LEÓN, Mexico, September 17, 2026.- The United States and Dominican Republic advanced to the final of the 2026 Women's Pan American Cup on Thursday after defeating Puerto Rico and Mexico, respectively, at the Domo de la Feria in León, Guanajuato. USA earned a 3-1 victory over Puerto Rico, while defending champion Dominican Republic rallied after dropping the opening set and held off Mexico's comeback to win in five sets.

The final is scheduled for Friday at 8:00 p.m., with Dominican Republic seeking its seventh gold medal and the United States its eighth. Two hours earlier, Mexico and Puerto Rico will meet again for bronze, as they did in the previous edition, with the hosts seeking their first medal in tournament history. Canada and Cuba will open Friday's schedule with the fifth-place match at 4:00 p.m.

Dominican Republic 3, Mexico 2 – Semifinal

Defending champion Dominican Republic rallied after losing the opening set and held off a Mexican comeback to win 3-2 (19-25, 25-21, 25-21, 20-25, 15-12) in the semifinals. The Dominicans will face the United States on Friday at 8:00 p.m., seeking their seventh gold medal. Dominican Republic has won six gold, 10 silver and three bronze medals in tournament history. Mexico, which forced a fifth set after trailing 2-1, will meet Puerto Rico in the bronze medal match on Friday at 6:00 p.m. The teams will face each other in the bronze medal match for the second consecutive edition, with the hosts seeking their first medal in the tournament. Mexico started strong and took the opening set 25-19. Dominican Republic responded with an offense led by Flormarie Heredia and Geraldine González's blocking to win the next two sets 25-21 and take a 2-1 lead. The Mexicans extended the match with a 25-20 win in the fourth set. Sofía Maldonado and Aimé Topete led the home team's offense, while Uxue Guereca scored the point that put Mexico ahead 24-19 before Topete closed out the set with a kill. In the deciding set, Dominican Republic took a 4-1 lead and later went ahead 9-6. Mexico fought back to tie the score at 11-11, but the Dominicans regained control. González blocked Topete for a 13-11 lead, and Massiel Matos scored the match-winning point to seal the 15-12 victory. Dominican Republic held a 60-57 advantage in attack points and a 15-11 edge in blocks. Mexico led 6-2 in aces and committed fewer unforced errors, 27 compared with 30. Heredia led Dominican Republic with 22 points on 20 kills, one block and one ace. González added 15 points, including a match-high eight blocks. Matos also scored 15 points, while Florangel Terrero contributed 14. Maldonado led all scorers with 24 points for Mexico, including 21 kills, two blocks and one ace. Topete added 17 points, and Guereca finished with 11.

United States 3, Puerto Rico 1 – Semifinal

The United States advanced to the final after defeating Puerto Rico 3-1 (25-18, 23-25, 28-26, 26-24). The U.S. will seek its eighth gold medal in tournament history. Puerto Rico will play for bronze for the second consecutive edition, aiming to earn its fifth bronze medal. Puerto Rico responded after losing the first set and took the second 25-23. The third set proved decisive: Puerto Rico held a 25-24 lead, but the United States fought back and eventually secured the set 28-26. In the fourth set, the U.S. led 16-12 before Puerto Rico closed the gap and tied the score at 23-23. Temitayo Thomas-Ailara put the Americans within one point of victory, but Ivania Ortiz leveled the score at 24-24. After a Puerto Rican error, Jessica Mruzik sealed the match with a kill for the 26-24 win. The United States held a 65-49 advantage in attack points and an 11-7 edge in blocks. The Americans also recorded the match's only ace. Puerto Rico

committed fewer errors, 25 compared with 37. Onyedikachi Ofoegbu led the United States with 19 points, including 13 kills and a match-high six blocks. Thomas-Ailara added 18 points, Callie Schwarzenbach contributed 15, including three blocks, and Mruzik finished with 10, all on kills. For Puerto Rico, Valeria Vázquez led the scoring with 17 points, followed by Dariana Hollingsworth with 14 and Ivania Ortiz with 11.

Venezuela 3, Costa Rica 2 – Final Positions 7/8

Venezuela claimed seventh place after defeating Costa Rica 3-2 (25-22, 25-23, 20-25, 20-25, 15-12). Venezuela finished the tournament with a 2-4 record, while Costa Rica placed eighth with a 1-5 record. Venezuela won the first two sets, but Costa Rica fought back to level the match and force a fifth set. In the tiebreaker, Venezuela built a 9-5 lead and held off a Costa Rican comeback that tied the score at 12-12 before winning the final three points, on two blocks by Lauria Vargas and a kill by Anarela Mejías. Daniela Azócar led Venezuela with 20 points, followed by Anarela Mejías with 19 and Amanda Pacheco with 17. Lauria Vargas contributed 12 points, and Antonella Lovera added 10. For Costa Rica, Krystel Vargas finished with 19 points, Joselyn Moraga added 18, and Lakysa Thompson and Valeria Campos contributed 11 each. The difference came in attack, where Venezuela outscored Costa Rica 72-49. The Central Americans held a 16-8 advantage in blocks, while both teams recorded three aces.

Nicaragua 3, Guatemala 0 – Final Positions 9/10

Nicaragua finished ninth at the 2026 Women's Pan American Cup after defeating Guatemala 3-0 (25-18, 25-20, 25-17). Nicaragua concluded the tournament with a 2-4 record, while Guatemala finished tenth with a 1-5 record. Nicaragua took control early, racing to a 7-0 lead in the opening set before winning it 25-18. Guatemala put up more resistance in the second set, but Nicaragua prevailed 25-20 to take a two-set lead. In the third set, Guatemala moved ahead 12-10, but Nicaragua responded with five consecutive points to take a 15-12 advantage. With Nicaragua leading 23-17, Josafat Díaz sealed the victory with two consecutive blocks. Nicaragua held advantage in attacks (38-27), blocks (8-4), and aces (4-3). The winners also committed fewer unforced errors, 21 to Guatemala's 25. Josafat Díaz led Nicaragua with 13 points, including nine kills and a match-high four blocks. María José Rivera contributed 12 points on ten kills and two blocks, while Brittany Forbes added 11 points, all on kills. For Guatemala, Melissa Guerra was the only player to reach double figures, finishing with ten points.

Estados Unidos y República Dominicana disputarán el oro

LEÓN, México, 17 de septiembre de 2026.- Estados Unidos y República Dominicana avanzaron este jueves a la final de la Copa Panamericana Femenina 2026, tras superar a Puerto Rico y México, respectivamente, en el Domo de la Feria de León, Guanajuato. Las estadounidenses vencieron a Puerto Rico 3-1, mientras que las dominicanas, campeonas defensoras, se recuperaron de perder el primer set y resistieron la reacción de México para imponerse en cinco sets.

La final se disputará el viernes a las 8:00 p. m. República Dominicana buscará su séptima medalla de oro y Estados Unidos, la octava. Dos horas antes, México y Puerto Rico volverán a enfrentarse por el bronce, como en la edición anterior, con las anfitrionas en busca de su primera medalla en el torneo. El partido por el quinto lugar abrirá la jornada a las 4:00 p.m. entre Canadá y Cuba.

República Dominicana 3, México 2 – Semifinal

República Dominicana remontó un set en contra y resistió la reacción de México para imponerse 3-2 (19-25, 25-21, 25-21, 20-25, 15-12) en las semifinales. Las campeonas defensoras enfrentarán a Estados Unidos el viernes a las 8:00 p. m., en busca de su séptima medalla de oro. República Dominicana acumula seis oros, diez platas y tres bronce en la historia del torneo. México, que forzó el quinto set después de quedar abajo 2-1, se medirá ante Puerto Rico el viernes a las 6:00 p. m. en el partido por el bronce. Ambos equipos disputarán este encuentro por segunda edición consecutiva y las anfitrionas buscarán su primera medalla en la Copa. México comenzó con mayor efectividad y se llevó el primer set 25-19. República Dominicana respondió con una ofensiva encabezada por Flormarie Heredia y el bloqueo de Geraldine González para ganar los dos siguientes por 25-21 y tomar ventaja de 2-1. Las mexicanas prolongaron el encuentro con una victoria de 25-20 en el cuarto set. Sofía Maldonado y Aimé Topete sostuvieron la ofensiva local, mientras Uxue Guereca anotó el punto que colocó a México arriba 24-19 y Topete cerró el set con un ataque. En el desempate, República Dominicana tomó ventaja de 4-1 y llegó a estar arriba 9-6. México reaccionó y empató 11-11, pero las dominicanas recuperaron el control: González bloqueó un ataque de Topete para el 13-11 y Massiel Matos anotó el punto que selló la victoria 15-12. República Dominicana superó a México 60-57 en puntos de ataque y 15-11 en bloqueos. Las anfitrionas tuvieron ventaja de 6-2 en servicios directos y cometieron menos errores no forzados, 27 frente a 30. Heredia encabezó la anotación dominicana con 22 puntos, producto de 20 ataques, un bloqueo y un ace. González sumó 15 puntos, incluidos ocho bloqueos, la mayor cantidad del encuentro. Matos también aportó 15 unidades y Florangel Terrero agregó 14. Maldonado fue la máxima anotadora del partido con 24 puntos para México: 21 de ataque, dos bloqueos y un ace. Topete contribuyó con 17 puntos y Guereca con 11.

Estados Unidos 3, Puerto Rico 1 – Semifinal

Estados Unidos avanzó a la final tras vencer a Puerto Rico 3-1 (25-18, 23-25, 28-26, 26-24). El conjunto estadounidense buscará su octava medalla de oro en la historia del torneo. Puerto Rico disputará el partido por el bronce por segunda edición consecutiva, con la posibilidad de obtener su quinta medalla de ese color. Puerto Rico respondió después de perder el primer set y se llevó el segundo 25-23. El tercero resultó decisivo: las puertorriqueñas llegaron a tener ventaja de 24-23, pero Estados Unidos igualó con un ataque de Jessica Mruzik. Onyedikachi Ofoegbu aportó dos puntos de ataque en el cierre y, tras un nuevo empate a 26, Temitayo Thomas-Ailara y Eva Hudson anotaron los dos puntos que dieron el set a Estados Unidos, 28-26. En el cuarto set, Estados Unidos llegó a estar arriba 16-12, pero Puerto Rico recortó la diferencia hasta empatar 23-23. Thomas-Ailara puso a las estadounidenses a un punto de la victoria; Ivania Ortiz igualó 24-24 y, después de un error puertorriqueño, Mruzik cerró el partido con un ataque para el 26-24. Estados Unidos dominó 65-49 en puntos de ataque y 11-7 en bloqueos. También registró el único punto de servicio directo del encuentro. Puerto Rico cometió menos errores no forzados, 25 frente a 37 de su rival. Onyedikachi Ofoegbu fue la máxima anotadora estadounidense con 19 puntos, incluidos 13 de ataque y seis bloqueos, la mayor cantidad del partido. Temitayo Thomas-Ailara sumó 18 puntos, Callie Schwarzenbach aportó 15, incluidos tres bloqueos, y Jessica Mruzik terminó con 10, todos de ataque. Por Puerto Rico, Valeria Vázquez encabezó la ofensiva con 17 puntos, seguida por Dariana Hollingsworth con 14 e Ivania Ortiz con 11.

Venezuela 3, Costa Rica 2 – Posición Final 7/8

Venezuela se quedó con el séptimo lugar tras vencer a Costa Rica 3-2 (25-22, 25-23, 20-25, 20-25, 15-12). Las venezolanas cerraron su participación con récord de 2-4, mientras que

Costa Rica finalizó octava con marca de 1-5. Venezuela ganó los dos primeros sets, pero Costa Rica reaccionó para igualar el encuentro y forzar un quinto set. En el desempate, las sudamericanas tomaron ventaja de 9-5 y resistieron la reacción costarricense, que empató el marcador 12-12, antes de asegurar los últimos tres puntos del partido, con dos bloqueos de Lauria Vargas y un ataque de Anarela Mejías. Daniela Azócar encabezó la ofensiva venezolana con 20 puntos, seguida por Anarela Mejías con 19 y Amanda Pacheco con 17. Lauria Vargas aportó 12 unidades y Antonella Lovera sumó 10. Por Costa Rica, Krystel Vargas terminó con 19 puntos, Joselyn Moraga agregó 18, mientras que Lakysa Thompson y Valeria Campos contribuyeron con 11 cada una. La diferencia estuvo en el ataque, donde Venezuela superó a Costa Rica 72-49. Las centroamericanas dominaron el bloqueo 16-8 y ambos equipos registraron tres puntos de servicio directo.

Nicaragua 3, Guatemala 0 – Posición Final 9/10

Nicaragua finalizó en el noveno lugar de la Copa Panamericana Femenina 2026 tras vencer a Guatemala 3-0 (25-18, 25-20, 25-17). El conjunto nicaragüense cerró su participación con récord de 2-4, mientras que Guatemala ocupó la décima posición con marca de 1-5.

Nicaragua tomó el control desde el inicio del encuentro con una ventaja de 7-0 en el primer set, que ganó 25-18. Guatemala ofreció mayor resistencia en el segundo, pero las nicaragüenses se impusieron 25-20 para tomar ventaja de dos sets. En el tercer set, Guatemala llegó a colocarse adelante 12-10, pero Nicaragua respondió con una racha de cinco puntos consecutivos para tomar ventaja de 15-12. Con el marcador 23-17, Josafat Díaz selló la victoria con dos bloqueos consecutivos. Nicaragua dominó con ventaja de 38-27 en ataques, 8-4 en bloqueos y 4-3 en puntos de servicio directo. Además, cometió 21 errores no forzados frente a 25 de Guatemala. Josafat Díaz encabezó la ofensiva nicaragüense con 13 puntos, incluidos nueve ataques y cuatro bloqueos, la mayor cantidad del encuentro. María José Rivera aportó 12 unidades, con diez ataques y dos bloqueos, mientras que Brittany Forbes sumó 11 puntos, todos de ataque. Por Guatemala, Melissa Guerra fue la única jugadora que alcanzó doble dígito, con diez puntos.
