Puerto Rico Goes Undefeated as Quarterfinals Are Set in León

LEÓN, Mexico, September 15, 2026.- Puerto Rico completed an undefeated run through pool play and earned a direct berth in the semifinals, while the quarterfinal matchups were set Tuesday as the preliminary round of the 2026 Women's Pan American Cup concluded at the Domo de la Feria in León, Guanajuato.

Puerto Rico defeated Dominican Republic in four sets to finish atop Pool A with a perfect 4-0 record. Canada secured third place in the pool and a quarterfinal berth with a straight-set win over Nicaragua. In Pool B, USA and Cuba advanced to the quarterfinals after defeating Guatemala and Costa Rica, respectively. Wednesday's quarterfinals will feature Dominican Republic against Cuba and USA against Canada.

United States 3, Guatemala 0

USA secured second place in Pool B and advanced to the quarterfinals after defeating Guatemala in straight sets. USA dominated Guatemala 3-0 (25-9, 25-8, 25-14) to close the pool-play round with a 3-1 record. Guatemala finished with a 1-3 record and will continue in the classification matches for positions 7-10. The U.S. team set the pace from the start with pressure from the service line and superiority at the net. After controlling the first two sets comfortably, Guatemala put up more resistance early in the third, taking a 4-3 lead. USA quickly regained control and gradually pulled away to complete the straight-set victory. USA held a commanding advantage in attacks 38-13, blocks 8-1 and aces 9-0. Guatemala committed 20 unforced errors compared to 17 by USA. Samantha Francis led the U.S. offense with 10 points on seven attacks, two blocks and one ace. Eva Hudson added nine points on seven attacks and two aces. Melissa Guerra and Andrea Garcés scored four points each for Guatemala.

Cuba 3, Costa Rica 0

Cuba finished third in Pool B and secured its spot in the quarterfinals with a straight-set victory over Costa Rica. Cuba defeated Costa Rica 3-0 (25-16, 25-16, 25-15) to finish with a 2-2 record and take third place in Pool B. Costa Rica closed the preliminary round winless at 0-4 and will continue in the classification matches for positions 7-10. The Cuban team took control from the first set and built an early lead that allowed it to manage the score. Cuba maintained its dominance in the second set, while Costa Rica put up its strongest resistance in the third. Costa Rica took a 12-11 lead in the third set and stayed level with Cuba through 13-13. From that point on, the Cubans regained control and pulled away to complete the straight-set victory. Cuba held a huge advantage in attacks 38-20, while also leading in blocks 11-4 and aces 6-1. The Cubans committed 22 errors compared to 20 by Costa Rica. Whitney James led Cuba's offense with 16 points and Dayana Martínez added 12. For Costa Rica, Krystel Vargas and Joselyn Moraga scored six points each.

Canada 3, Nicaragua 0

Canada came out on top in a head-to-head match against Nicaragua that determined third place in Pool A and a berth in the quarterfinals. Canada defeated Nicaragua 3-0 (25-13, 25-9, 25-18) to close pool play with a 2-2 record and finish in third place. Nicaragua finished with a 1-3 record and will continue in the classification round for positions 7-10. Canada will face the loser of the match between Dominican Republic and Puerto Rico in the quarterfinals. Nicaragua will face Costa Rica on Wednesday at 2:00 p.m. in a classification match for positions 7-10. The Canadians made the biggest difference at the net, where they

did not allow Nicaragua to score a single block. Canada finished with a 34-21 advantage in attacks and a commanding 10-0 edge in blocks, while also leading 6-2 in aces. Nicaragua committed 25 errors compared to 17 by Canada. Canada controlled the first set 25-13 and, although Nicaragua stayed close during the early exchanges of the second, the Canadians quickly pulled away to dominate it 25-9. Nicaragua put up more resistance in the third, but Canada once again built a comfortable advantage and closed out the match 25-18. Emma Boyd delivered an all-around performance to lead Canada with 13 points, including six attacks, four blocks and three aces. Jessica Andrews added 11 points on seven attacks, two blocks and two aces. Josafat Díaz was Nicaragua's leading scorer with five points.

Puerto Rico 3, Dominican Republic 1

Puerto Rico won the Caribbean showdown against Dominican Republic that decided first place in Pool A, advancing directly to the semifinals. Puerto Rico prevailed 3-1 (25-22, 23-25, 25-16, 25-19) to complete pool play undefeated with a 4-0 record. Dominican Republic finished with a 3-1 record and took second place in the pool, sending them to Wednesday's quarterfinal against Cuba at 6:00 p.m. The first set featured a tight finish. After the teams were tied 21-21, Puerto Rico found answers from Dariana Hollingsworth and a block by Ana Sofía Jusino to move ahead 23-21. Dominican Republic pulled within 23-22, but the Puerto Ricans scored the final two points, with Hollingsworth sealing the 25-22 win with an attack. Dominican Republic responded in the second set. In another close finish, the teams were tied at 21-21 and later at 23-23 before the Dominicans scored the final two points to take the set 25-23 and even the match. Puerto Rico regained control in the third. With Hollingsworth leading the offense and contributions from Valeria Vázquez and Ivania Ortiz, the Puerto Ricans established a lead that Dominican Republic was unable to overcome. Hollingsworth closed the set with a block for the 25-16 win. In the fourth, Puerto Rico began to pull away after an evenly played start. Hollingsworth continued to make her presence felt on offense, while Vázquez, Ortiz and Jusino also contributed. The Puerto Ricans widened the gap in the second half of the set and remained in control to close it 25-19 and secure a direct berth in the semifinals. Puerto Rico held the advantage in the main scoring categories, outscoring Dominican Republic 59-51 in attacks, 9-5 in blocks and 5-0 in aces. The Dominicans committed one fewer error, 25 compared with Puerto Rico's 26. Hollingsworth was the match's leading scorer with 30 points on 26 attacks and four blocks. Vázquez added 13 points, Ortiz contributed 12 and Jusino finished with 11. For Dominican Republic, Flormarie Heredia led the offense with 20 points, all on kills, and was the only Dominican player to reach double figures in scoring.

Puerto Rico cierra invicto y quedan definidos los cuartos de final en León

LEÓN, México, 15 de septiembre de 2026.- Puerto Rico completó invicto la fase de grupos y obtuvo el pase directo a las semifinales, mientras quedaron definidos los cruces de cuartos de final este martes, al concluir la ronda preliminar de la Copa Panamericana Femenina 2026 en el Domo de la Feria de León, Guanajuato.

Puerto Rico derrotó a República Dominicana en cuatro sets para finalizar en el primer lugar del Grupo A con récord perfecto de 4-0. Canadá aseguró el tercer lugar del grupo y su pase a cuartos de final con una victoria en sets corridos sobre Nicaragua. En el Grupo B, Estados Unidos y Cuba avanzaron a cuartos tras vencer a Guatemala y Costa Rica,

respectivamente. Los cuartos de final del miércoles enfrentarán a República Dominicana contra Cuba y a Estados Unidos contra Canadá.

Estados Unidos 3, Guatemala 0

Estados Unidos aseguró el segundo lugar del Grupo B y avanzó a los cuartos de final tras vencer a Guatemala en sets corridos. Estados Unidos dominó 3-0 (25-9, 25-8, 25-14) para cerrar la fase de grupos con récord de 3-1. Guatemala terminó con marca de 1-3 y continuará su participación en los partidos de clasificación por las posiciones 7-10. El conjunto estadounidense impuso su ritmo desde el inicio con presión desde el servicio y superioridad en la red. Después de controlar ampliamente los primeros dos sets, Guatemala ofreció mayor resistencia al comienzo del tercero, llegando a tomar una ventaja de 4-3. Estados Unidos recuperó rápidamente el control y se separó progresivamente para completar la victoria en tres sets. Estados Unidos fue ampliamente superior en ataques 38-13, bloqueos 8-1 y puntos de servicio 9-0. Guatemala cometió 20 errores no forzados y Estados Unidos 17. Samantha Francis encabezó la ofensiva estadounidense con 10 puntos, producto de siete ataques, dos bloqueos y un ace. Eva Hudson agregó nueve puntos, con siete ataques y dos aces. Por Guatemala, Melissa Guerra y Andrea Garcés anotaron cuatro puntos cada una.

Cuba 3, Costa Rica 0

Cuba cerró en tercer lugar del Grupo B y selló su clasificación a los cuartos de final al vencer en sets corridos a Costa. Cuba venció a Costa Rica 3-0 (25-16, 25-16, 25-15) para finalizar con récord de 2-2 y ocupar el tercer lugar del Grupo B. Costa Rica cerró la ronda preliminar sin victorias, con marca de 0-4, y continuará en los partidos de clasificación por las posiciones 7-10. El conjunto cubano tomó el control desde el primer set y estableció una ventaja temprana que le permitió manejar el marcador. Cuba mantuvo el dominio en el segundo parcial, mientras que Costa Rica presentó su mayor resistencia en el tercero.

Costa Rica llegó a tomar ventaja 12-11 en el tercer set y se mantuvo igualada con Cuba hasta el 13-13. A partir de ese momento, las cubanas recuperaron el control y se separaron en el marcador para completar la victoria en tres sets. Cuba marcó una amplia diferencia en ataque 38-20, además de imponerse en bloqueos 11-4 y puntos de servicio 6-1. Las cubanas cometieron 22 errores frente a 20 de Costa Rica. Whitney James encabezó la ofensiva de Cuba con 16 puntos y Dayana Martínez agregó 12. Por Costa Rica, Krystel Vargas y Joselyn Moraga anotaron seis puntos cada una.

Canadá 3, Nicaragua 0

Canadá salió victorioso del duelo directo ante Nicaragua que definía el tercer lugar del Grupo A y el pase a los cuartos de final. Canadá venció a Nicaragua 3-0 (25-13, 25-9, 25-18) para cerrar la fase de grupos con récord de 2-2 y quedarse con la tercera posición. Nicaragua finalizó con marca de 1-3 y continuará en la ronda de clasificación por las posiciones 7-10. Canadá se enfrentará en cuartos de final al perdedor del partido entre República Dominicana y Puerto Rico. Nicaragua enfrentará a Costa Rica el miércoles a las 2:00 p. m. en un partido de clasificación por las posiciones 7-10. Las canadienses marcaron la diferencia principalmente desde la red, donde no permitieron puntos de bloqueo a Nicaragua. Canadá terminó con ventaja de 34-21 en ataques y un contundente 10-0 en bloqueos, además de imponerse 6-2 en aces. Nicaragua cometió 25 errores frente a 17 de Canadá. Canadá controló el primer set 25-13 y, aunque Nicaragua se mantuvo cerca durante los primeros intercambios del segundo, las canadienses rápidamente abrieron distancia para dominarlo 25-9. Nicaragua presentó mayor resistencia en el tercero, pero Canadá volvió a establecer

una ventaja cómoda y cerró el encuentro 25-18. Emma Boyd tuvo una actuación completa para encabezar a Canadá con 13 puntos, distribuidos en seis ataques, cuatro bloqueos y tres aces. Jessica Andrews aportó otros 11 puntos, con siete ataques, dos bloqueos y dos aces. Josafat Díaz fue la máxima anotadora de Nicaragua con cinco puntos.

Puerto Rico 3, República Dominicana 1

Puerto Rico ganó el duelo caribeño ante República Dominicana que definía el primer lugar del Grupo A, para avanzar directamente a las semifinales. Puerto Rico se impuso 3-1 (25-22, 23-25, 25-16, 25-19) para completar invicto la fase de grupos con récord de 4-0. República Dominicana cerró con marca de 3-1 y ocupó el segundo lugar del grupo, por lo que disputará los cuartos de final el miércoles frente a Cuba a las 6:00 p. m. El primer set tuvo un cierre cerrado. Después de llegar empatados 21-21, Puerto Rico encontró respuestas en Dariana Hollingsworth y en el bloqueo de Ana Sofía Jusino para tomar ventaja 23-21. República Dominicana se acercó 23-22, pero las puertorriqueñas anotaron los últimos dos puntos y Hollingsworth selló el 25-22 con un ataque. República Dominicana respondió en el segundo set. En otro cierre apretado, los equipos llegaron igualados 21-21 y posteriormente 23-23, antes de que las dominicanas consiguieran los dos puntos finales para imponerse 25-23 y empatar el encuentro. Puerto Rico recuperó el control en el tercero. Con Hollingsworth liderando la ofensiva y el aporte de Valeria Vázquez e Ivania Ortiz, las puertorriqueñas establecieron una ventaja que República Dominicana no logró reducir. Hollingsworth cerró el parcial con un bloqueo para el 25-16. En el cuarto, Puerto Rico comenzó a despegarse después de un inicio equilibrado. Hollingsworth volvió a tener presencia constante en ataque, mientras Vázquez, Ortiz y Jusino también aportaron en la ofensiva. Las puertorriqueñas ampliaron la diferencia en la segunda mitad del set y mantuvieron el control hasta cerrarlo 25-19 y asegurar el pase directo a semifinales. Puerto Rico sostuvo ventaja en los principales fundamentos, superando a República Dominicana 59-51 en ataques, 9-5 en bloqueos y 5-0 en aces. Las dominicanas cometieron un error menos, 25 frente a 26 de Puerto Rico. Hollingsworth fue la máxima anotadora del encuentro con 30 puntos, producto de 26 ataques y cuatro bloqueos. Vázquez sumó 13 puntos, Ortiz aportó 12 y Jusino terminó con 11. Por República Dominicana, Flormarie Heredia encabezó la ofensiva con 20 puntos, todos en ataque, y fue la única jugadora dominicana que alcanzó doble dígito en anotación.
