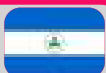

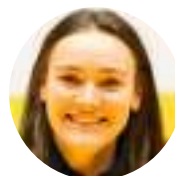

USA Defeats Dominican Republic to Reclaim Pan American Cup Gold

LEÓN, Mexico, September 18, 2026.- The United States returned to the top of the Women's Pan American Cup podium for the first time since 2019, defeating defending champion Dominican Republic 3-0 (28-26, 25-19, 25-18) on Friday to claim the 2026 title in León, Guanajuato.

The victory gave USA its eighth gold medal in tournament history, adding to three silvers and five bronzes. Dominican Republic finished with its 11th silver medal and now holds six golds, 11 silvers and three bronzes.

The opening set provided the final's most dramatic moments. USA reached set point at 24-21 after an attack by Caitlin Baird, but Dominican Republic fought back, with a block by Florangel Terrero helping level the score at 24-24. Temitayo Thomas-Ailara restored the American lead, and Flormarie Heredia answered for the Dominicans. Callie Schwarzenbach then put USA ahead 26-25 with a kill, before Heredia tied it again. Two Dominican errors finally gave USA the set, 28-26.

USA carried that momentum into the second set, building a lead that Dominican Republic could not erase. Thomas-Ailara delivered a kill for a 24-19 advantage, and a Dominican attacking error ended the set 25-19.

The third set was close early, but USA pulled away behind its offense. Jessica Mruzik and Claire Hoffman contributed key attacks as the Americans extended their lead. Schwarzenbach delivered the final point with a kill to seal the championship, 25-18.

USA held a 56-35 advantage in attack points and led 3-1 in aces. Dominican Republic had the edge in blocks, 8-5, and committed fewer errors, giving away 14 points compared with USA's 20.

Four American players scored in double figures. Schwarzenbach led the team with 15 points, followed by Mruzik and Thomas-Ailara with 12 each, and Baird with 10. Heredia led all scorers with 16 points for Dominican Republic.

Mexico 3, Puerto Rico 1 – Bronze Medal Match

Mexico bounced back from its semifinal defeat to claim the bronze medal defeating Puerto Rico 3-1 (20-25, 25-20, 25-23, 28-26). The result marks Mexico's first medal in Women's Pan American Cup history. Mexico won silver at the 2021 Women's Pan American Cup Final Six, an event later recognized as the inaugural NORCECA Women's Final Six. Puerto Rico took the opening set 25-20, but Mexico responded to win the second 25-20. The third set remained close until the final points, when Uxue Guereca delivered an attack to give Mexico a 24-22 lead. Puerto Rico saved one set point before a service error handed Mexico the set 25-23. The fourth set produced a dramatic finish. Mexico reached match point at 24-23, but Puerto Rico's Dariana Hollingsworth kept her team alive with an attack. Coming off the bench, Sofía Maldonado put Mexico ahead 25-24, only for Hollingsworth to level the score again. Grecia Castro struck to give Mexico another match point at 26-25; Puerto Rico tied it once more before Castro's next attack made it 27-26. A Puerto Rican error on the final rally sealed Mexico's historic bronze medal, 28-26. Mexico led 59-47 in attack points and 3-1 in aces, while both teams recorded 11 blocks. Puerto Rico committed fewer errors, 25 to Mexico's 35. Castro led all scorers with 22 points. Guereca contributed 17, Aimé Topete added 11 and Jocelyn

Urías finished with 10. Hollingsworth led Puerto Rico with 17 points, followed by Paola Santiago with 11.

Canada 3, Cuba 0 – Positions 5/6

Canada secured fifth place with a 3-0 (25-22, 25-20, 25-16) victory over Cuba. Canada faced resistance from Cuba in the opening set, with Evilania Martínez leading the Cuban offense, before securing a 25-22 win. The Canadians maintained their advantage in the second set, taking it 25-20, and Emoni Bush led the charge in the third as Canada pulled away to seal the match 25-16. Canada held the advantage in attacks (44-34) and blocks (6-1), while both teams recorded two aces. The Canadians committed 21 errors, compared to Cuba's 22. Emoni Bush led Canada with a match-high 18 points, followed by Payton Henderson with 10. For Cuba, Evilania Martínez scored 15 points and Whitney James added 10.

Estados Unidos vence a República Dominicana y recupera el oro de la Copa Panamericana Femenina

LEÓN, México, 18 de septiembre de 2026.- Estados Unidos regresó a lo más alto del podio de la Copa Panamericana Femenina por primera vez desde 2019, tras derrotar a República Dominicana, campeona defensora, 3-0 (28-26, 25-19, 25-18) este viernes en León, Guanajuato.

La victoria le dio a Estados Unidos su octava medalla de oro en la historia del torneo, que se suma a tres platas y cinco bronce. República Dominicana obtuvo su undécima medalla de plata y acumula seis oros, once platas y tres bronce.

El primer set tuvo los momentos más intensos de la final. Estados Unidos llegó al punto para set con ventaja de 24-21, después de un ataque de Caitlin Baird, pero República Dominicana reaccionó y un bloqueo de Florangel Terrero contribuyó a empatar el marcador 24-24. Temitayo Thomas-Ailara devolvió la ventaja a las estadounidenses y Flormarie Heredia respondió por las dominicanas. Callie Schwarzenbach puso a Estados Unidos adelante 26-25 con un ataque, antes de que Heredia igualara nuevamente. Dos errores dominicanos le dieron finalmente el set a Estados Unidos, 28-26.

Estados Unidos mantuvo el impulso en el segundo set y construyó una ventaja que República Dominicana no pudo remontar. Thomas-Ailara anotó con un ataque para colocar el marcador 24-19 y un error de ataque dominicano cerró el set 25-19.

El tercer set comenzó parejo, pero Estados Unidos se distanció gracias a su ofensiva. Jessica Mruzik y Claire Hoffman aportaron ataques importantes para ampliar la ventaja estadounidense. Schwarzenbach anotó el último punto con un ataque y selló el campeonato con marcador de 25-18.

Estados Unidos dominó 56-35 en puntos de ataque y 3-1 en servicios directos. República Dominicana tuvo ventaja de 8-5 en bloqueos y cometió menos errores, al conceder 14 puntos frente a los 20 de Estados Unidos.

Cuatro jugadoras estadounidenses anotaron en doble dígito. Schwarzenbach encabezó al equipo con 15 puntos, seguida por Mruzik y Thomas-Ailara, con 12 cada una, y Baird, con 10. Heredia fue la máxima anotadora del encuentro con 16 puntos para República Dominicana.

México 3, Puerto Rico 1 – Partido Medalla de Bronce

México se recuperó de su derrota en semifinales y conquistó la medalla de bronce al vencer este viernes a Puerto Rico 3-1 (20-25, 25-20, 25-23, 28-26). El resultado representa la primera medalla de México en la historia de la Copa Panamericana Femenina. En 2021, México obtuvo la plata en la Copa Panamericana Final Six Femenina, competencia que posteriormente fue reconocida como la primera edición del Final Six Femenino de NORCECA. Puerto Rico se llevó el primer set 25-20, pero México reaccionó para ganar el segundo por idéntico marcador. El tercer parcial se mantuvo cerrado hasta los puntos finales, cuando un ataque de Uxue Guereca puso a México arriba 24-22. Puerto Rico salvó un punto para set, antes de que un error de servicio le diera a México el parcial 25-23. El cuarto set tuvo un cierre dramático. México llegó al punto para partido con ventaja de 24-23, pero Dariana Hollingsworth mantuvo con vida a Puerto Rico con un ataque. Sofía Maldonado, quien ingresó desde la banca, puso entonces a México adelante 25-24, aunque Hollingsworth volvió a igualar el marcador. Grecia Castro consiguió el 26-25 para México y Puerto Rico empató una vez más. Castro respondió con otro ataque para el 27-26 y un error puertorriqueño en la última jugada selló el histórico bronce mexicano, 28-26. México dominó 59-47 en puntos de ataque y 3-1 en servicios directos, mientras que ambos equipos registraron 11 puntos de bloqueo. Puerto Rico cometió menos errores, 25 frente a 35 de México. Castro fue la máxima anotadora del encuentro con 22 puntos. Guereca contribuyó con 17, Aimé Topete sumó 11 y Jocelyn Urías terminó con 10. Hollingsworth encabezó a Puerto Rico con 17 puntos, seguida de Paola Santiago con 11.

Canadá 3, Cuba 0 – Posiciones 5/6

Canadá aseguró el quinto lugar tras vencer a Cuba 3-0 (25-22, 25-20, 25-16). Canadá encontró resistencia de Cuba en el primer set, con Evilania Martínez liderando la ofensiva cubana, antes de imponerse 25-22. Las canadienses mantuvieron su ventaja en el segundo set, que ganaron 25-20, y Emoni Bush encabezó el ataque en el tercero, cuando Canadá amplió la diferencia para sellar la victoria 25-16. Canadá tuvo ventaja en puntos de ataque (44-34) y bloqueos (6-1), mientras que ambos equipos registraron dos servicios directos. Las canadienses cometieron 21 errores, frente a 22 de Cuba. Emoni Bush lideró a Canadá con 18 puntos, la mayor cantidad del encuentro, seguida por Payton Henderson con 10. Por Cuba, Evilania Martínez anotó 15 puntos y Whitney James agregó 10.
