determination and courage. It is a great achievement for Venezuela."

Guatemala dominó los fundamentos estadísticos del juego, con ventaja de 43-20 en ataques, 5-2 en bloqueos y 8-3 en servicios. Los guatemaltecos cometieron 22 errores no forzados, mientras que Honduras registró 19.

Guatemala terminó el torneo con récord de 2 victorias y 4 derrotas, mientras que Honduras finalizó con marca de 0-5.

El guatemalteco Oscar Velásquez fue el máximo anotador del encuentro con 17 puntos, seguido por sus compañeros Javier Pérez, con 11, y Eduardo Palala, con 10.

Por Honduras, Josué Ávila fue el máximo anotador con 6 puntos.

Juan David Zúñiga, capitán de Guatemala: "No logramos el objetivo inicial, pero dimos lo mejor que teníamos. Fue una gran experiencia, jugamos contra equipos muy fuertes y eso nos ayuda a mejorar y a hacer mejor las cosas en otros torneos".

Puerto Rico derrota a Costa Rica y finaliza en la quinta posición de la Copa Panamericana U17

CIUDAD DE GUATEMALA, Guatemala, 9 de agosto de 2026.- Puerto Rico derrotó 3-1 (25-20, 19-25, 25-11, 25-18) a Costa Rica y se quedó con la quinta posición de la Copa Panamericana U17 Masculina, que se disputa en el Domo Polideportivo de la Ciudad de Guatemala.

Puerto Rico ganó el primer set gracias a una buena coordinación en el bloqueo. El juego se mantuvo bastante parejo hasta el punto 17, cuando los puertorriqueños lograron distanciarse para tomar ventaja en el encuentro.

Costa Rica tomó el control del segundo set desde el inicio y Puerto Rico nunca logró incomodar a los centroamericanos, que igualaron el partido. En el tercer set ocurrió lo contrario: los caribeños impusieron su ritmo desde los primeros puntos y manejaron con comodidad la ventaja para colocarse nuevamente al frente.

El cuarto set fue más parejo y, aunque por momentos Puerto Rico encontró dificultades, logró mantener la ventaja para cerrar el partido en cuatro sets.

Puerto Rico dominó las estadísticas en ataques 58-37 y en bloqueos 9-5, mientras que ambos equipos terminaron empatados con 5 puntos de servicio.

Antonio Figueroa, de Puerto Rico, fue la figura del encuentro con 21 puntos, mientras que su compañero Sebastián Colón aportó 17. Por Costa Rica, Braulio Alvarado fue el máximo anotador con 10 puntos.

Héctor Lavergne, capitán de Puerto Rico: “Nos sentimos bastante bien. Fue un verano largo, de muchos entrenamientos. Quizá en el torneo no obtuvimos el resultado que esperábamos, pero trabajamos duro, todo el tiempo unidos y como equipo”.

El Bronce de la Copa Panamericana U17 es de Estados Unidos

CIUDAD DE GUATEMALA, Guatemala, 9 de agosto de 2026.- Estados Unidos conquistó la medalla de bronce de la Copa Panamericana U17 Masculina al derrotar 3-0 (25-17, 25-21, 25-19) a México, en el torneo que se disputa en el Domo Polideportivo de la Ciudad de Guatemala.

Los tres sets fueron bastante disputados. Estados Unidos fortaleció su bloqueo, lo que le permitió contrarrestar el ataque mexicano. Fue en el primer set donde los estadounidenses lograron establecer una ventaja más amplia para encaminarse a la victoria.

En el segundo y tercer set, el marcador se mantuvo con diferencias mínimas durante gran parte del juego y fue hasta los puntos finales cuando Estados Unidos logró distanciarse para cerrar ambos parciales.

En las estadísticas por equipos, Estados Unidos superó a México en ataques 52-38 y en bloqueos 8-2, mientras que en servicios ambos equipos terminaron empatados con 2 aces. Gabriele Desiderio, de Estados Unidos, fue el máximo anotador del encuentro con 23 puntos, Jackson Real aportó 15 y Siddanth Saikanth terminó con 13. Por México, Sebastián Merino destacó con 19 puntos.

Estados Unidos terminó el torneo en la tercera posición con récord de 4 victorias y 2 derrotas, mientras que México finalizó en el cuarto lugar con marca de 2 victorias y 3 derrotas.

Carter Tchaikovsky, capitán de Estados Unidos: “Obviamente, el objetivo era ganar. Recuperarnos después de una derrota y quedarnos con el tercer lugar es muy importante; es difícil reponerse después de una derrota tan dura como esa. Hicimos un buen trabajo para recuperarnos y seguimos luchando con todo hasta el final”.

Sobre la derrota ante Venezuela en las semifinales agregó: “Creo que no estábamos tan preparados como debíamos y, sinceramente, Venezuela es un buen equipo. Entraron con mucha energía, tomaron el impulso del partido y se aseguraron de que no pudiéramos reaccionar”.



Venezuela Campeón de la Copa Panamericana U17 Masculina

CIUDAD DE GUATEMALA, Guatemala, 9 de agosto de 2026.- Venezuela se consagró campeón de la segunda Copa Panamericana U17 Masculina al derrotar 3-0 (25-22, 25-22, 25-19) a Canadá, en la final disputada en el Domo Polideportivo de la Ciudad de Guatemala.

Venezuela comenzó el encuentro con mucho empuje y llegó a establecer una ventaja de 19-12 en el primer set. Canadá se reorganizó y logró reducir la diferencia en la recta final, pero la reacción no fue suficiente y los sudamericanos se quedaron con el parcial 25-22.

Venezuela se mantuvo adelante en el marcador durante el resto del encuentro. Canadá luchó por mantenerse cerca, pero la defensa venezolana y la diferencia en el servicio y los errores no forzados fueron determinantes para que los sudamericanos cerraran el partido en sets corridos.

A pesar de la derrota, Canadá superó a Venezuela 36-31 en ataques y 10-5 en bloqueos, siete de ellos de Liam Bendavid. Los campeones tuvieron una amplia ventaja de 7-1 en servicios. Los errores no forzados también marcaron una importante diferencia: Canadá cometió 32 y Venezuela solamente 16.

Venezuela cerró el torneo invicto con cinco victorias y sin perder un solo set, mientras que Canadá finalizó con récord de cuatro victorias y dos derrotas.
