New Challenge, Same Goal at the NORCECA Women's Final Six

ZINACANTEPEC, Mexico, September 20, 2026. – Just days after competing at the 2026 Women's Pan American Cup in León, Guanajuato, six teams are ready for a new challenge as the NORCECA Women's Final Six gets underway on September 21 at the Unidad Deportiva Juan Fernández Albarrán in Zinacantepec, Estado de México.

Canada, Cuba, Dominican Republic, Mexico, Puerto Rico and the United States will compete through September 27, bringing different objectives to the tournament. While Pan American Cup champion USA looks to continue its winning form, the other teams aim to build on their recent performances, develop their players and pursue a place on the podium.

Ahead of the competition, the six head coaches shared their expectations for the tournament, highlighting the challenges of competing in back-to-back events and the opportunities this new competition presents for their teams.

Carolyn O'Dwyer, Canada Head Coach: "This is a completely different group from the one that competed at the Pan American Cup. Canada is being represented by the University of Alberta, one of our top collegiate programs. It will be a valuable experience for these athletes and certainly a challenging tournament, but we are looking forward to seeing how the team develops throughout the competition. We have a young group with limited international experience. A few players have competed at the U19 and U21 levels, but this will be their first experience at the senior international level. There will definitely be a learning curve, and we are excited to see how they grow throughout the tournament."

Luizomar de Moura, Cuba Head Coach: "Our main goal is to continue the rebuilding process of the Cuban national team. That is why competing in high-level tournaments like this one is essential. It allows our players to adapt to the demands of international competition and strengthen our project, tournament after tournament. At the Pan American Cup, we used two very young setters, and it is important for them to gain playing time and receive support from the attackers as they continue to mature. Every international experience is a valuable opportunity for their development as players and for the growth of the team."

Marcos Kwiek, Dominican Republic Head Coach: "The competition will be more selective compared to the Pan American Cup, with only six teams participating. With the exception of Canada, which is fielding a different roster, all the teams are familiar with one another. However, this is a new competition, and the players arrive with a different mindset. We played at a good level at the Pan American Cup and achieved our goal. Now we hope to continue improving, keep working, and provide new opportunities for our players to develop individually, which is one of our main objectives."

Juan Carlos Núñez, Puerto Rico Head Coach: "This is our final tournament of the year, and we arrive after a long summer that began with the Final Four in May. Many of our players are dealing with physical and emotional fatigue, but we are here to complete our competition schedule and compete with the highest possible expectations. Our goal is to finish among the top four teams and have the opportunity to compete for a medal. We are also looking to earn

valuable world ranking points in the matches where we have the opportunity to do so, as well as NORCECA ranking points that will help us in our pursuit of qualification for the Pan American Games.”

Nicola Negro, Mexico Head Coach: “This is the final competition of a very demanding schedule. We arrive after a Pan American Cup that required a lot of energy, and we could have up to seven matches ahead of us if we reach the finals. That is why managing our players’ workload throughout the week will be essential, along with staying focused and taking it one match at a time.”

Erik Sullivan, USA Head Coach: “New challenge, same goal. We’re excited to be competing again. Our team always enjoys the opportunity to play and compete at this level. Now that the teams know each other a little better after the Pan American Cup, I think this tournament will be even more interesting. It’s another great opportunity for us, and our goal remains the same: to win the tournament.”

Nuevo reto, misma meta en el Final Six Femenino de NORCECA

ZINACANTEPEC, México, 20 de septiembre de 2026. – Apenas unos días después de competir en la Copa Panamericana Femenina 2026 en León, Guanajuato, seis equipos se preparan para un nuevo reto con el inicio del Final Six Femenino de NORCECA, el 21 de septiembre, en la Unidad Deportiva Juan Fernández Albarrán de Zinacantepec, Estado de México.

Canadá, Cuba, Estados Unidos, México, Puerto Rico y República Dominicana competirán hasta el 27 de septiembre, cada uno con objetivos diferentes. Mientras que Estados Unidos, campeón de la Copa Panamericana, buscará mantener su buen momento, los demás equipos intentarán aprovechar sus recientes actuaciones, desarrollar a sus jugadoras y luchar por un lugar en el podio.

Previo al inicio de la competencia, los seis entrenadores compartieron sus expectativas para el torneo, destacando los desafíos de disputar dos eventos consecutivos y las oportunidades que esta nueva competencia representa para sus equipos.

Carolyn O’Dwyer, entrenadora de Canadá: “Este es un grupo completamente diferente al que compitió en la Copa Panamericana. Canadá estará representado por la Universidad de Alberta, uno de nuestros principales programas universitarios. Será una experiencia muy valiosa para estas jugadoras y, sin duda, un torneo exigente, pero tenemos muchas expectativas de ver cómo evoluciona el equipo a lo largo de la competencia. Contamos con un grupo joven y con experiencia internacional limitada. Algunas jugadoras han participado en competencias de las categorías Sub-19 y Sub-21, pero esta será su primera experiencia internacional a nivel mayor. Sin duda, habrá un proceso de aprendizaje y estamos entusiasmados por ver cómo crecen durante el torneo”.

Luizomar de Moura, entrenador de Cuba: “Nuestro principal objetivo es continuar con el proceso de reconstrucción de la selección cubana. Por eso, es fundamental participar en competencias de alto nivel como esta, que permiten a las jugadoras adaptarse a las exigencias internacionales y consolidar nuestro proyecto, torneo tras torneo. En la Copa Panamericana utilizamos a dos colocadoras muy jóvenes, y es importante que acumulen

tiempo de juego y cuenten con el apoyo de las atacantes en su proceso de maduración. Cada experiencia internacional es una oportunidad valiosa para su desarrollo como jugadoras y para el crecimiento del equipo”.

Marcos Kwiek, entrenador de República Dominicana: “La competencia será más selectiva en comparación con la Copa Panamericana, ya que ahora participan únicamente seis equipos. Con excepción de Canadá, que presenta un plantel diferente, todos los equipos se conocen. Sin embargo, esta es una nueva competencia y las jugadoras llegan con un estado de ánimo distinto. En la Copa Panamericana mostramos un buen nivel y cumplimos nuestro objetivo. Ahora esperamos seguir mejorando, continuar trabajando y brindar nuevas oportunidades a las jugadoras para que puedan desarrollarse individualmente, que es uno de nuestros principales objetivos”.

Nicola Negro, entrenador de México: “Esta es la última competencia de un calendario muy exigente. Llegamos después de una Copa Panamericana que nos demandó mucha energía y tenemos por delante hasta siete partidos si avanzamos a las finales. Por eso, será fundamental administrar el esfuerzo de las jugadoras a lo largo de la semana, mantener el enfoque e ir partido a partido”.

Juan Carlos Núñez, entrenador de Puerto Rico: “Este es nuestro último torneo del año y llegamos después de un verano largo, que comenzó con el Final Four en mayo. Muchas jugadoras acumulan cansancio físico y emocional, pero venimos a cumplir con nuestro calendario y a competir con las mayores expectativas posibles. Nuestro objetivo es terminar entre los cuatro mejores equipos del torneo para tener la oportunidad de disputar una medalla. También buscamos sumar puntos importantes para el ranking mundial en los enfrentamientos que nos permitan hacerlo, así como puntos a nivel de NORCECA que contribuyan a nuestra clasificación a los Juegos Panamericanos”.

Erik Sullivan, entrenador de Estados Unidos: “Nuevo reto, misma meta. Estamos entusiasmados de volver a competir. Nuestro equipo siempre disfruta la oportunidad de jugar y competir a este nivel. Ahora que los equipos se conocen un poco mejor después de la Copa Panamericana, creo que este torneo será aún más interesante. Es otra gran oportunidad para nosotros y nuestro objetivo sigue siendo el mismo: ganar el torneo”.
